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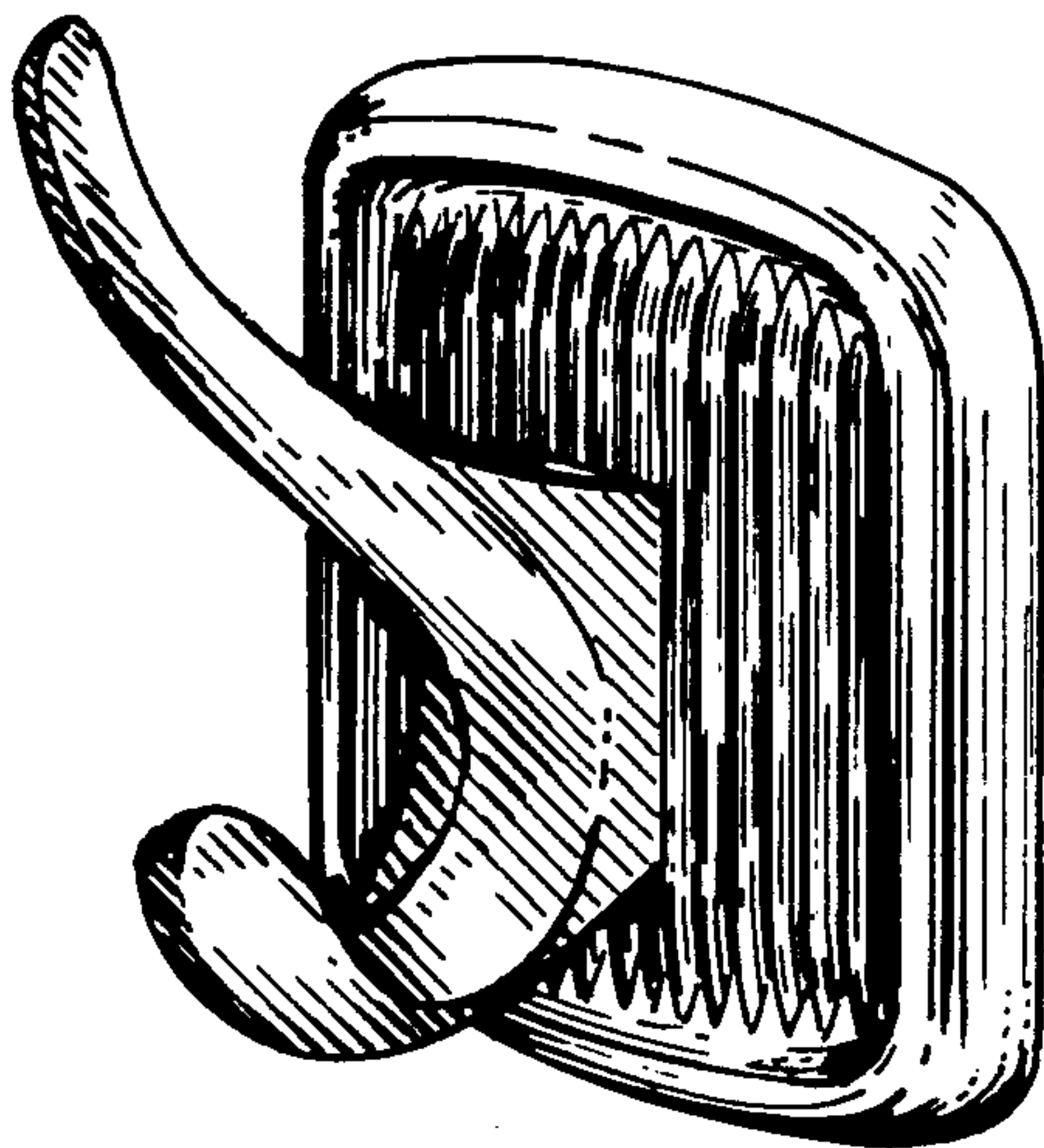

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a hook showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view;
FIG. 3 is a front view;

FIG. 6 is a enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in line 6—6 of FIG. 3.



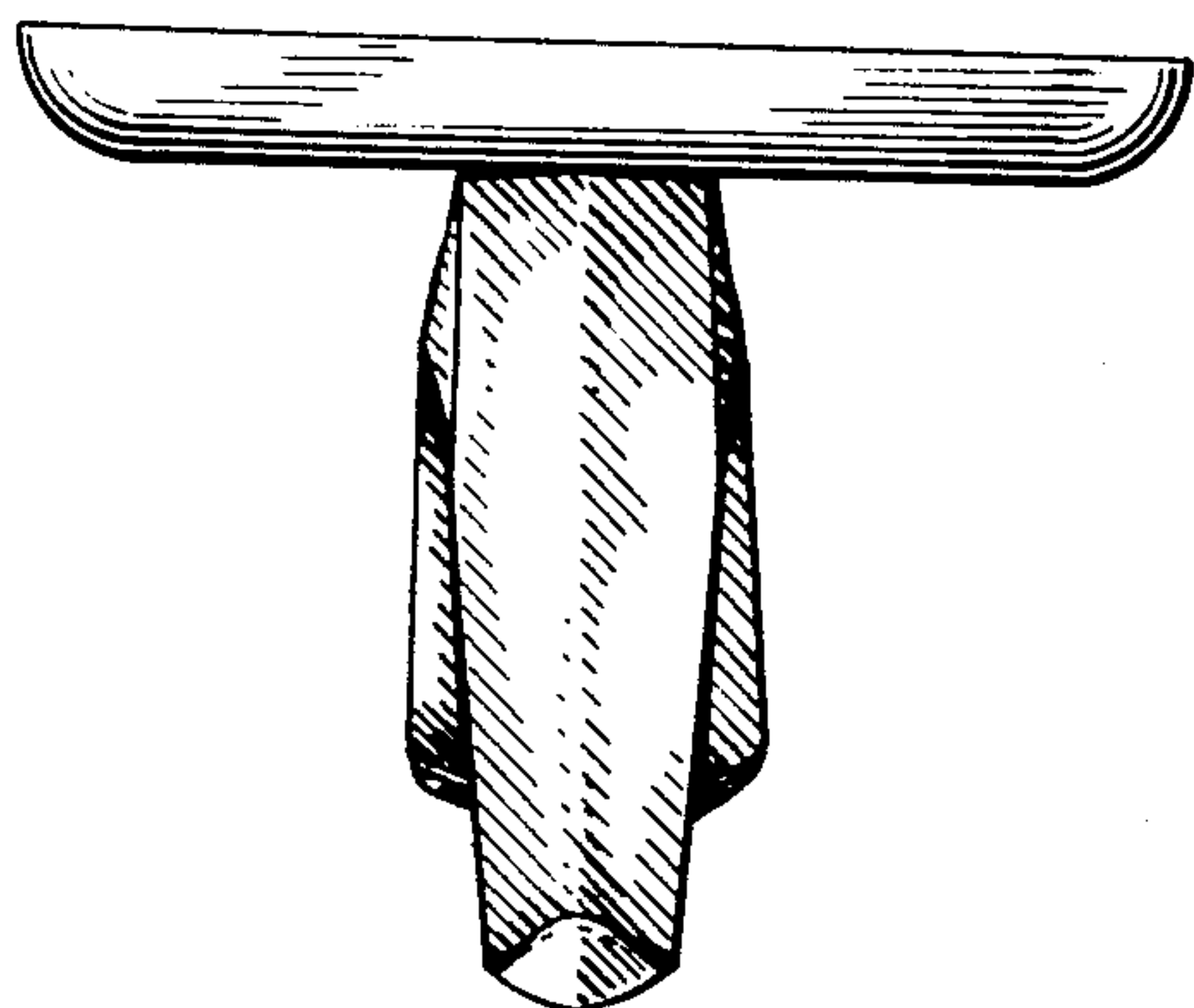

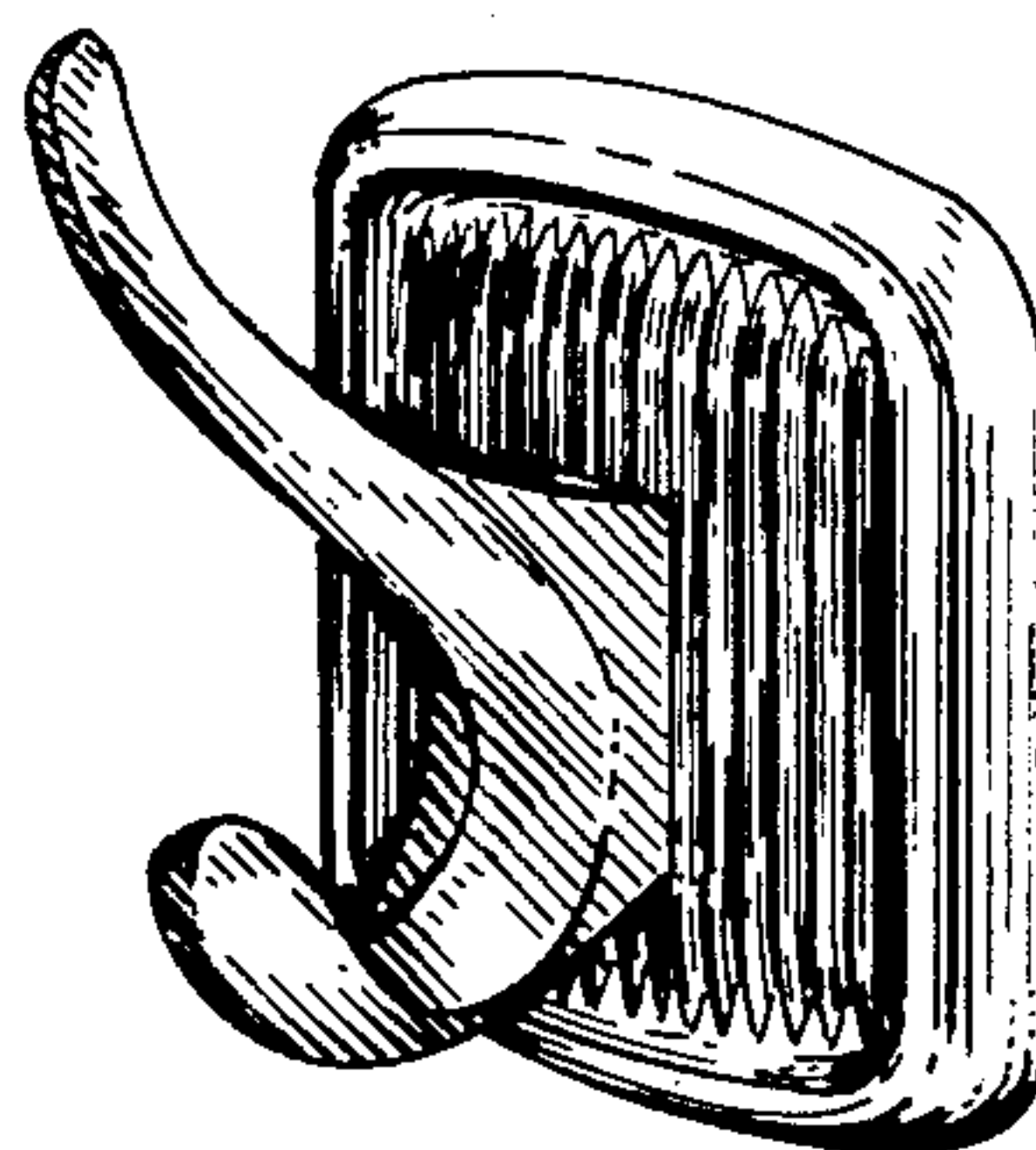

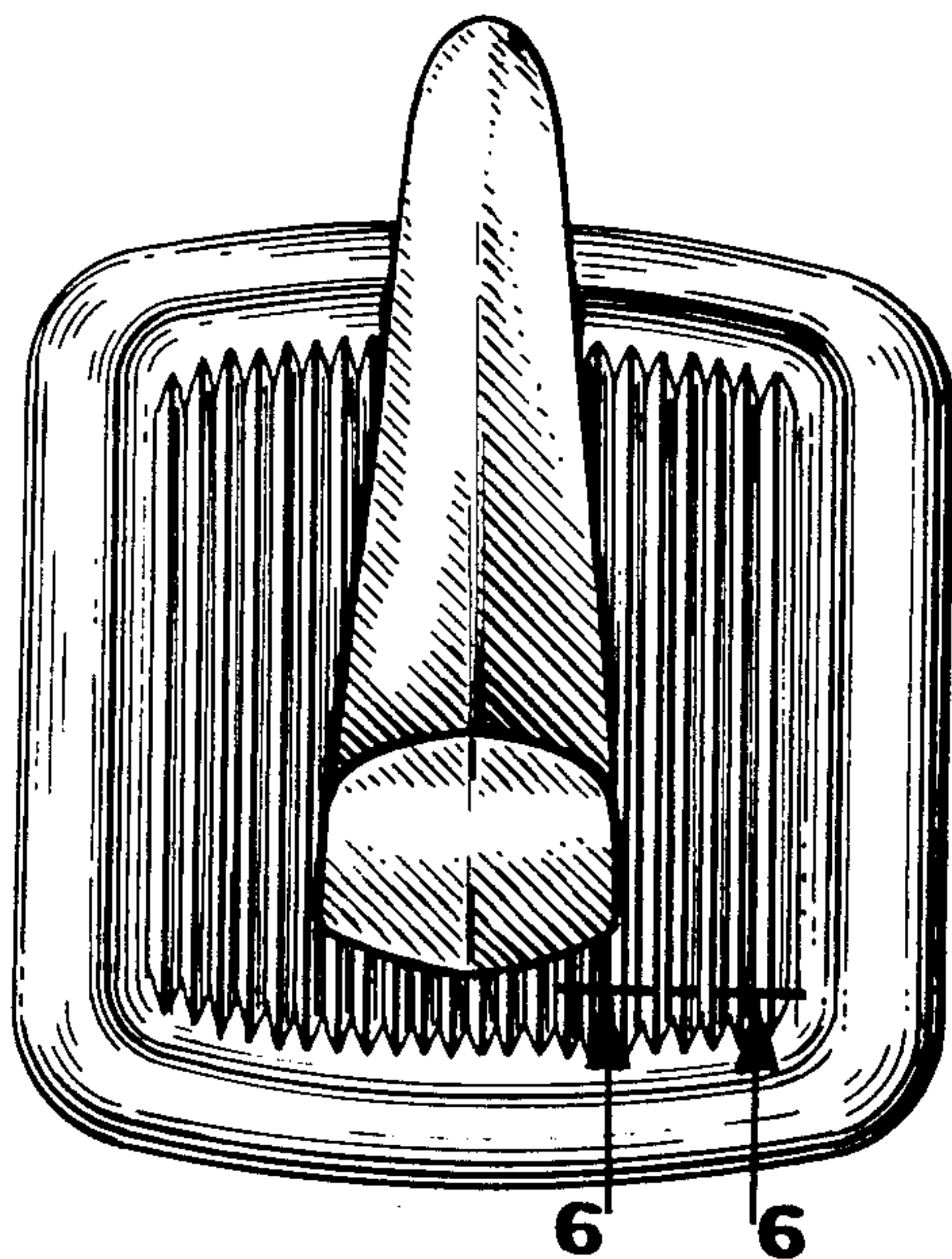

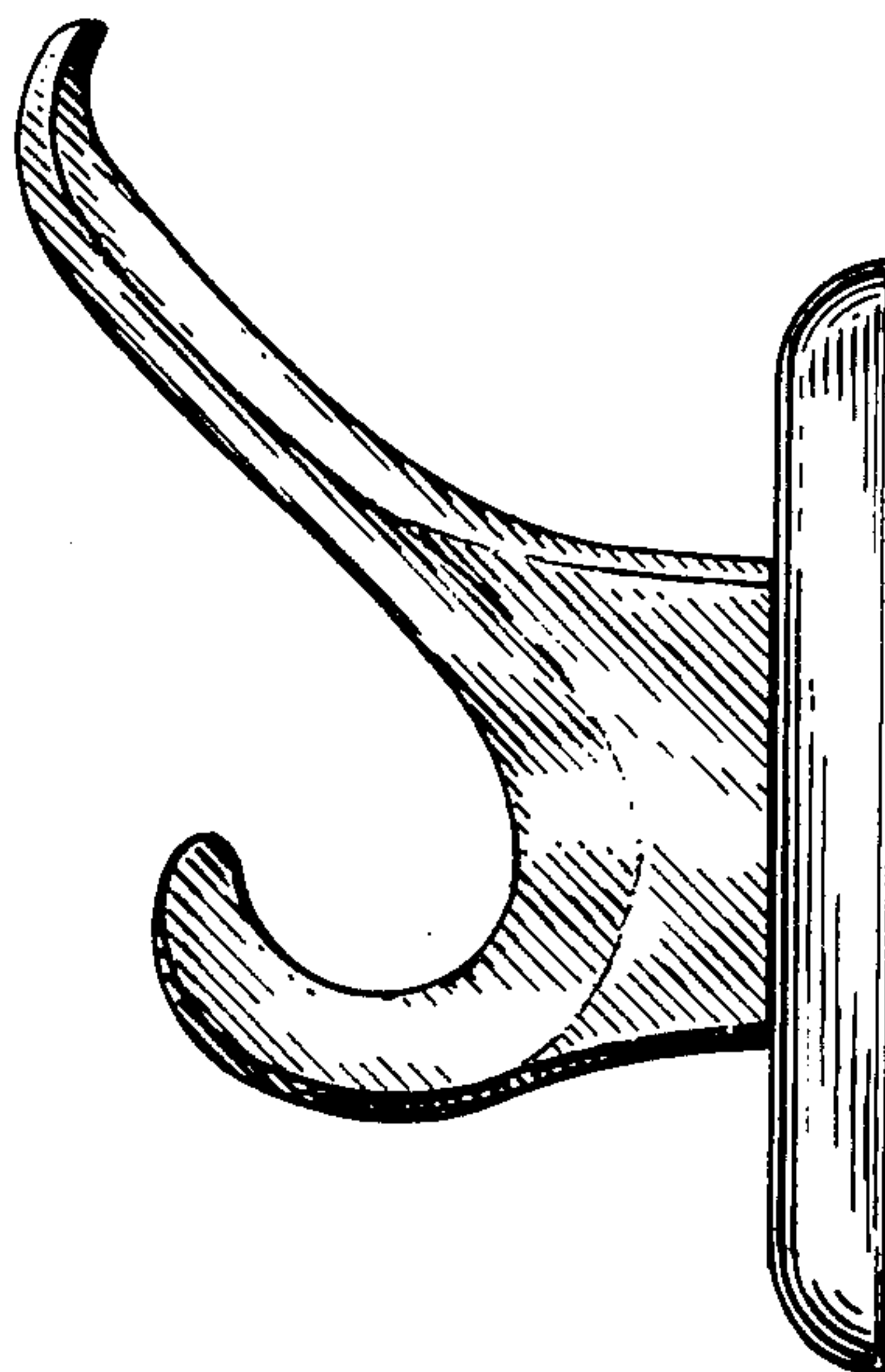

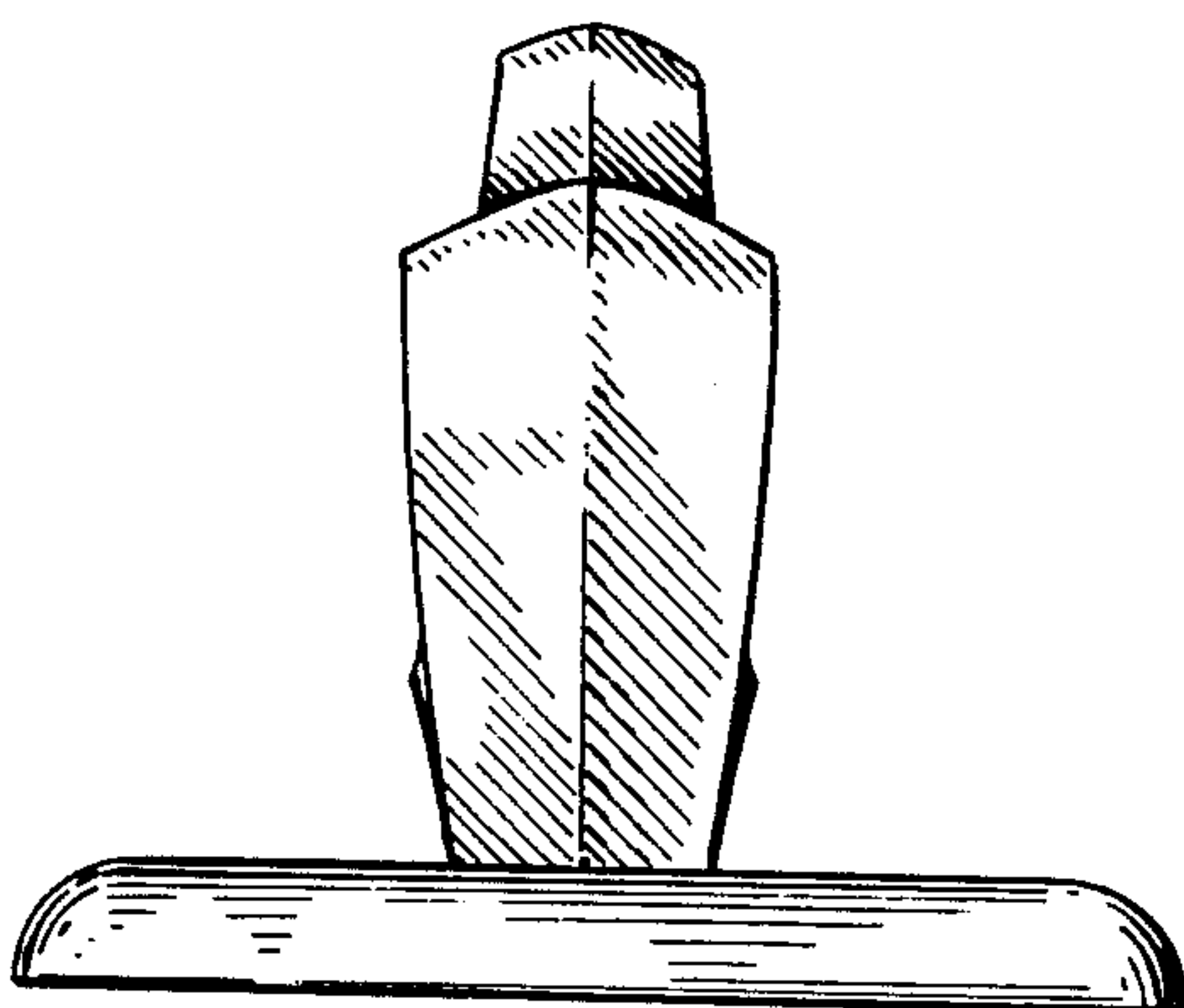
