[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a paint brush holder for mounting on a ladder step, rung, or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a paint brush holder for mounting on a ladder step, rung, or the like embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being the attachment clip which is shown broken away to indicate indeterminate length.

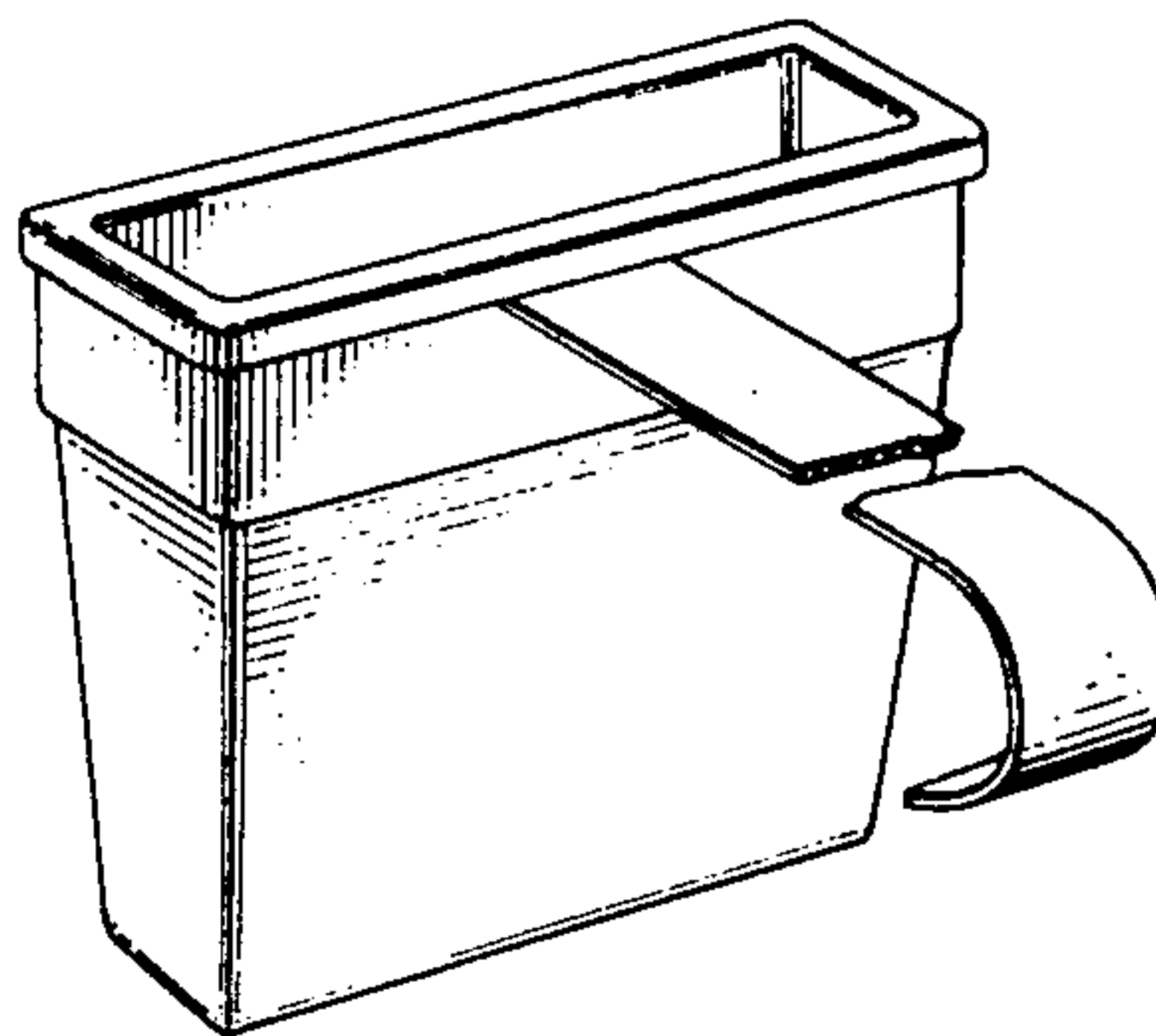
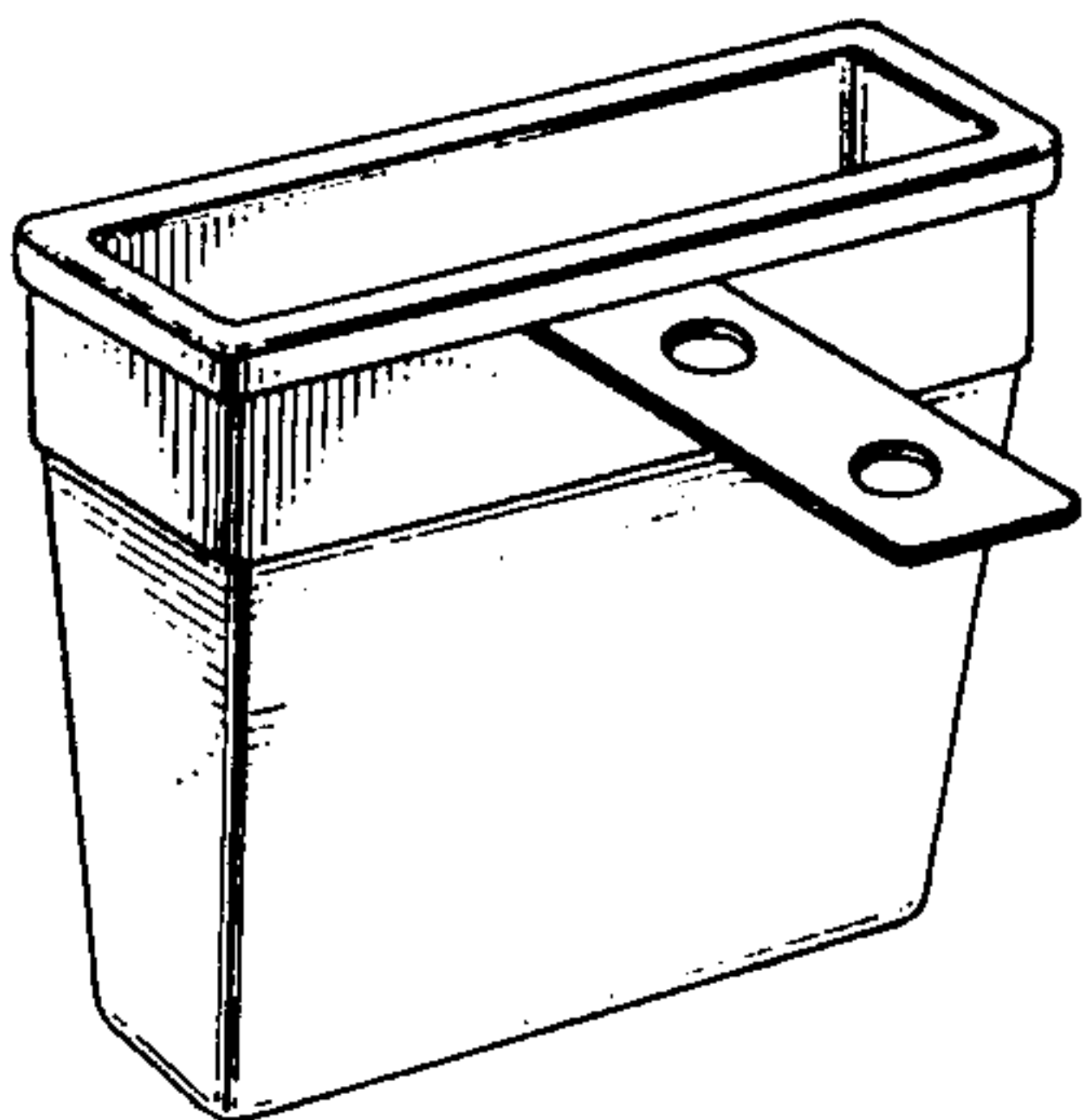

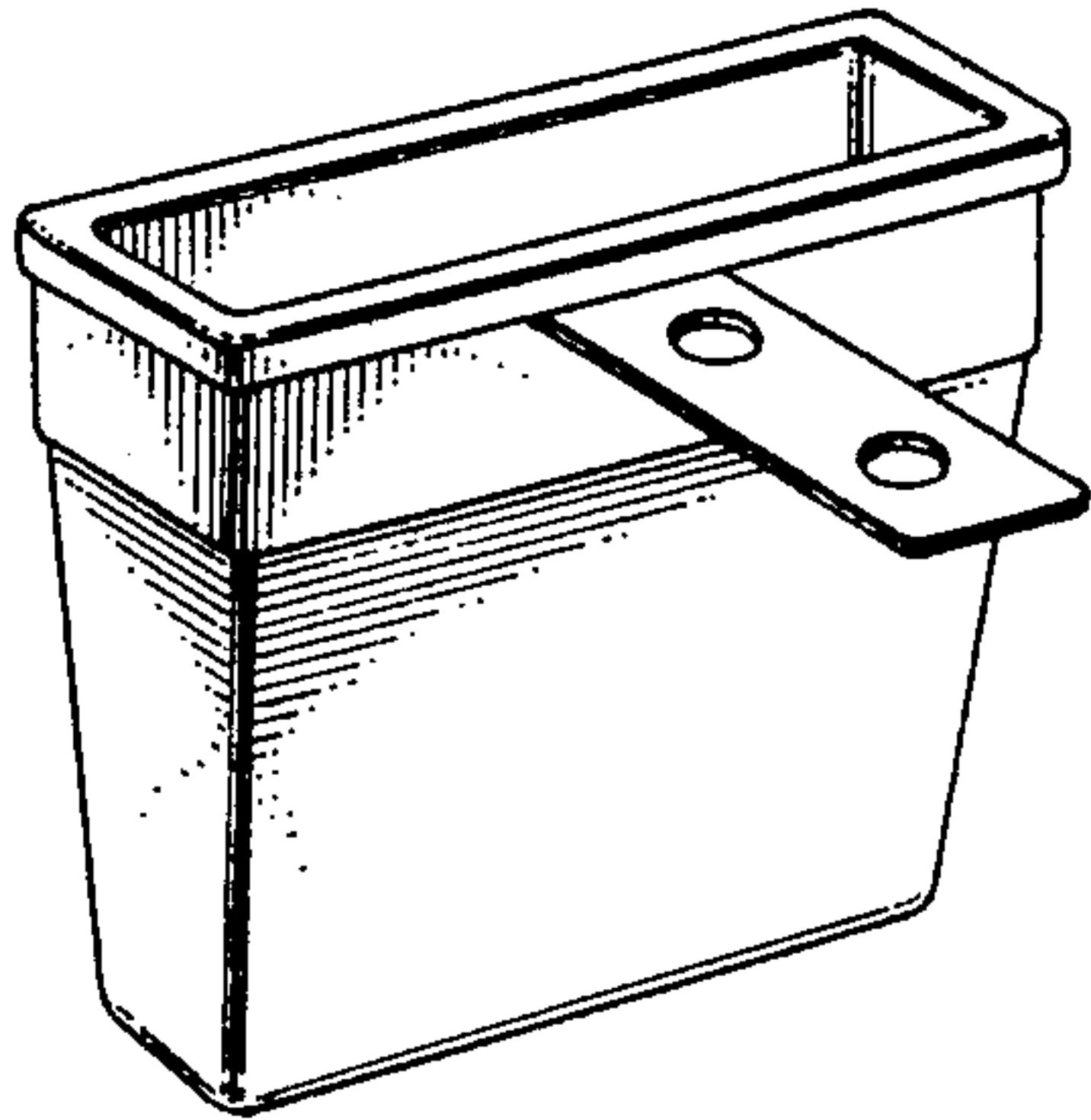

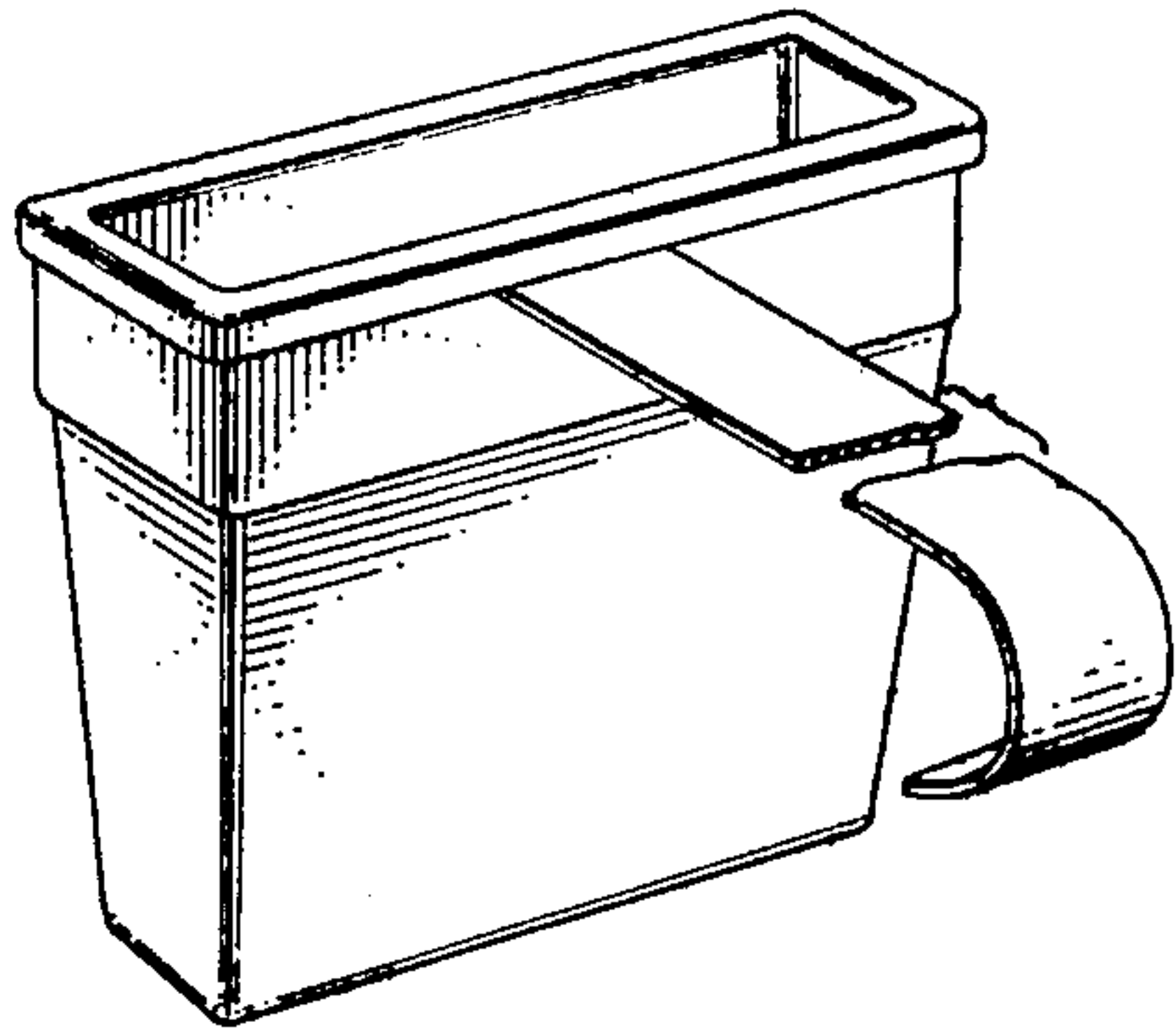

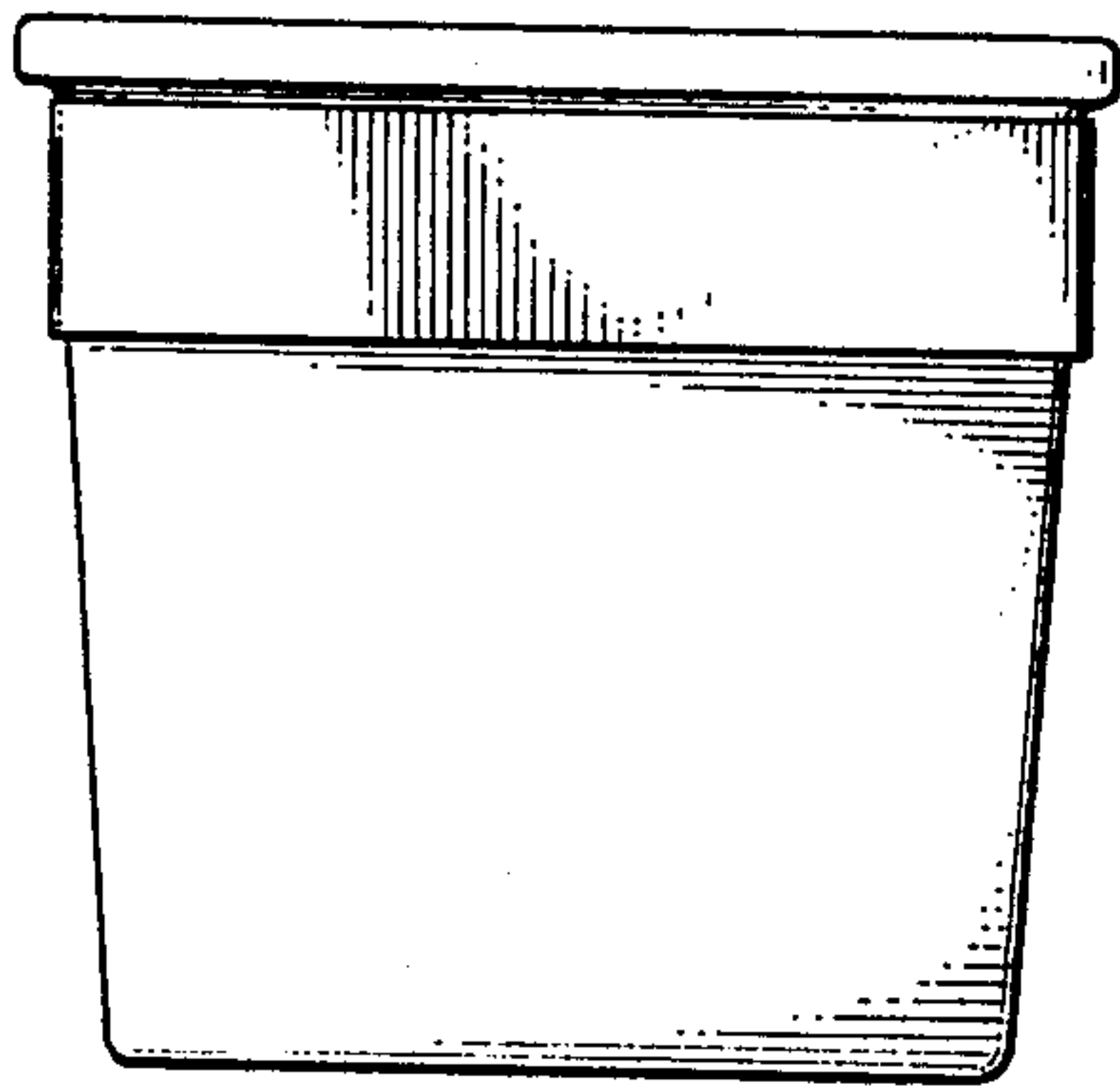

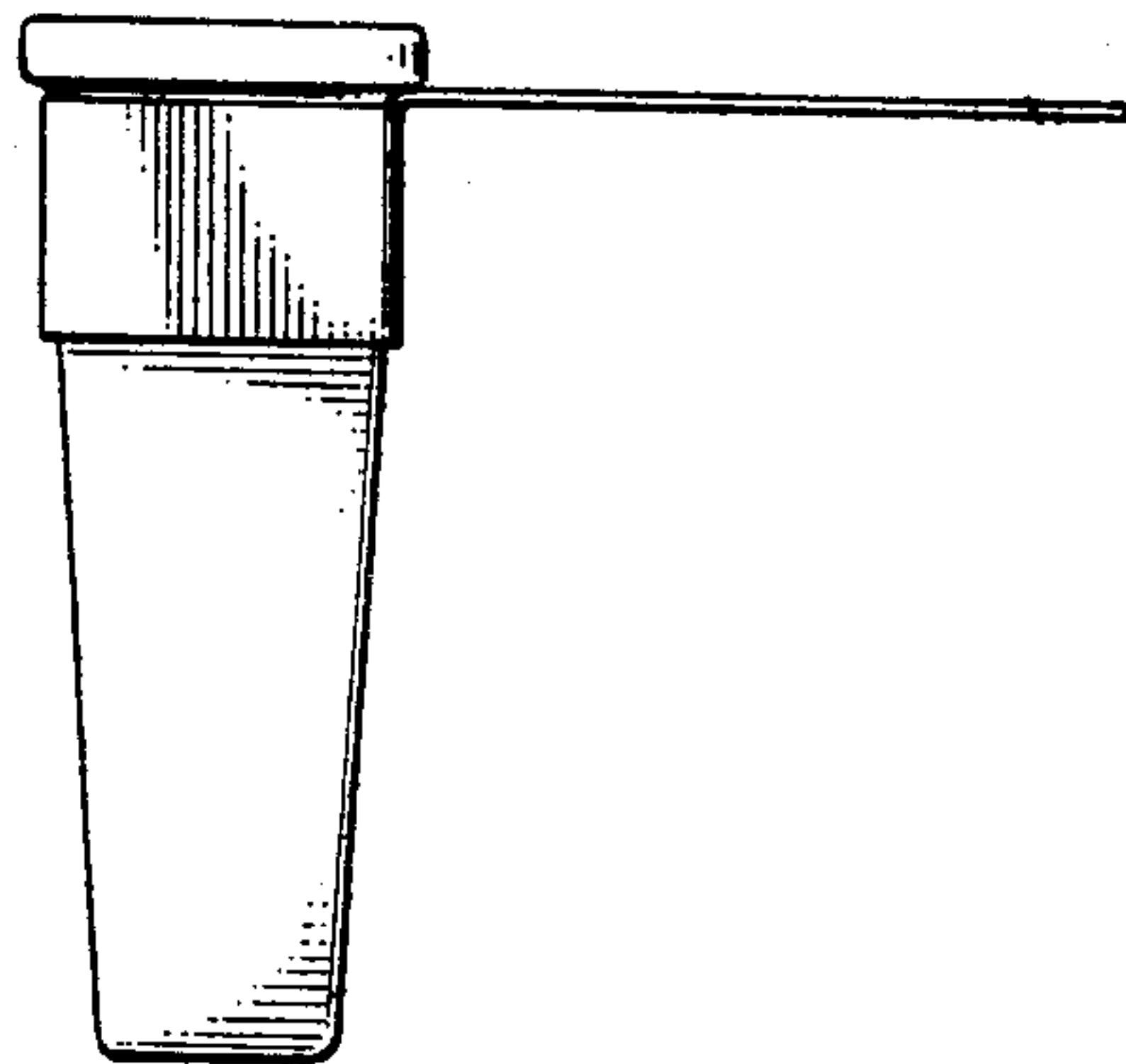

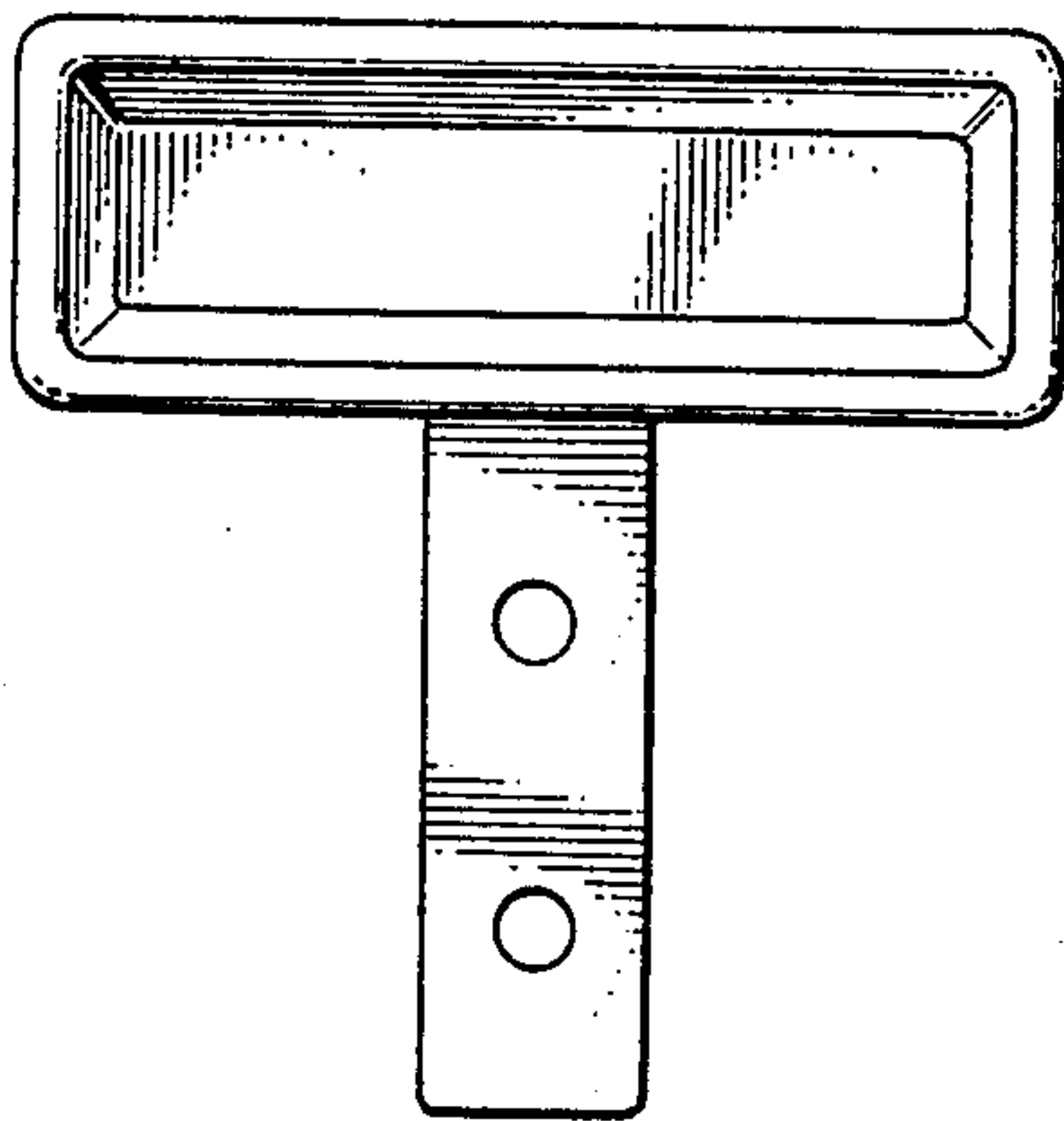
