DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair showing a first embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the first embodiment;


FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a chair showing a second embodiment of my new design;


FIG. 7 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of the second embodiment.









