[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a foldable chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a foldable chair embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the chair shown in its folded position;
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the chair shown in its folded position;
 FIG. 9 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the present invention, the corresponding side elevational views being substantially similar to FIG. 7;
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the alternate embodiment;
 FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of the alternate embodiment shown in its folded position.

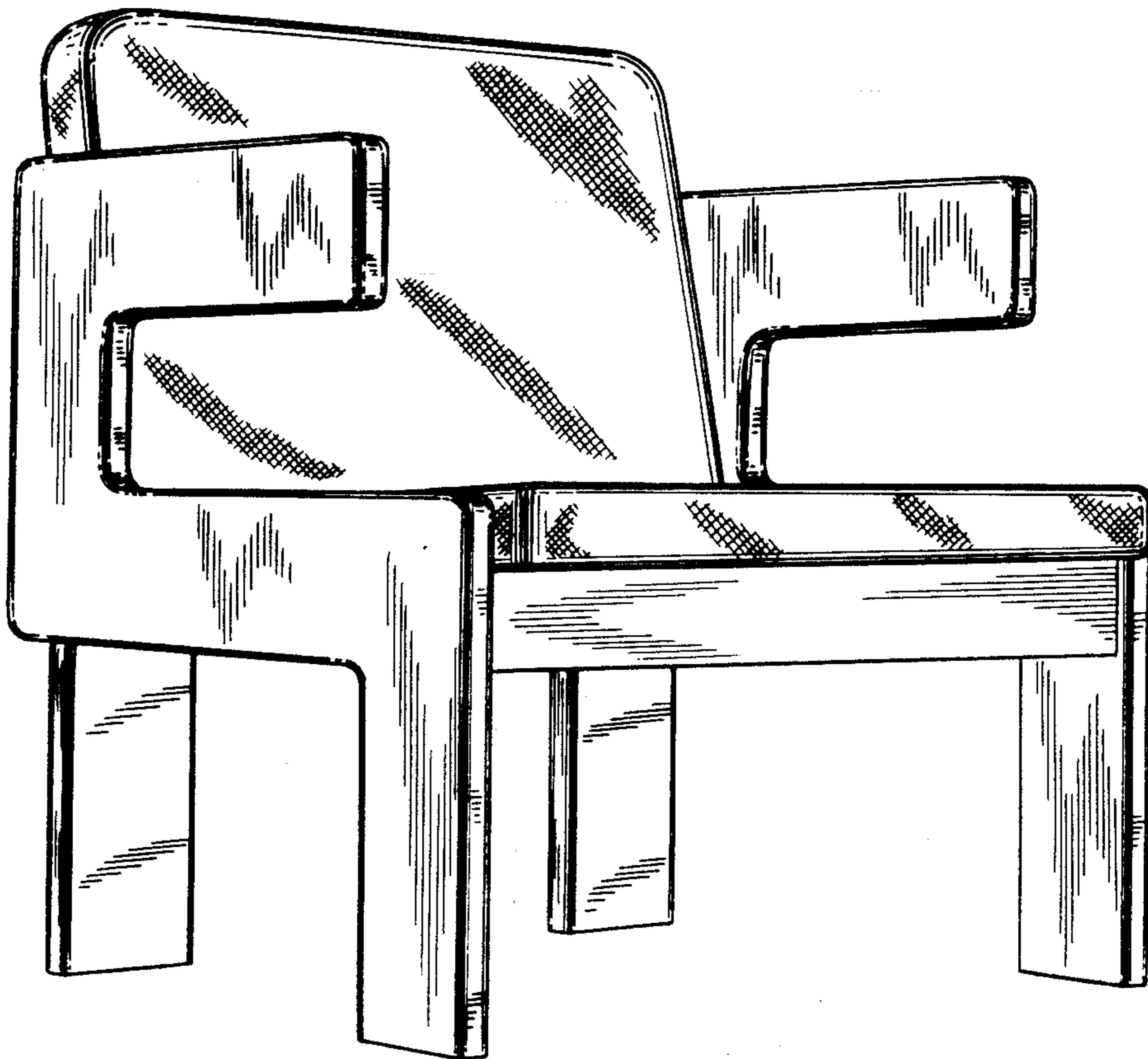

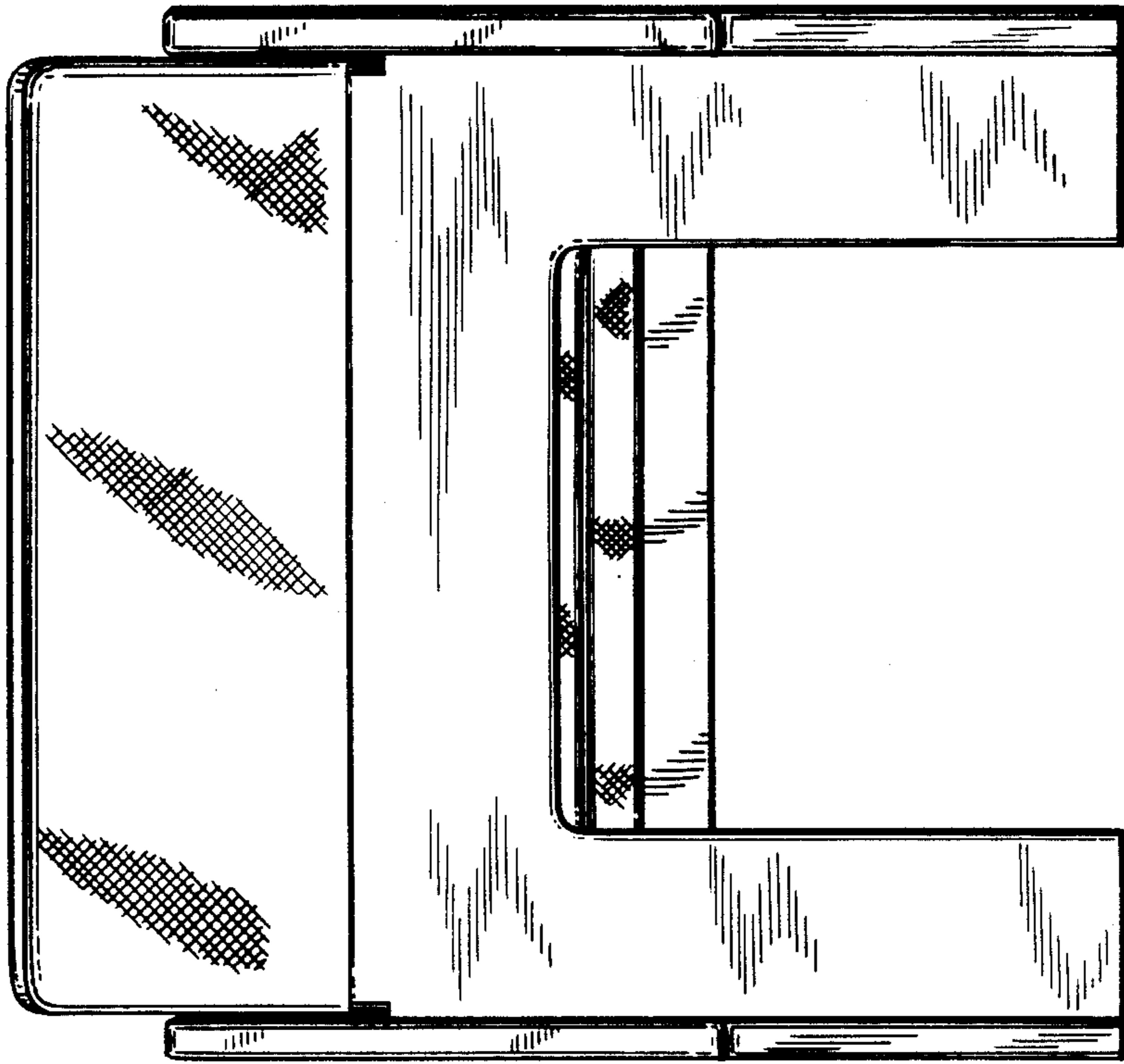

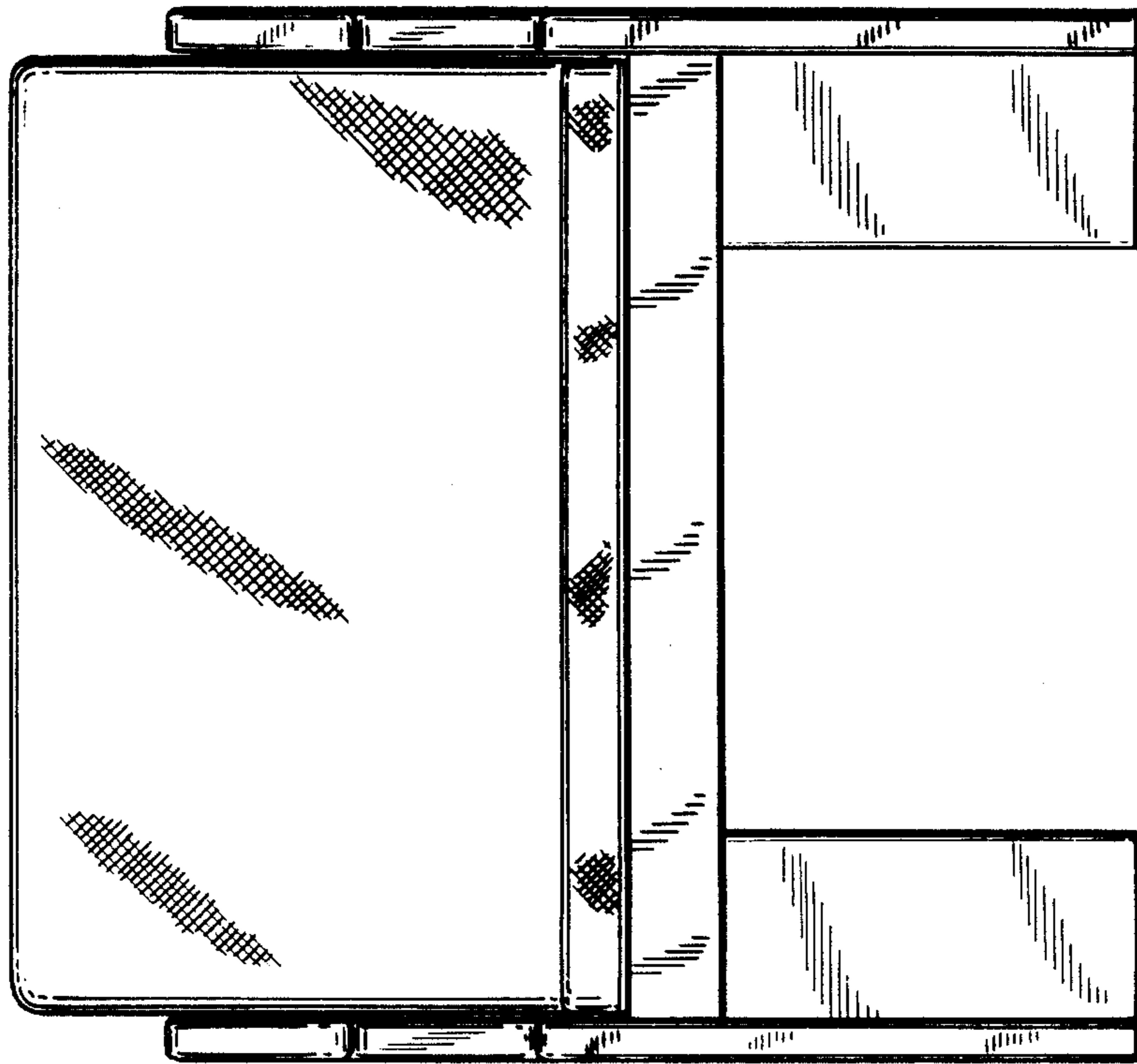

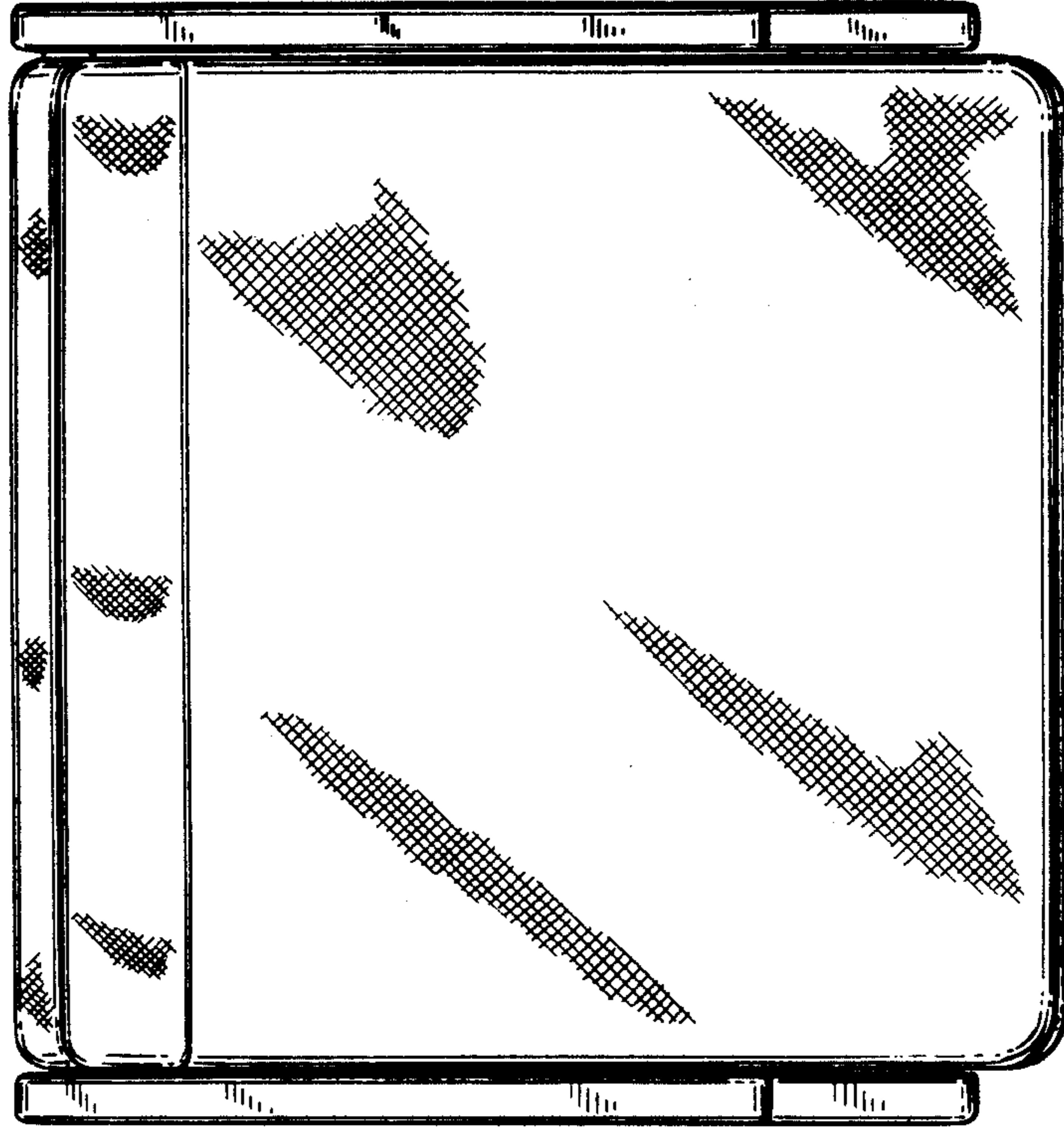

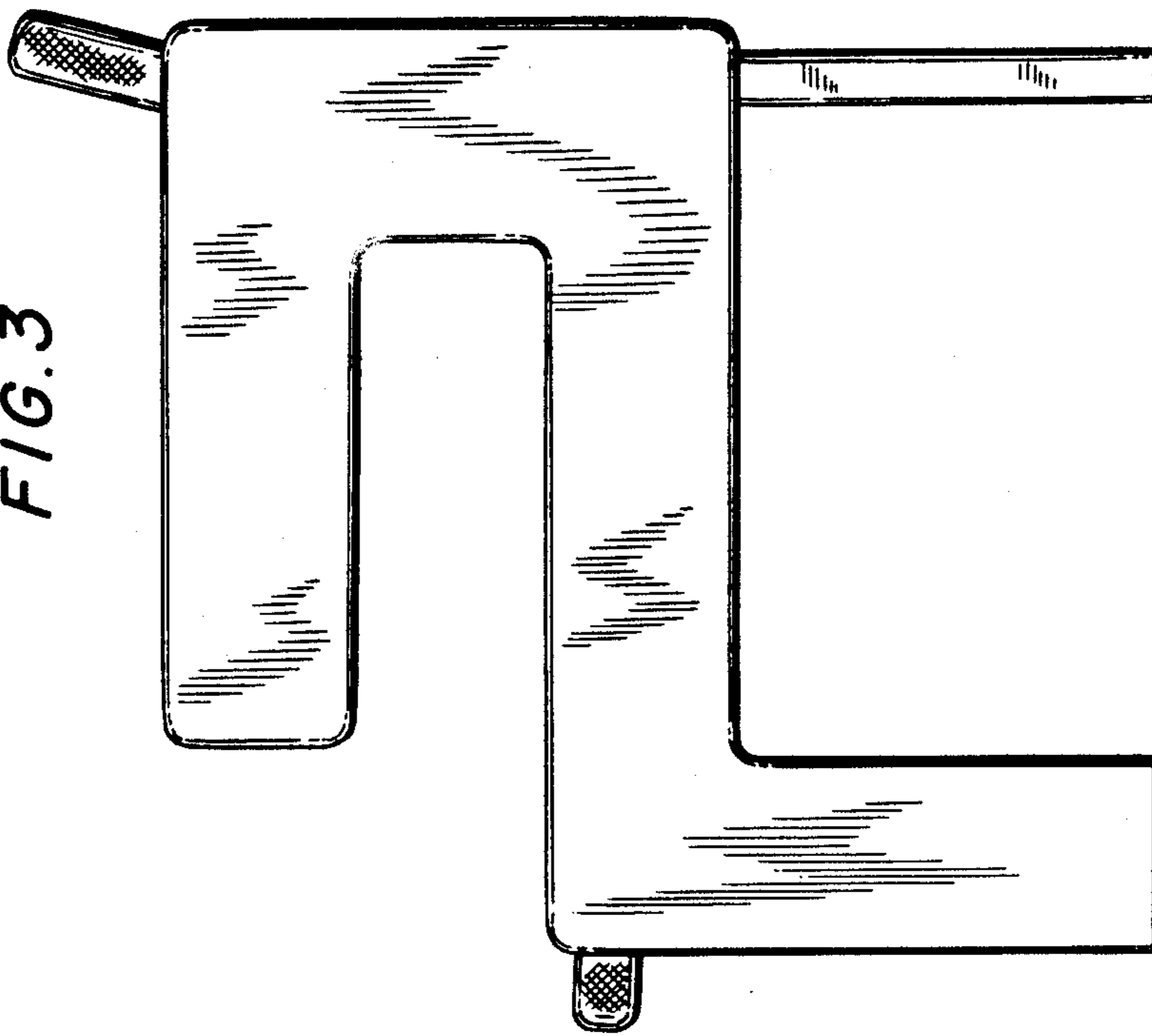

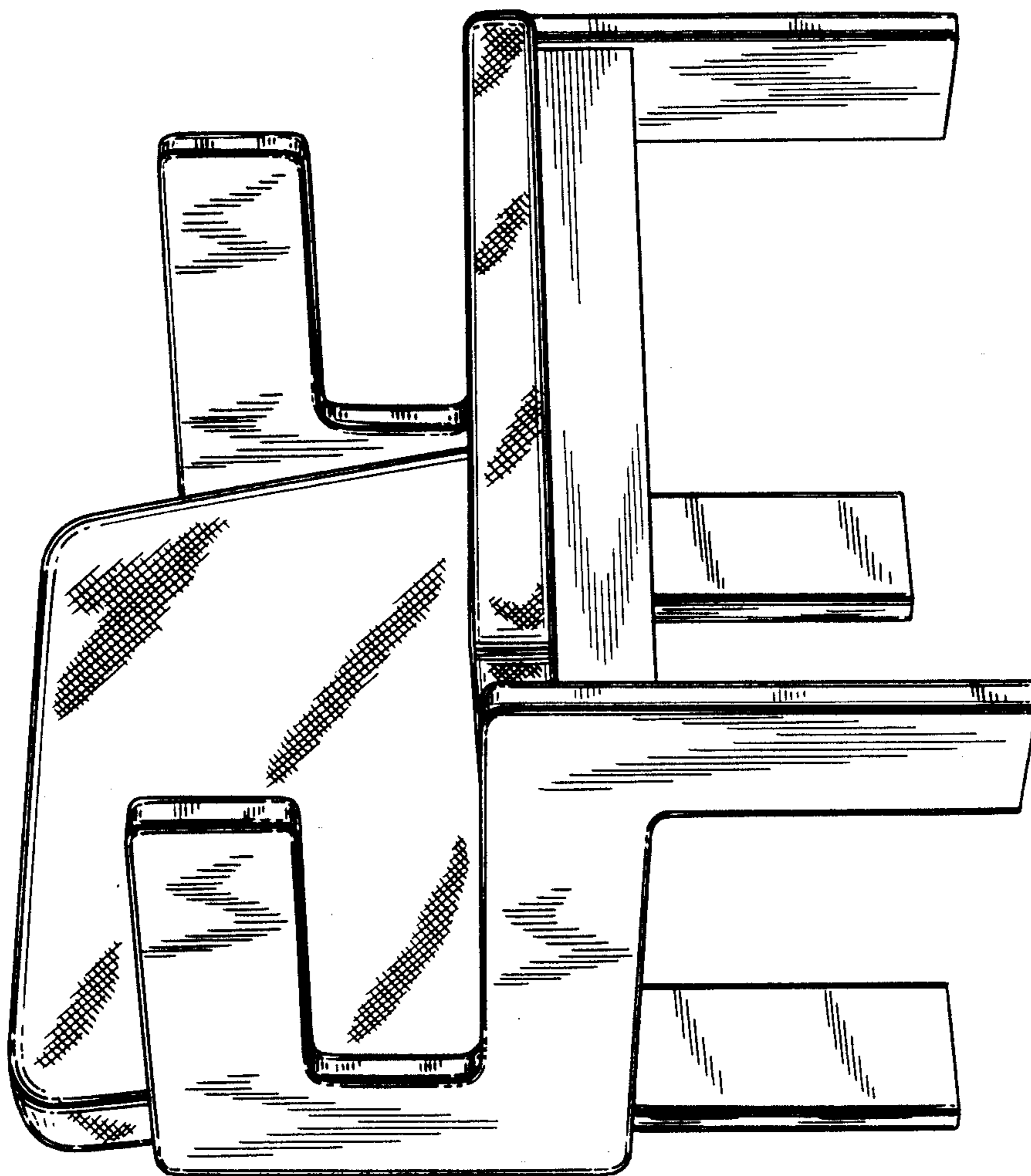

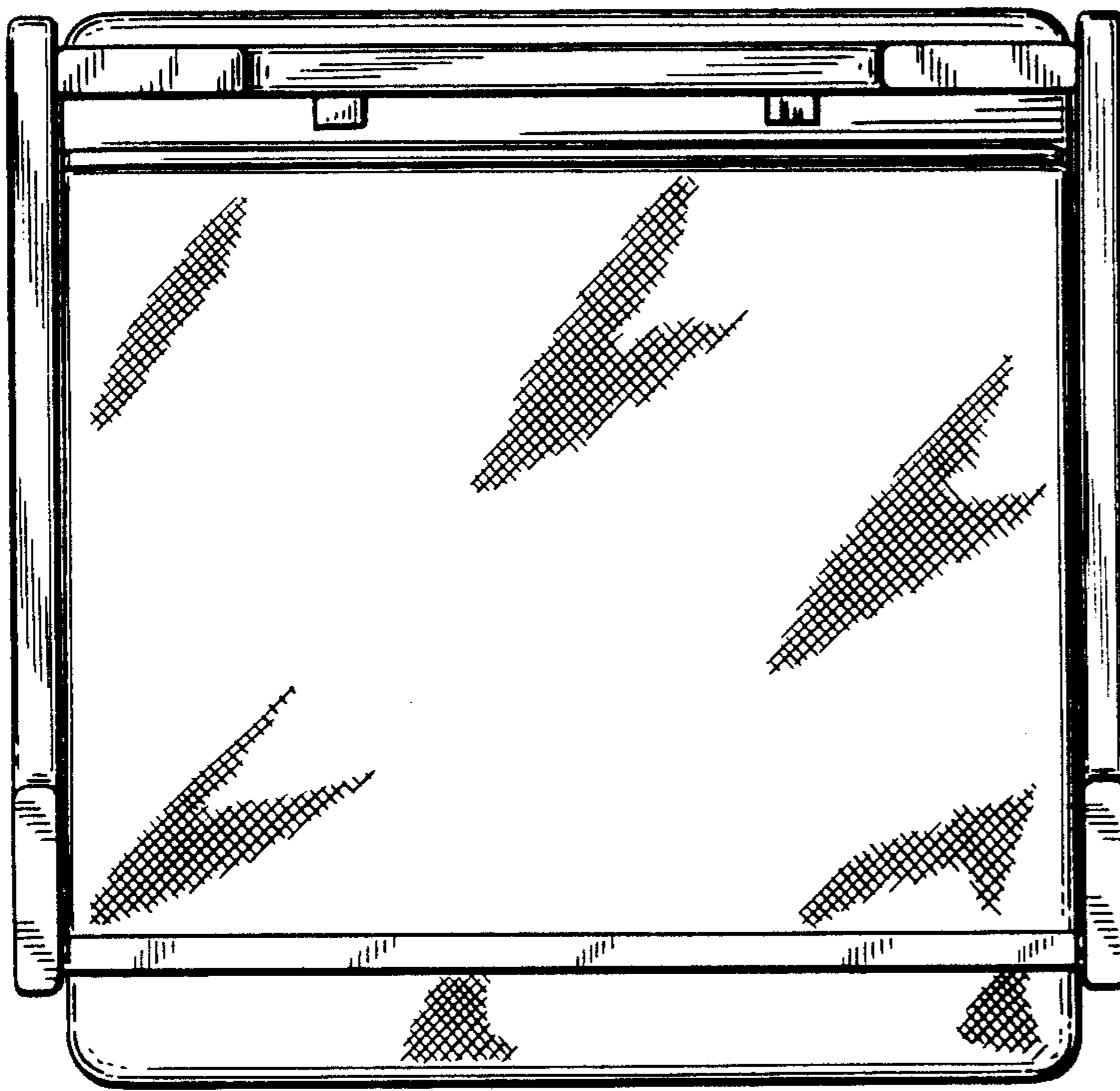

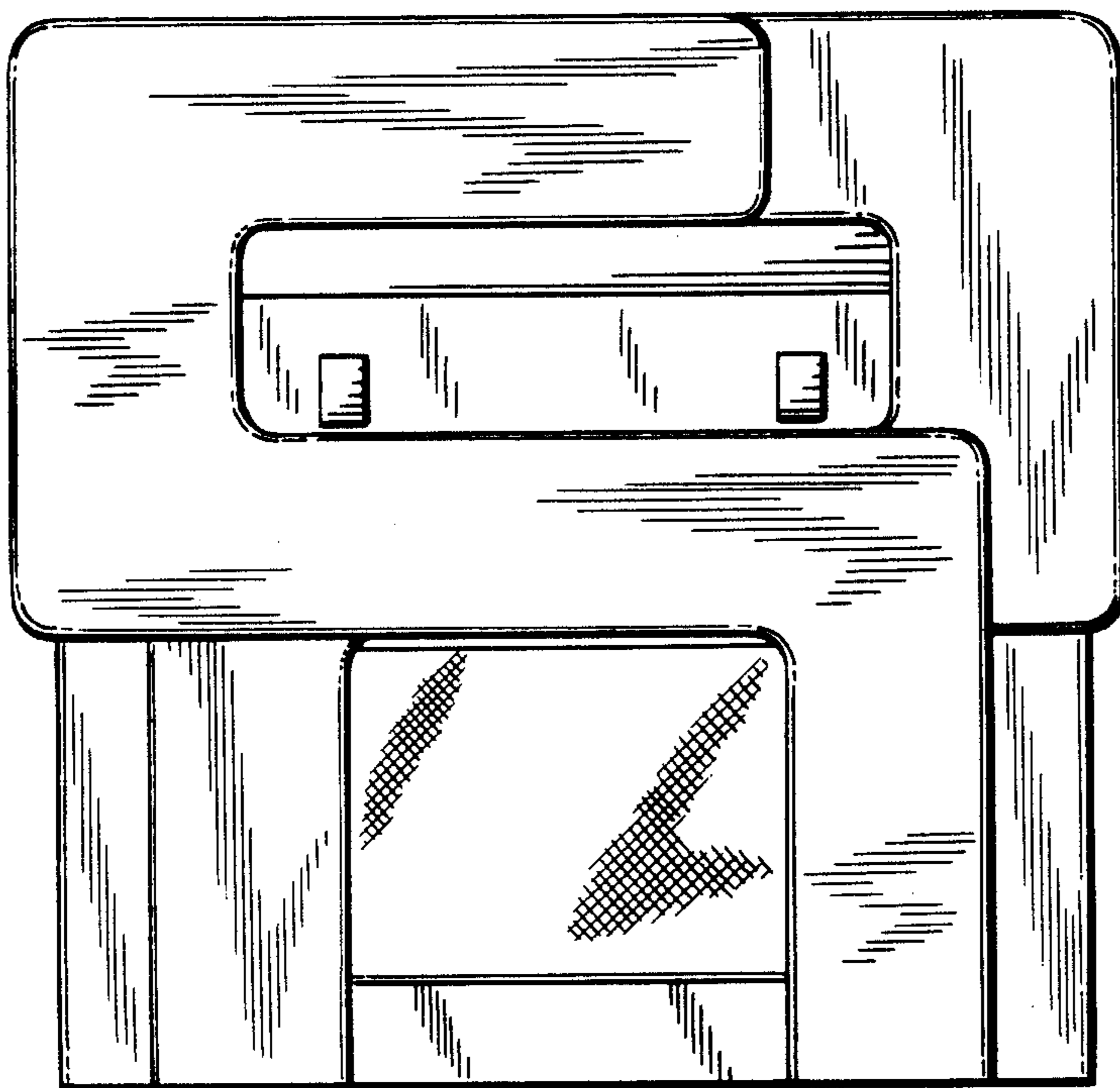
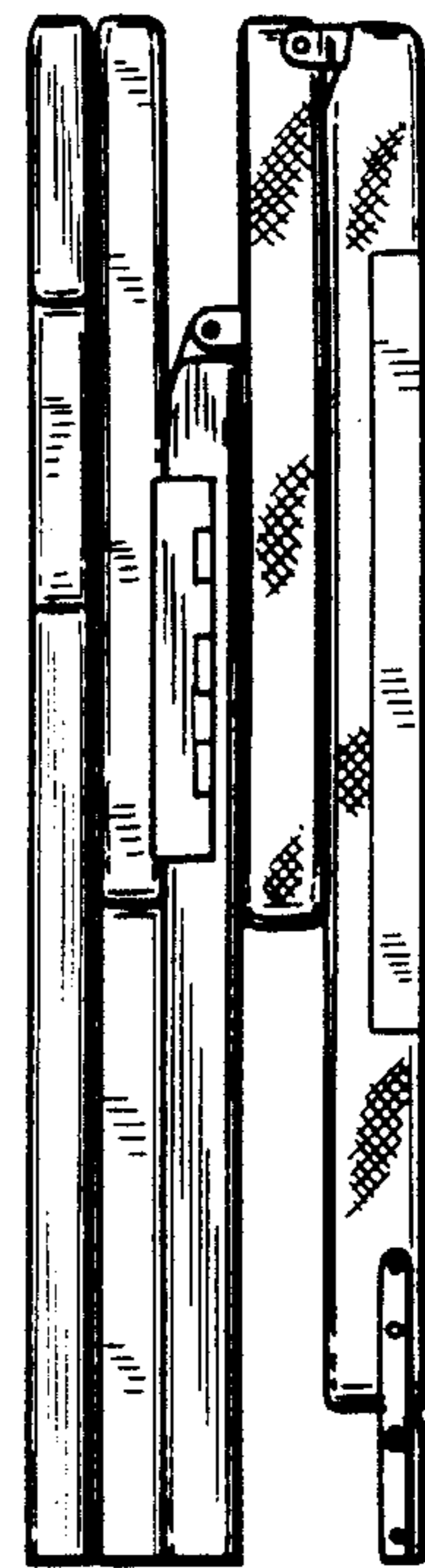

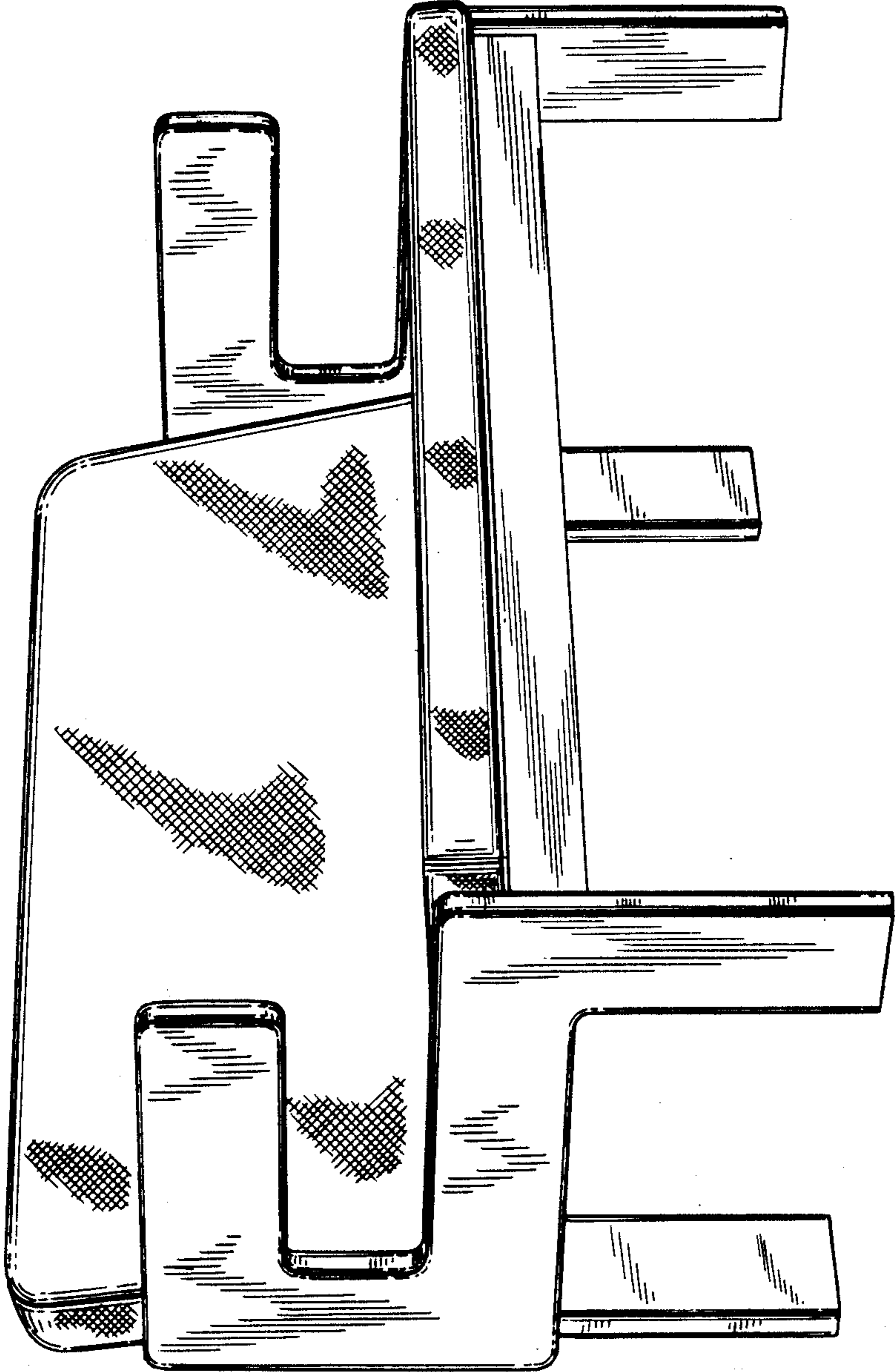

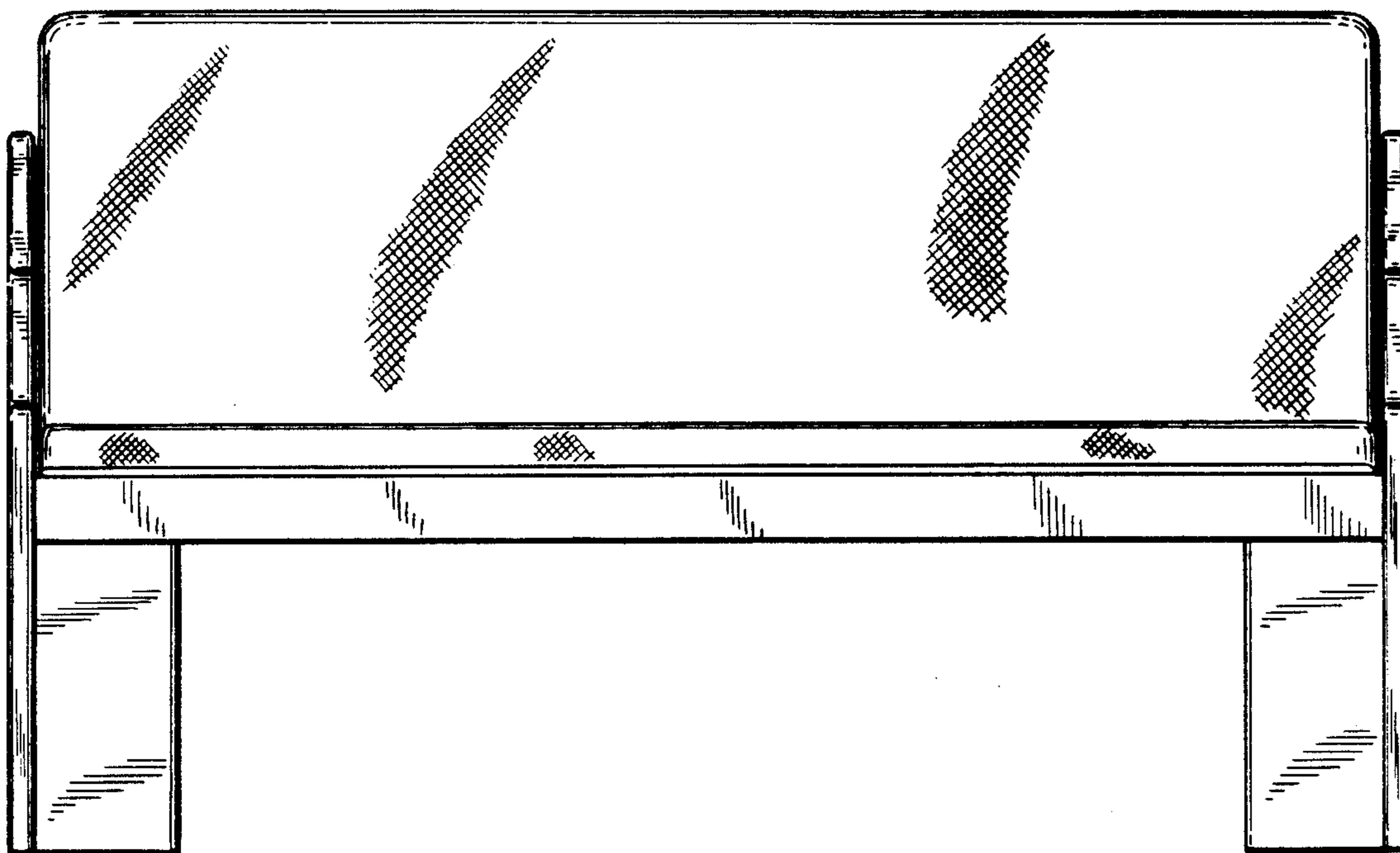
