FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

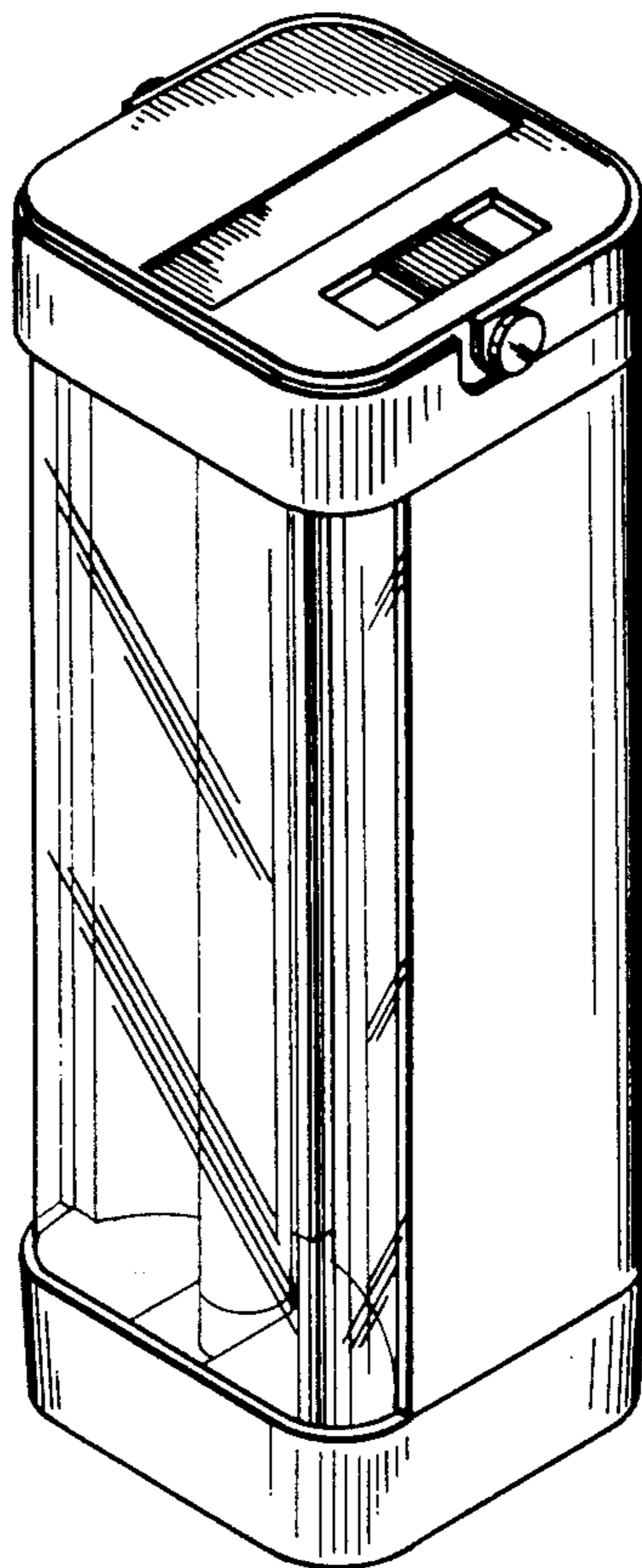
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.



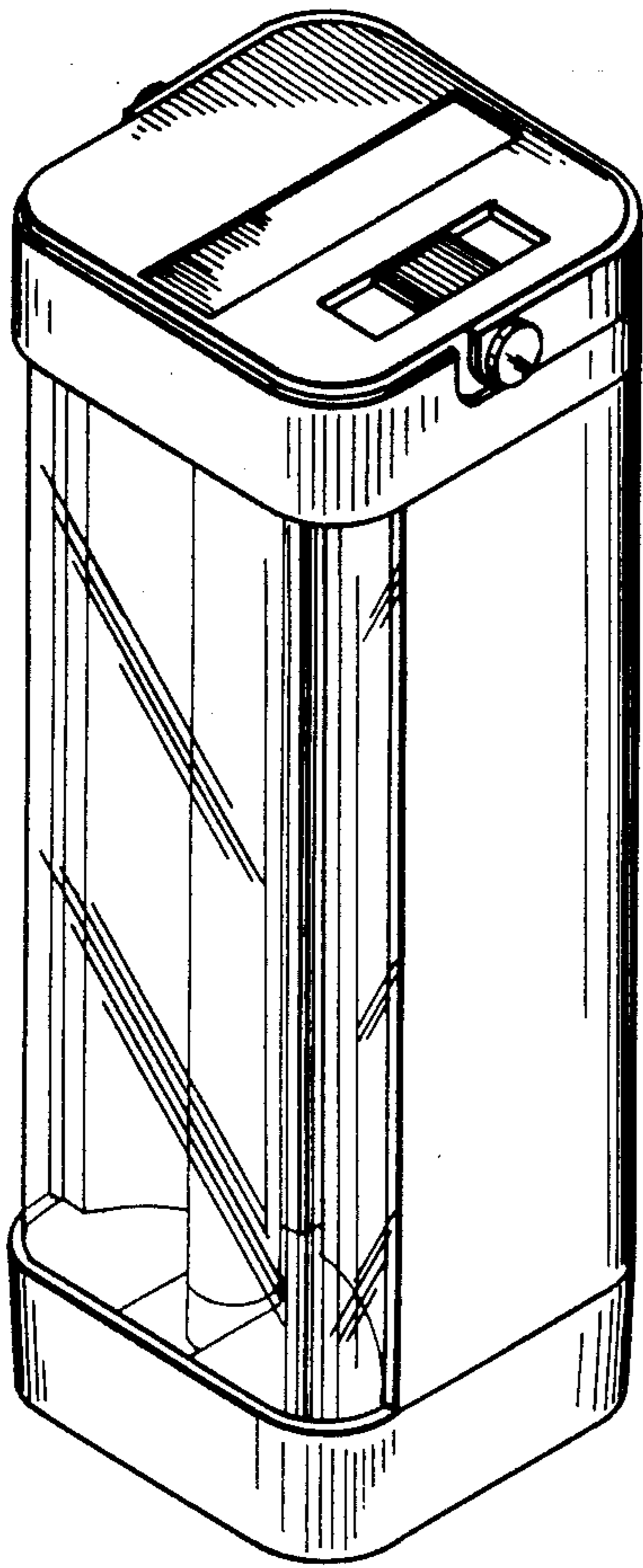

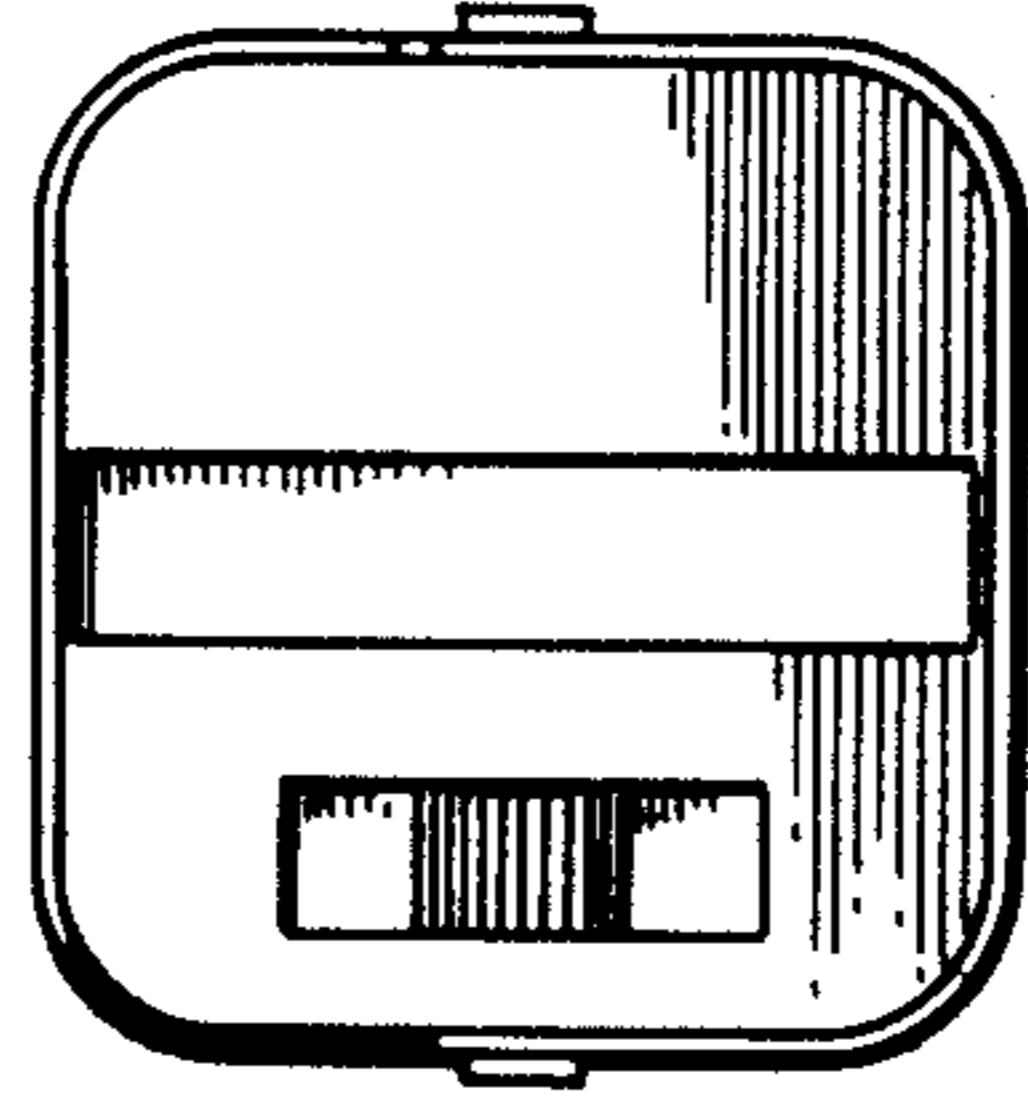

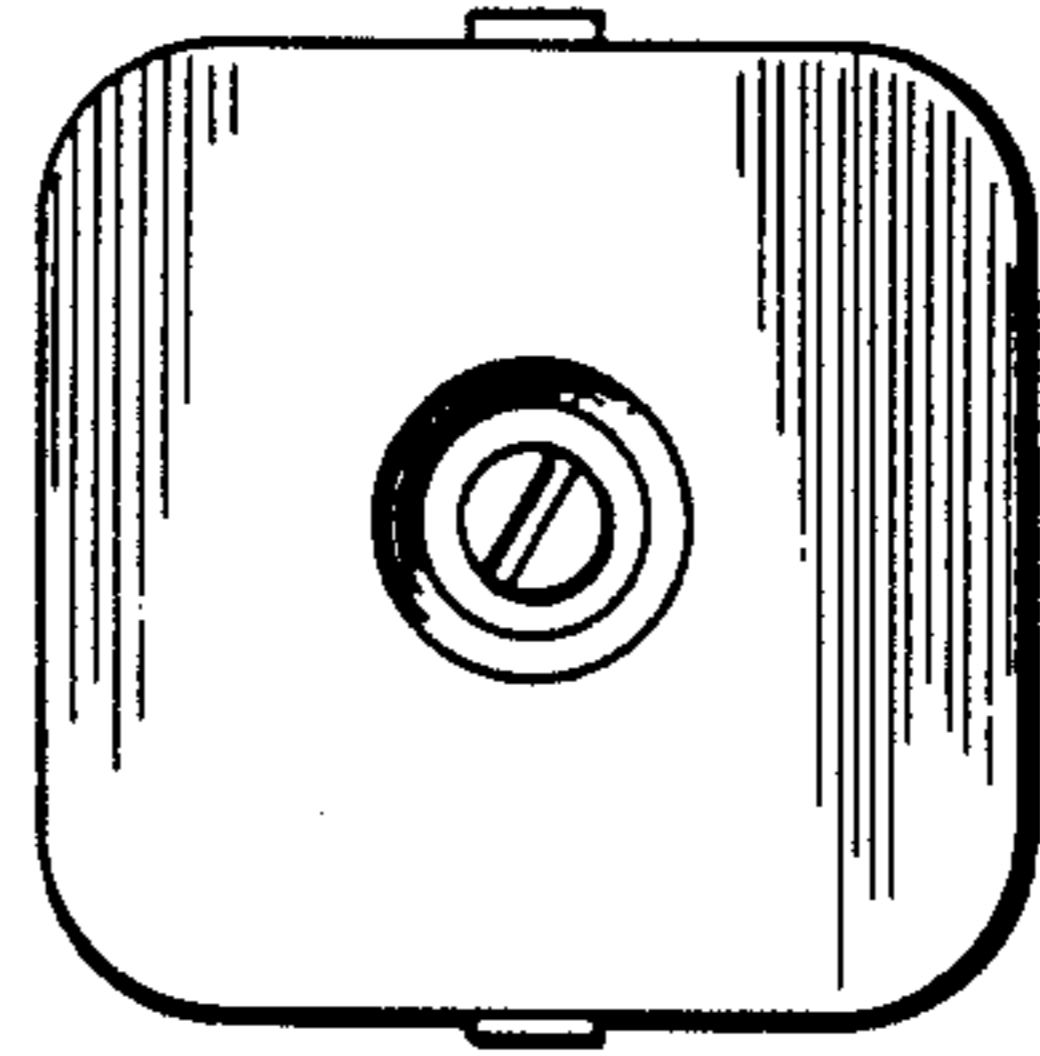

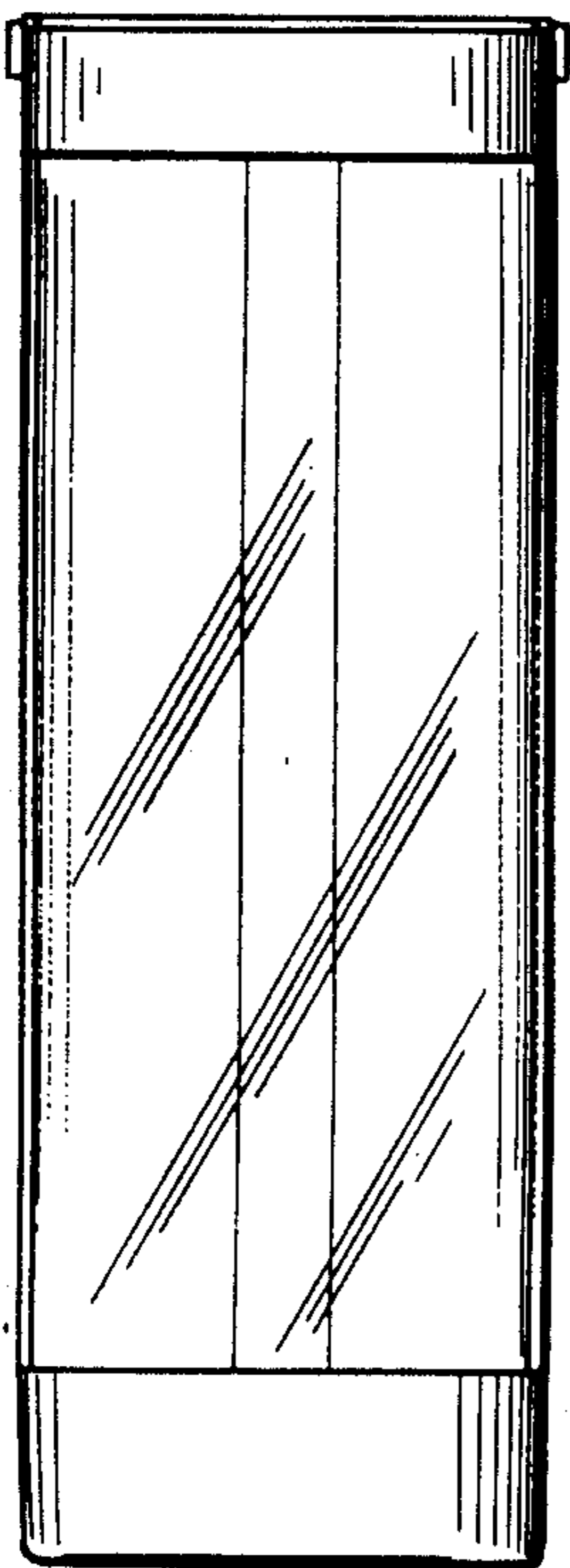

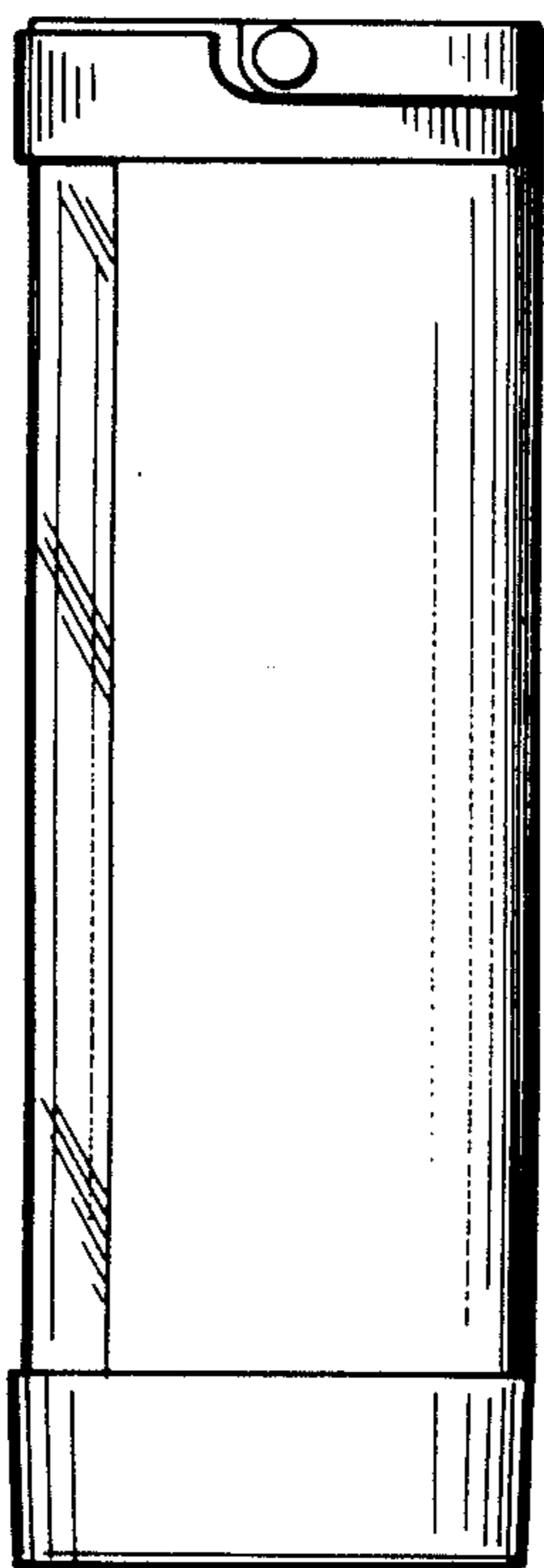

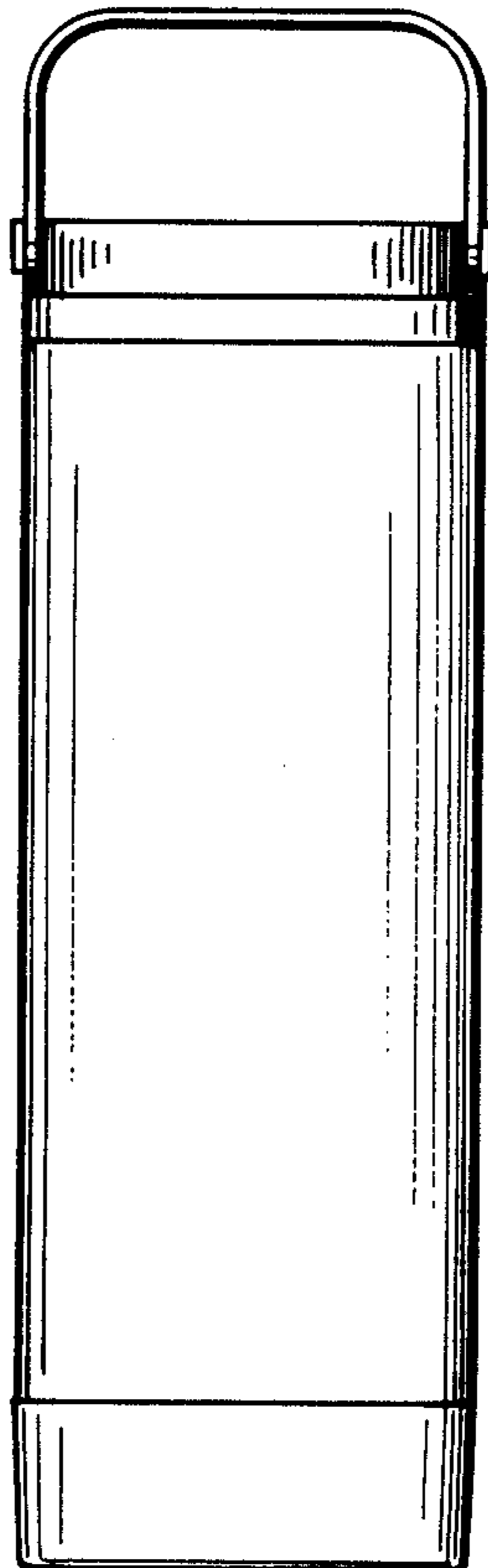

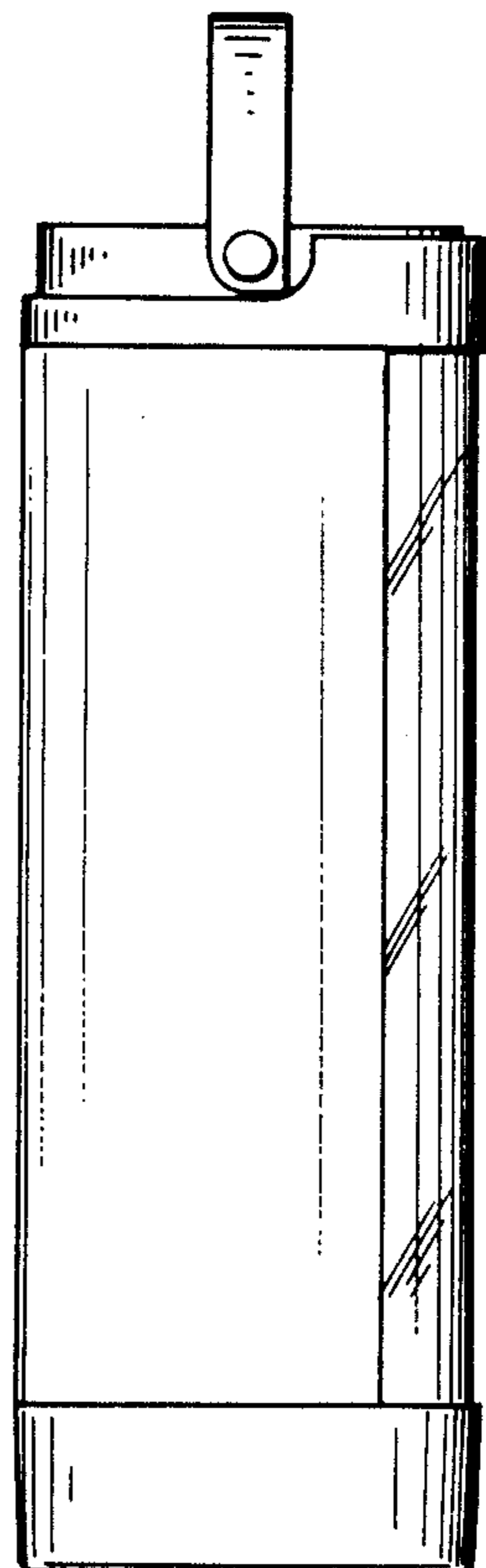
