The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle incorporating our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

The side opposite that seen in FIG. 1 is a mirror image of the side shown.

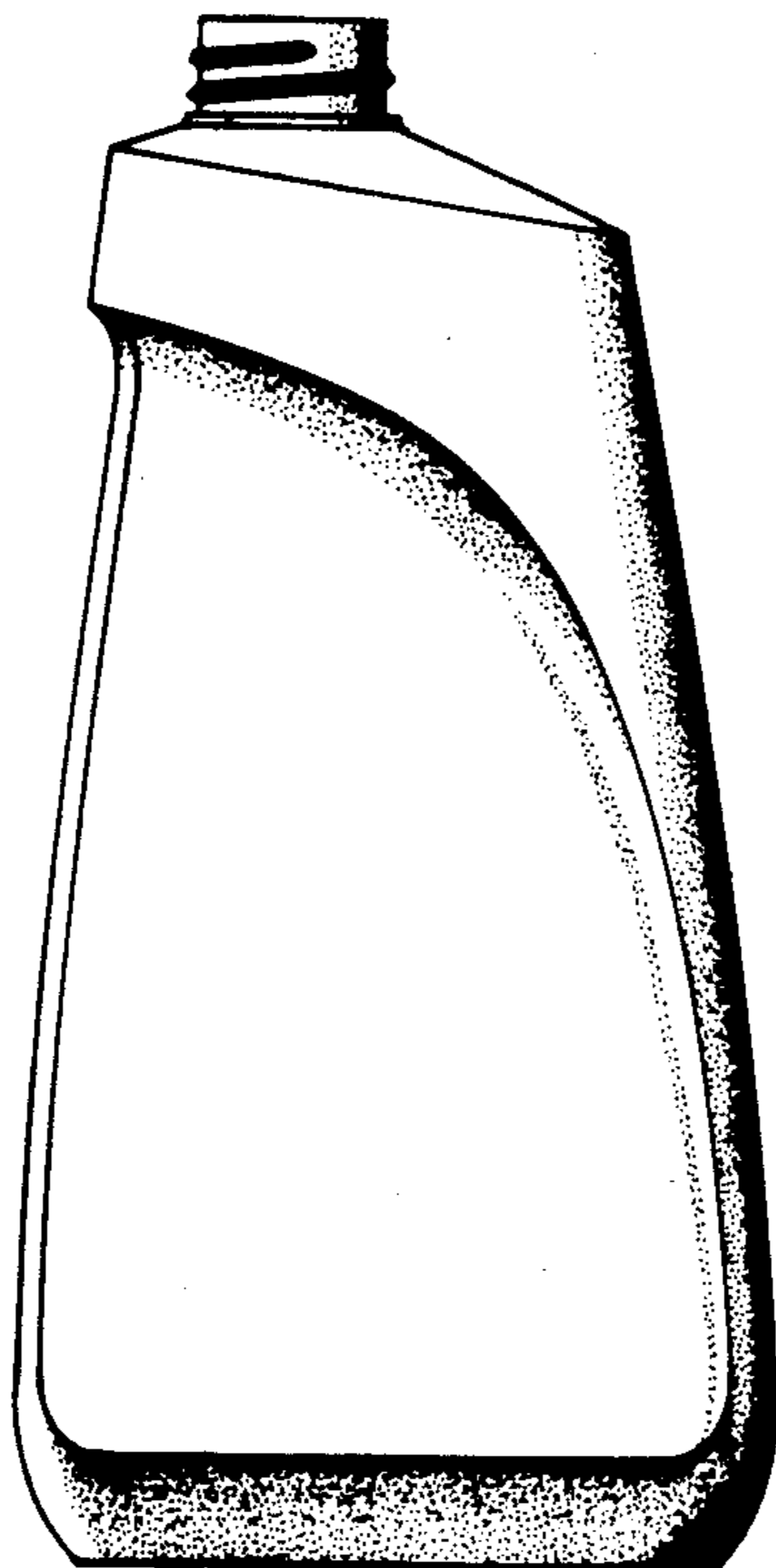

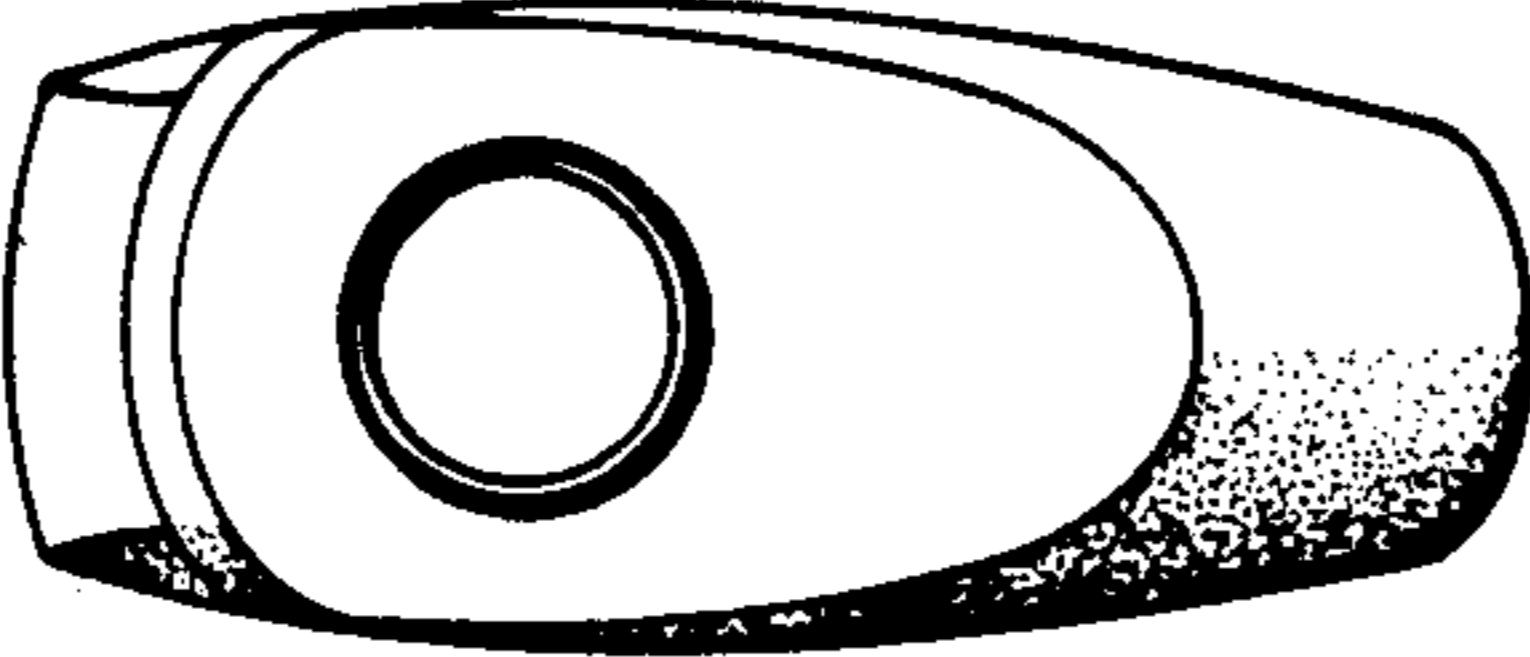

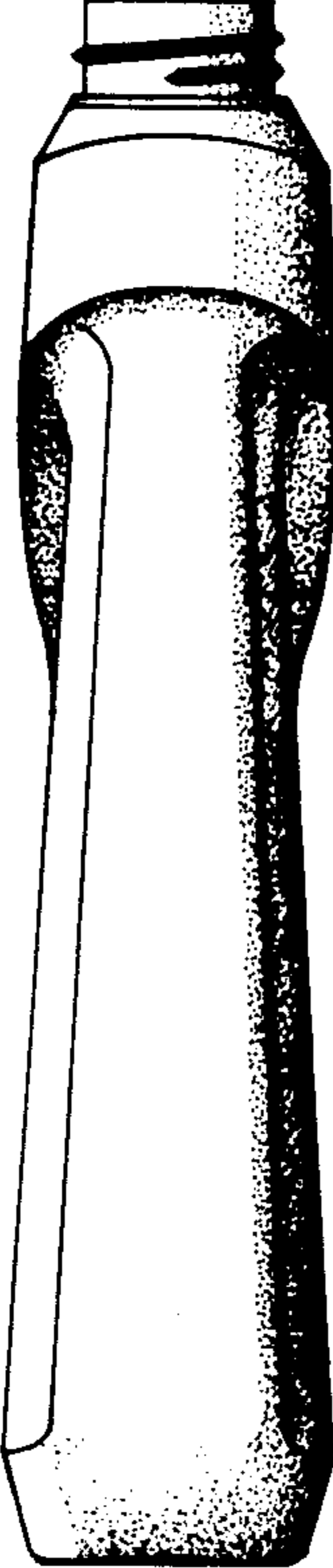

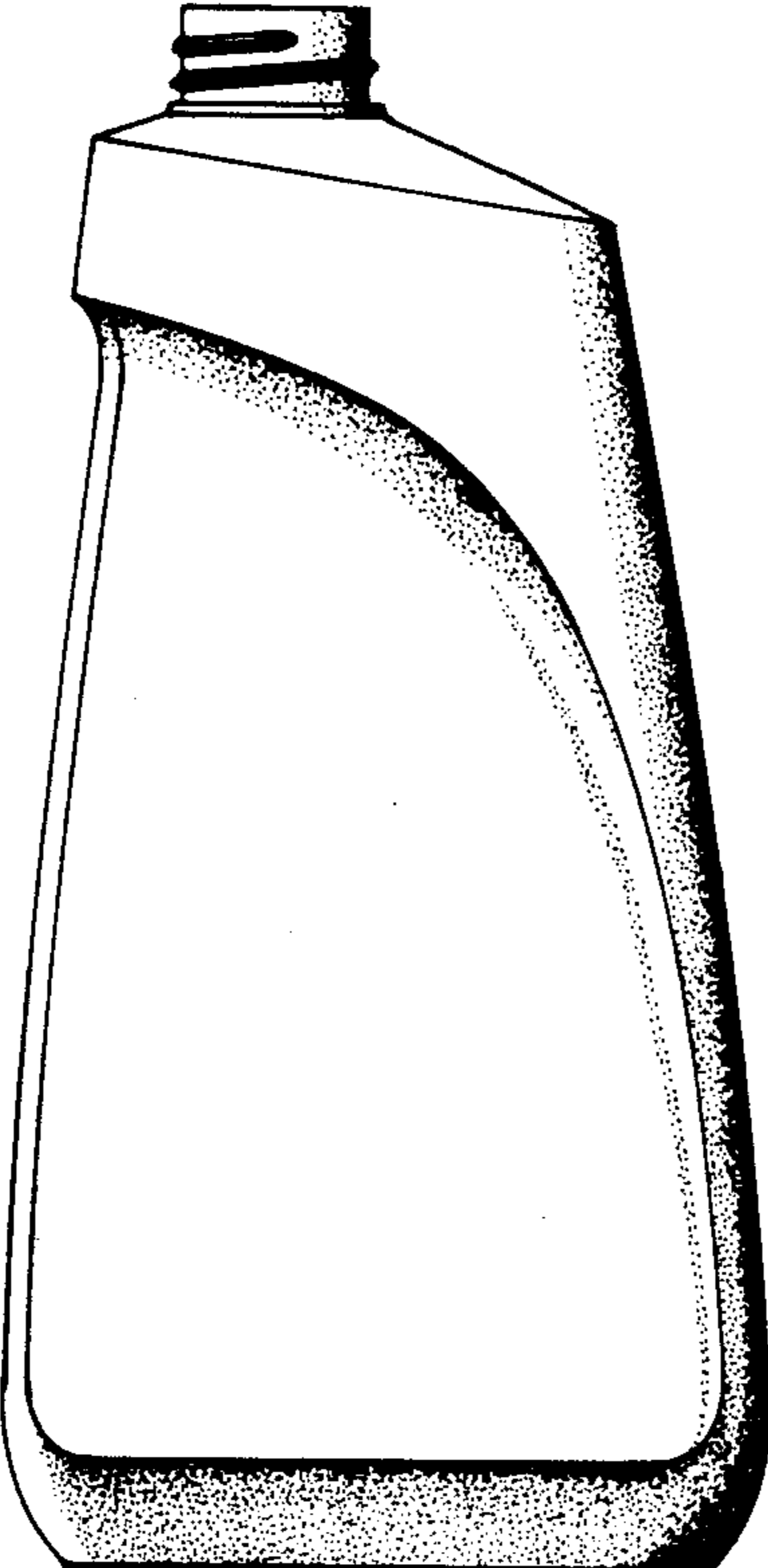
