DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a plant container embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a reduced side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a reduced bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 5-5 of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 6-6 of FIG. 3.
