FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy glider showing our new design;

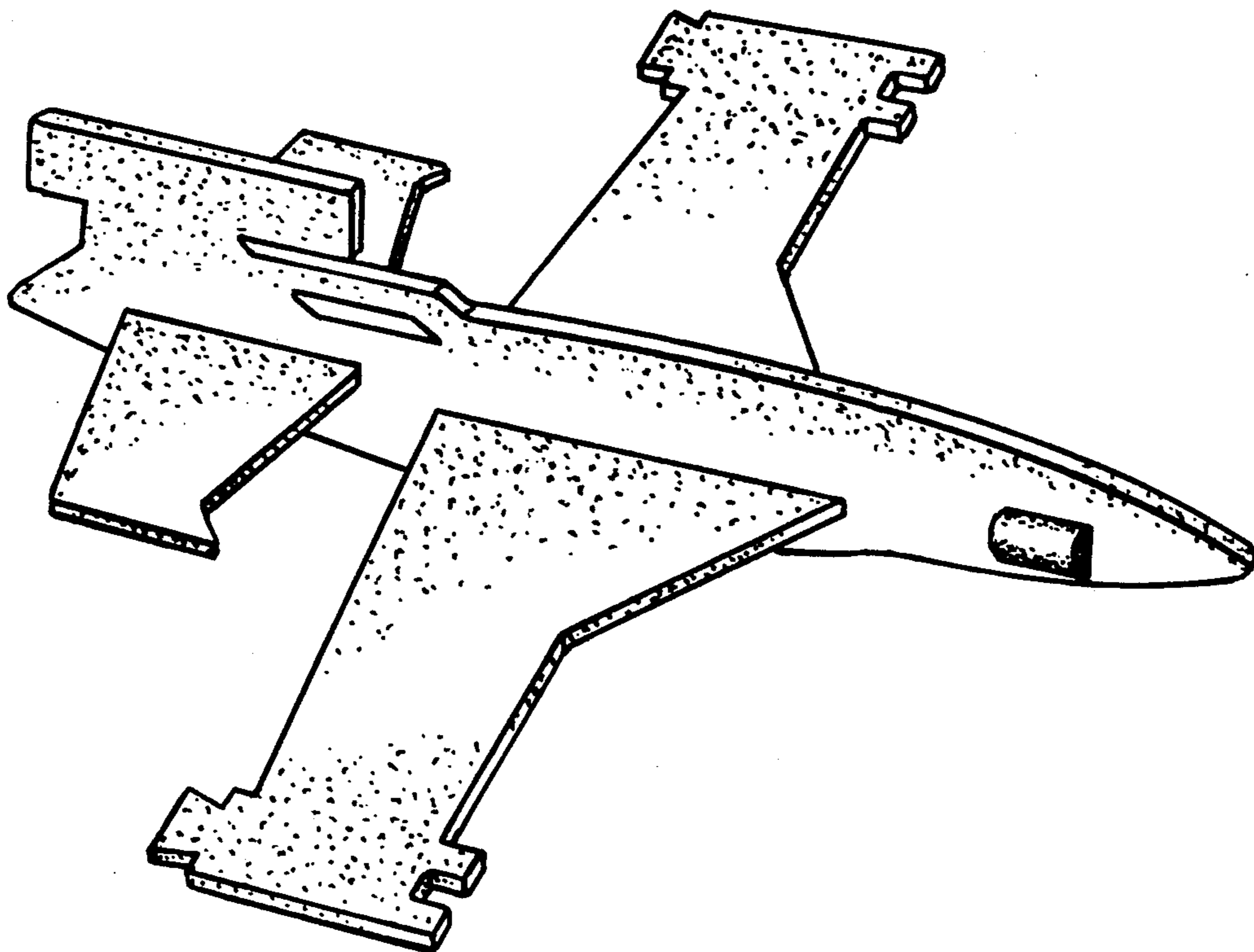
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof shown on a slightly reduced scale;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



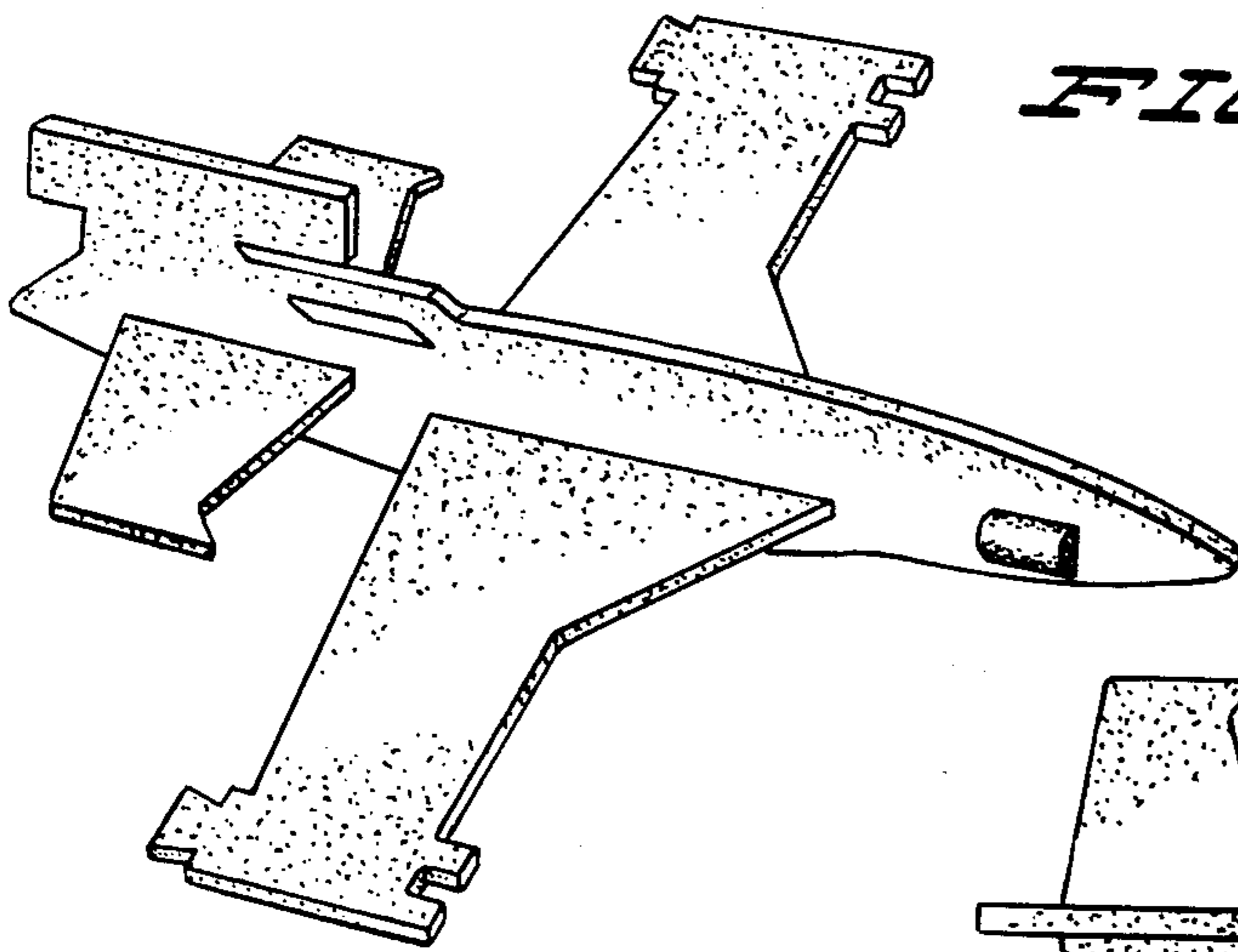

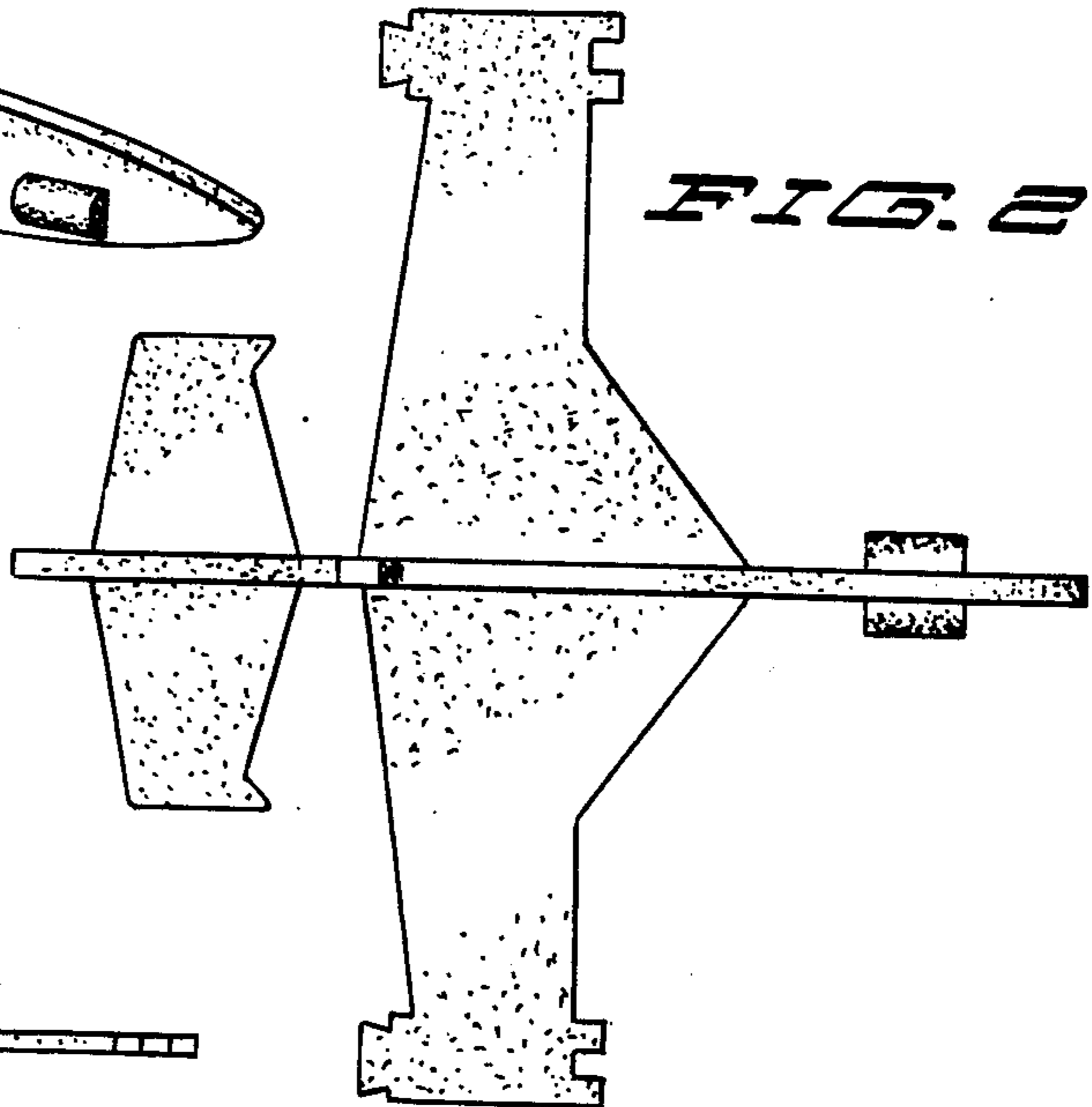

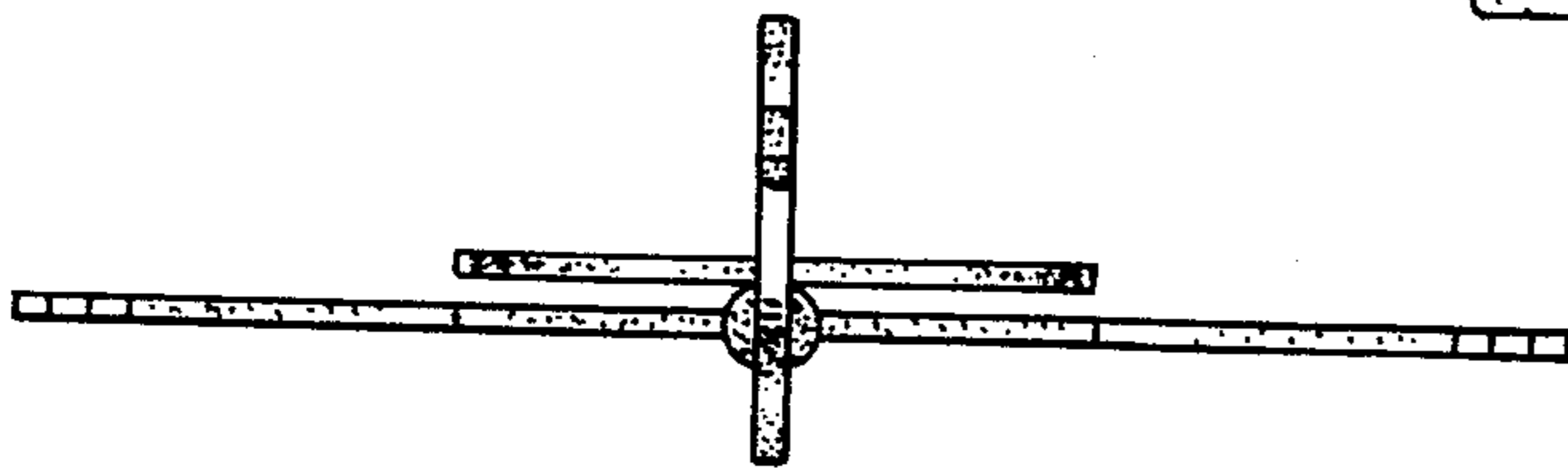

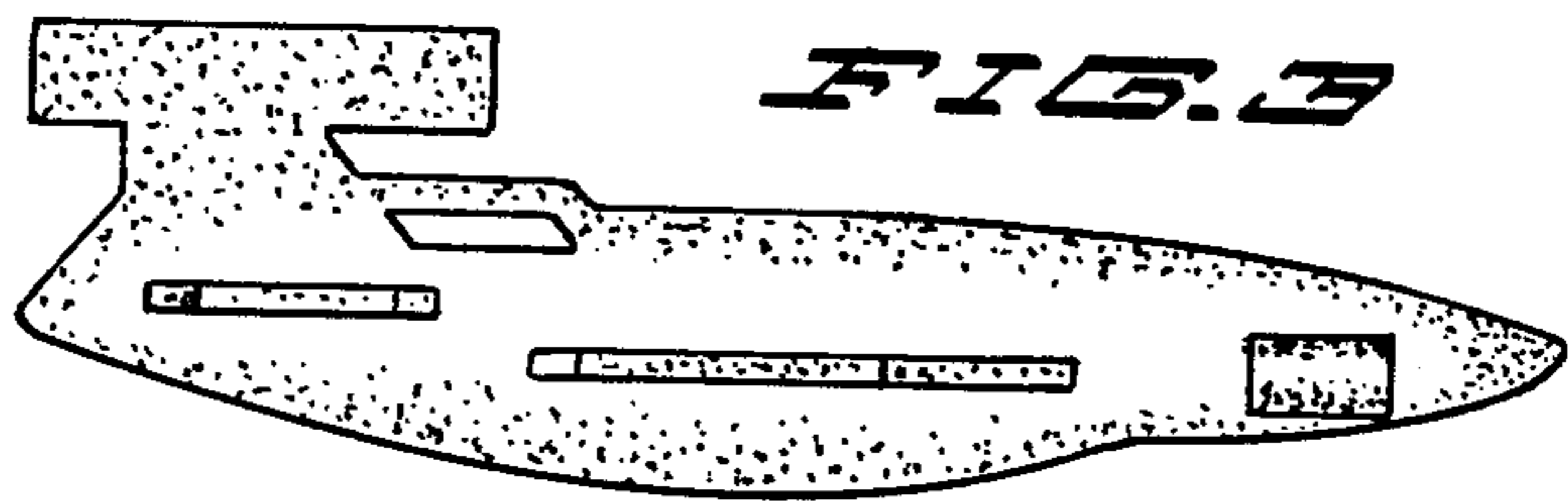

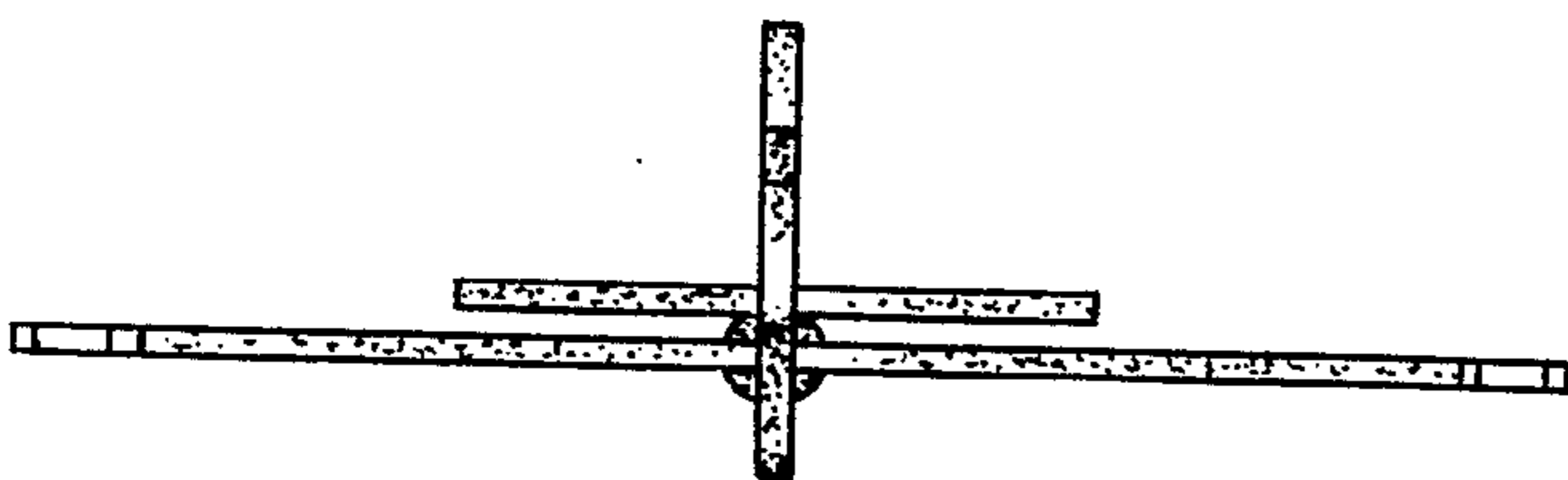

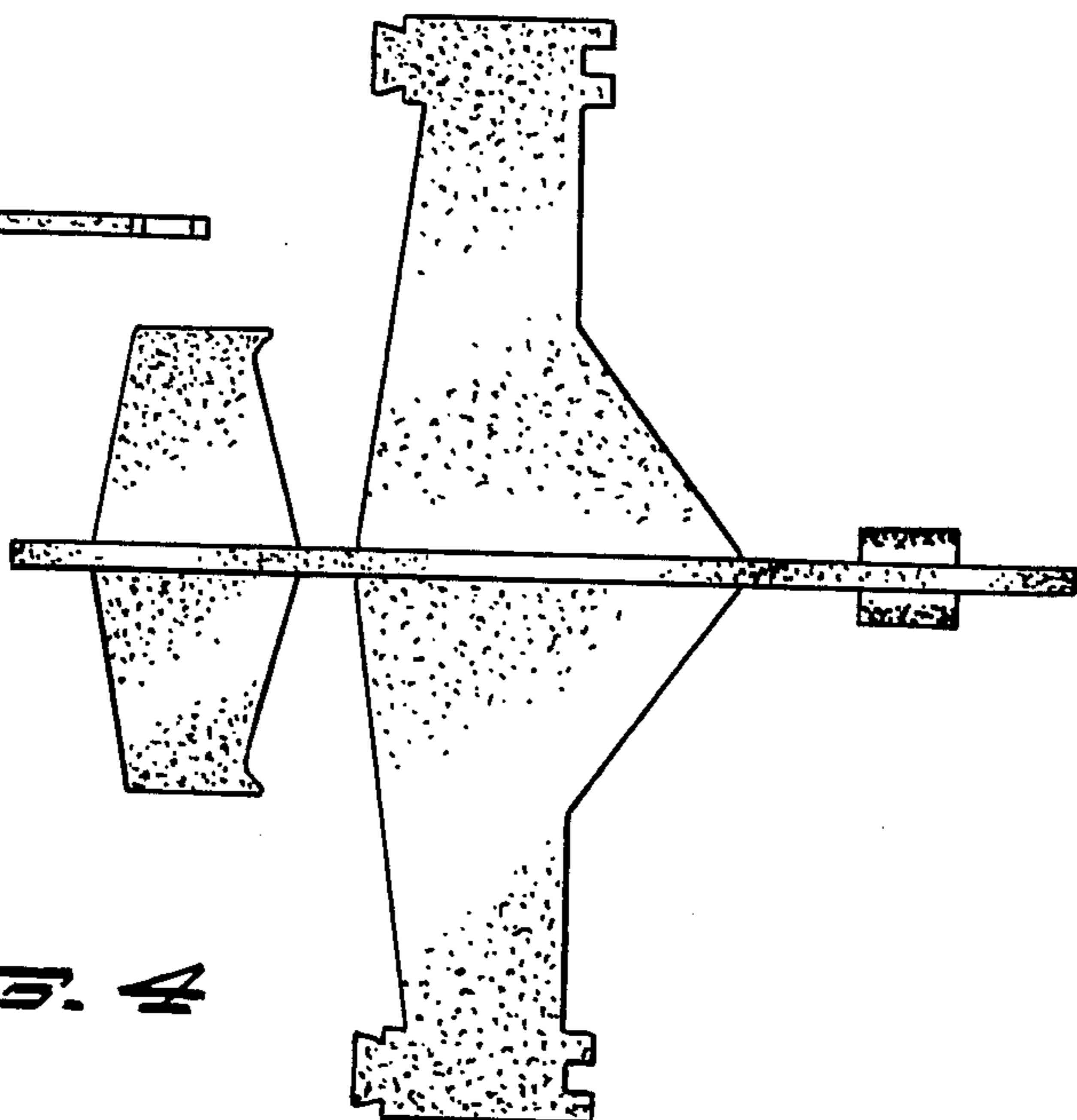
