The sides not shown are similar to the sides shown in FIG. 2 and the bottom is plain and unornamented.

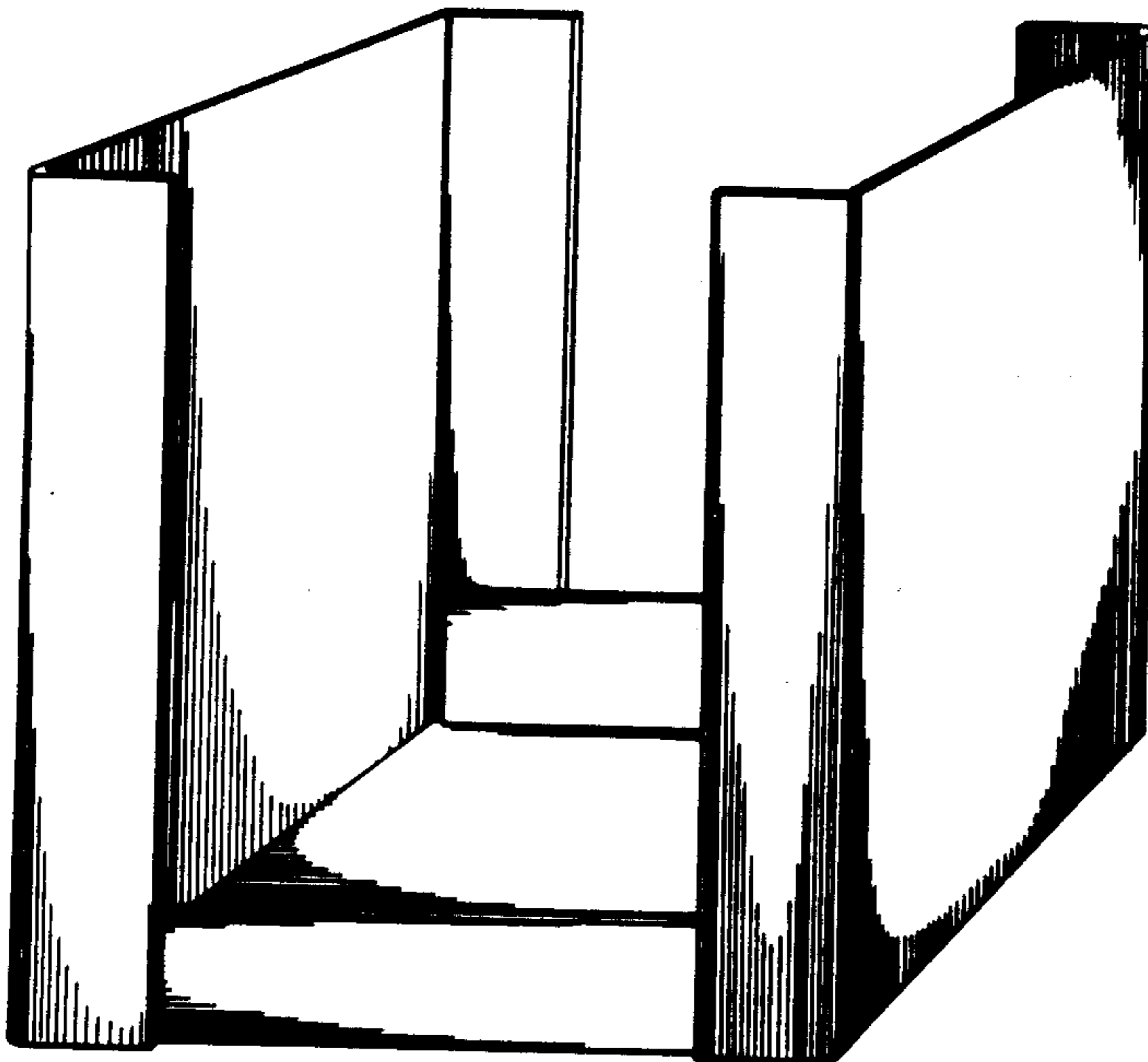

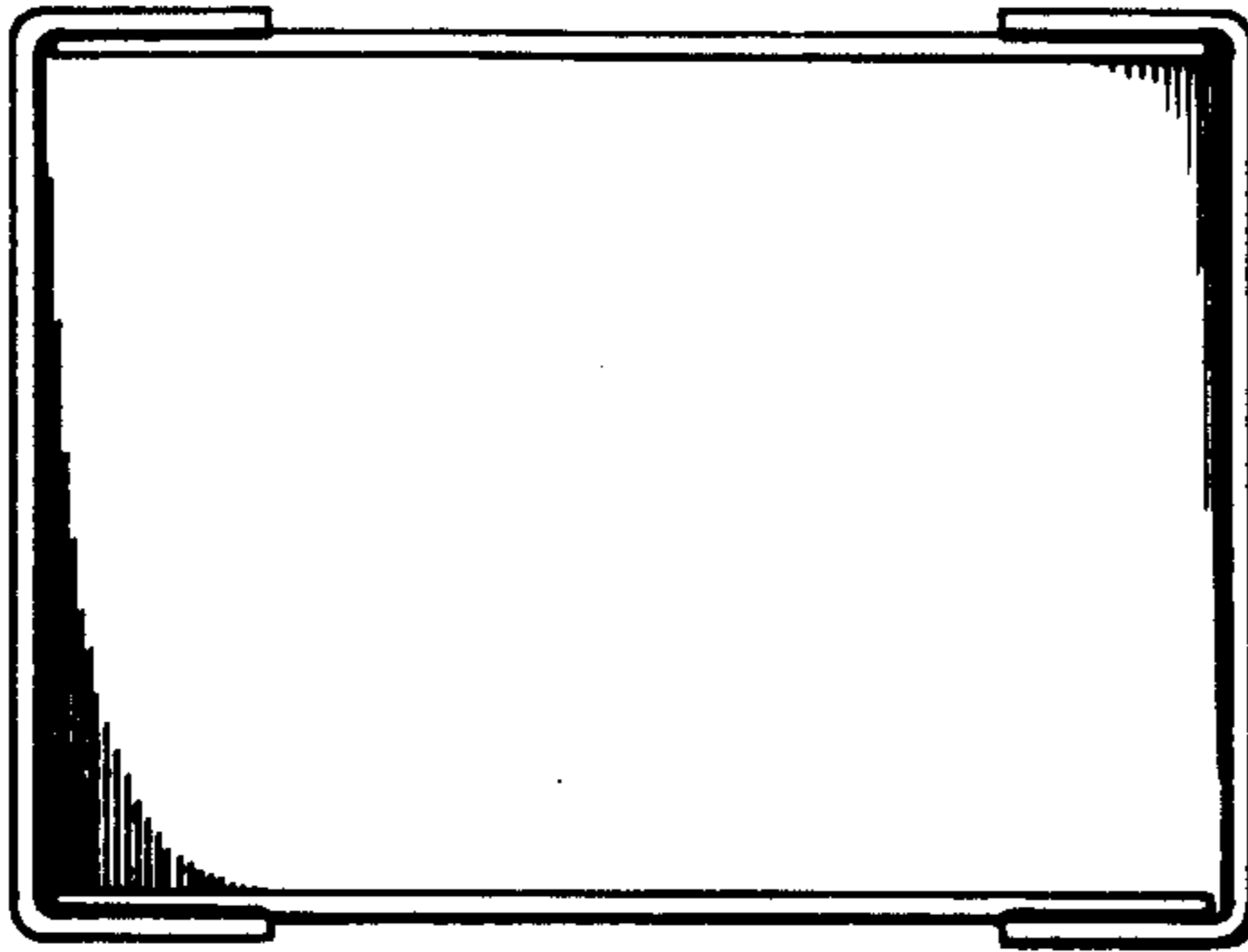
