CLAIM

The ornamental design for a popcorn maker appliance, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a popcorn maker appliance showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view partially broken away for ease of illustration;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the cone portion of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a horizontal sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 1 looking in the direction of the arrows;

and FIG. 5 is an elevation view of the carousel portion of FIG. 1.

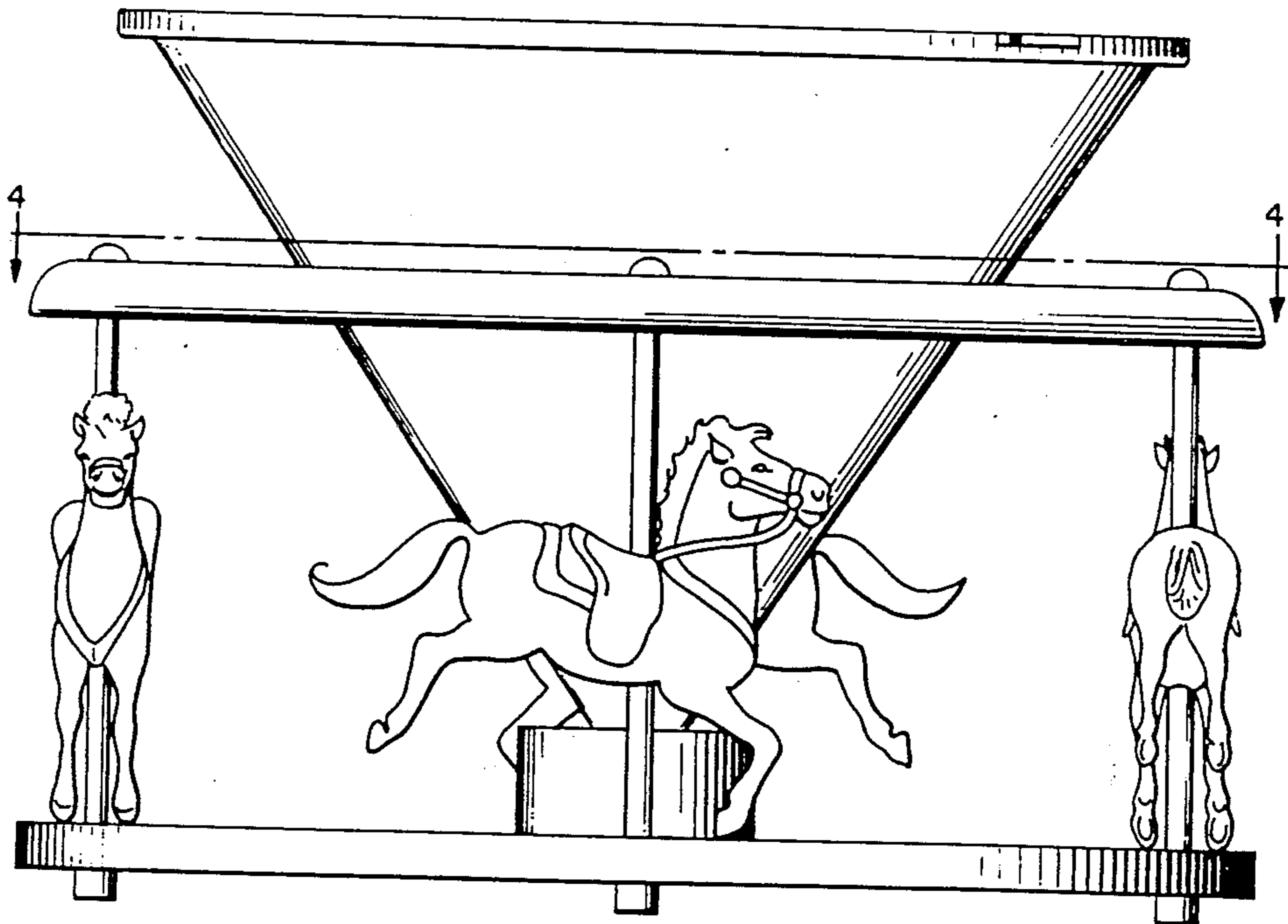

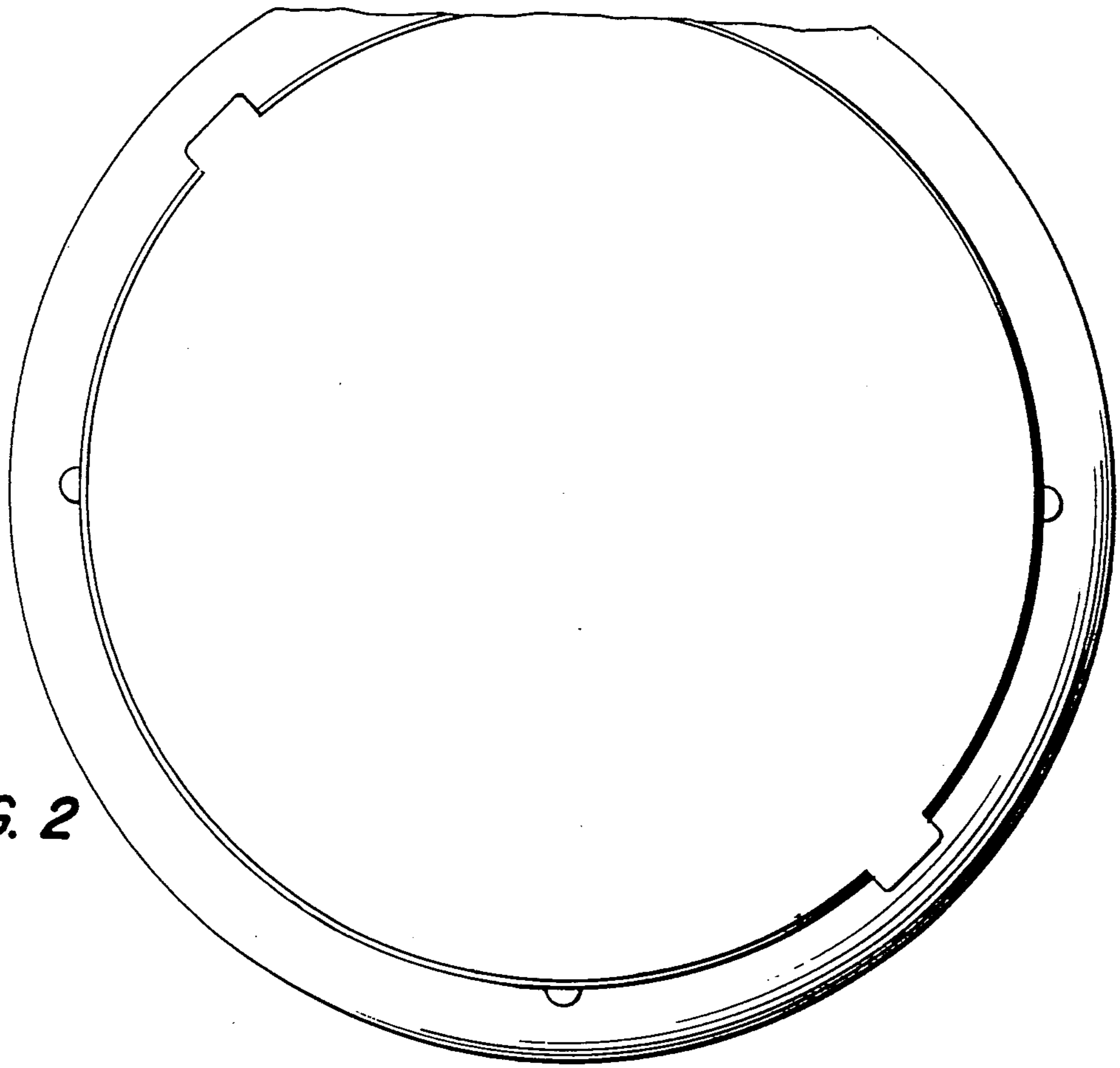

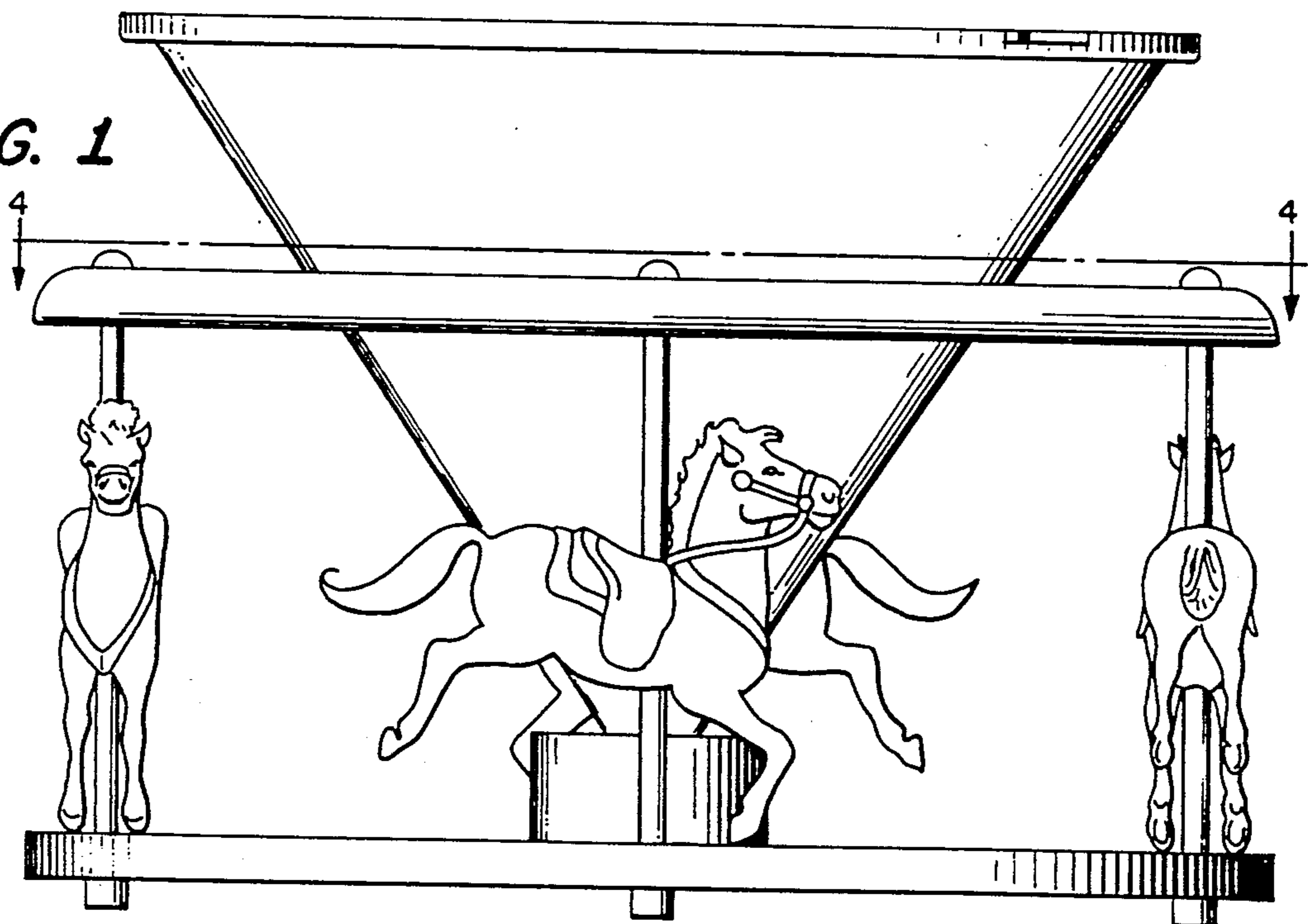

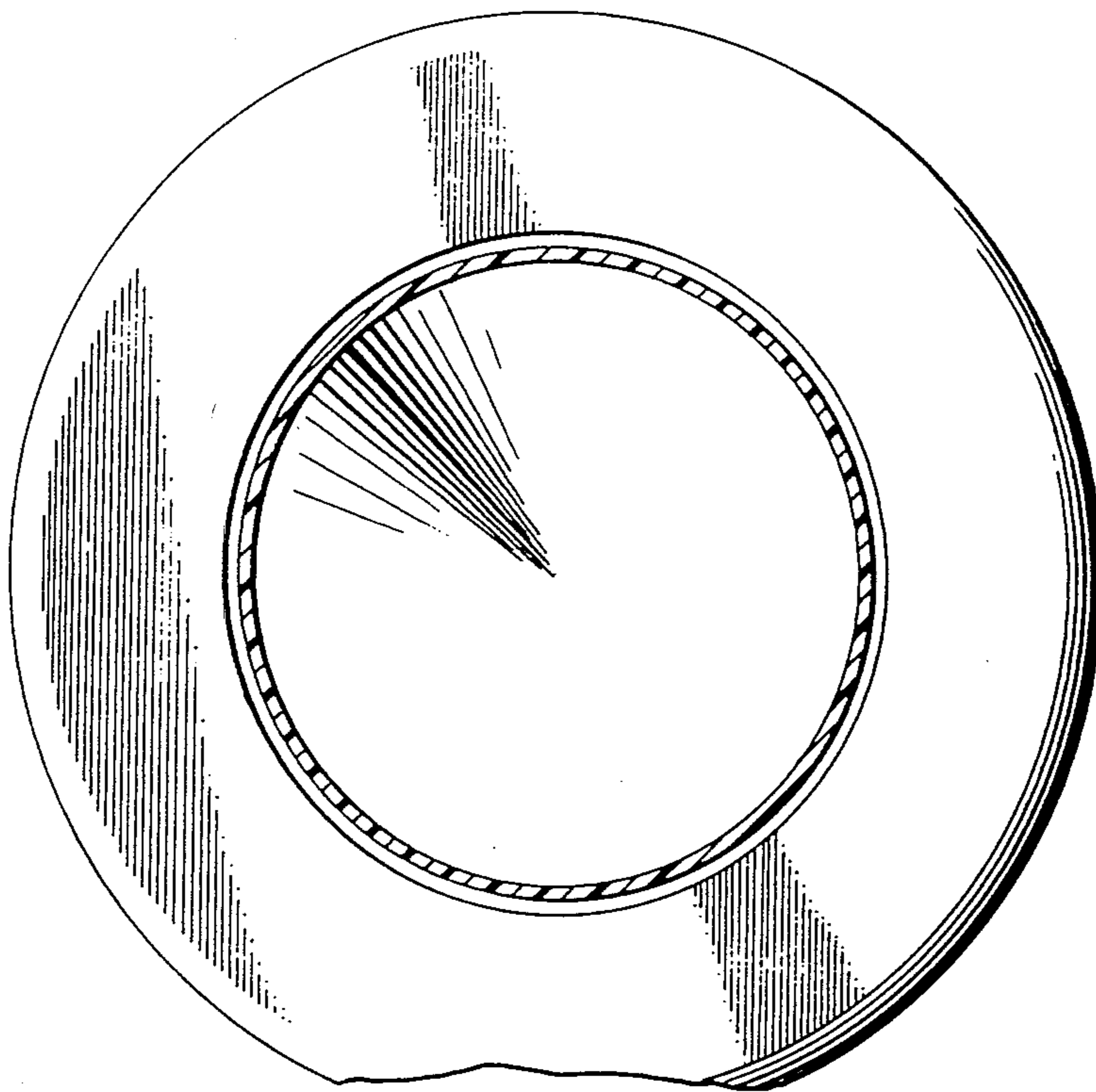

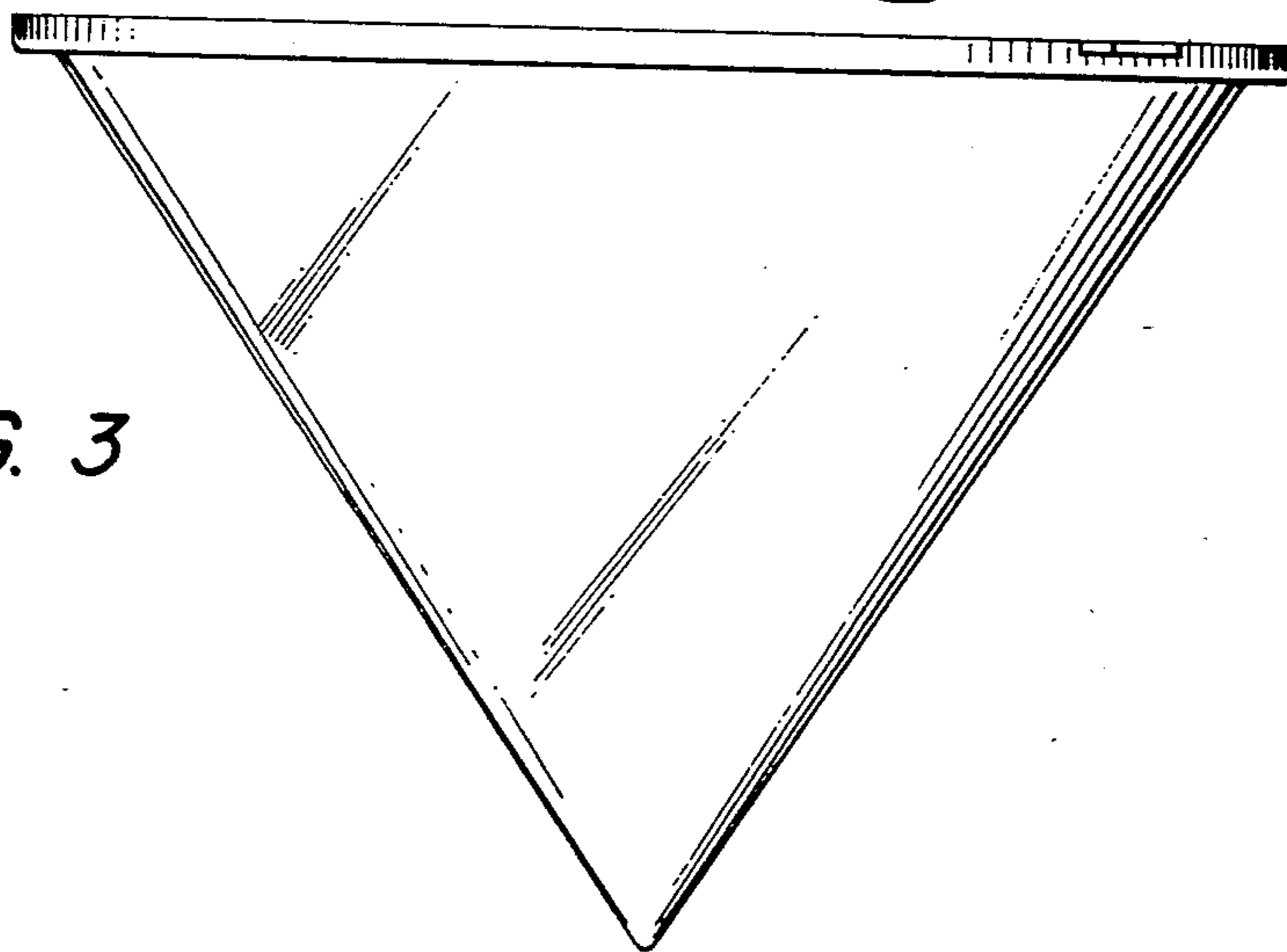
