[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a nonwoven sheet material or the like, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

The FIGURE is a nonwoven sheet material or the like showing our new design, the design unit being shown within the broken lines, which unit is repeated in regular succession as is indicated by the extension beyond the unit boundaries.
