[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a washer spin tube puller, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of a washer spin tube puller showing my new design with an L-shaped head plate.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of an alternative embodiment of a washer spin tube puller showing my new design with a triangular shaped head plate, the washer spin tube puller being otherwise similar to the FIG. 1 embodiment.

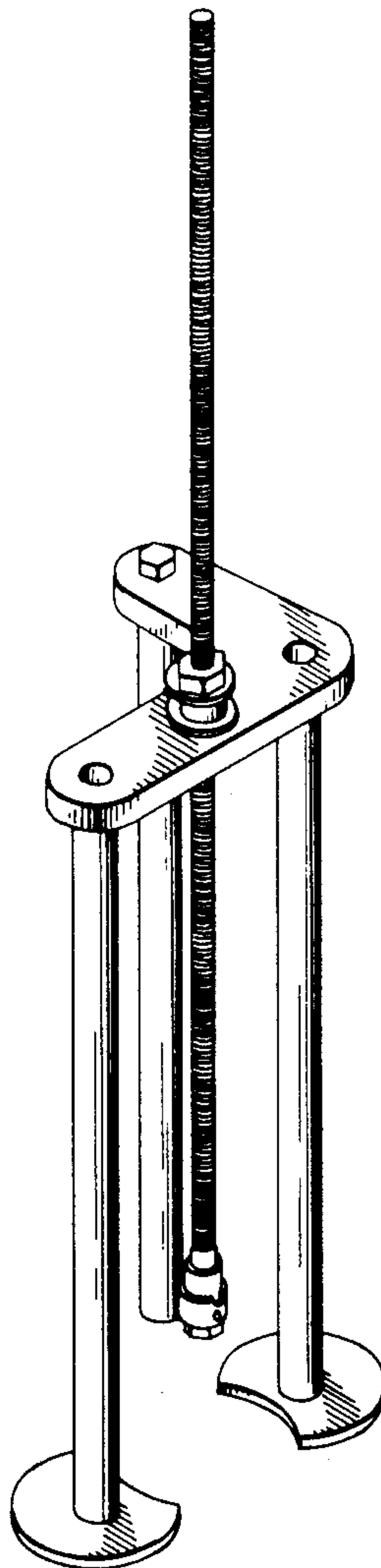

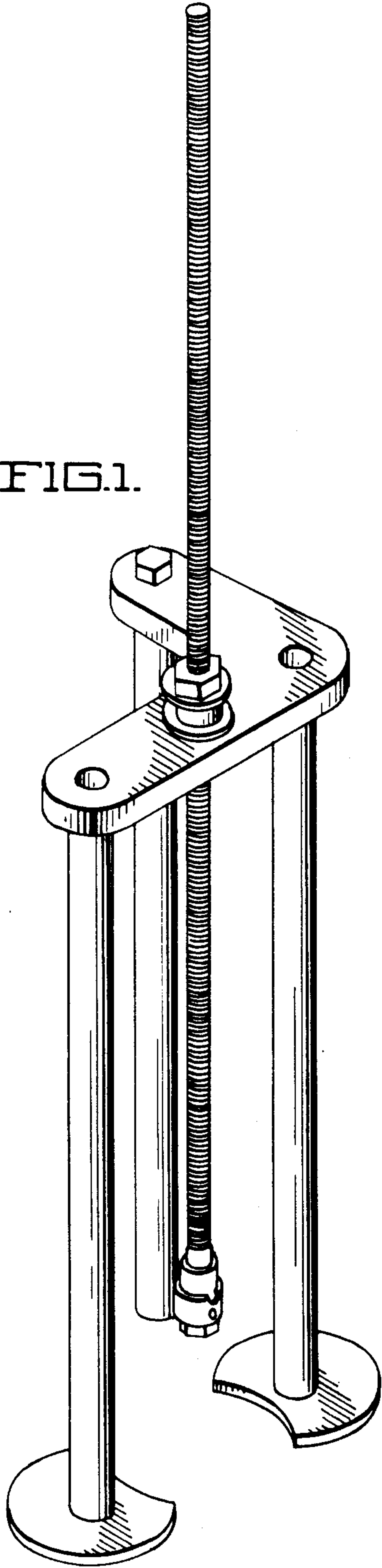

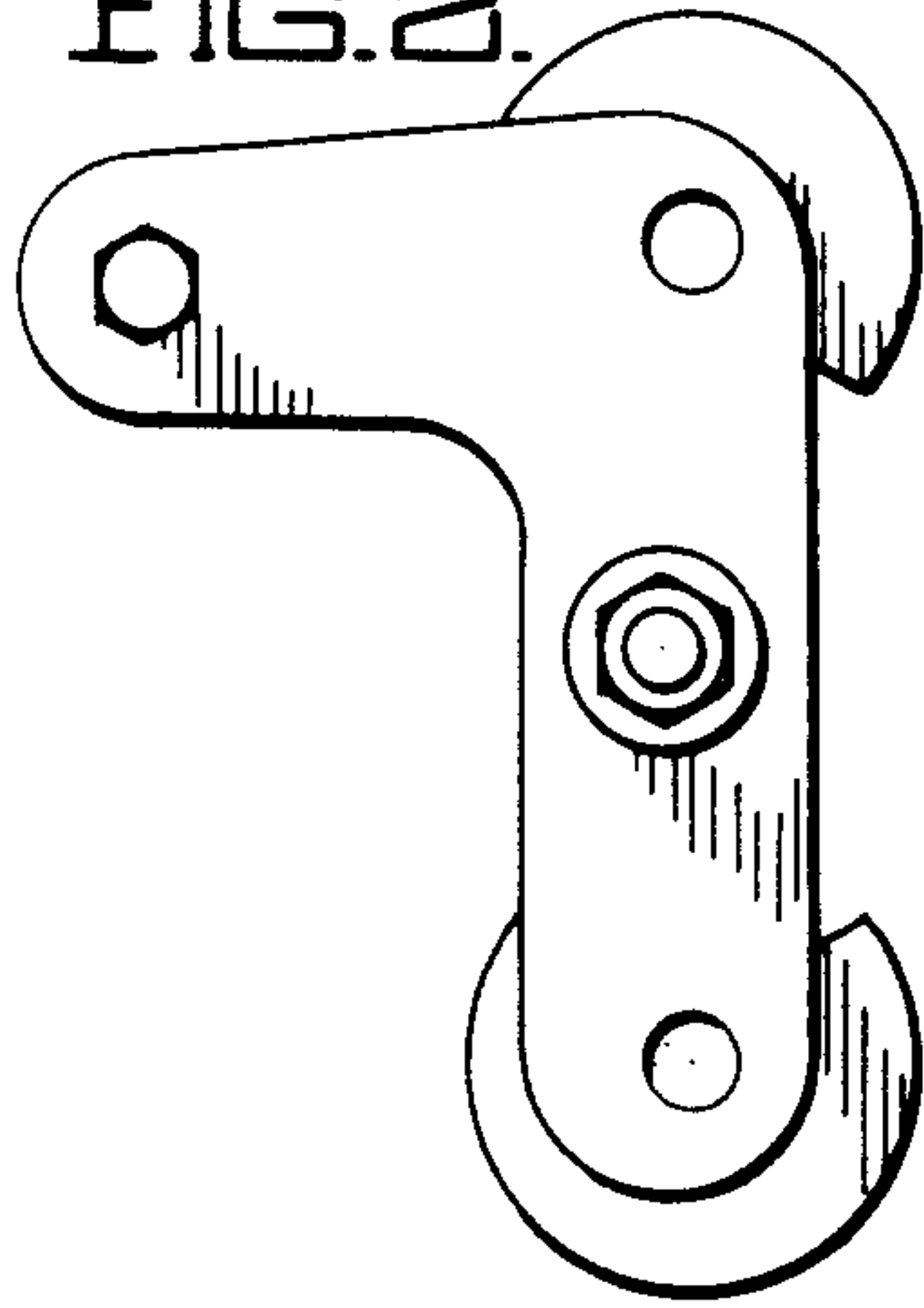

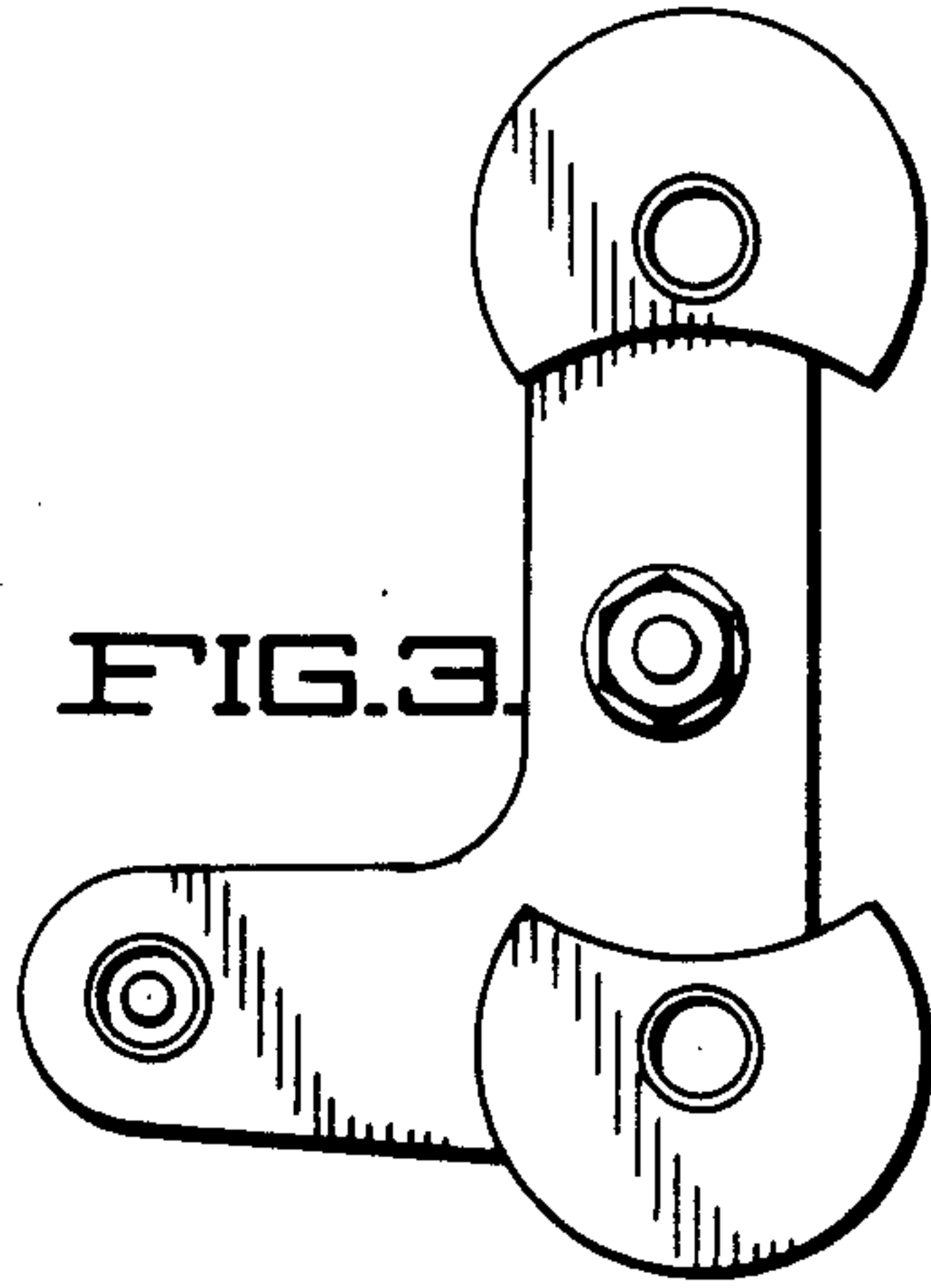
