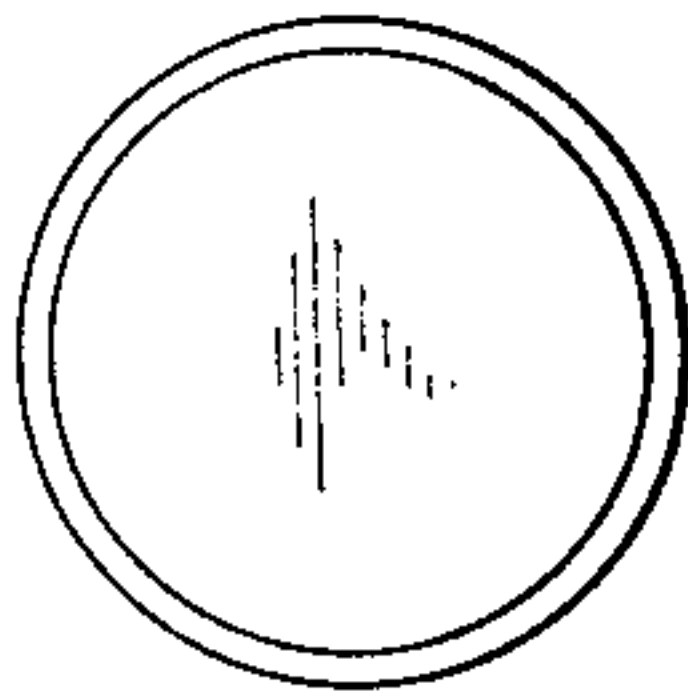
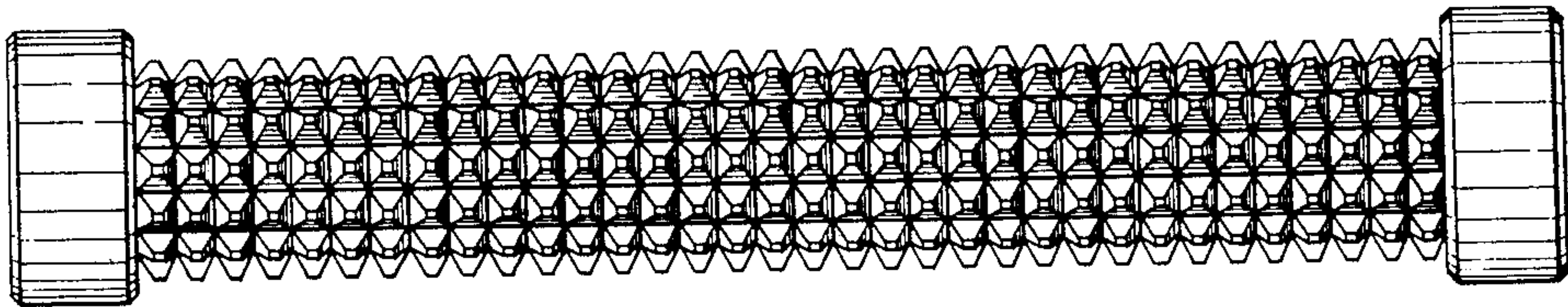
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[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 2 is an end elevation thereof, the opposite side is a mirror image of the side shown.



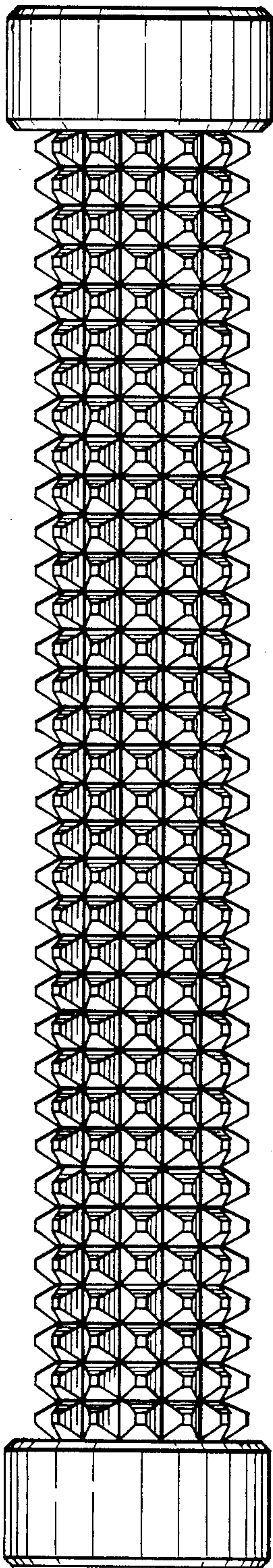

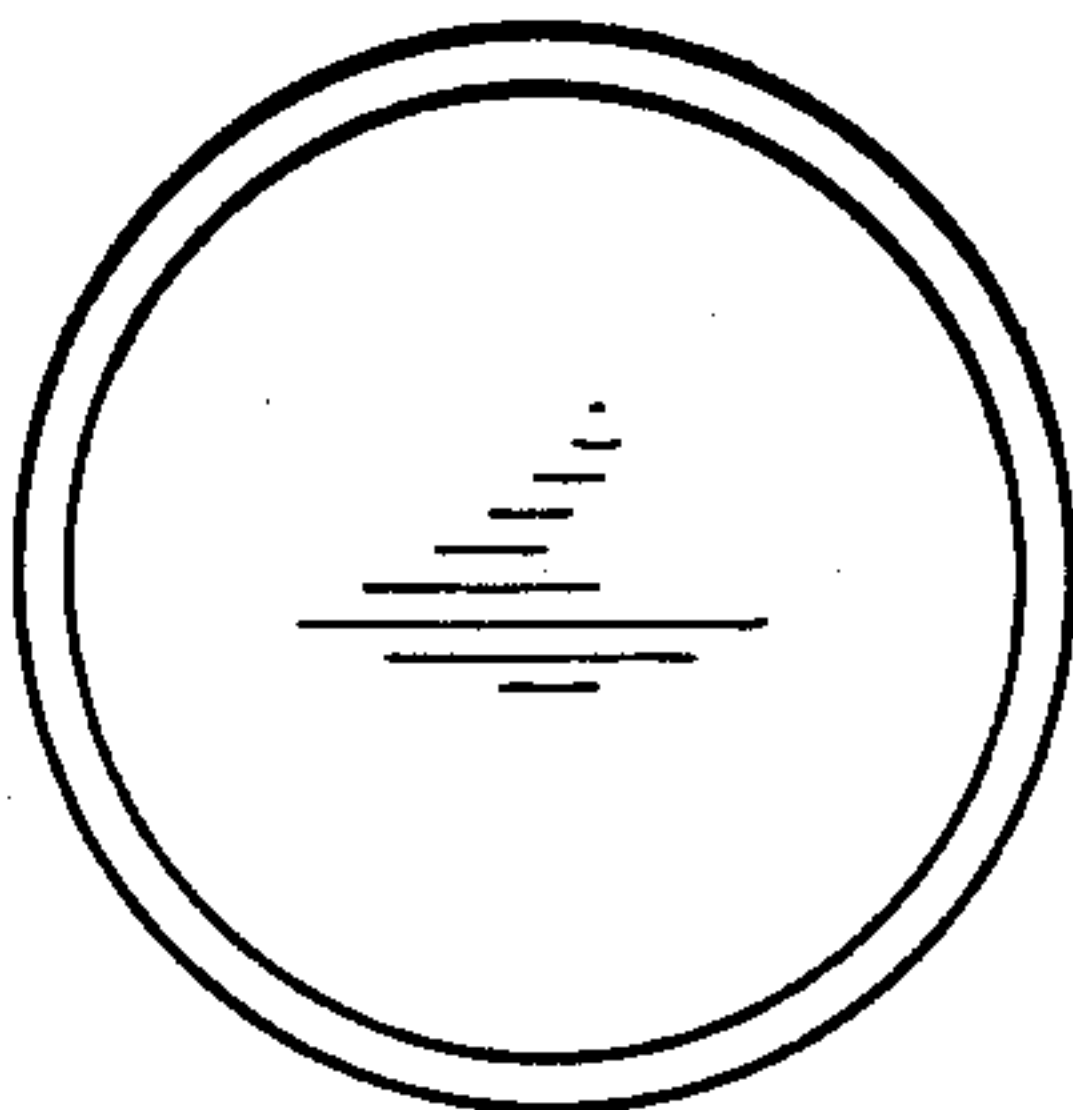
