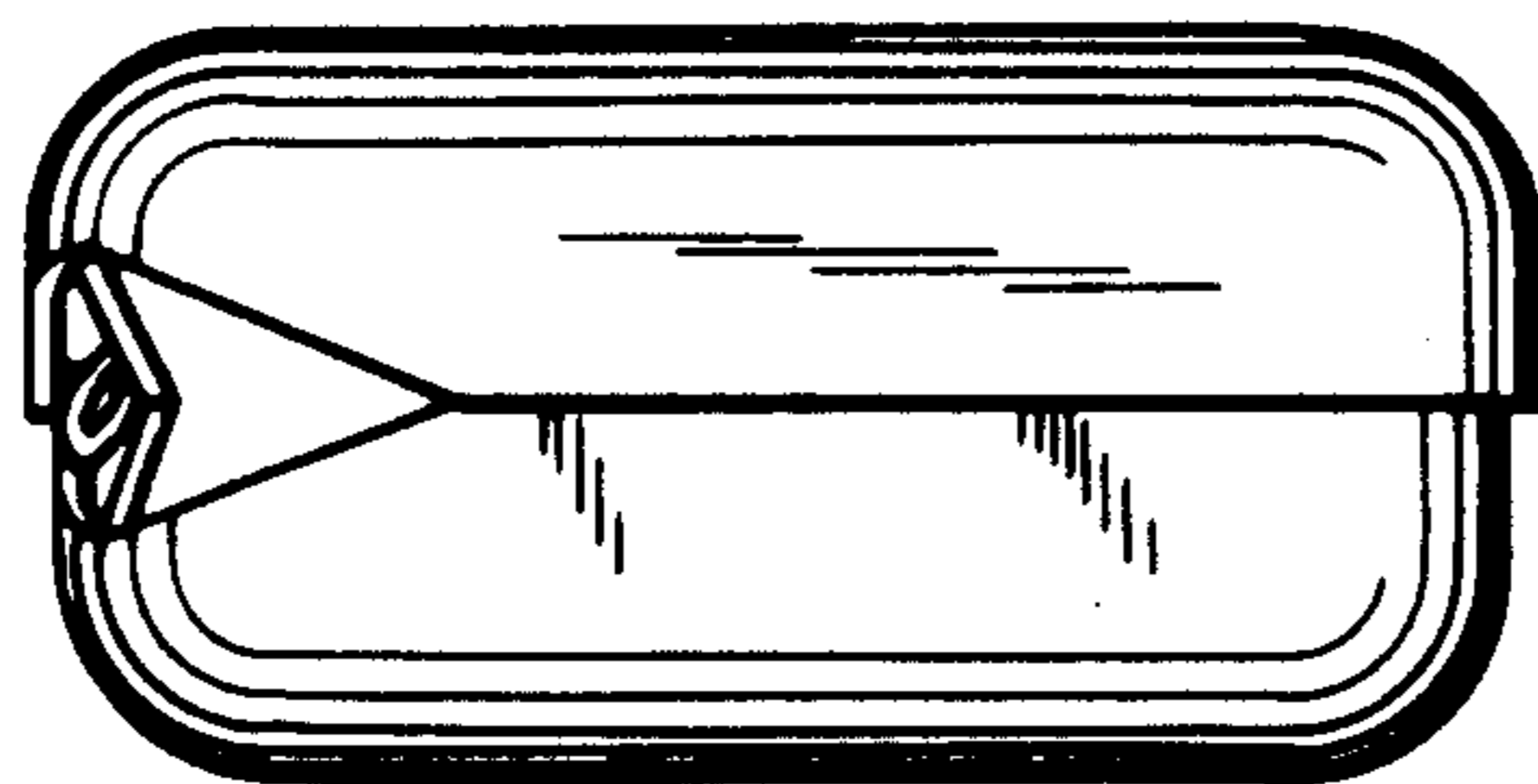
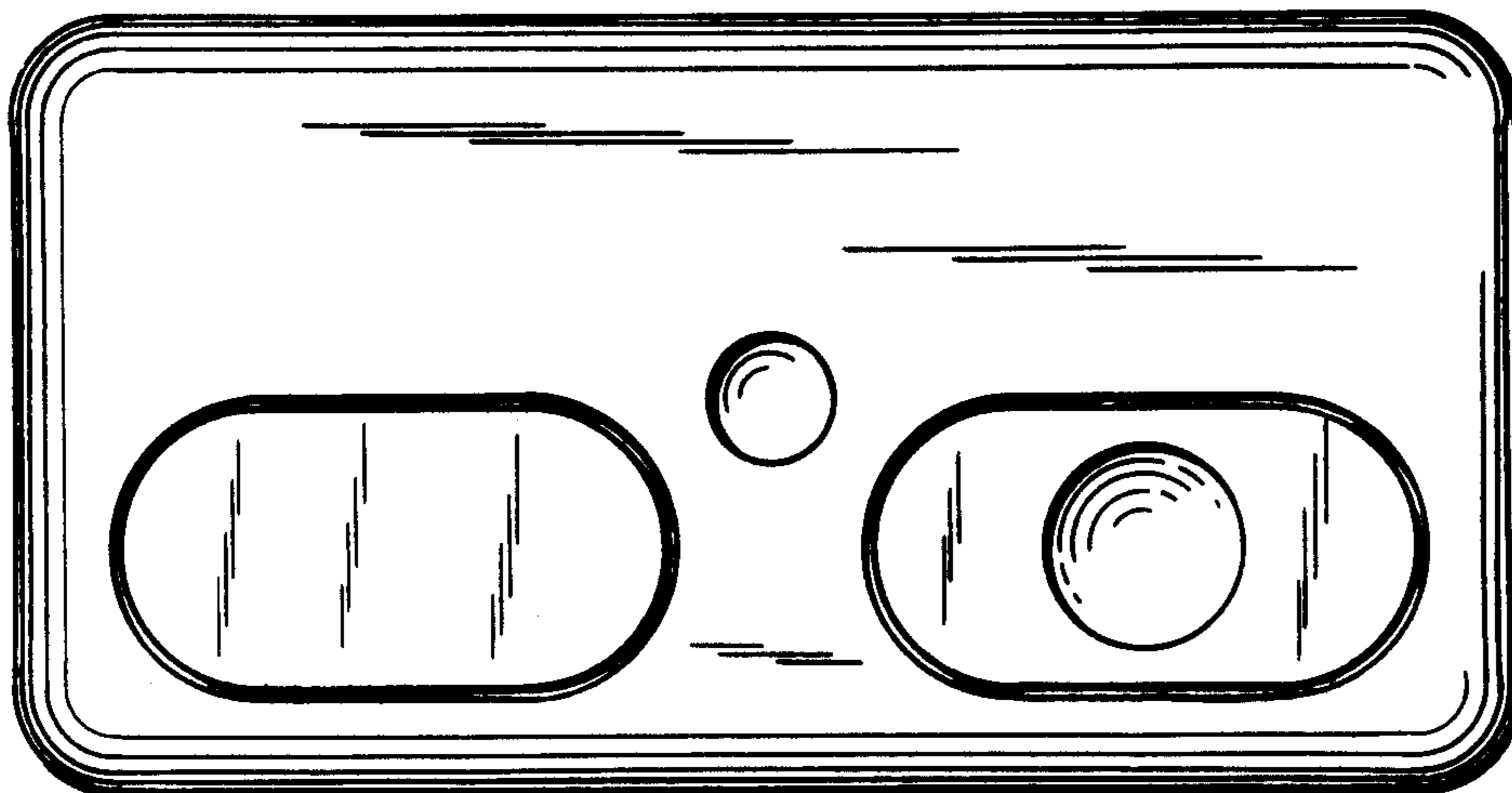

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a perforator showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view.



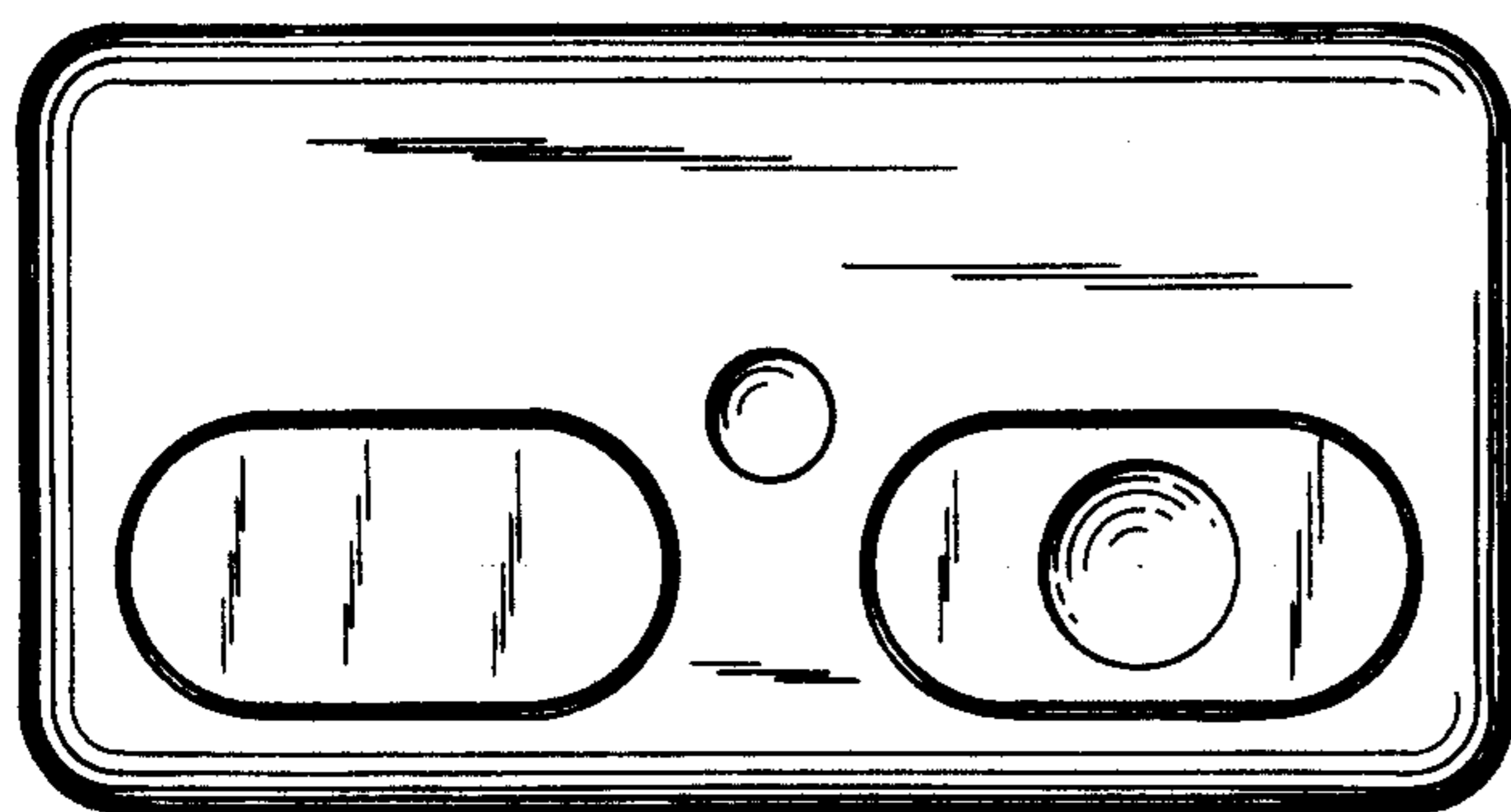

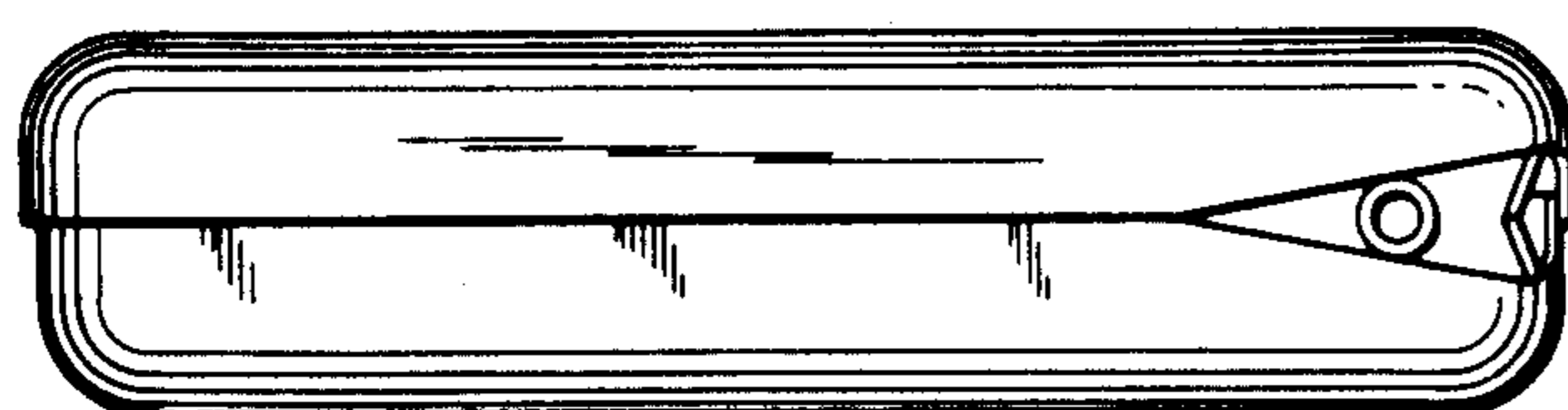

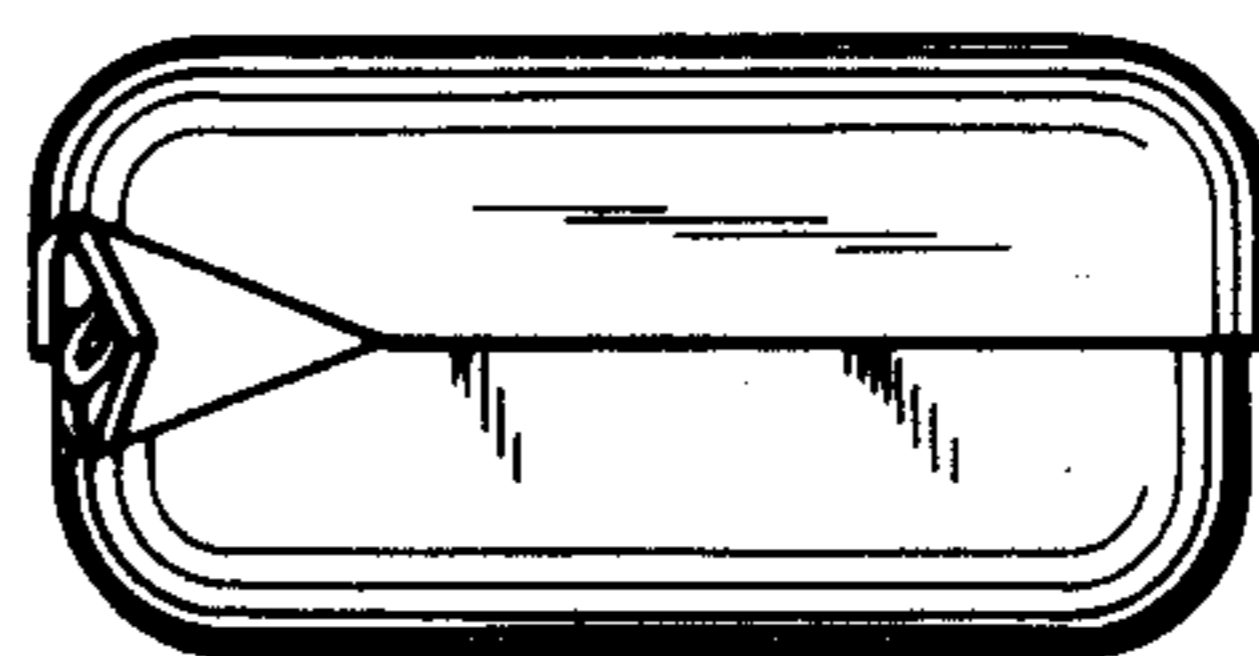

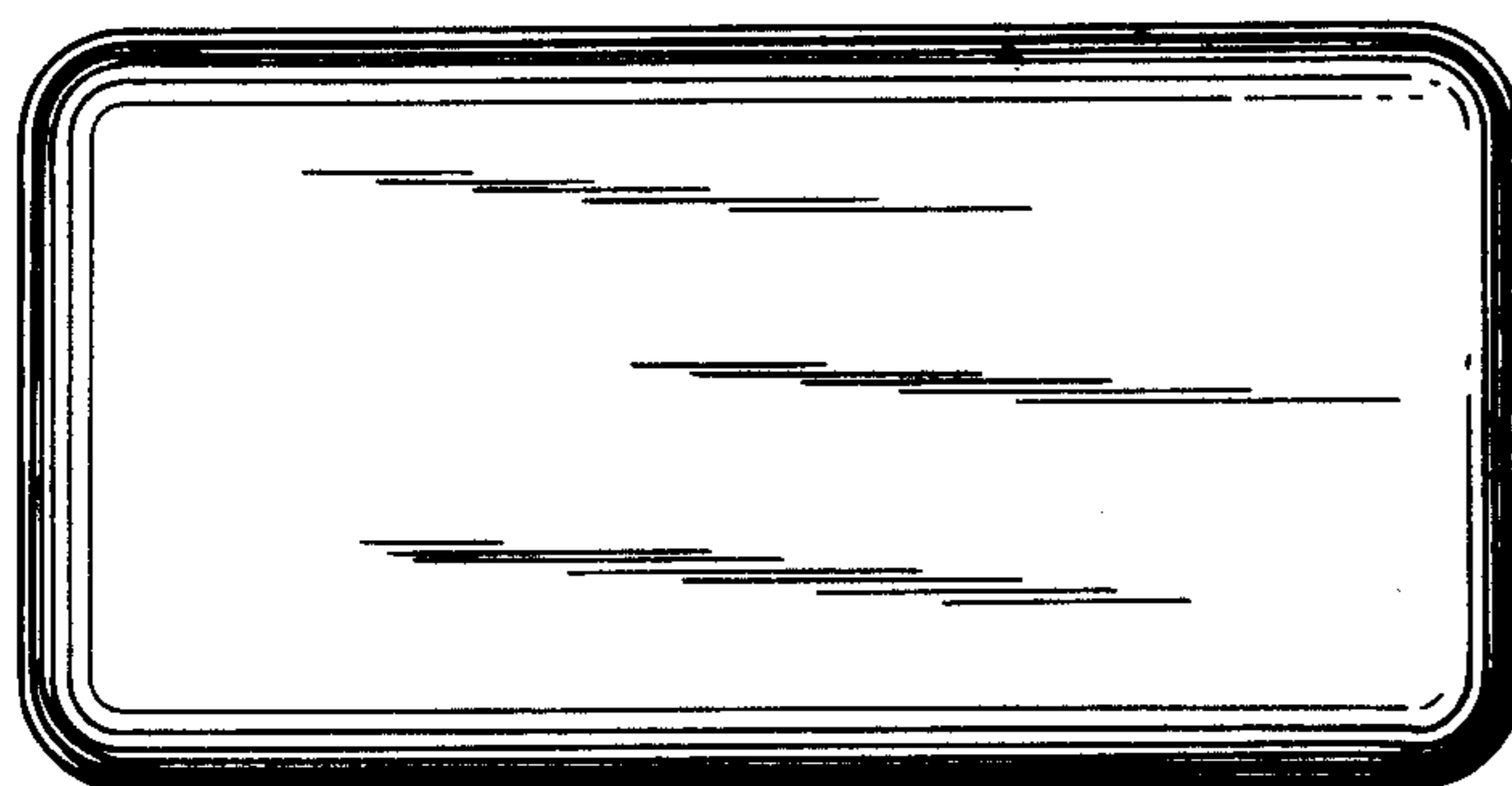

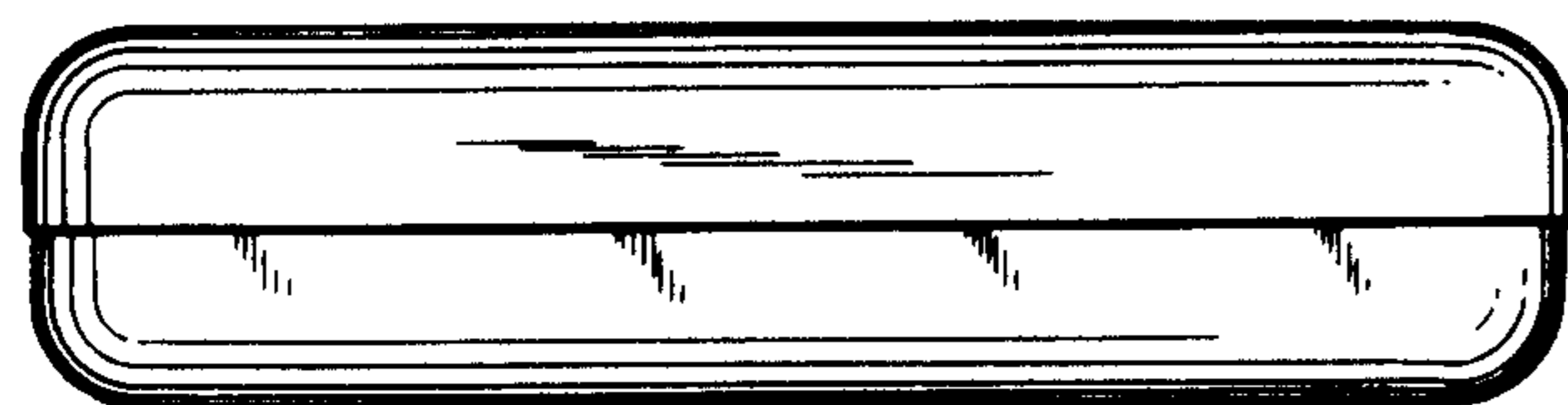

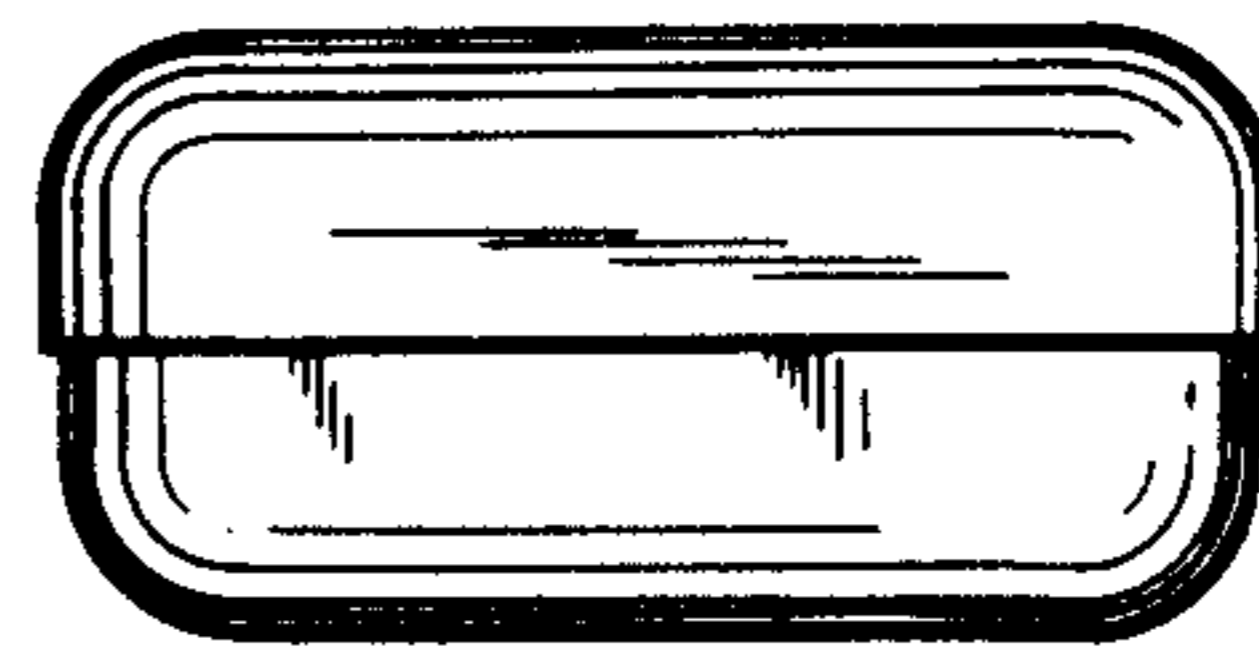
