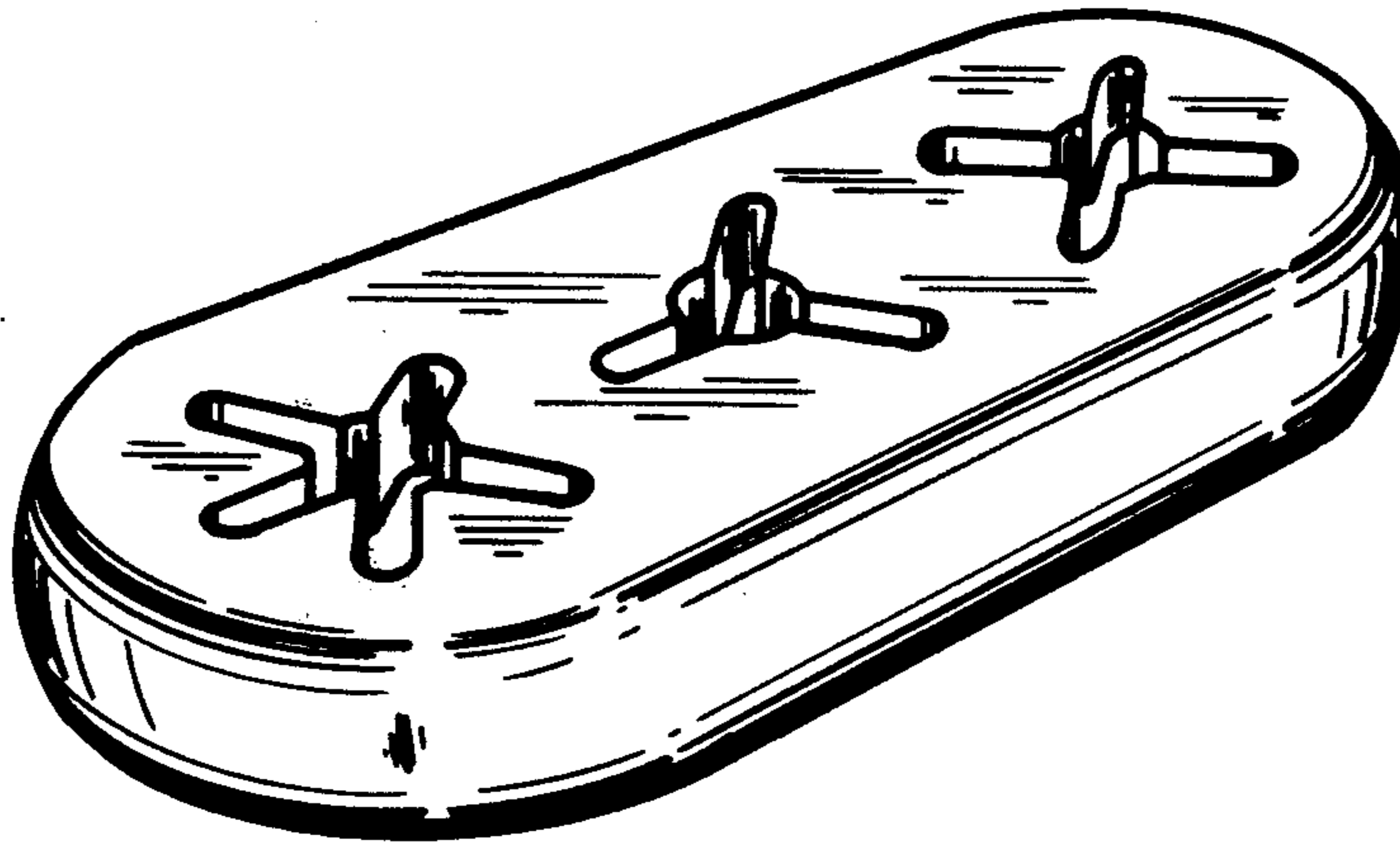

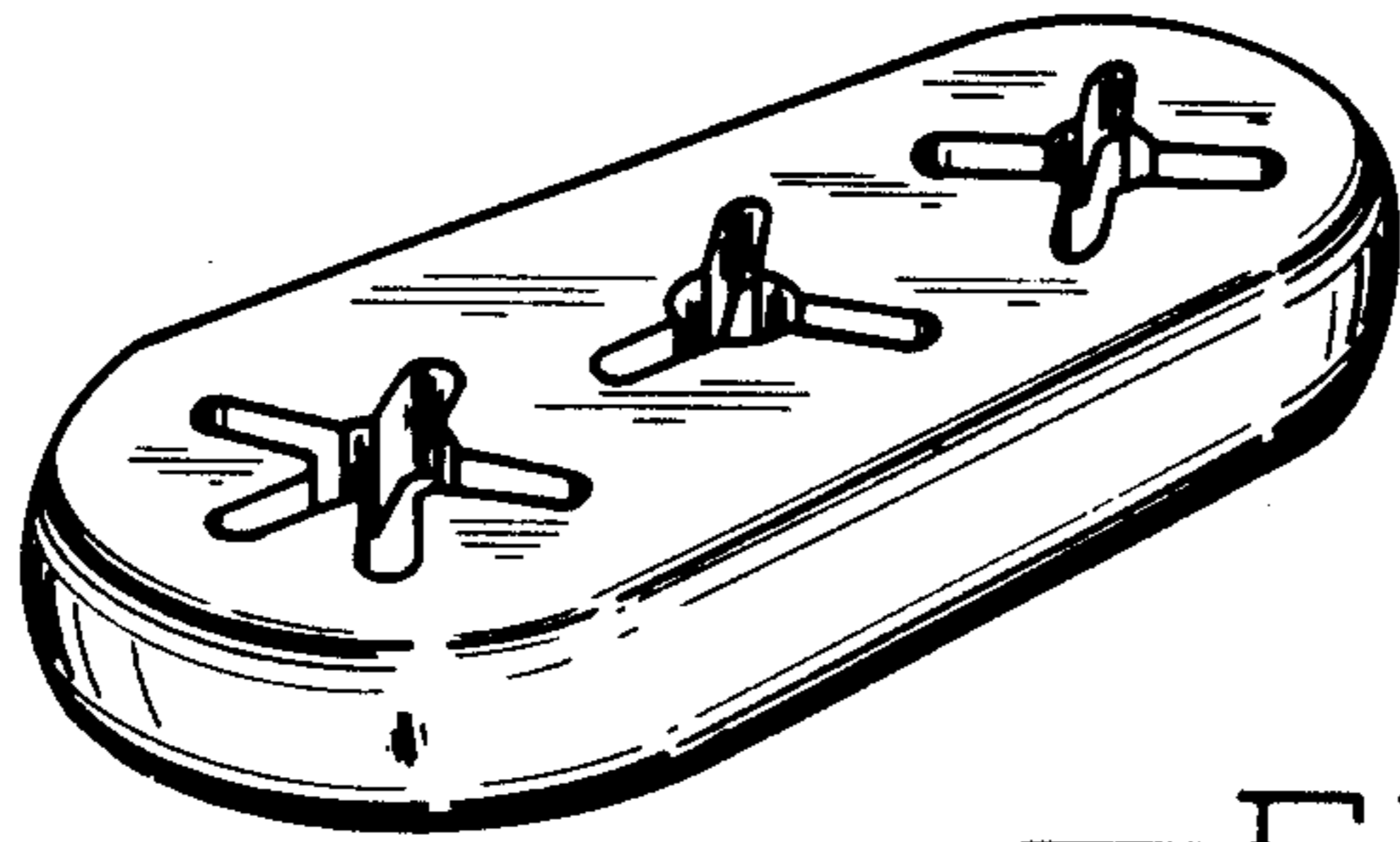

The ornamental design for an arrowhead remover, as shown.

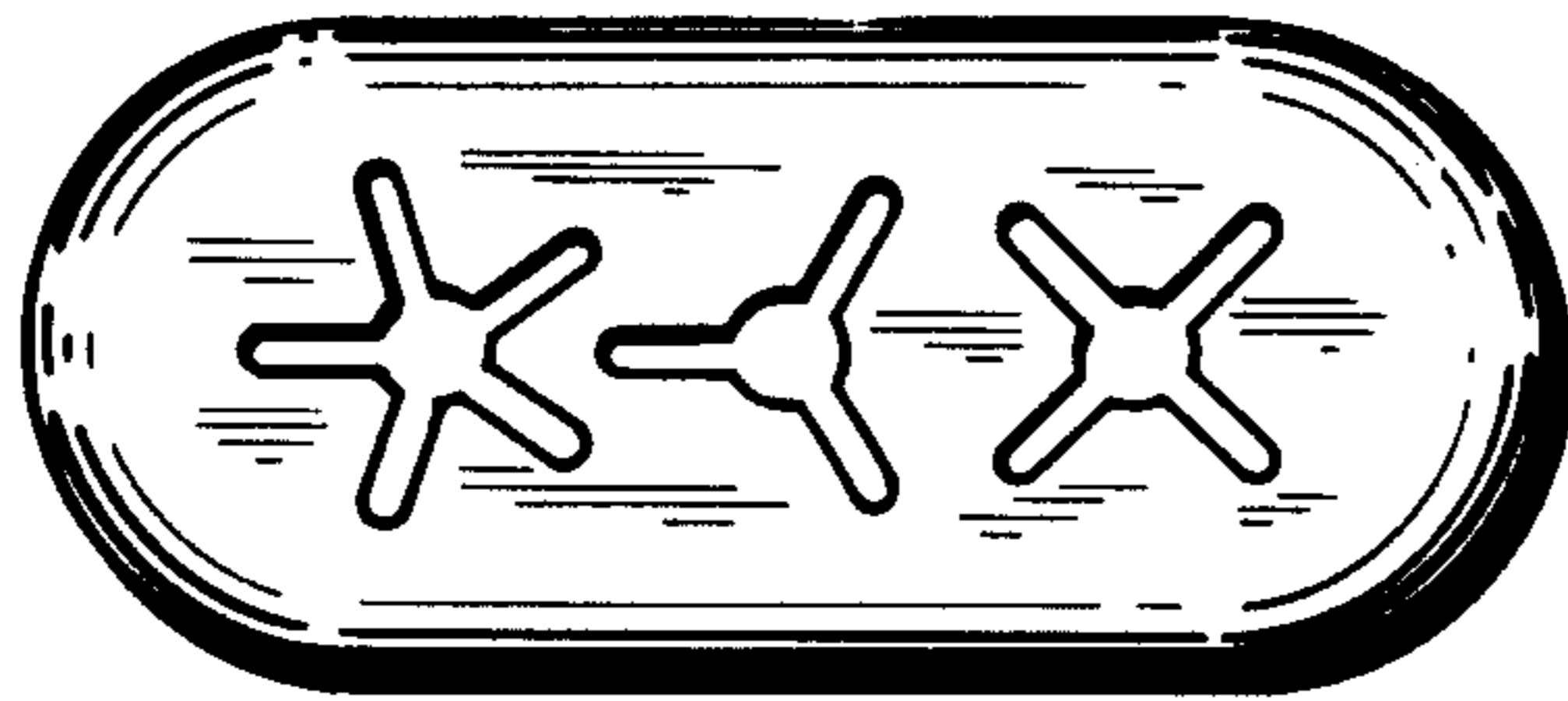
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is an end view.

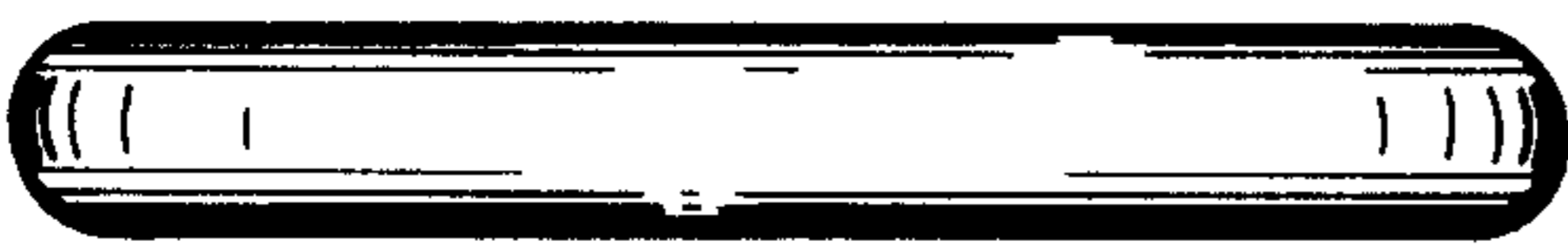
