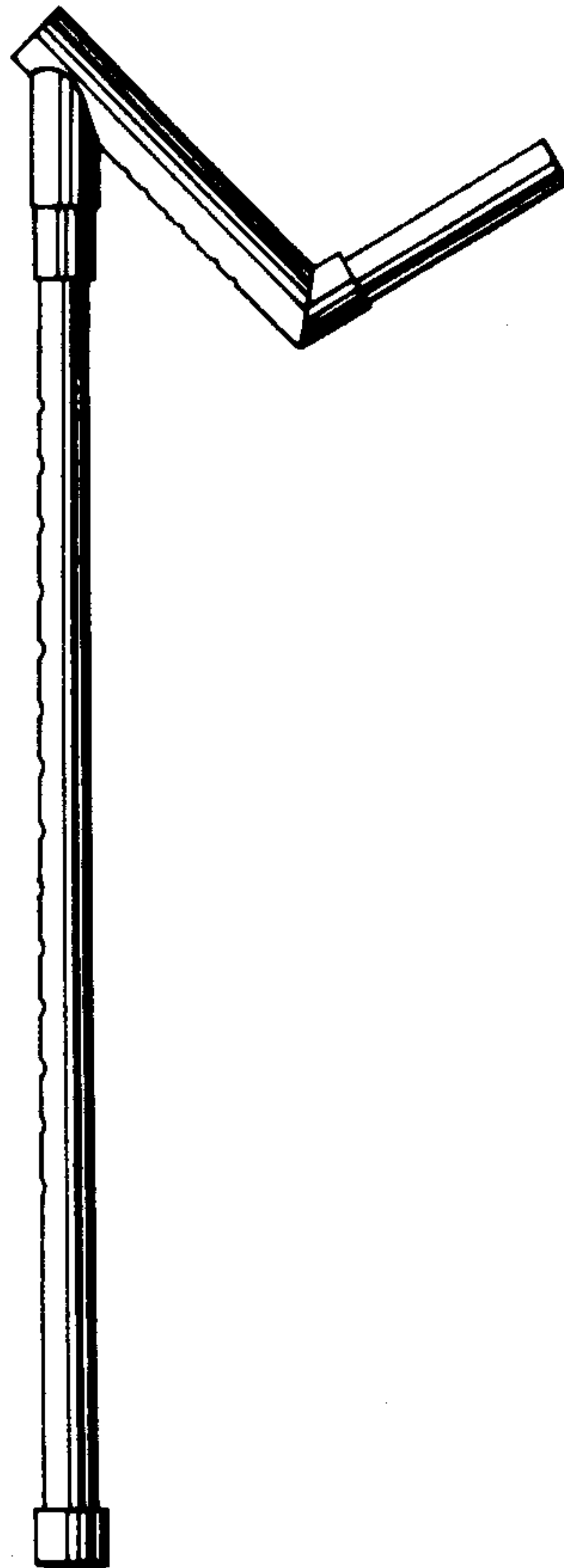

 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof.



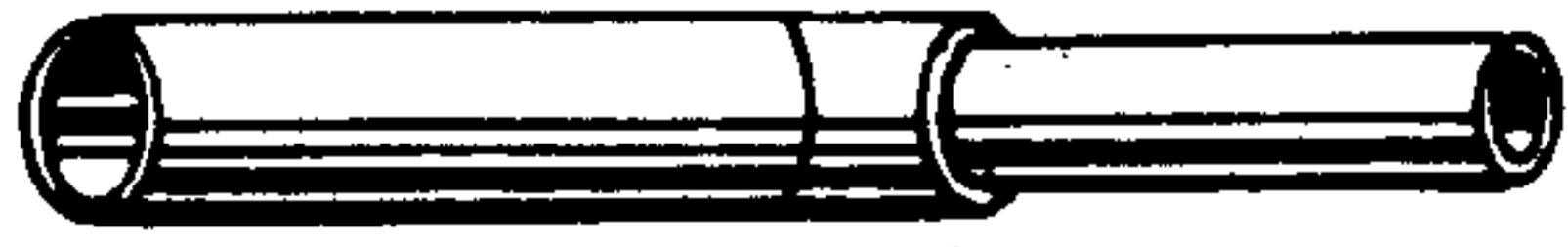

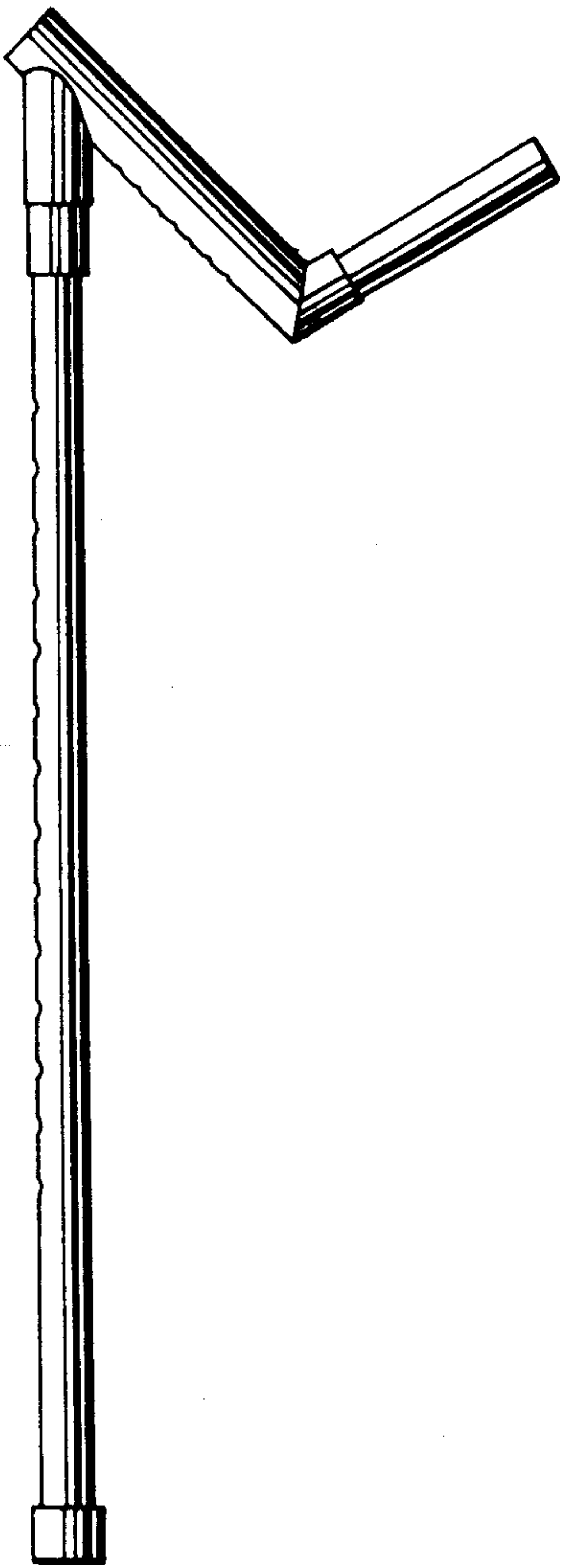

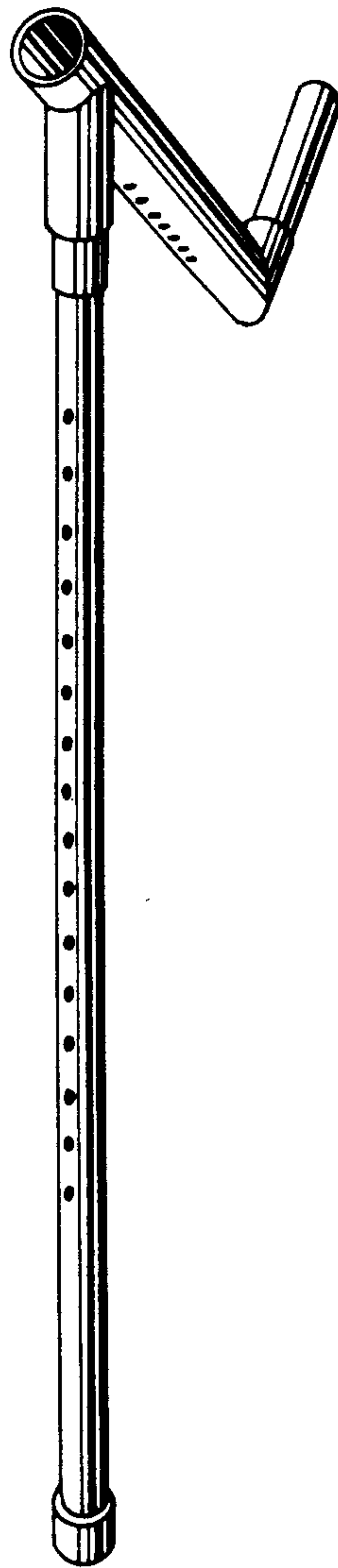
