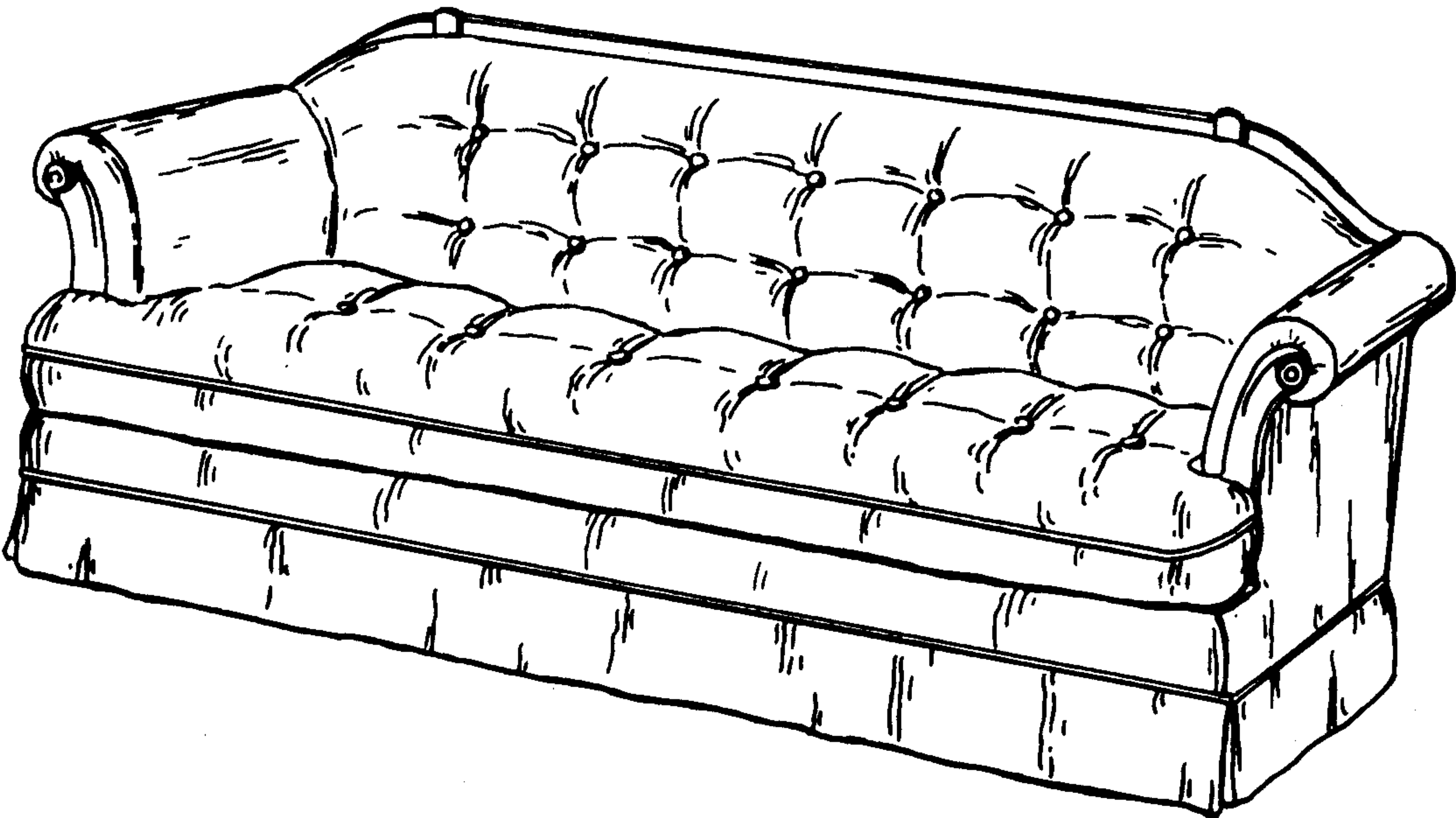

form of an armchair.



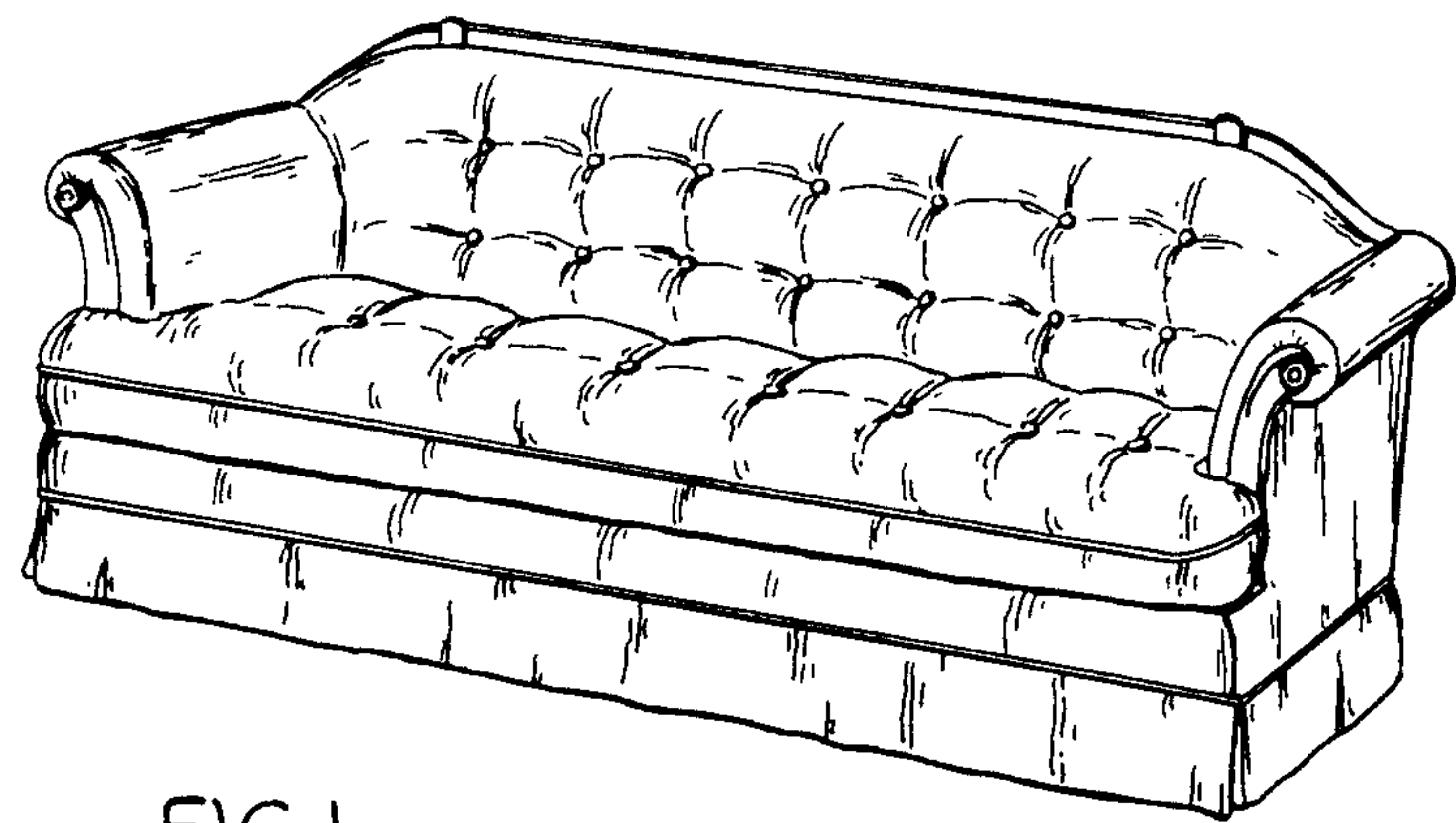

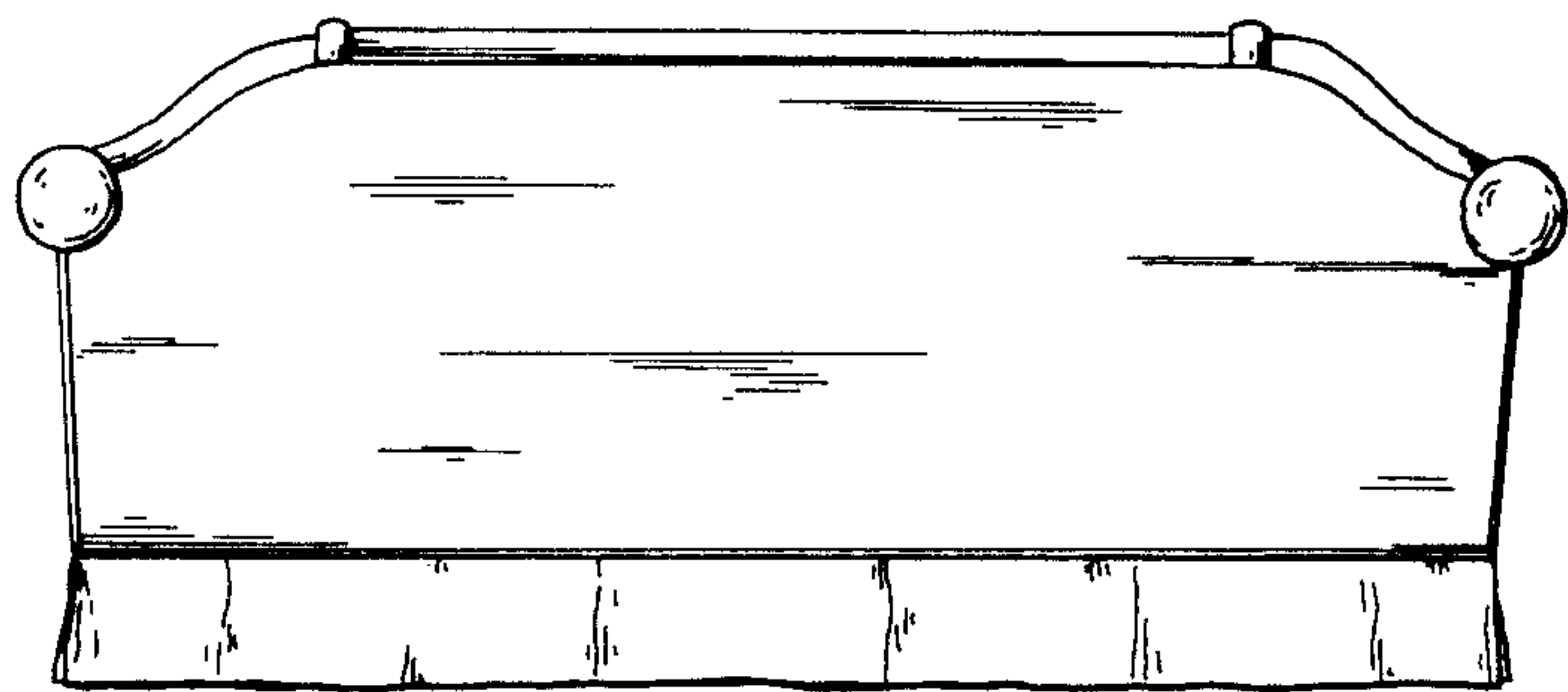

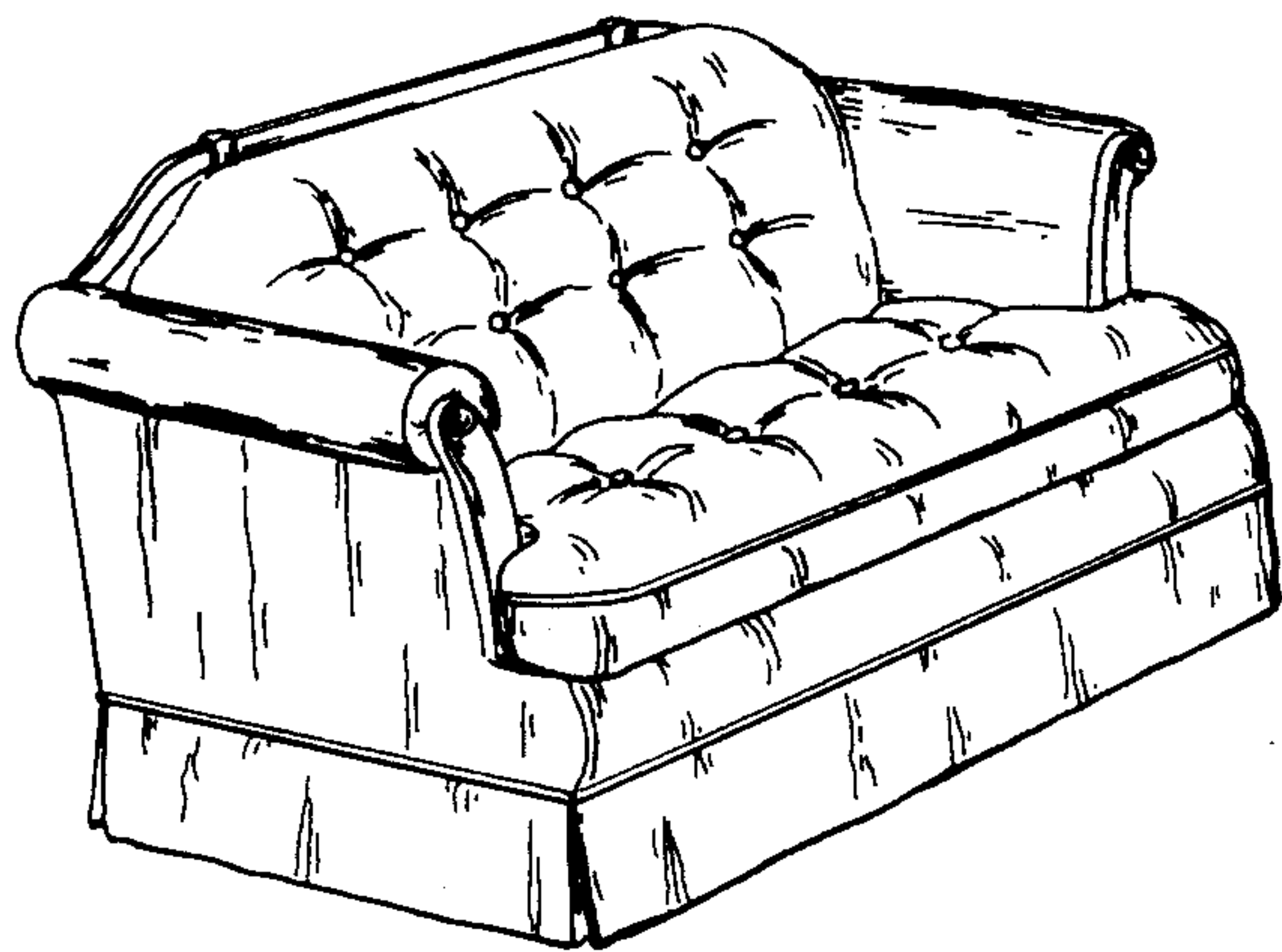

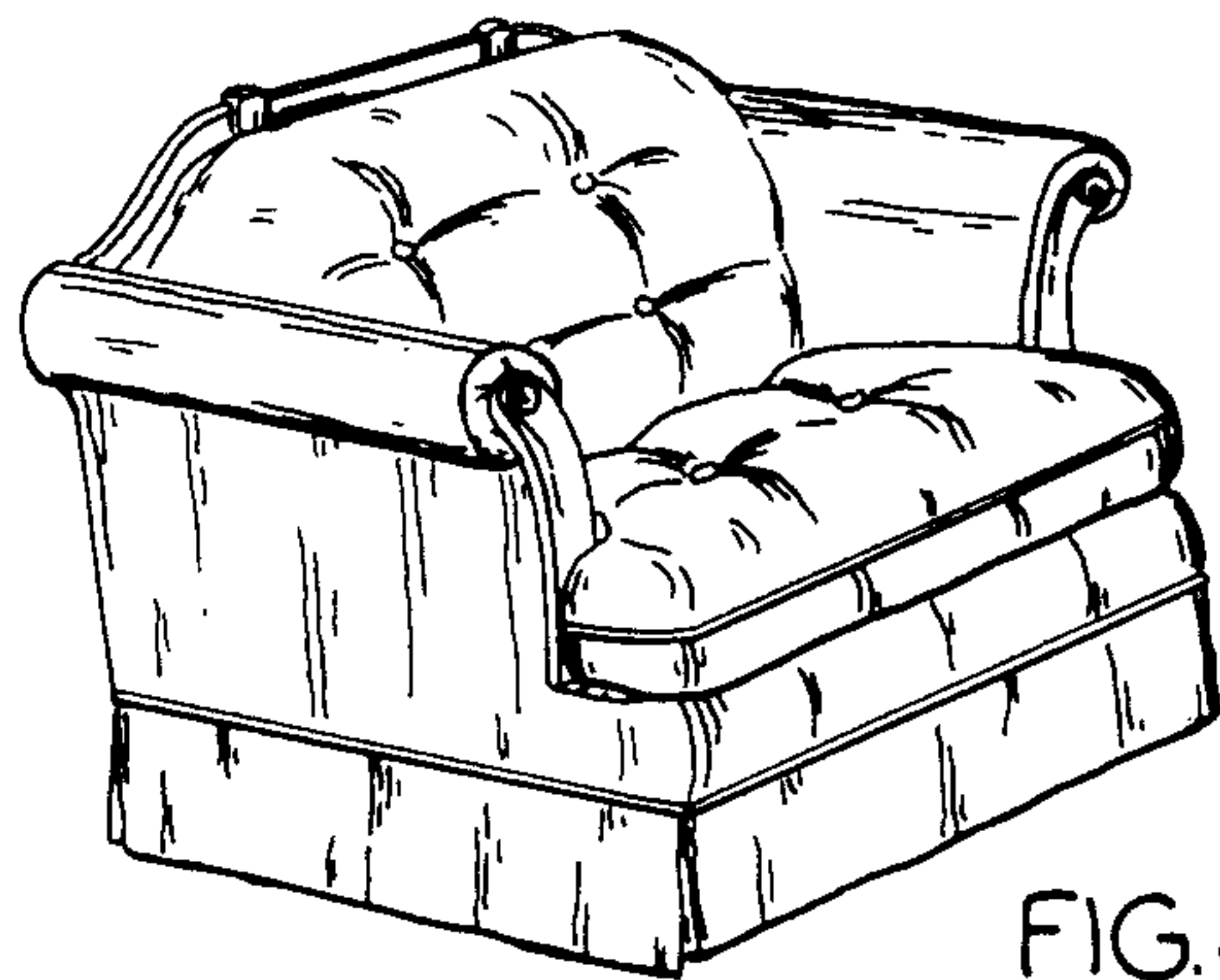
