The ornamental design for sunglasses, as shown and described.

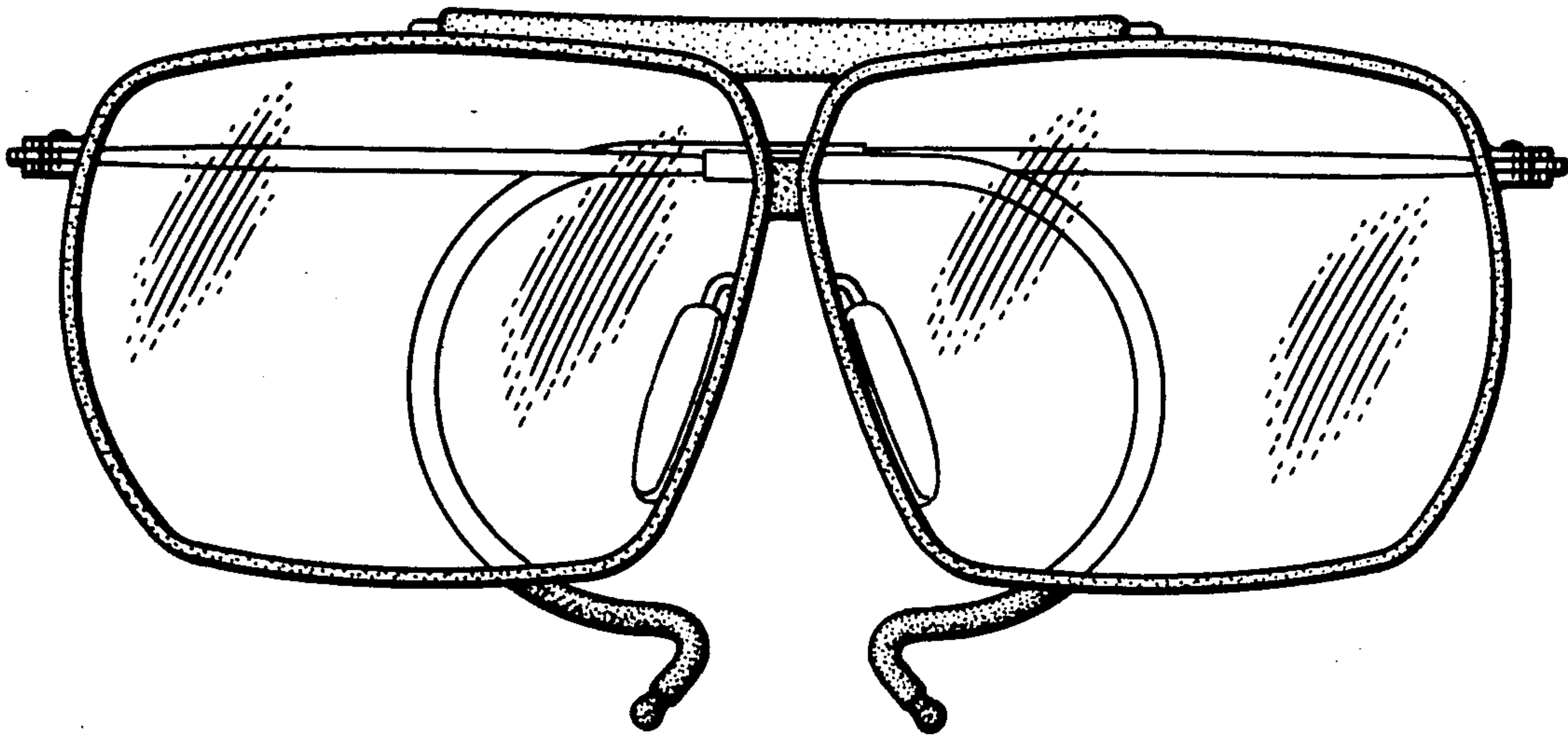
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a view of the sunglasses shown in FIG. 3 from the rear and below the lower edges of the sunglasses.



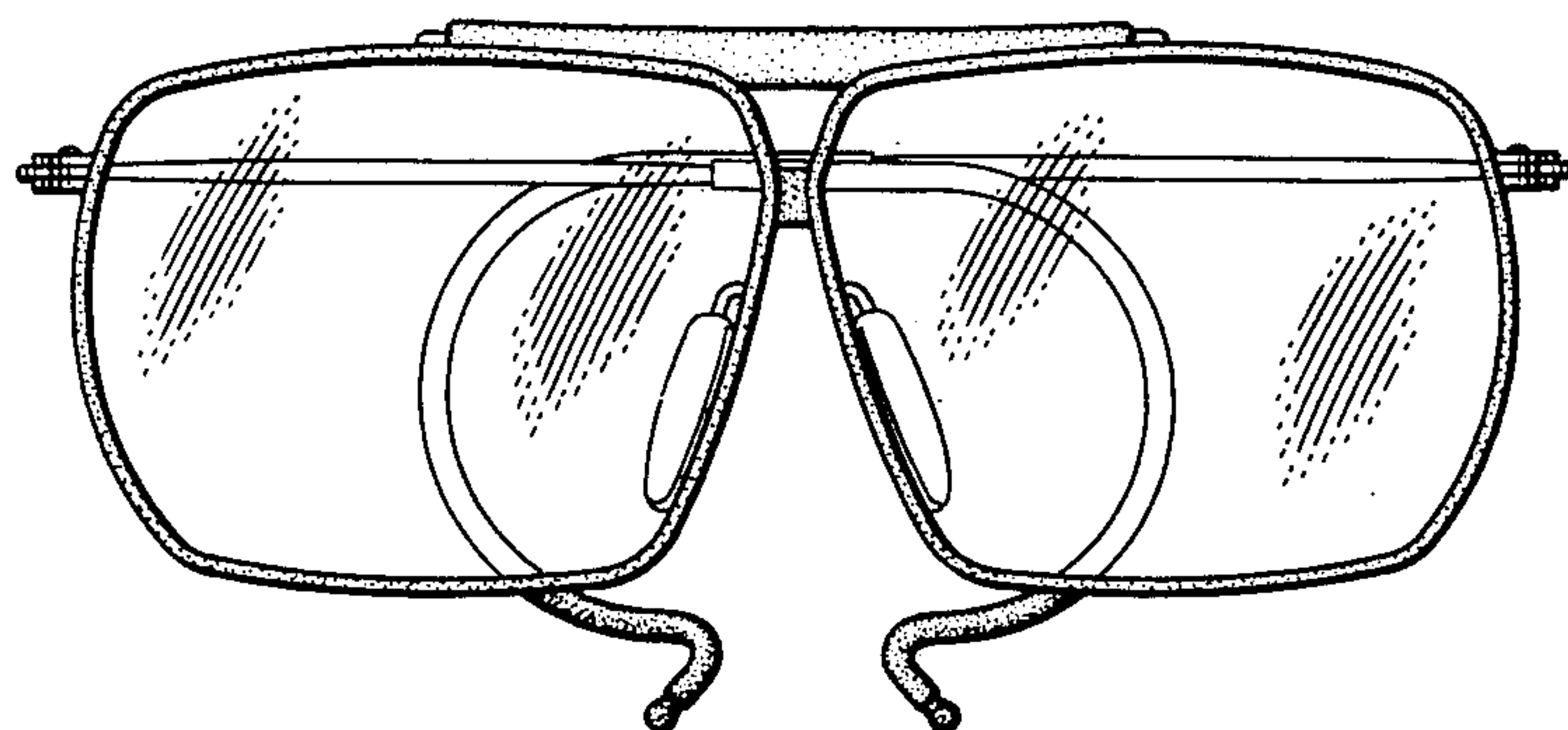

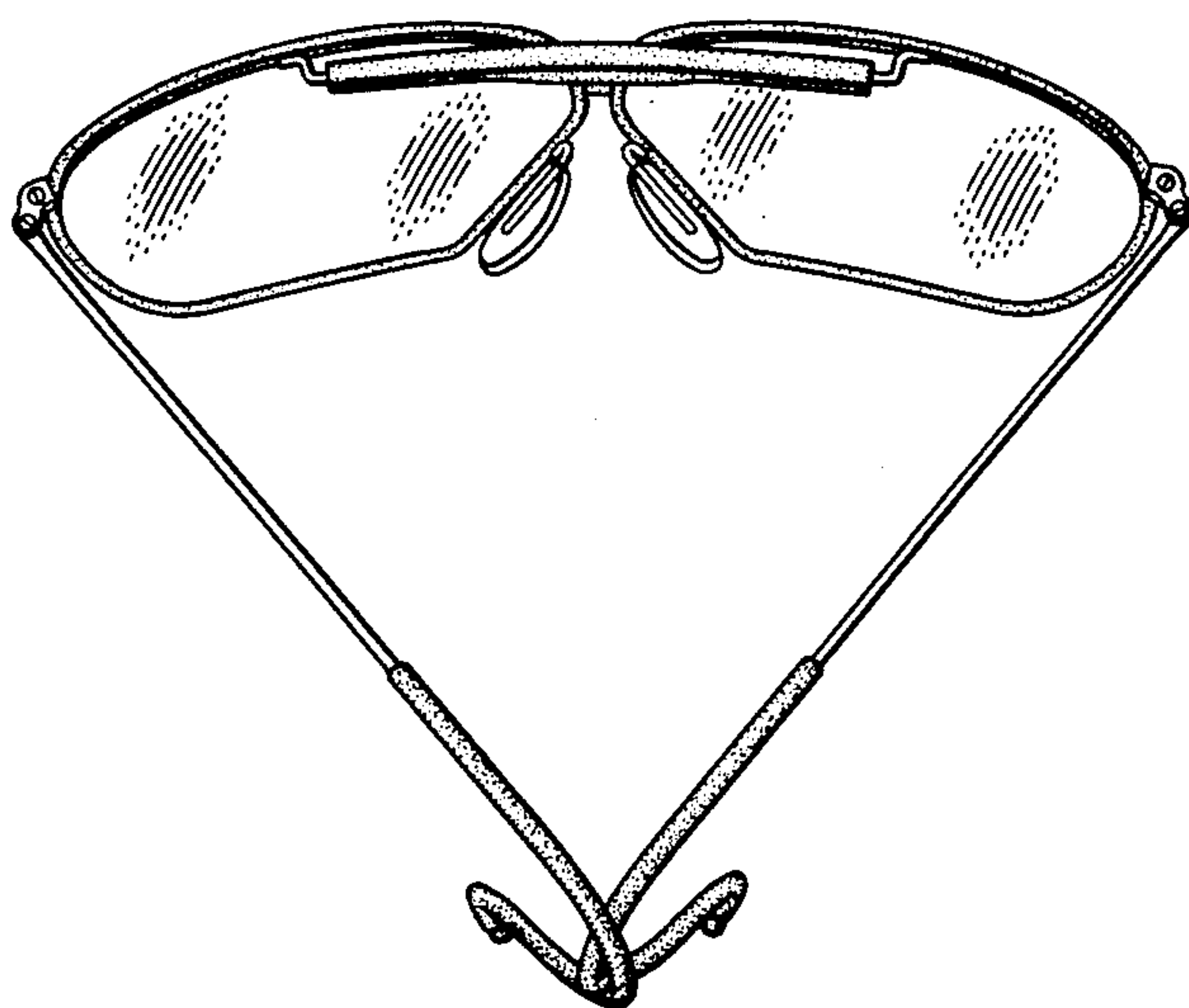

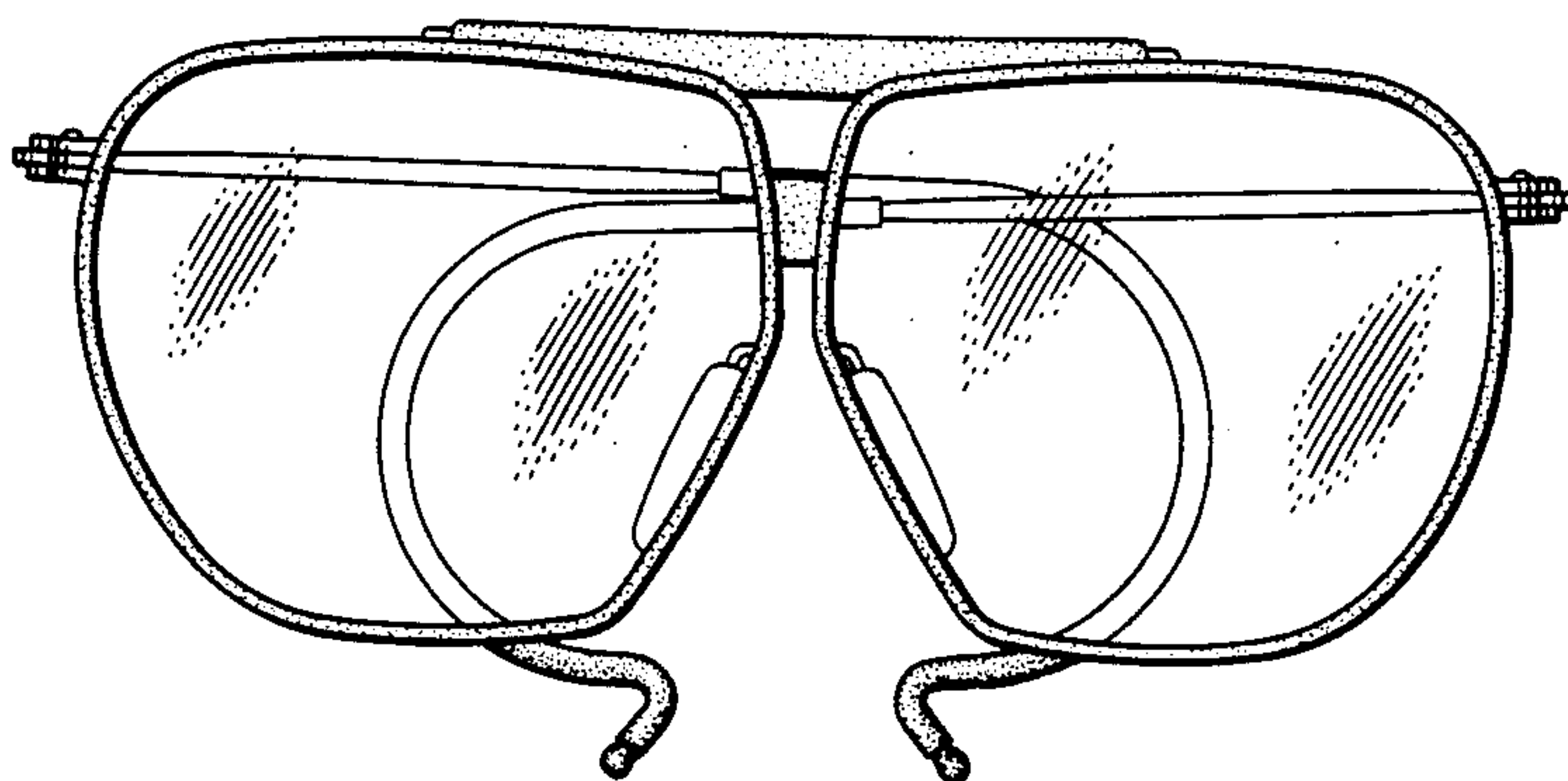

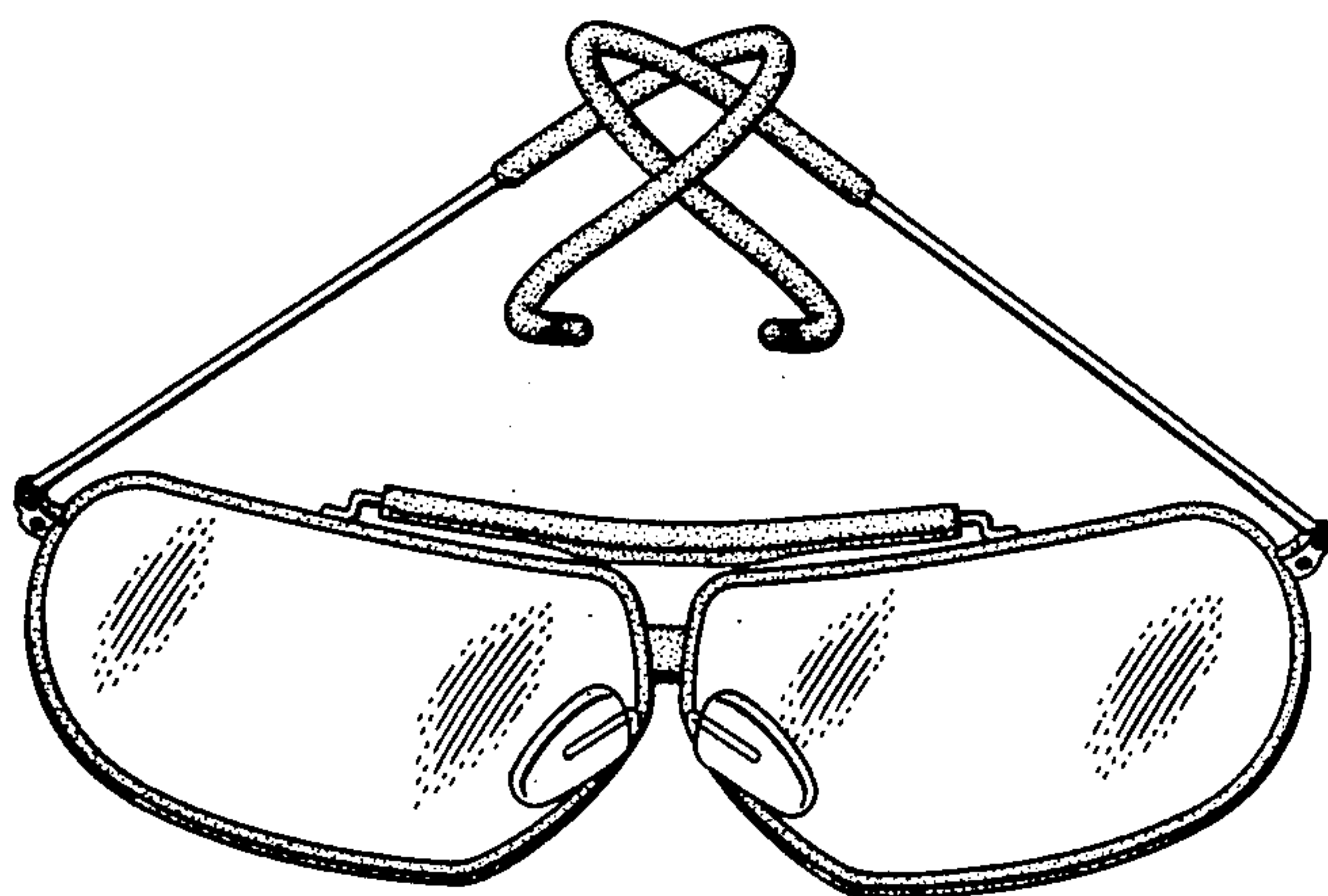
