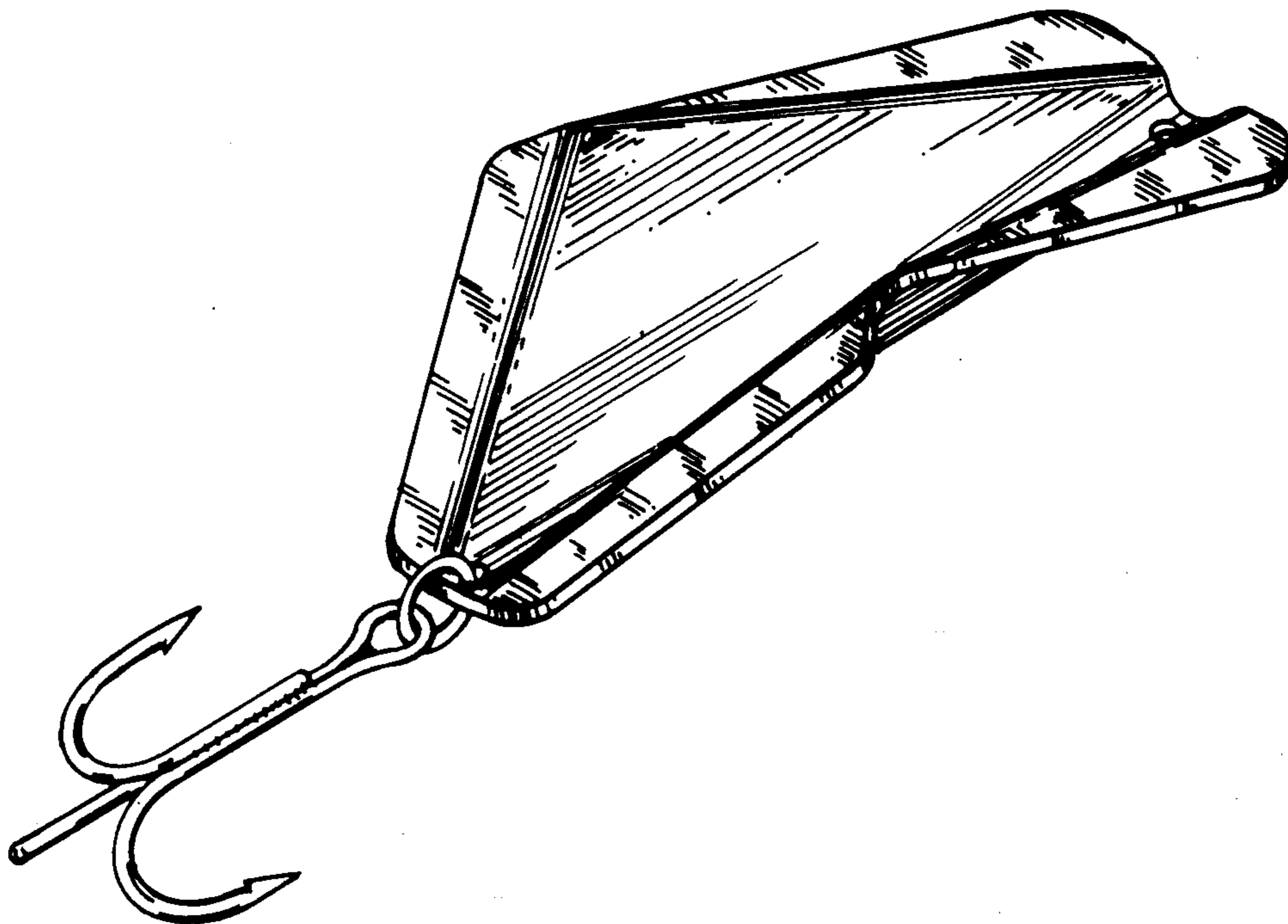

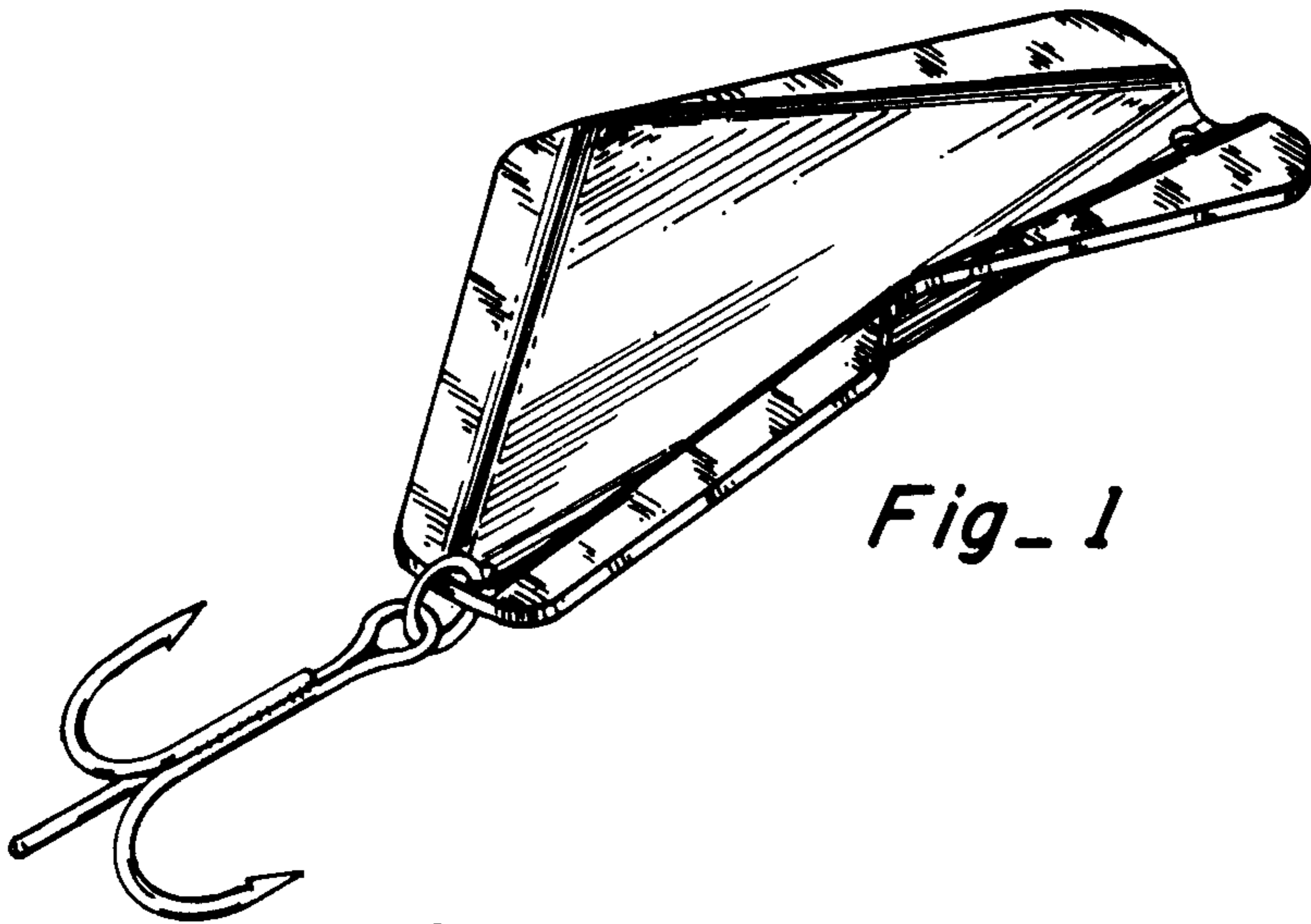

The ornamental design for the adjustable fish lure, as shown and described.

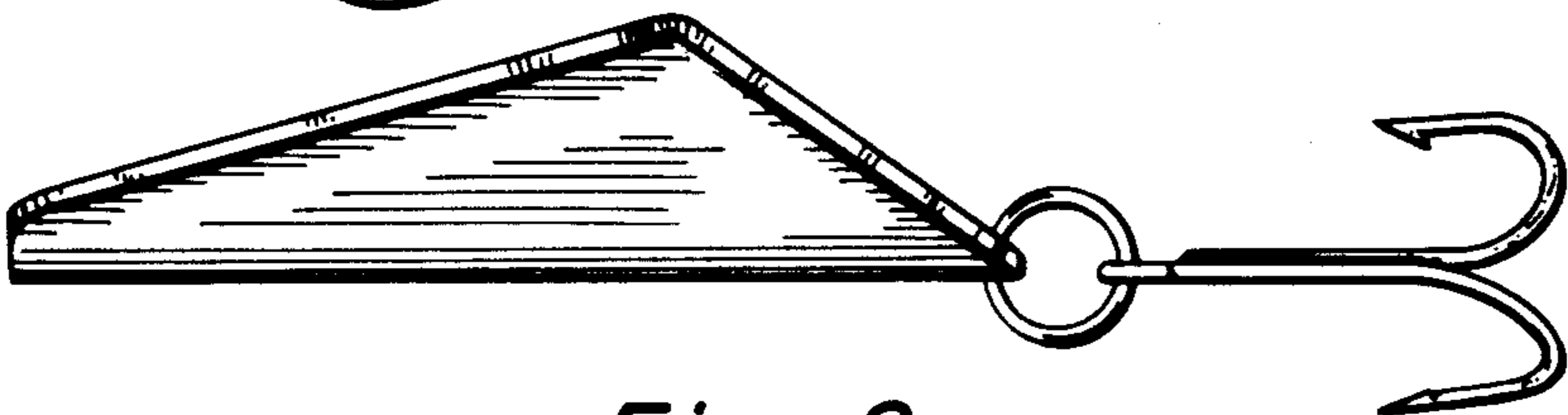
DESCRIPTION

 FIG. 12 is a rear end view of FIG. 7.

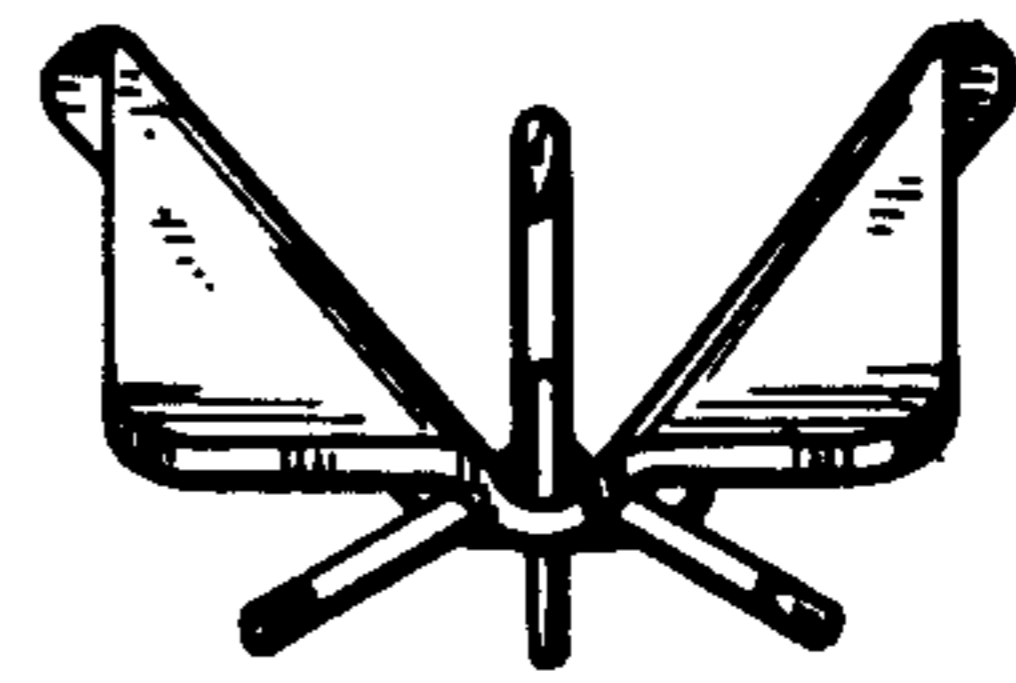




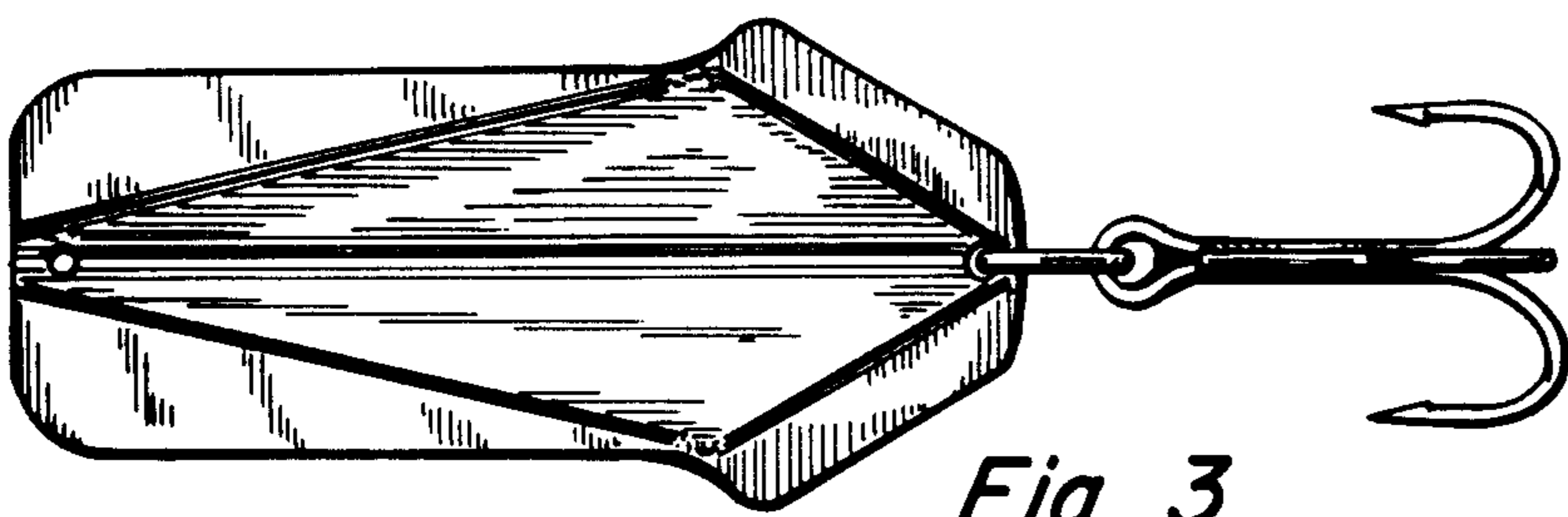

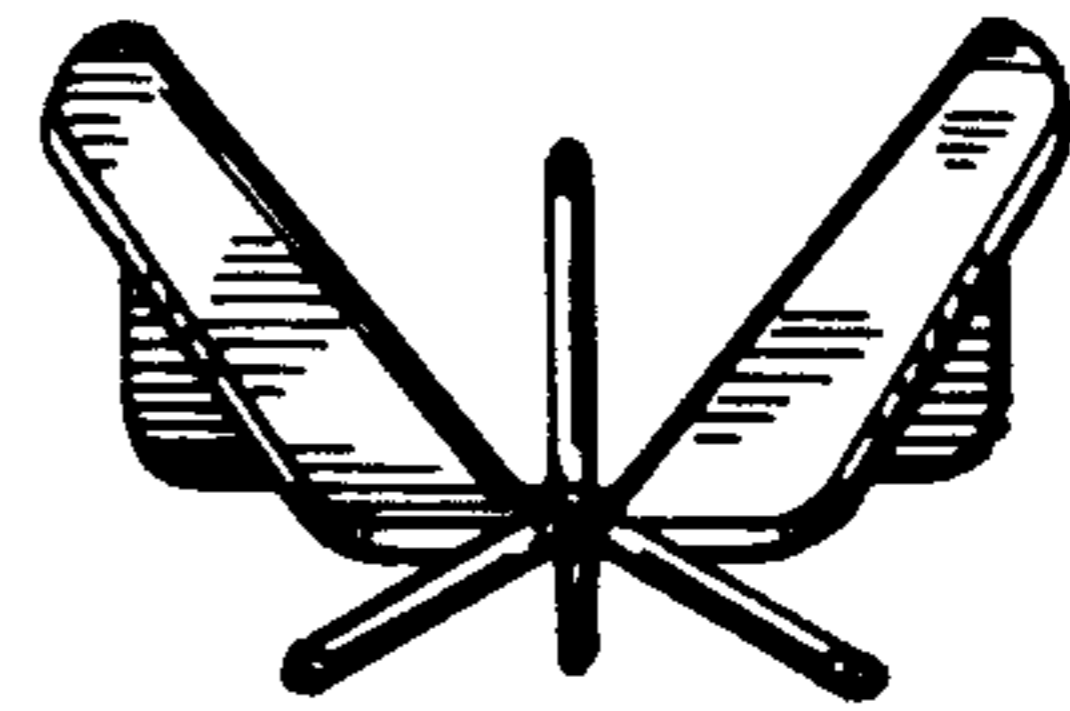

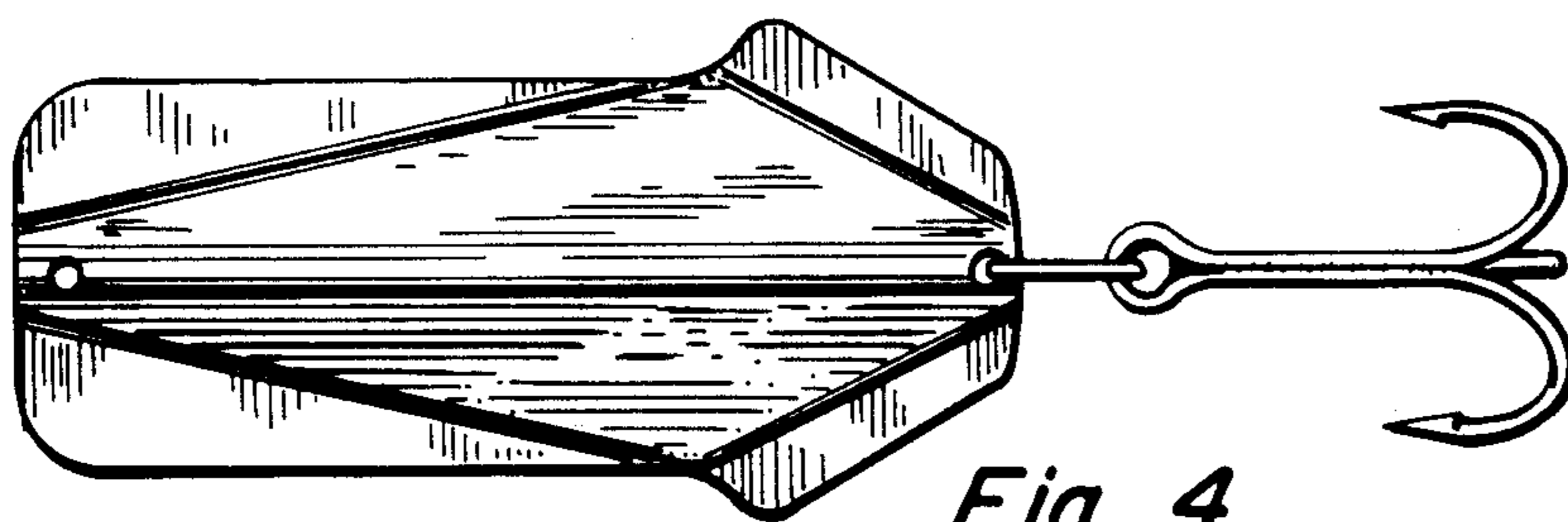

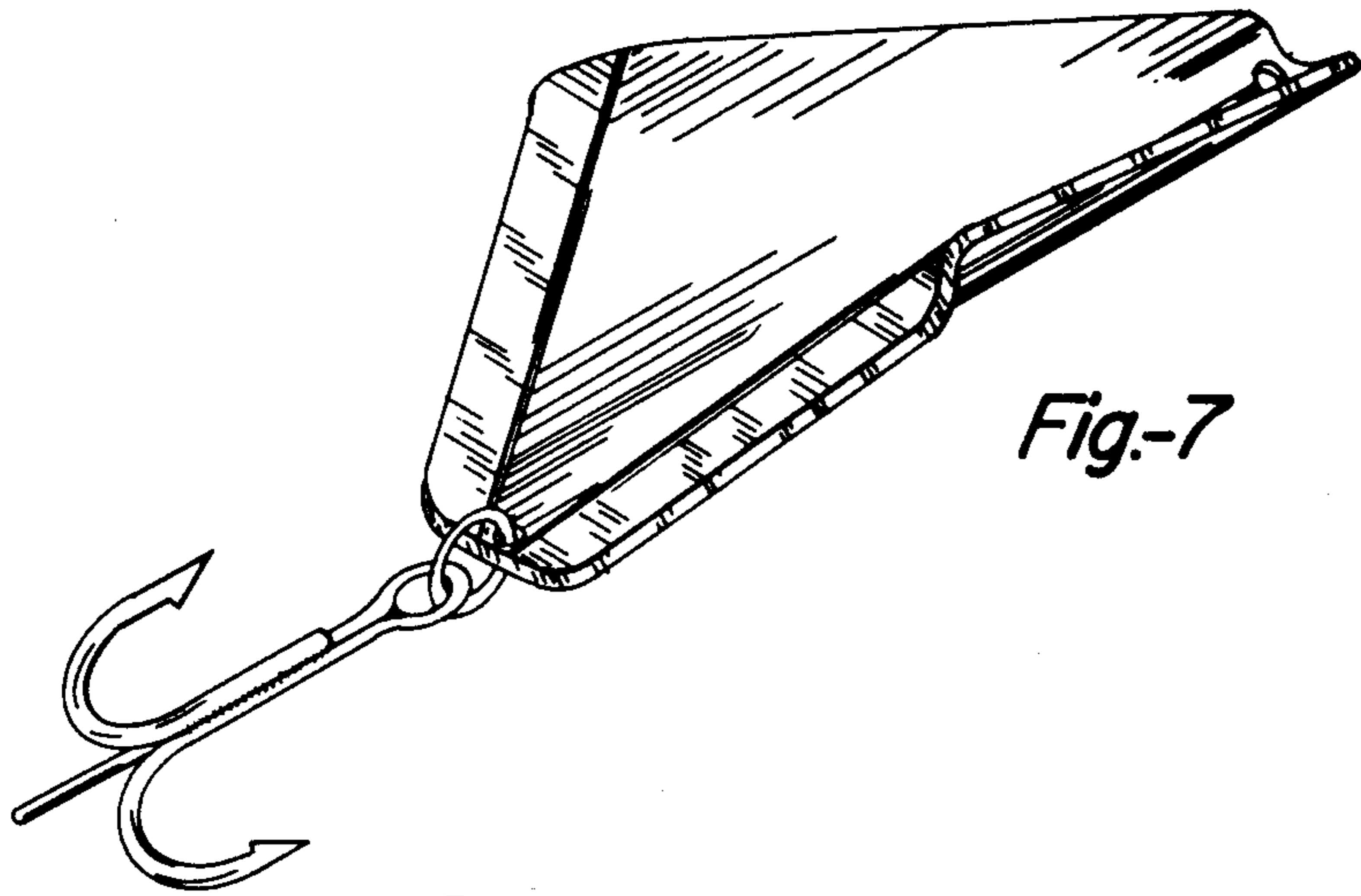

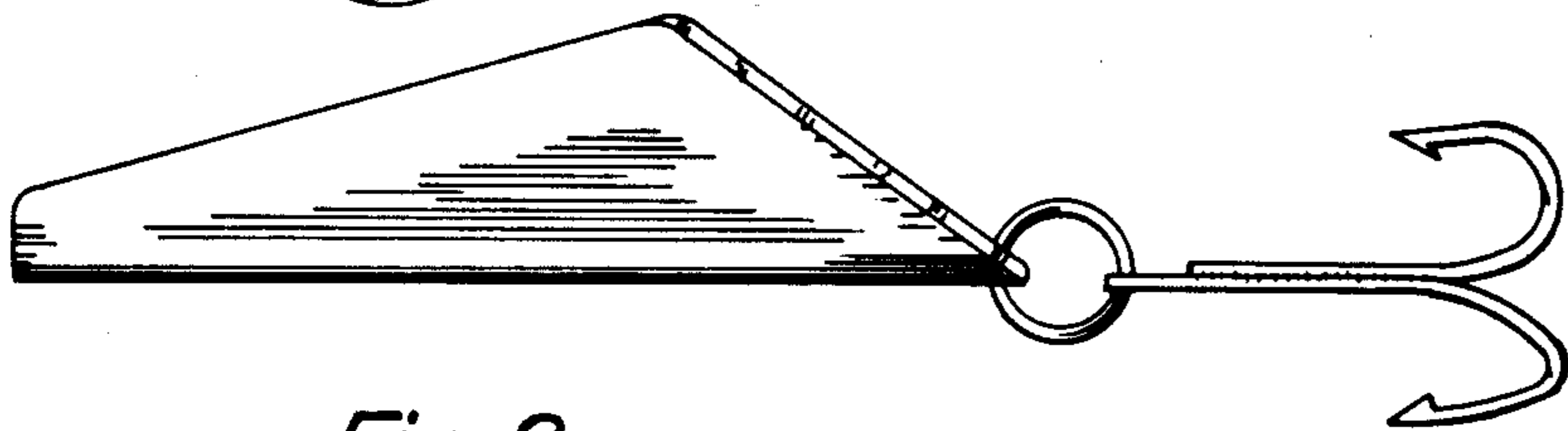

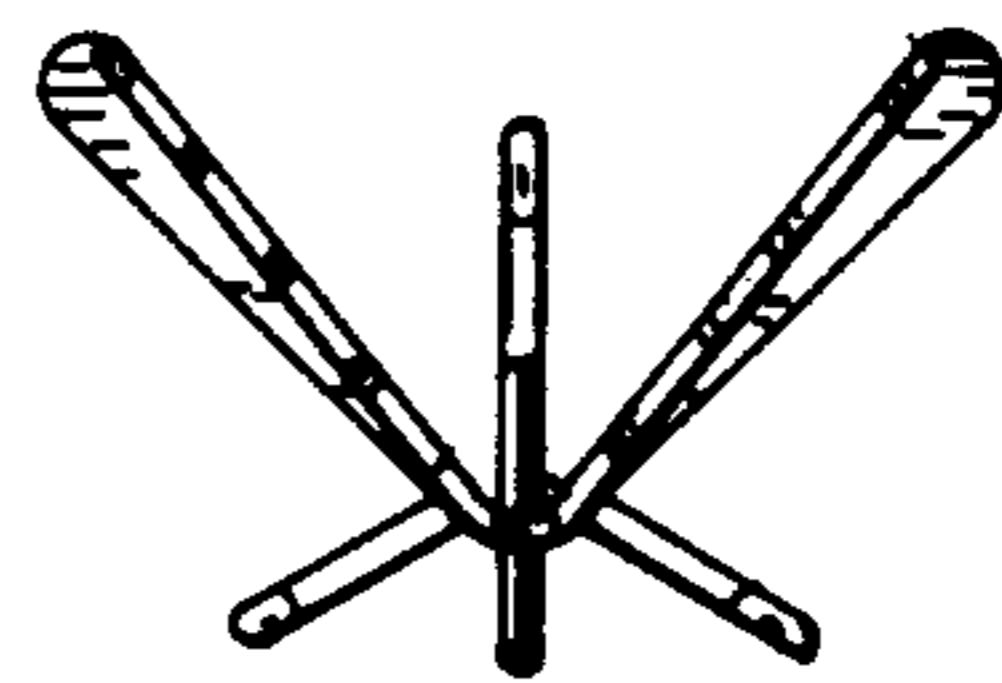

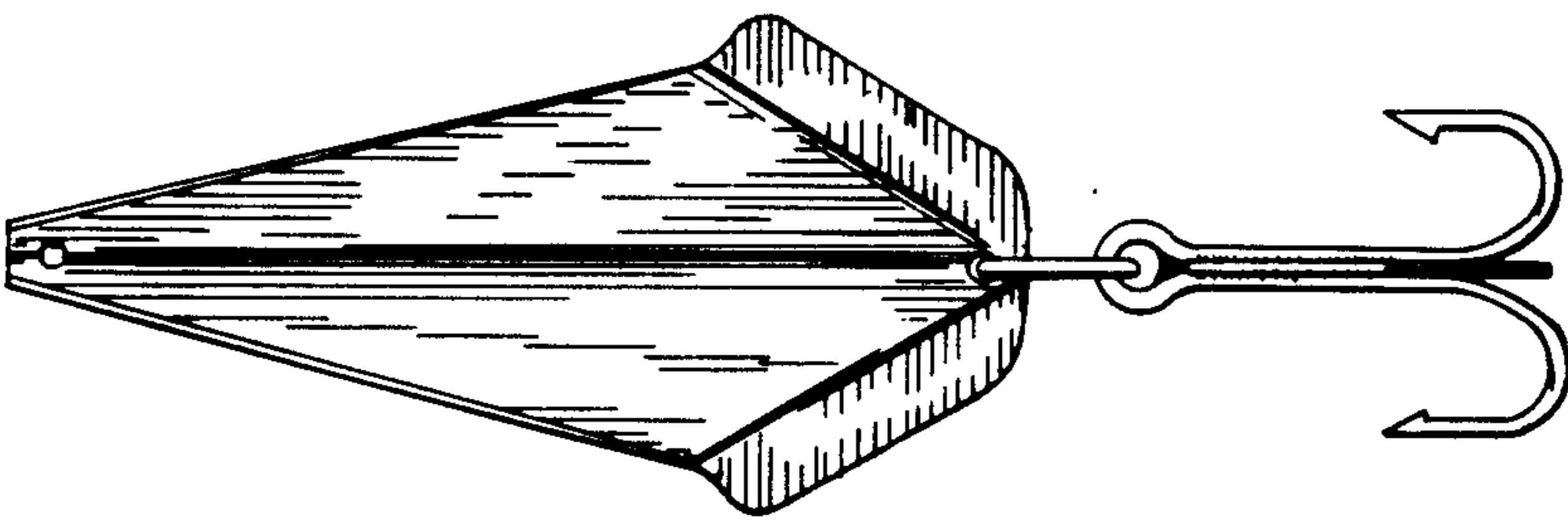

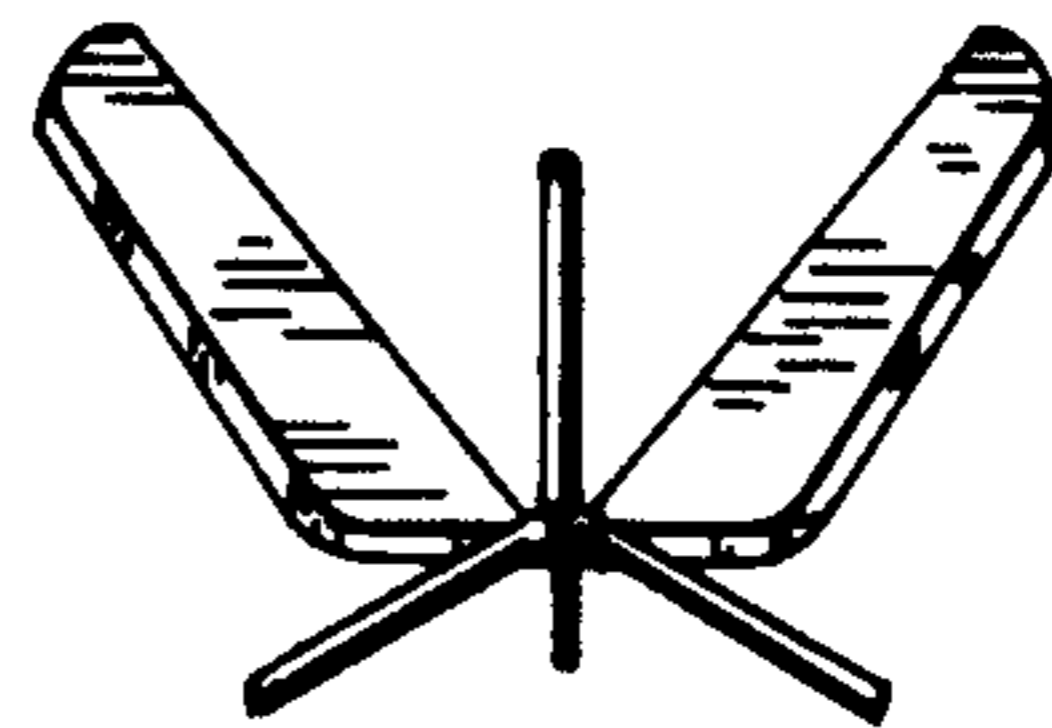

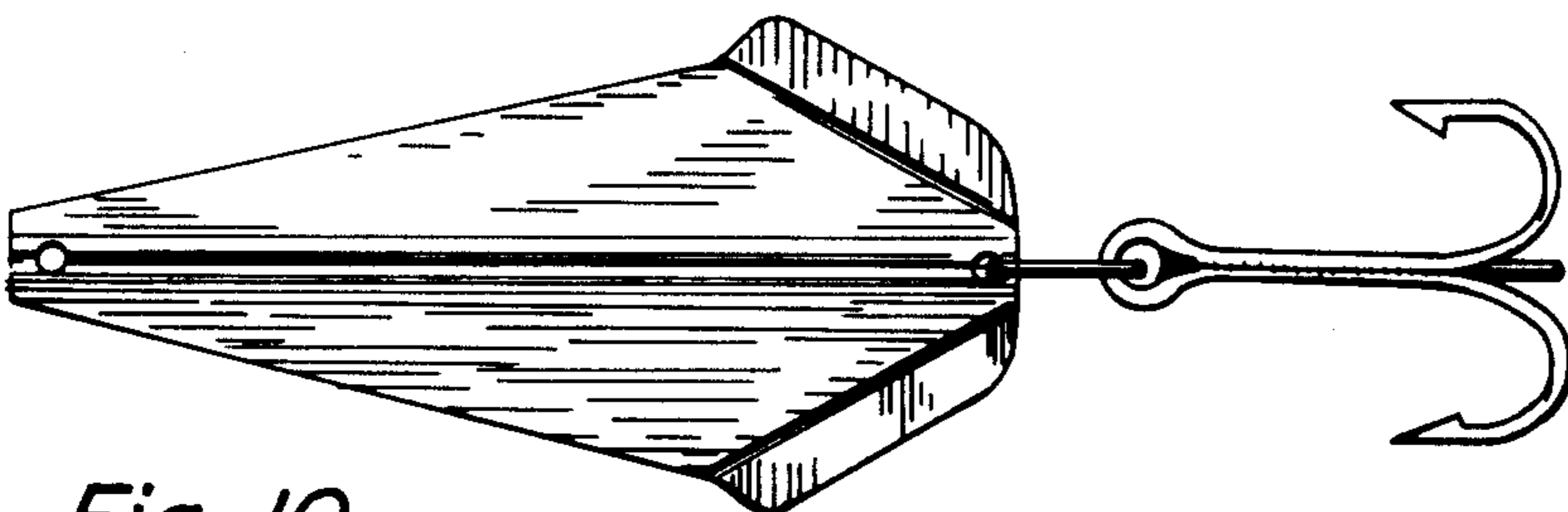
