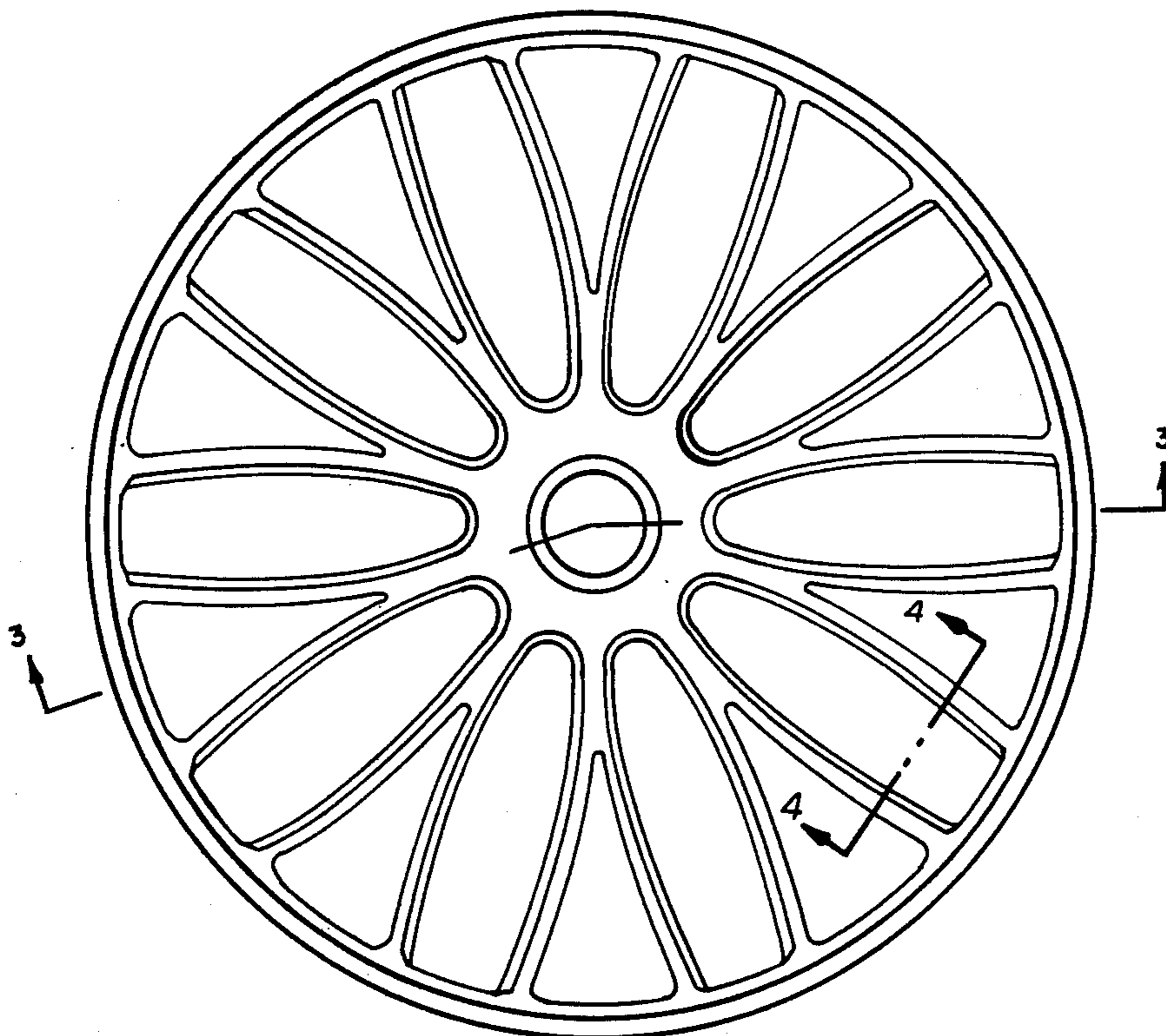

The ornamental design for a bicycle wheel or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a bicycle wheel or similar article showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an end elevation view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken on the line 3—3 of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken on the line 4—4 in FIG. 1.



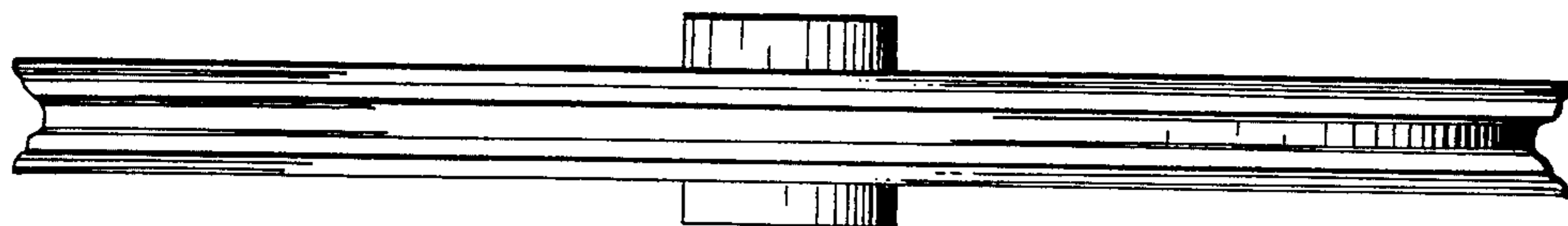

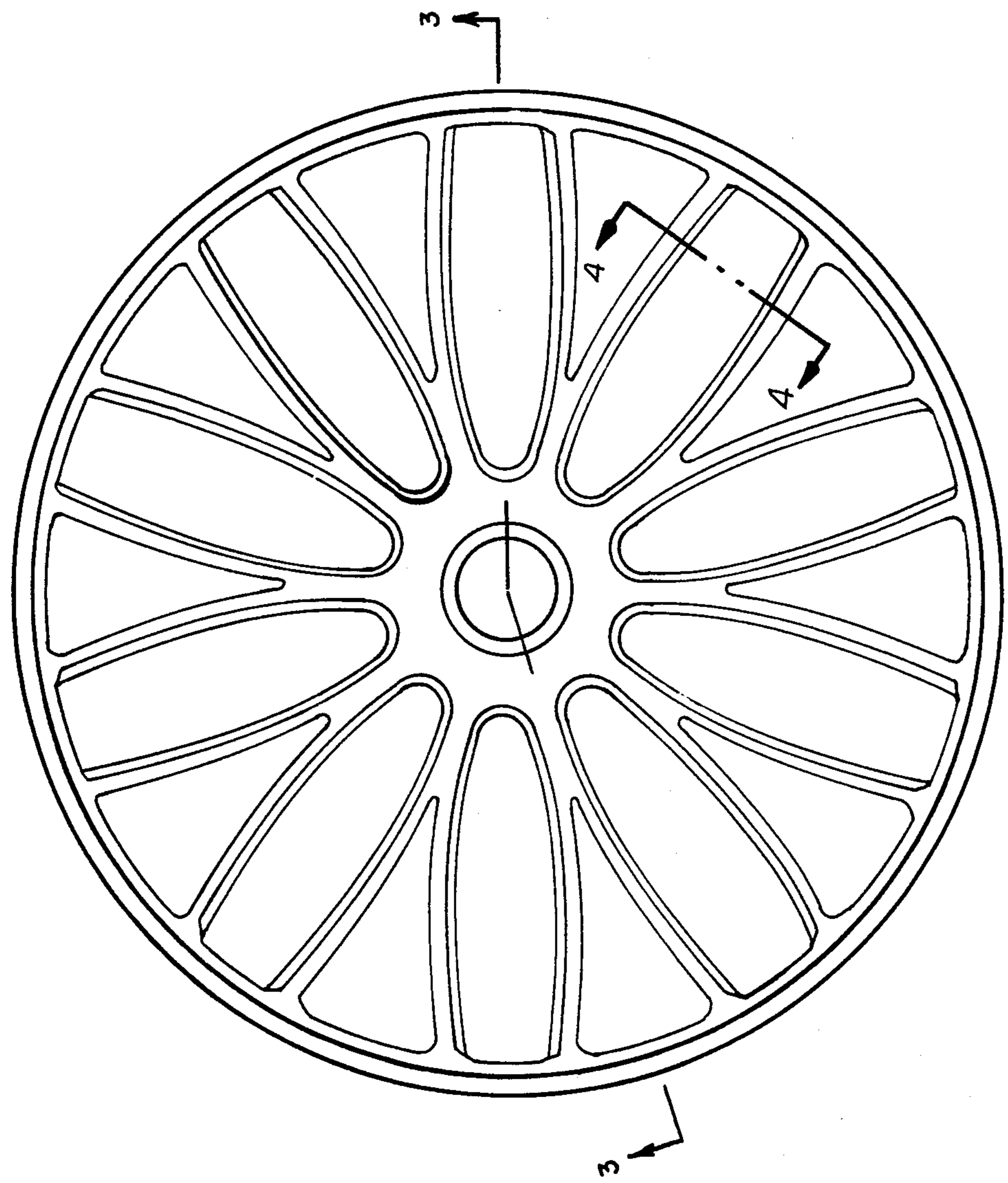

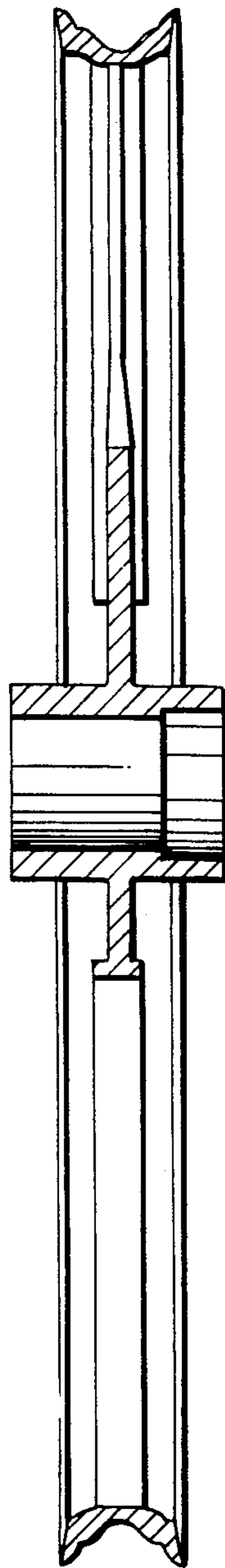
