The ornamental design for a packaging container for food, as shown and described.

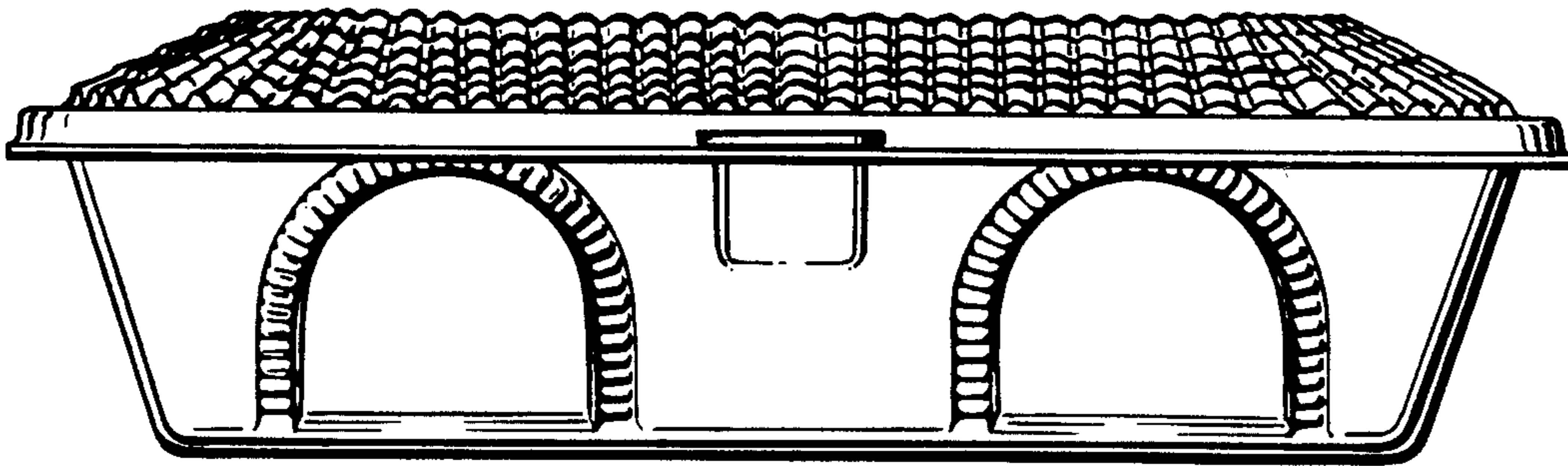
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof.



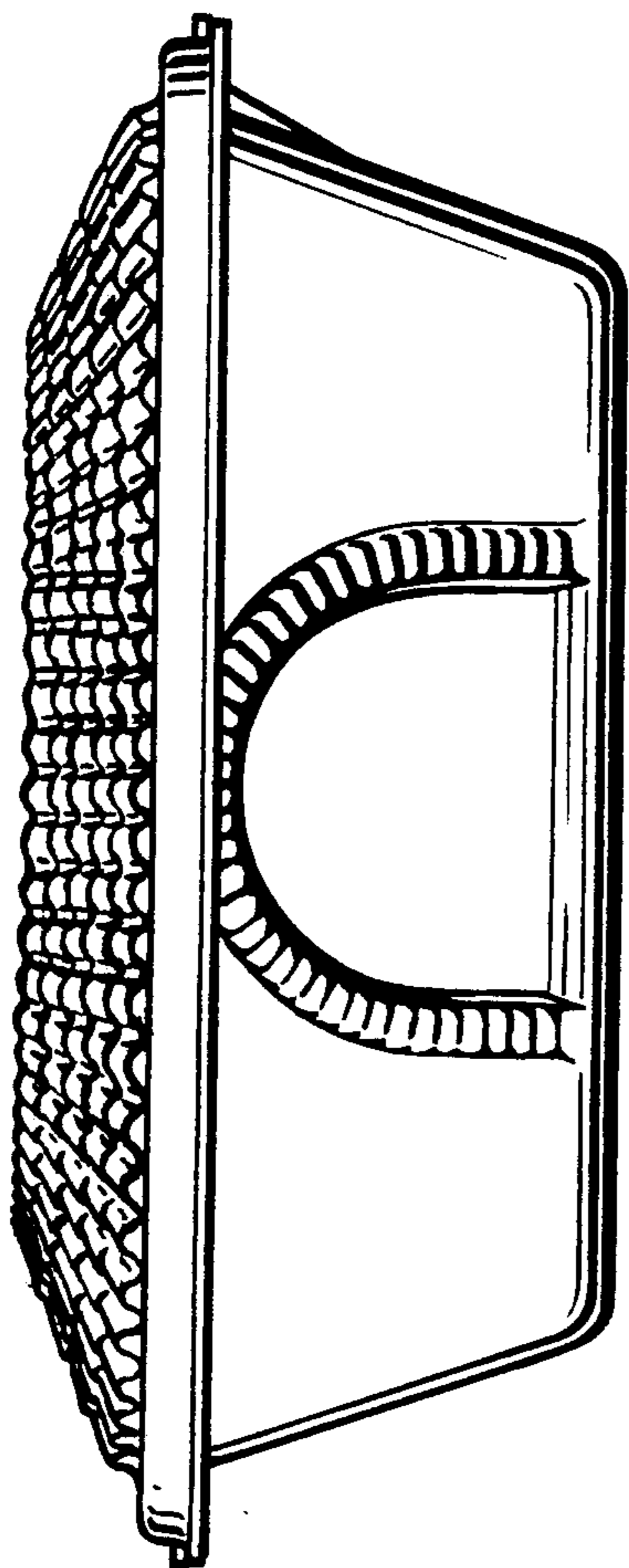

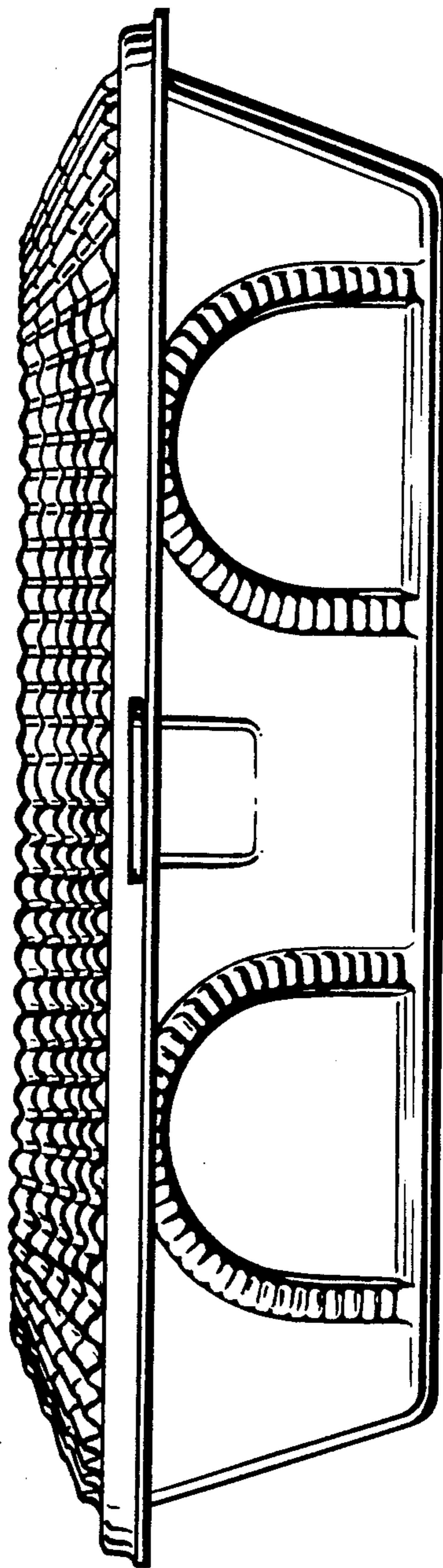

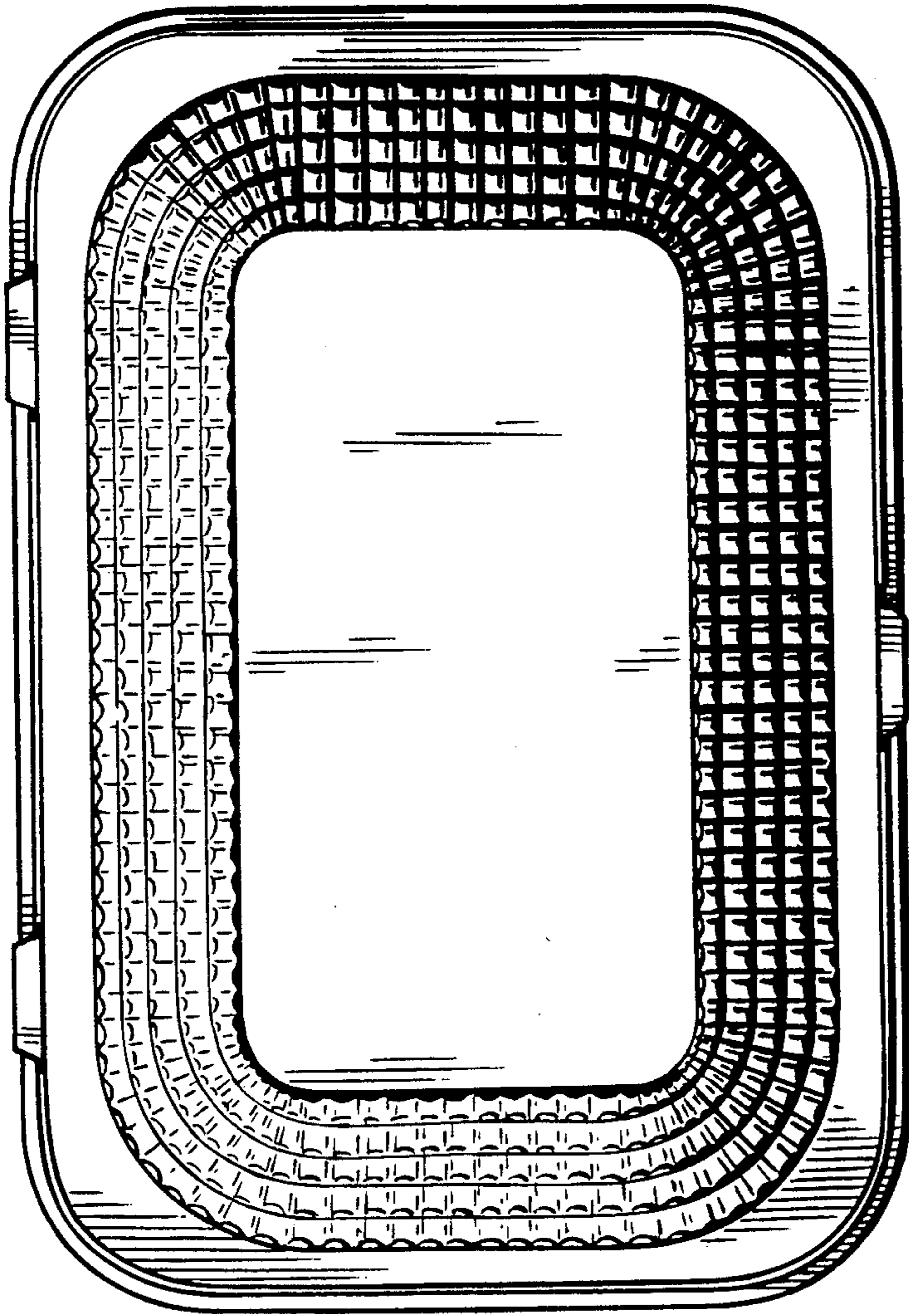

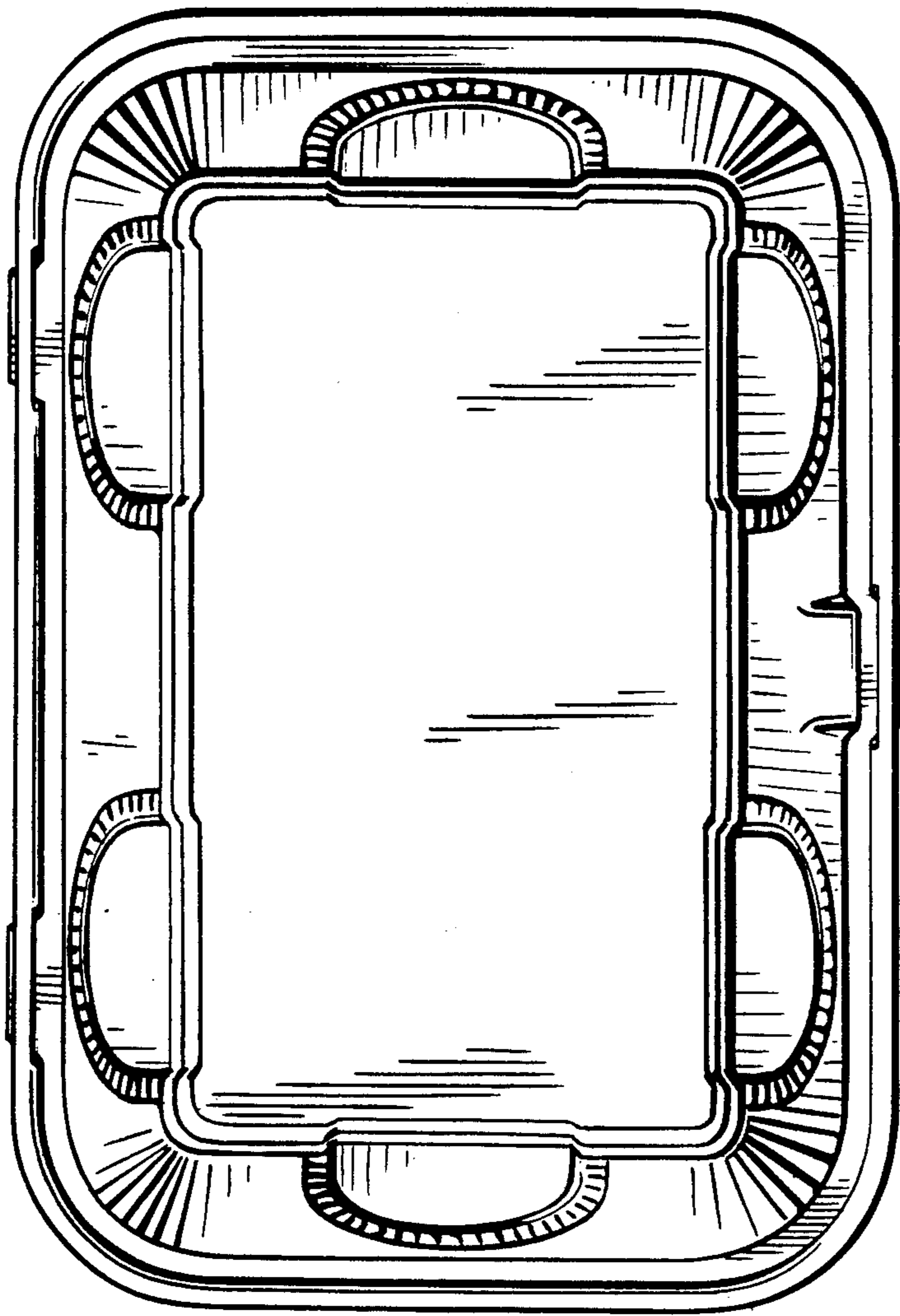
