DESCRIPTION

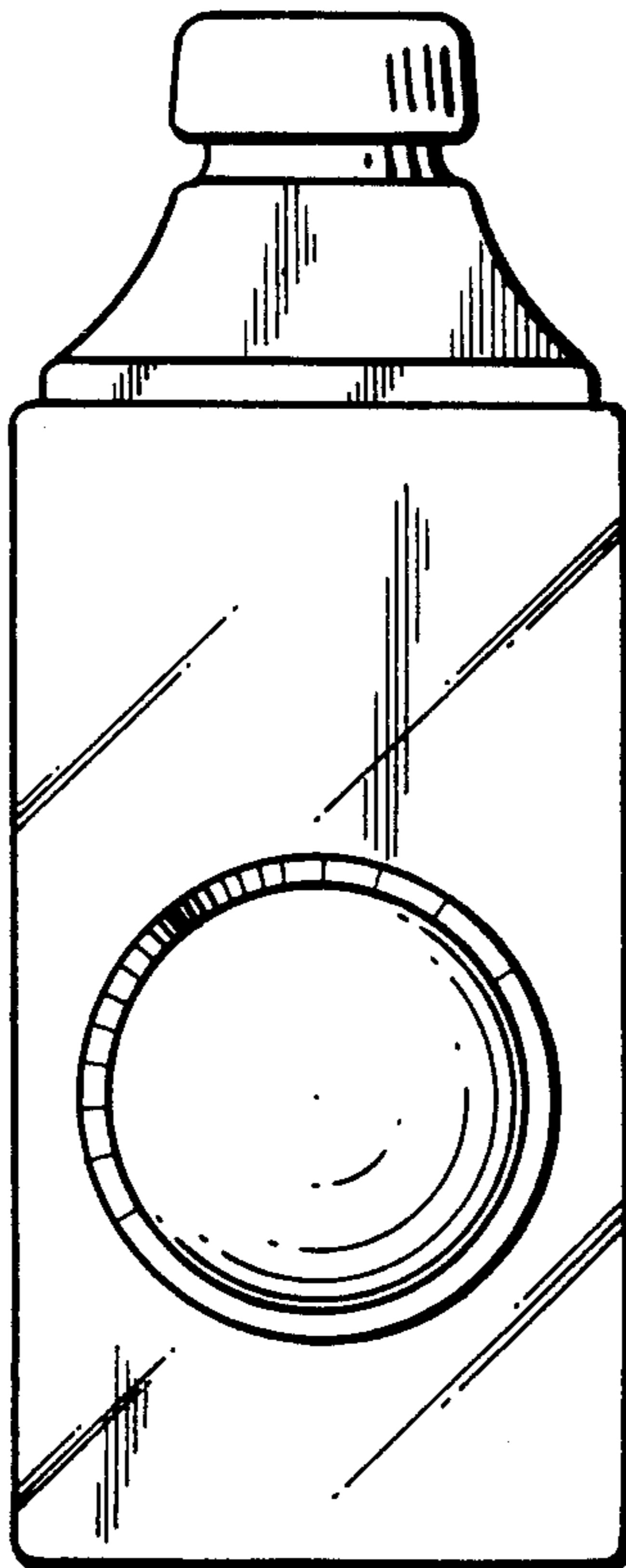
FIG. 1 is a front view of a bottle showing my new

The back of the bottle is plain and unornamented.



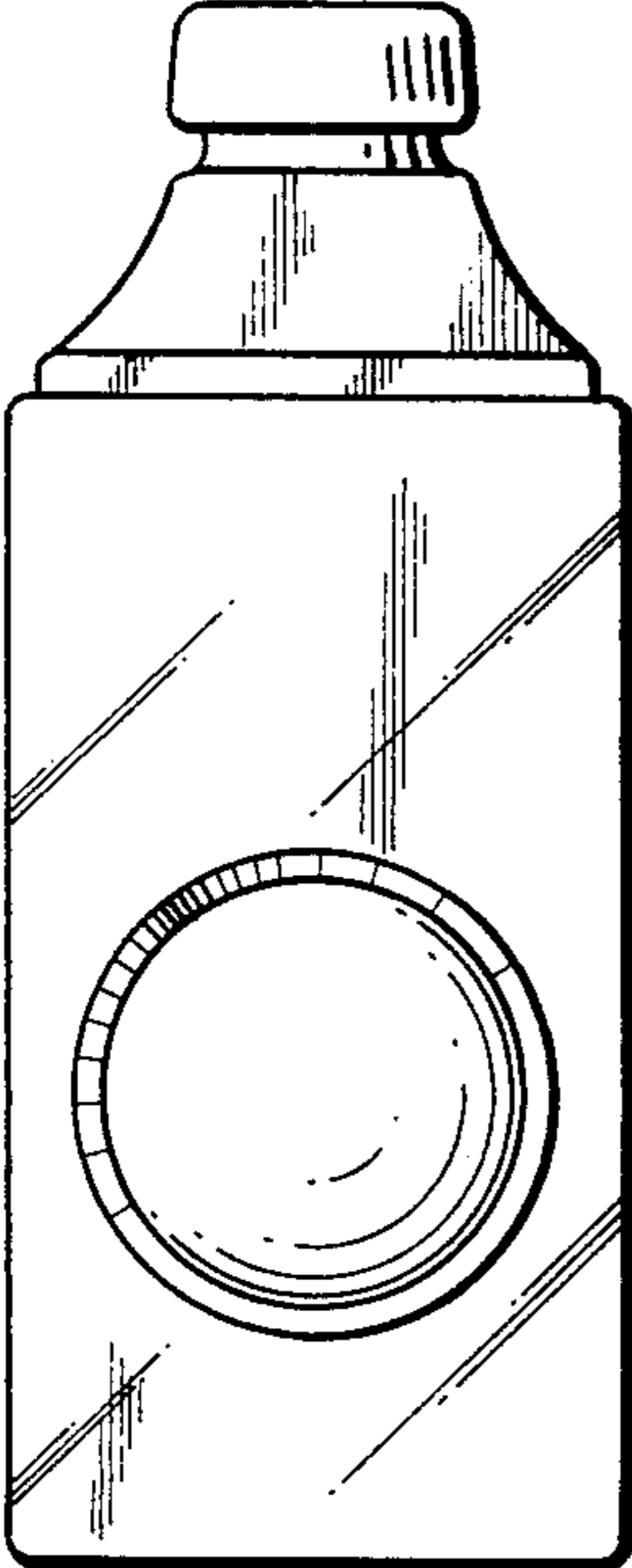

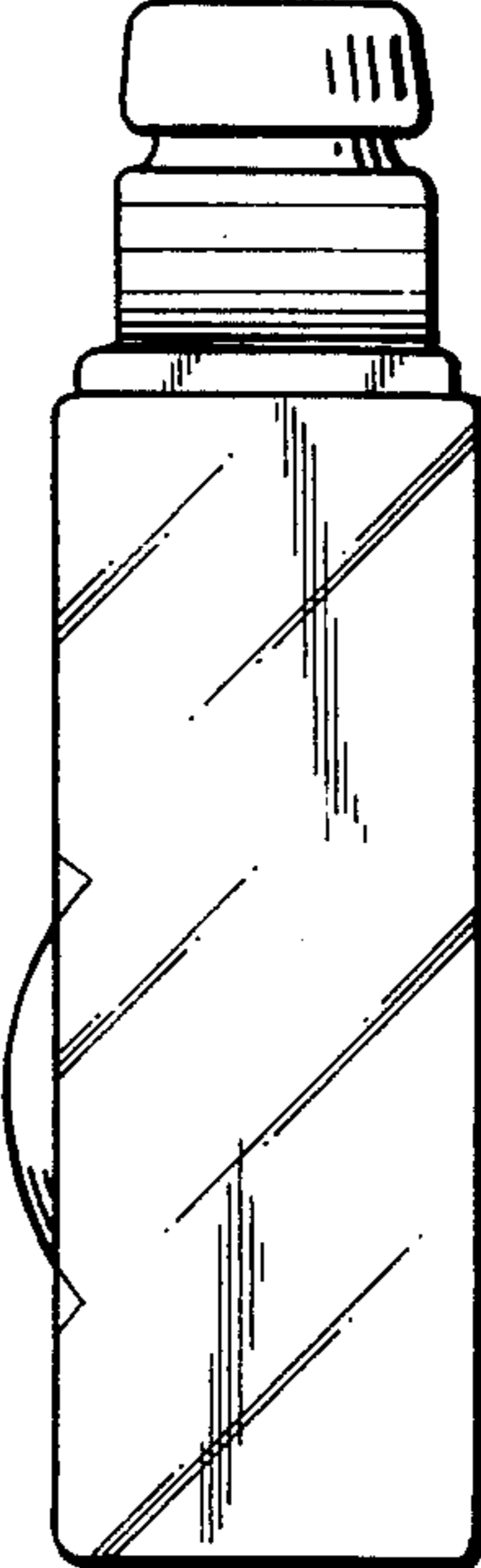

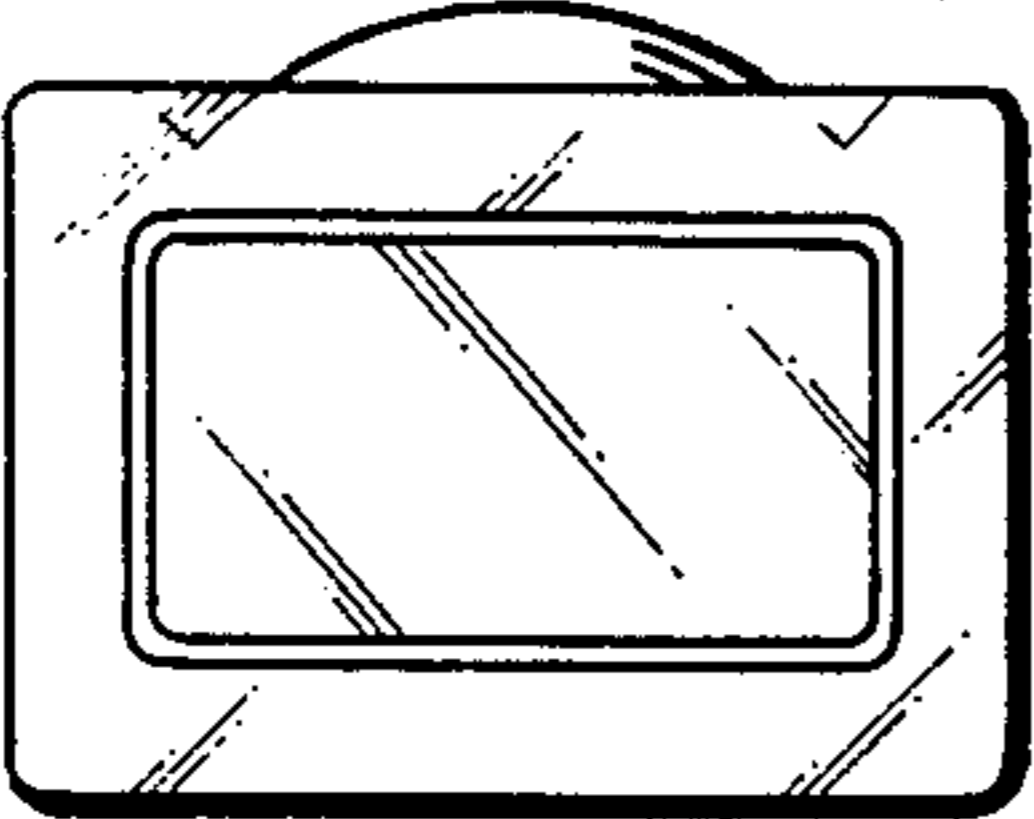

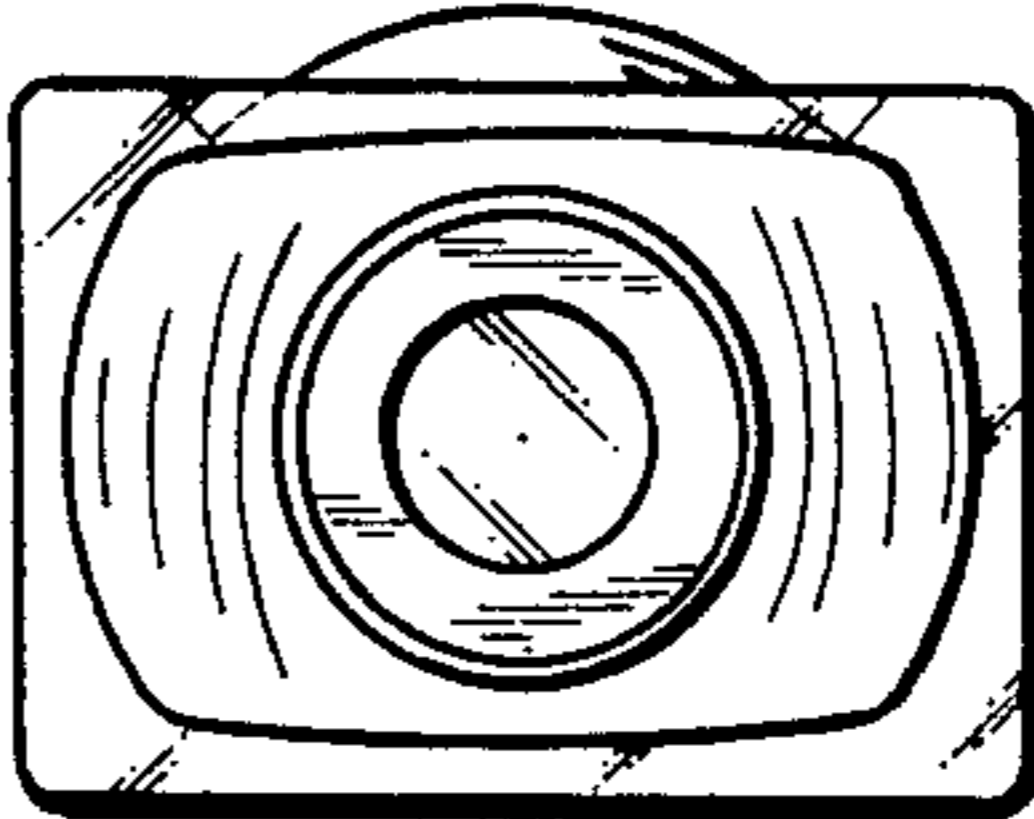
