DESCRIPTION

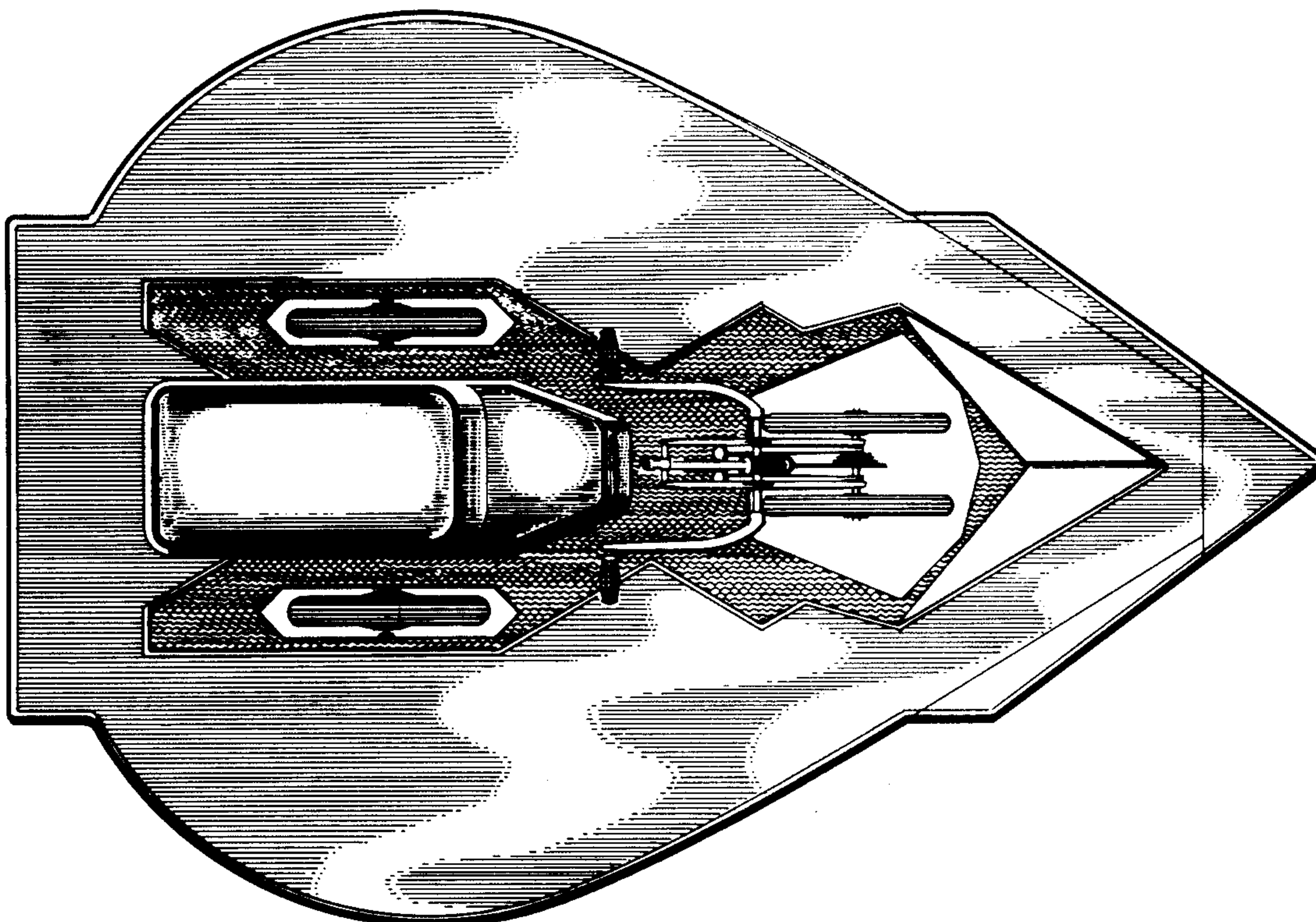
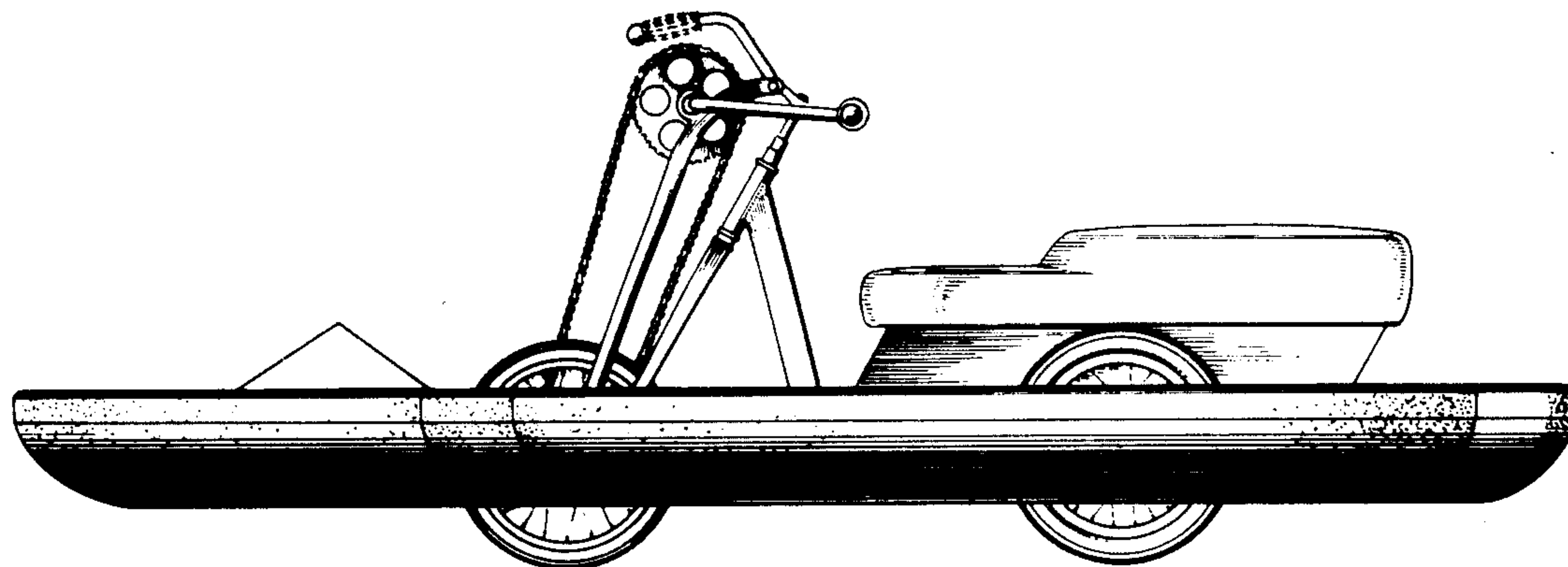
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an amphibious people powered vehicle that embodies my new and ornamental design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of said vehicle.



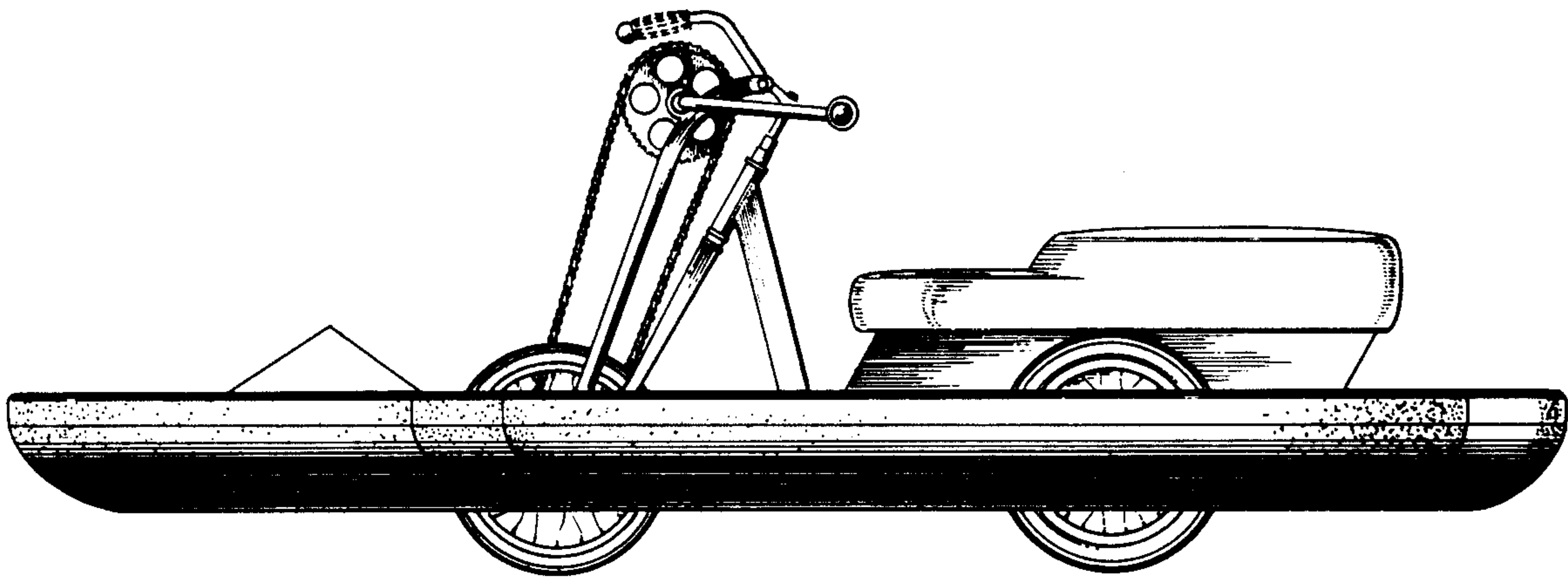

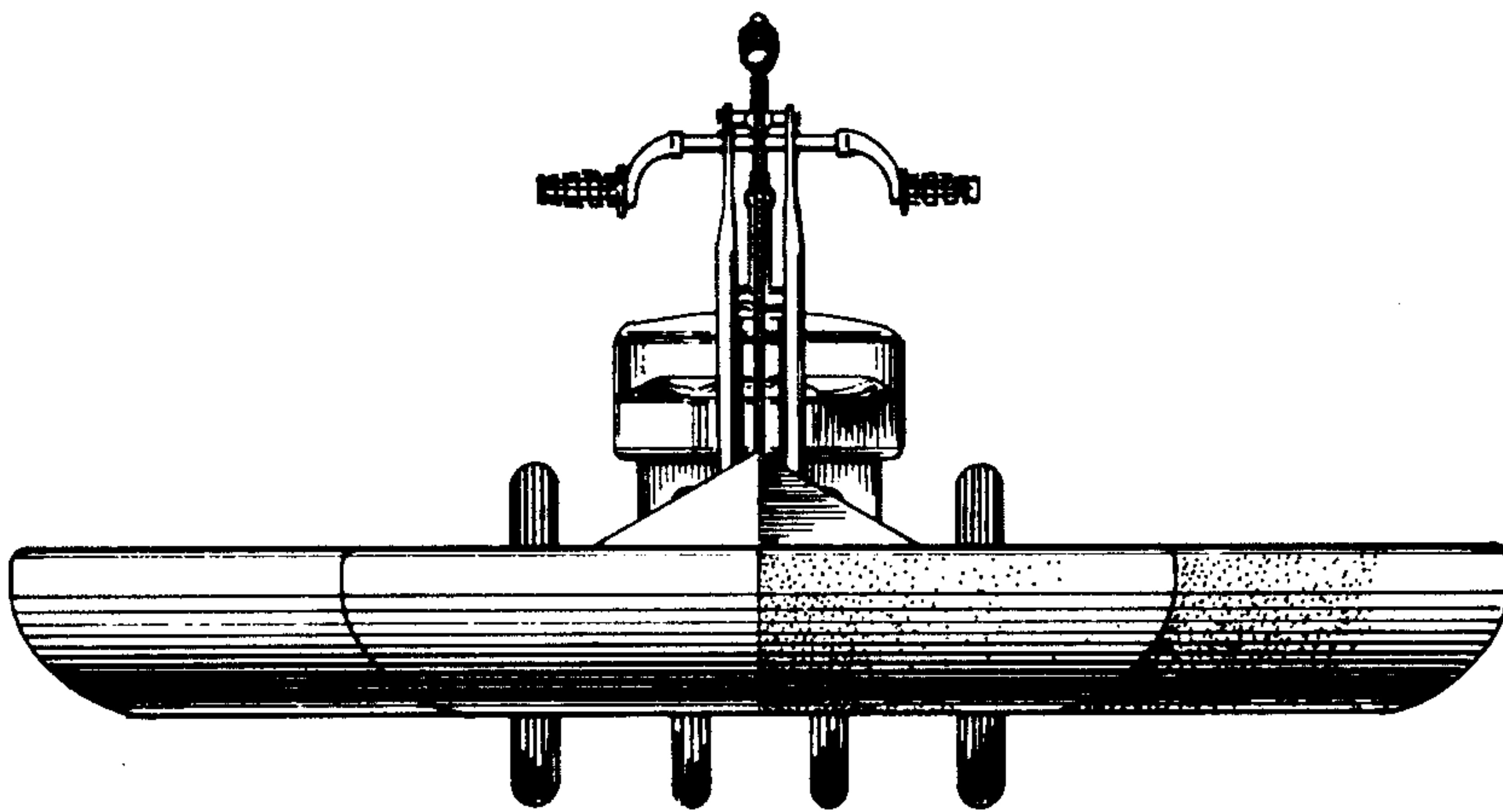

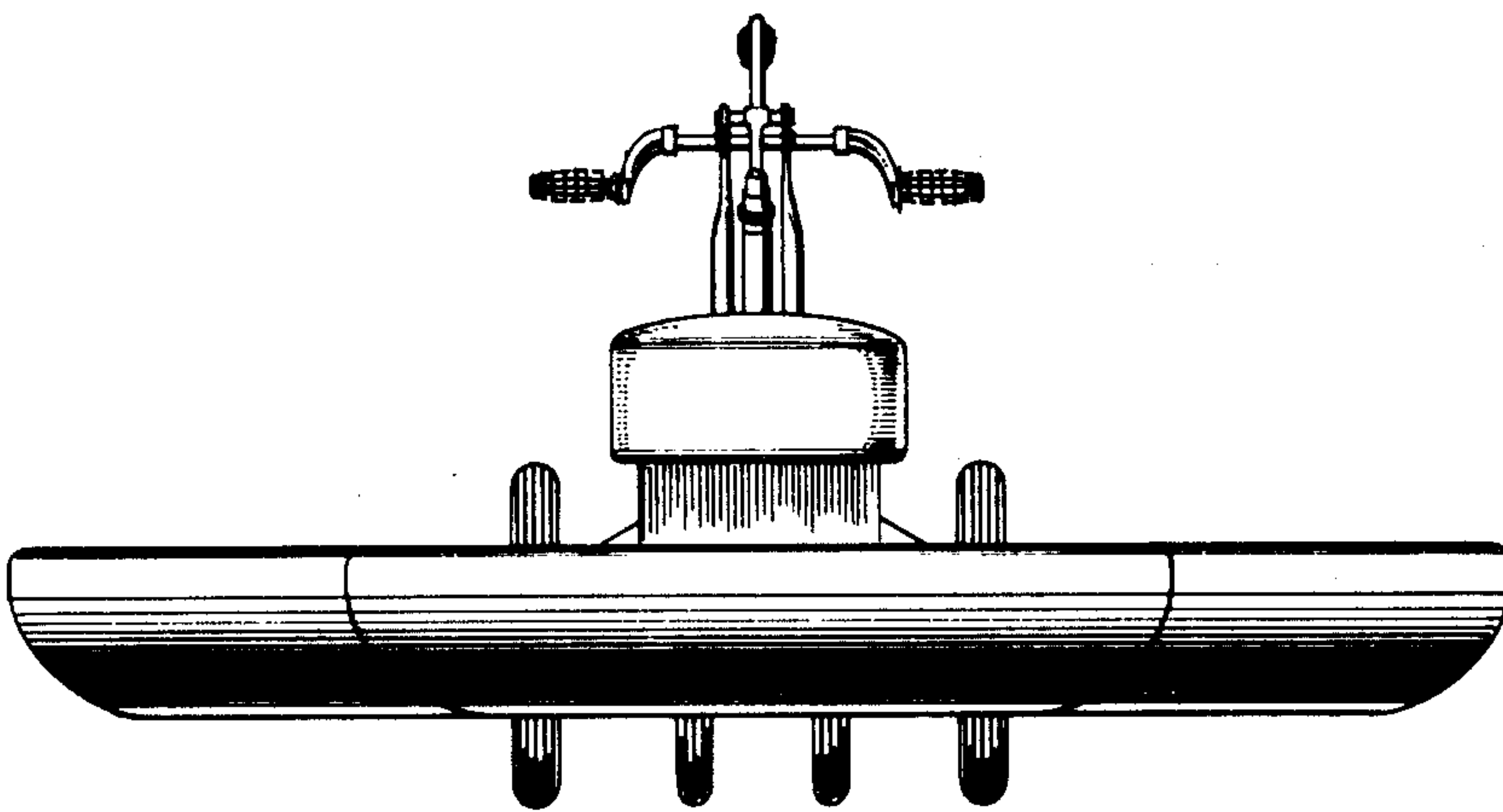

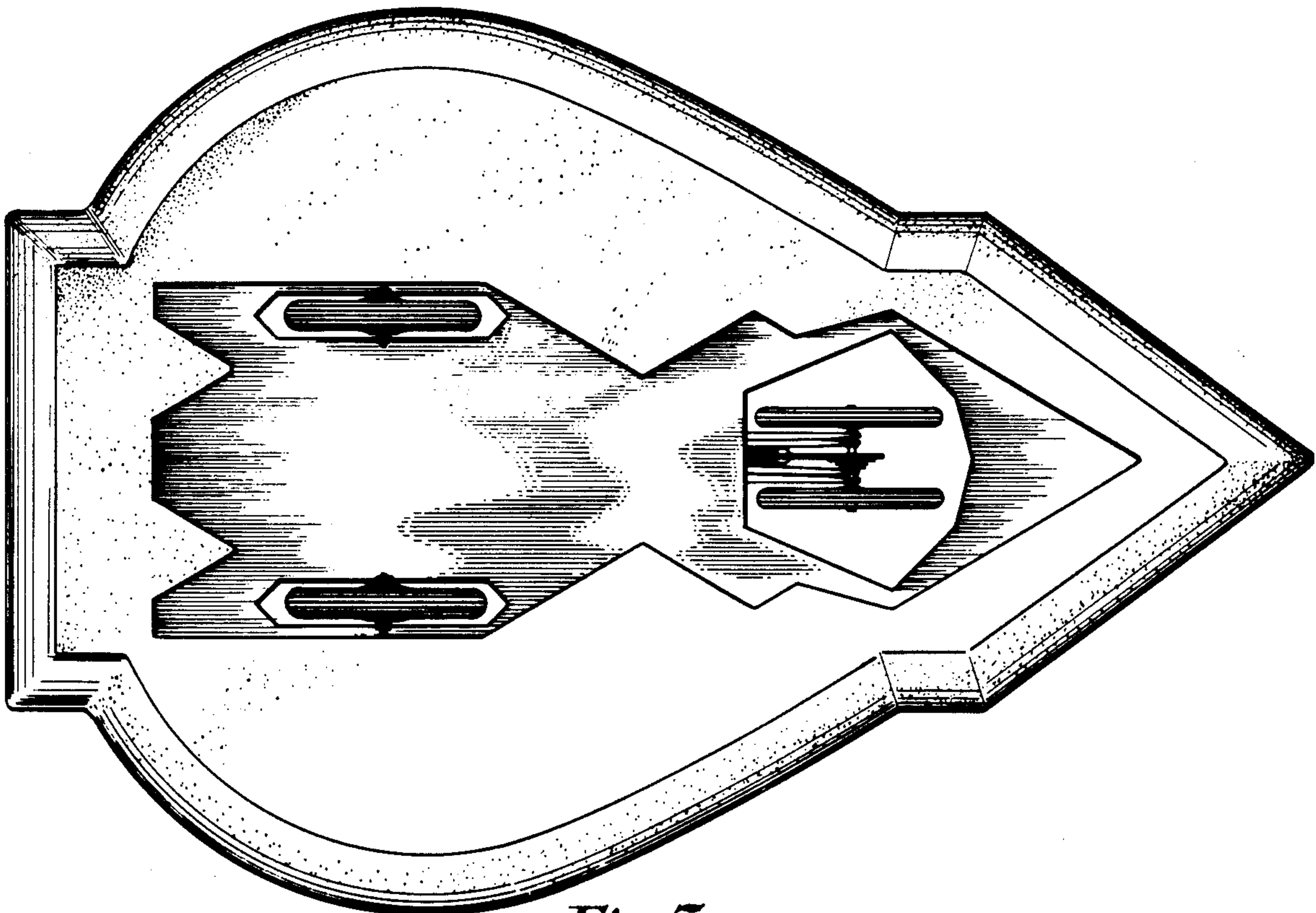
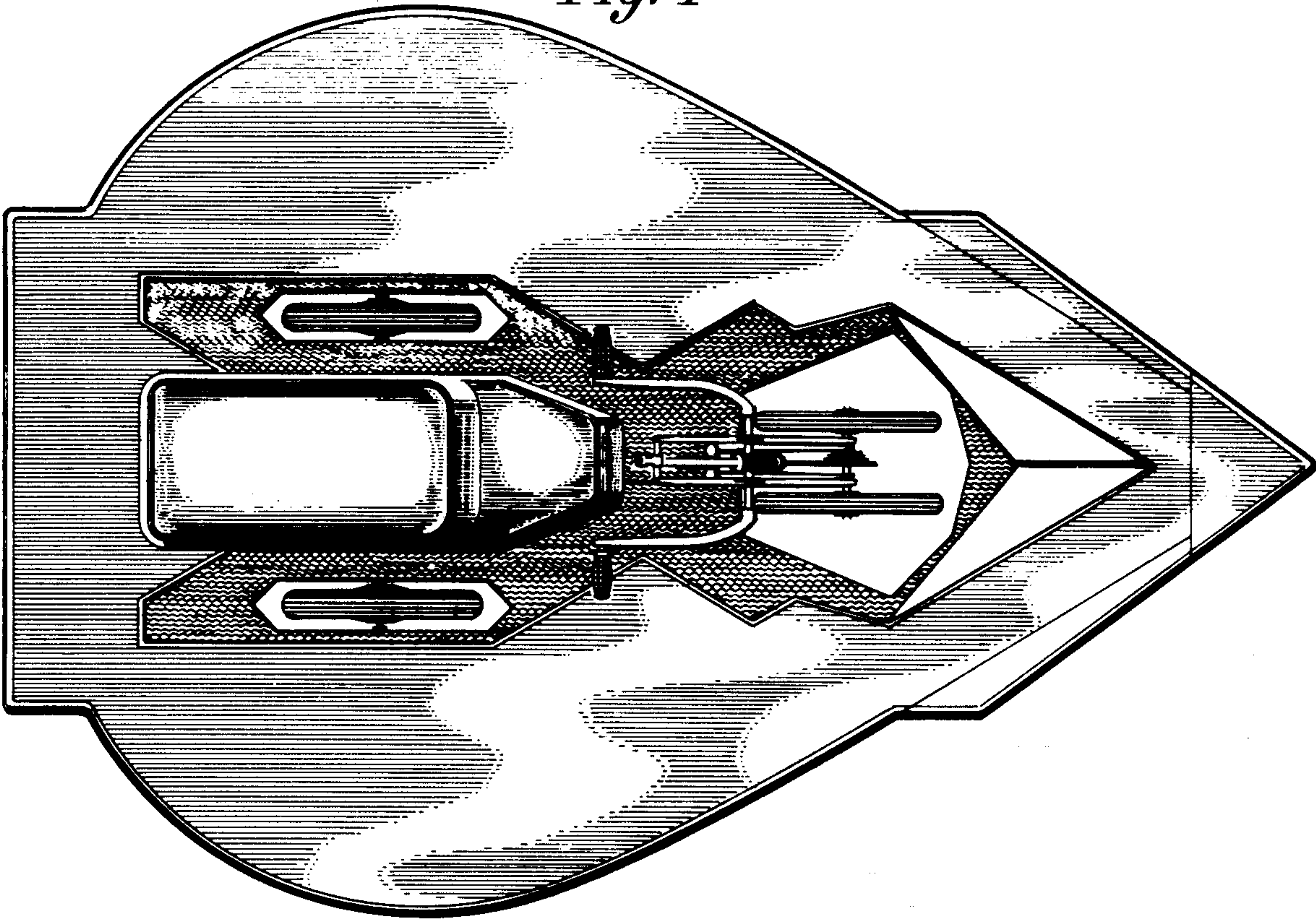
