CLAIM

The ornamental design for a water slide or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a water slide or similar article showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a water slide or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of a water slide or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is an elevation view, taken in the direction of the arrow "7" in FIG. 2.


