


The ornamental design for a desk clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right front perspective view of a desk clock showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof as taken from line 4—4 of FIG. 3, the bottom being flat and unornamented.






