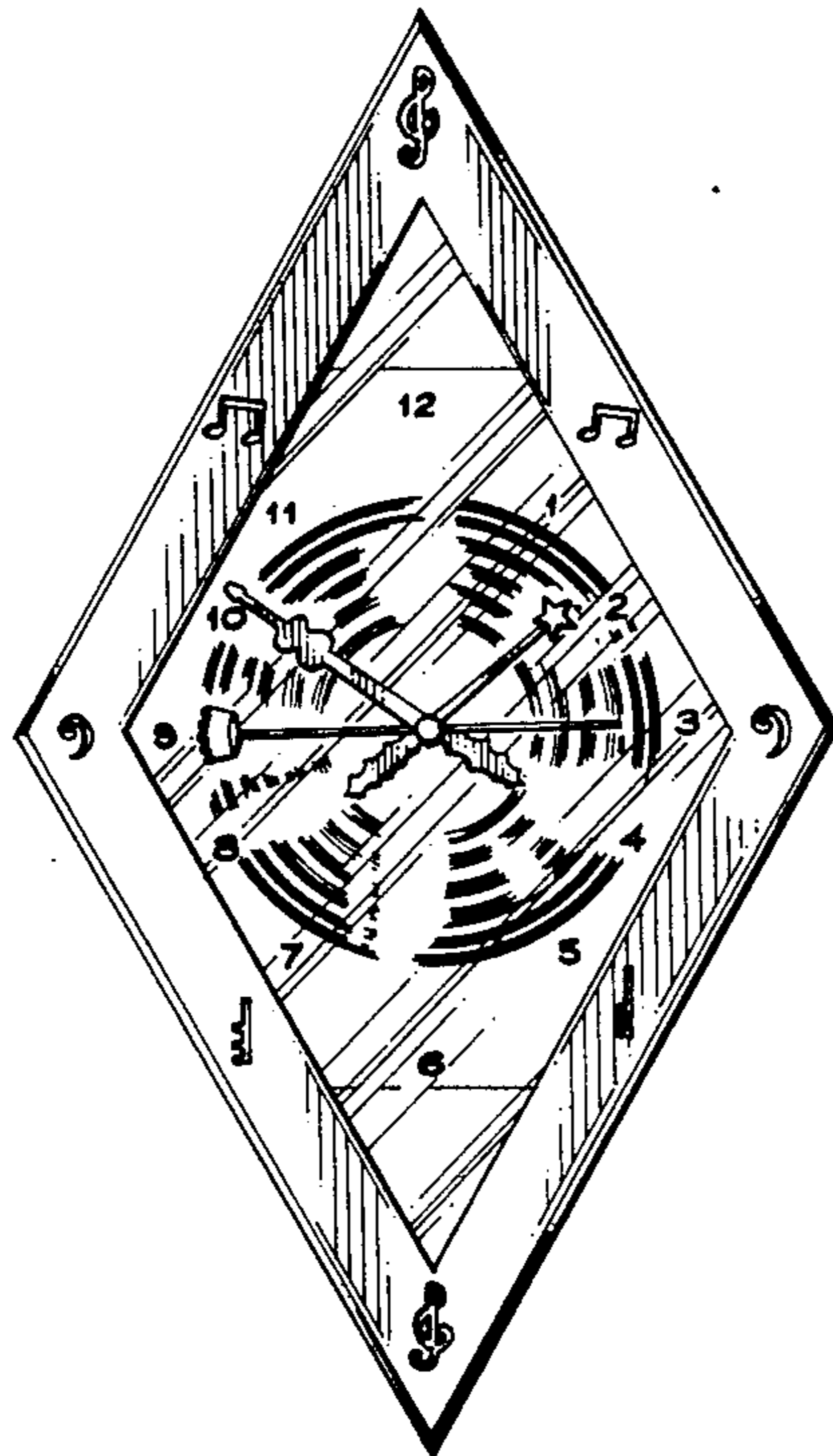

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereto;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan being a mirror image thereto;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale.



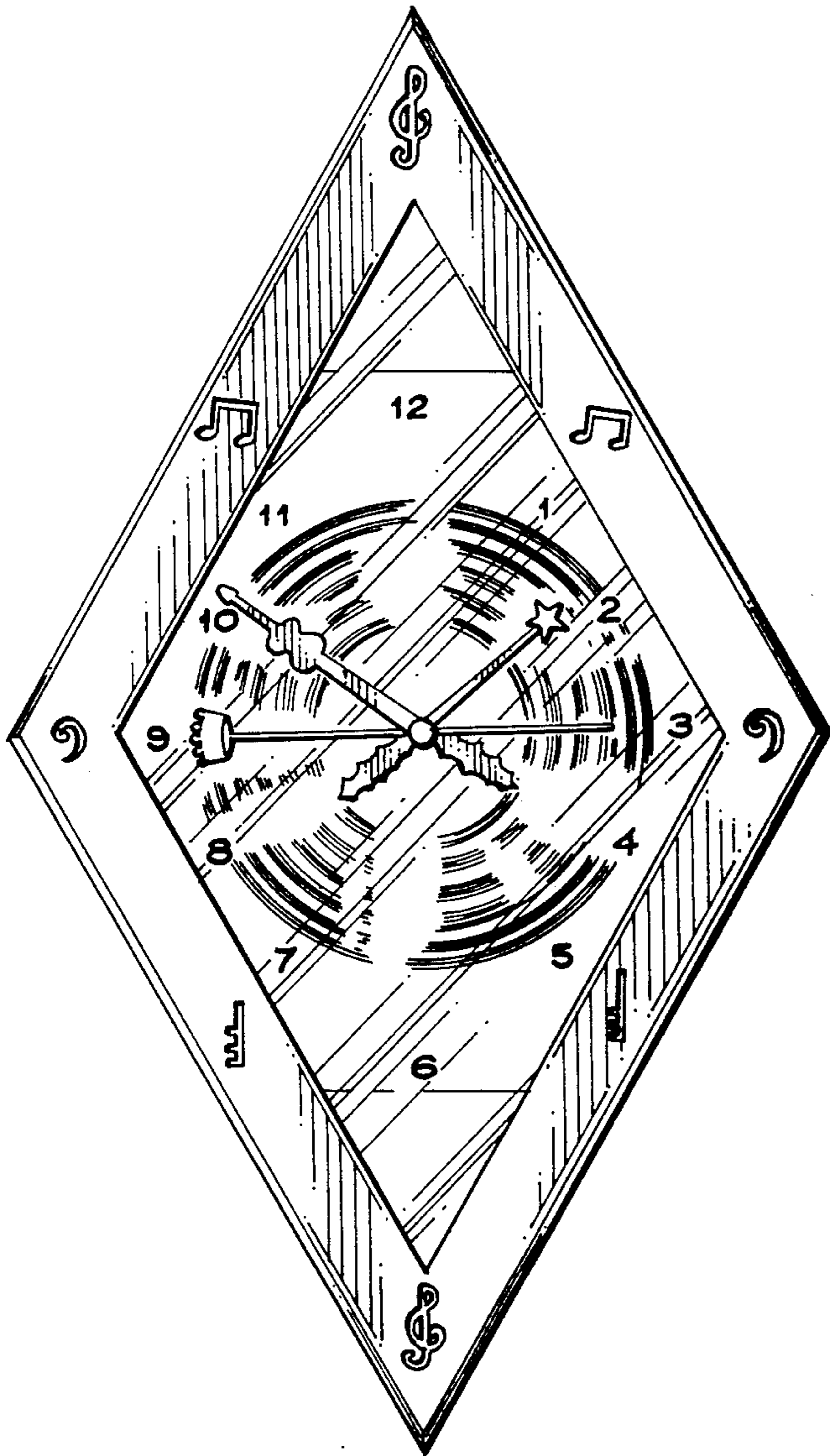

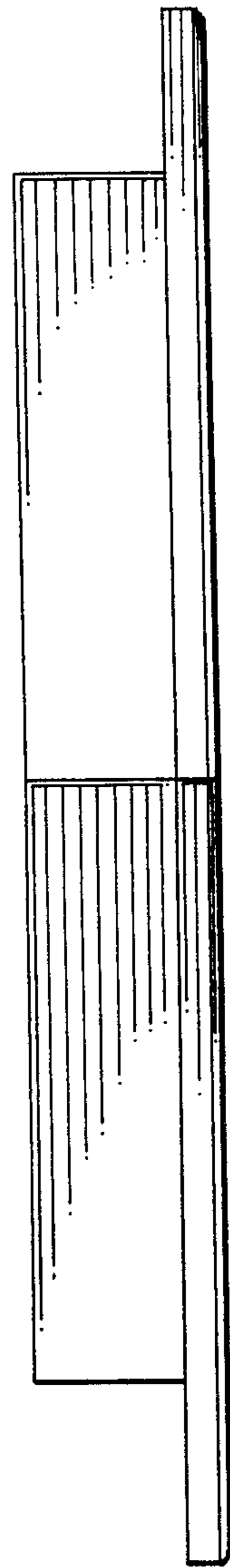

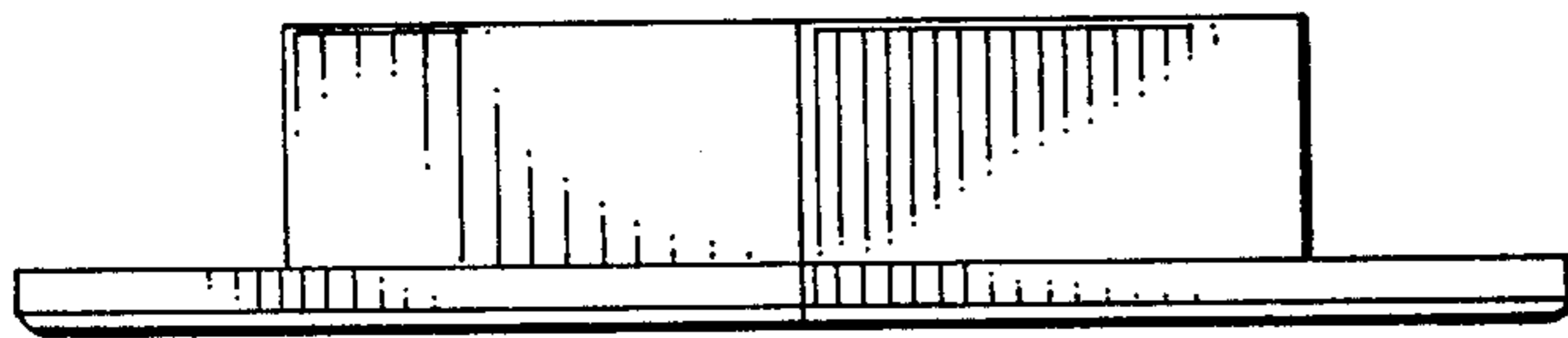

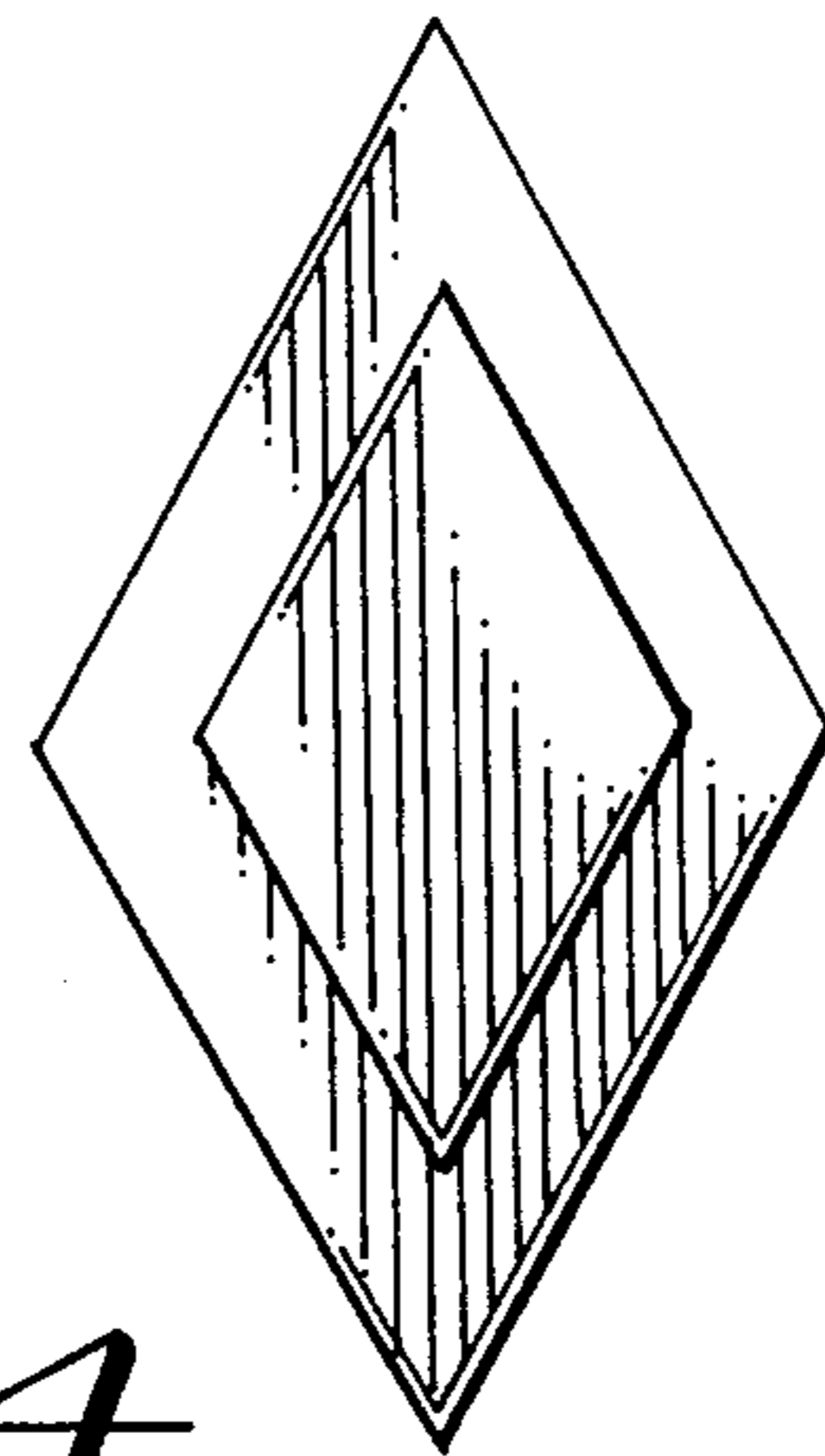
