FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a flower vase embodying my new design;

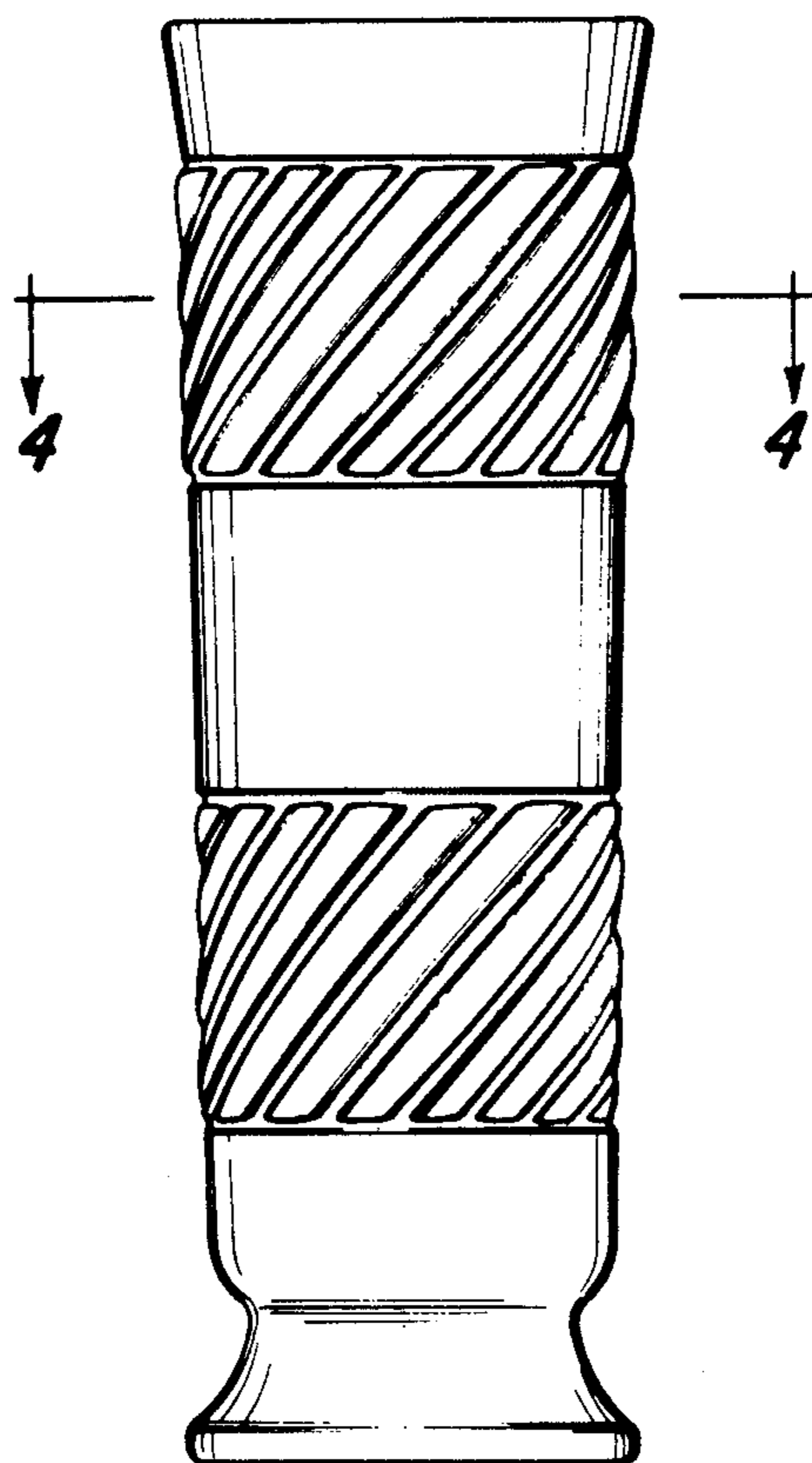

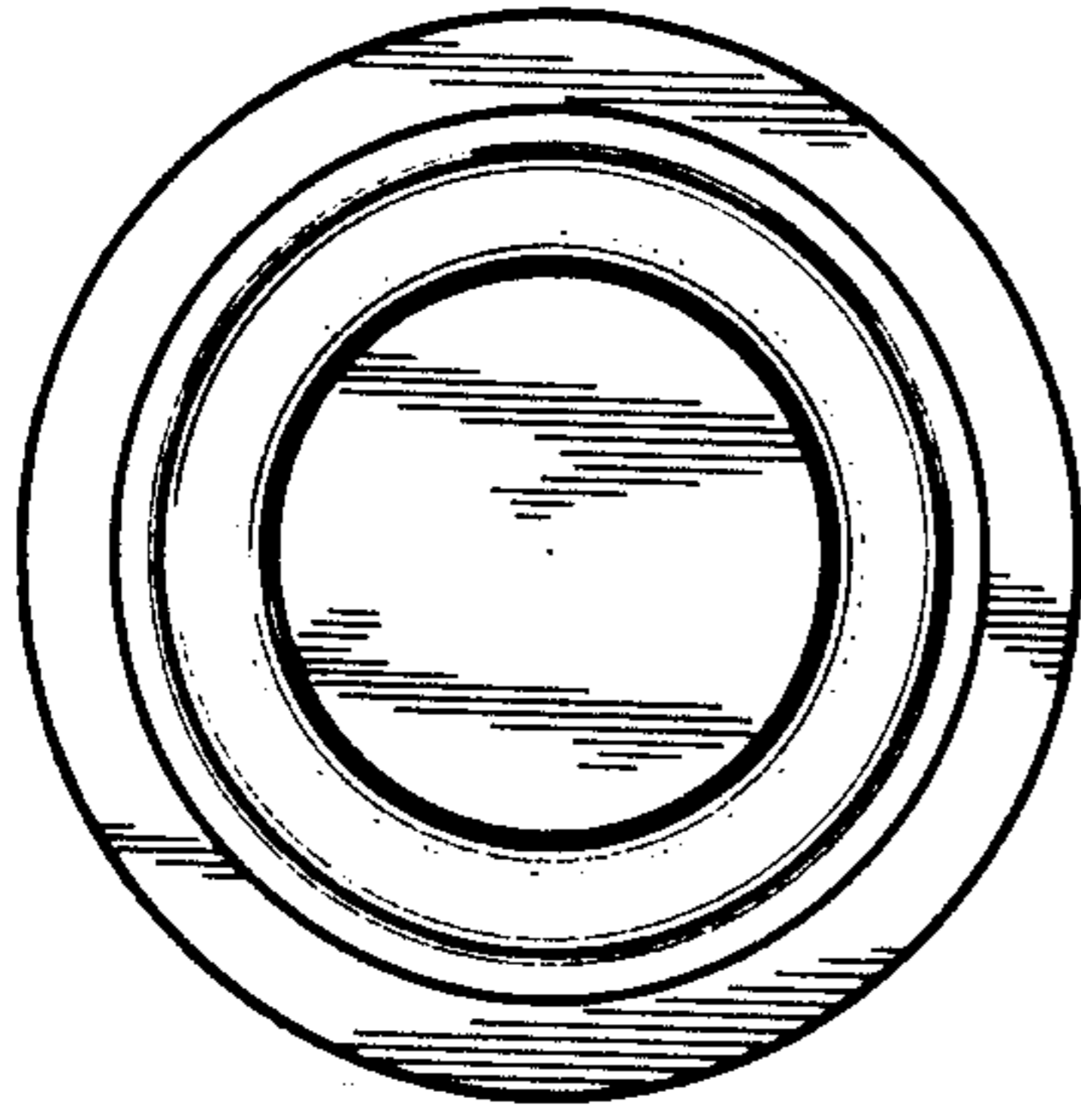

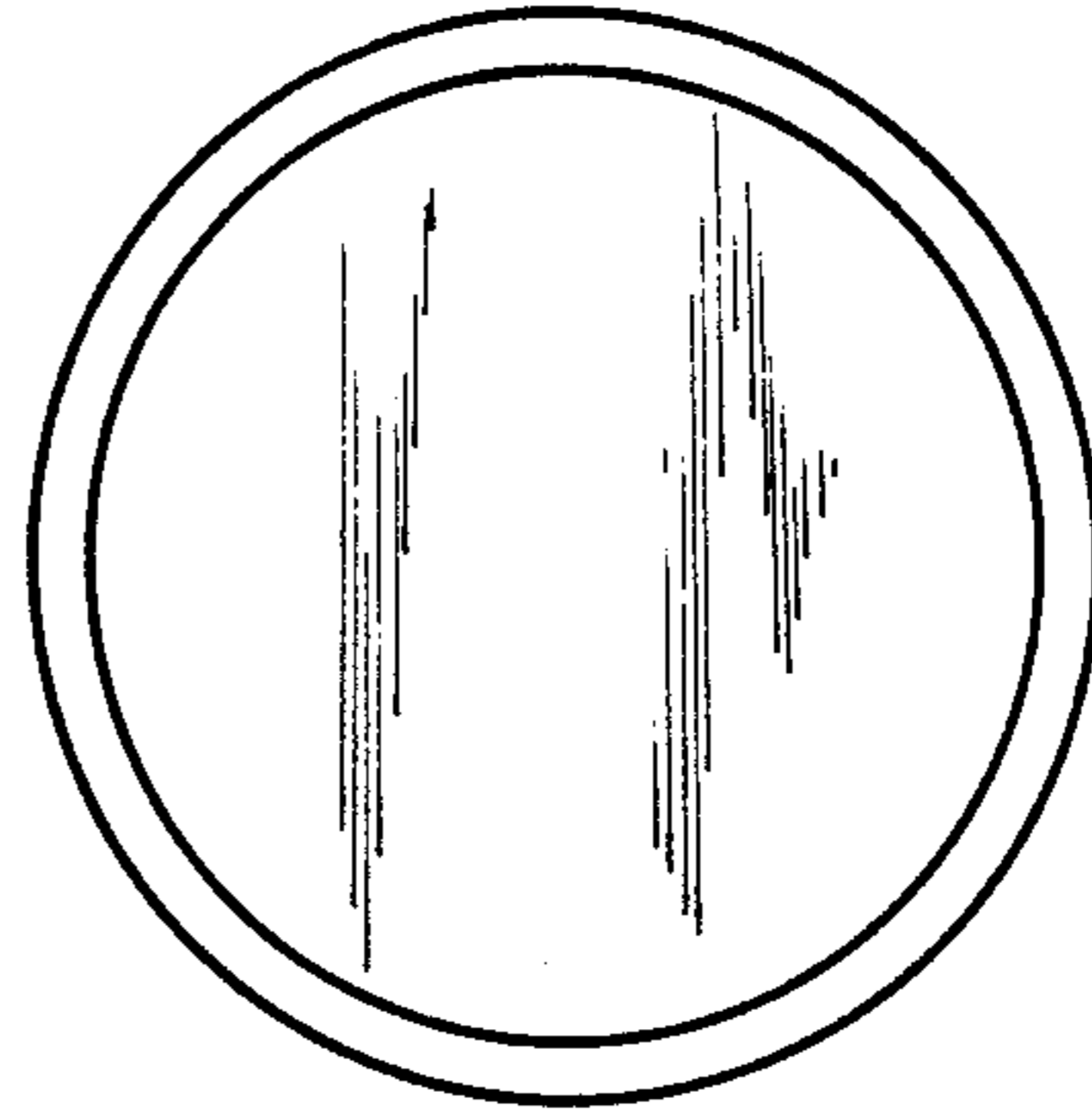

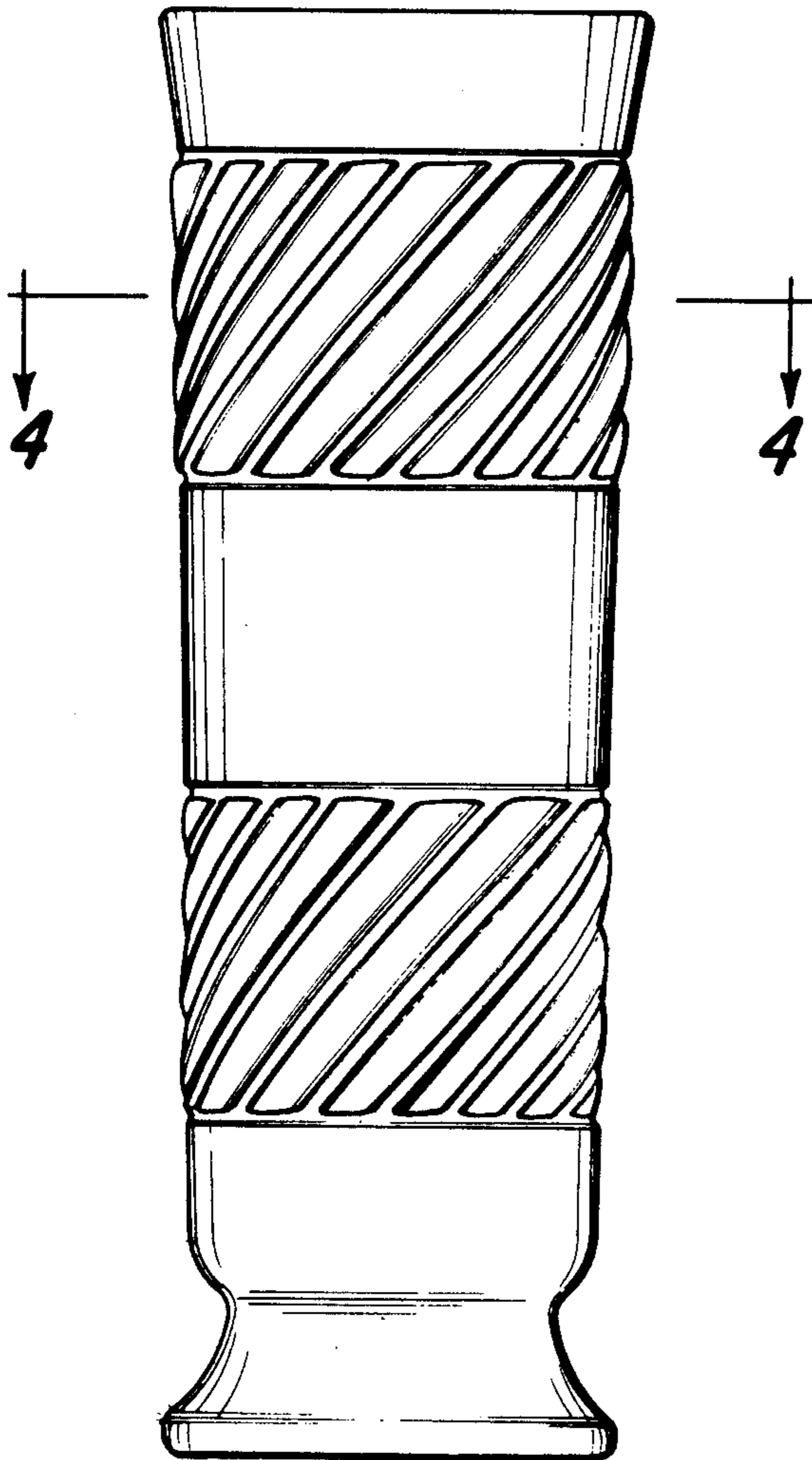

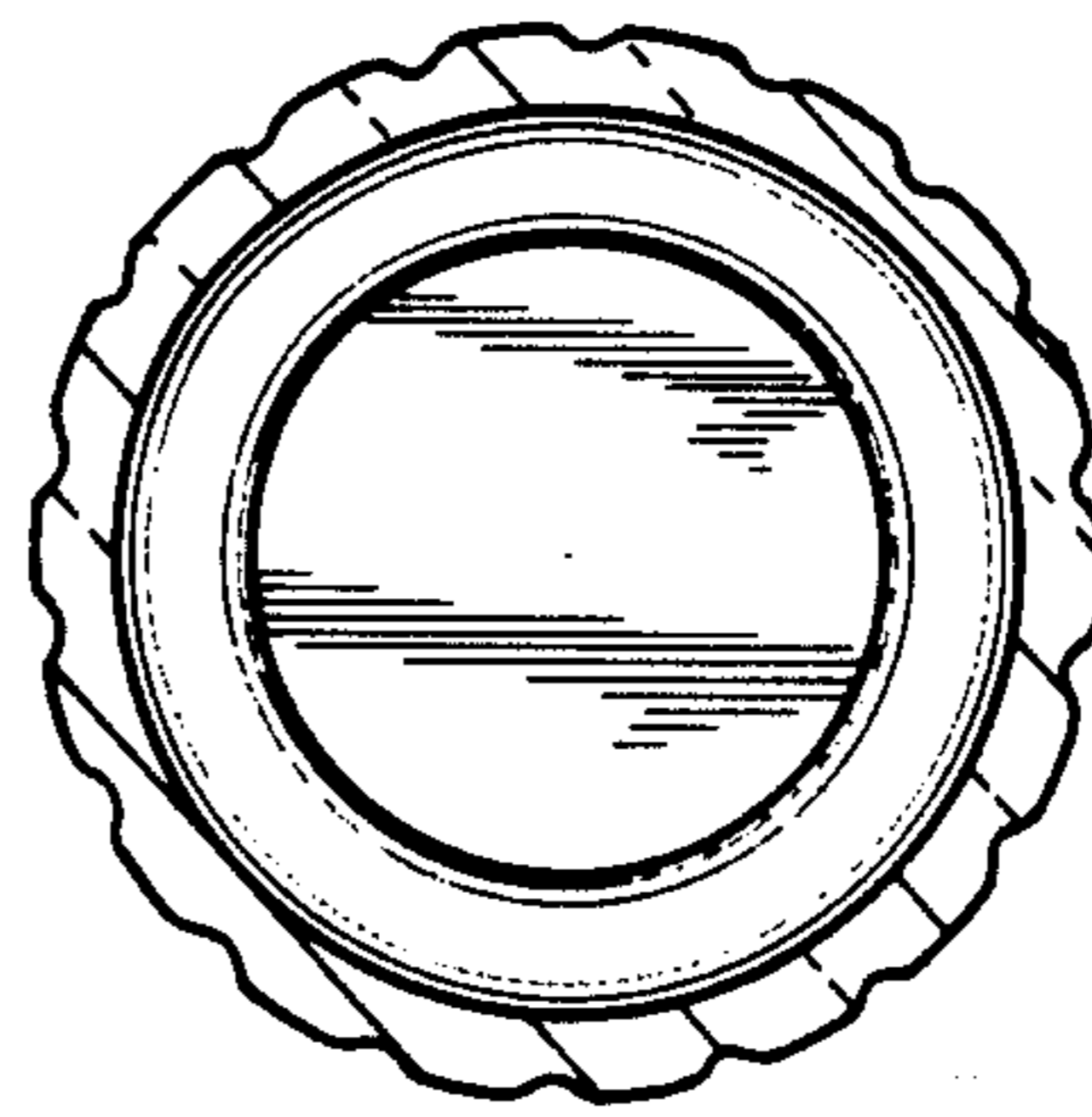
