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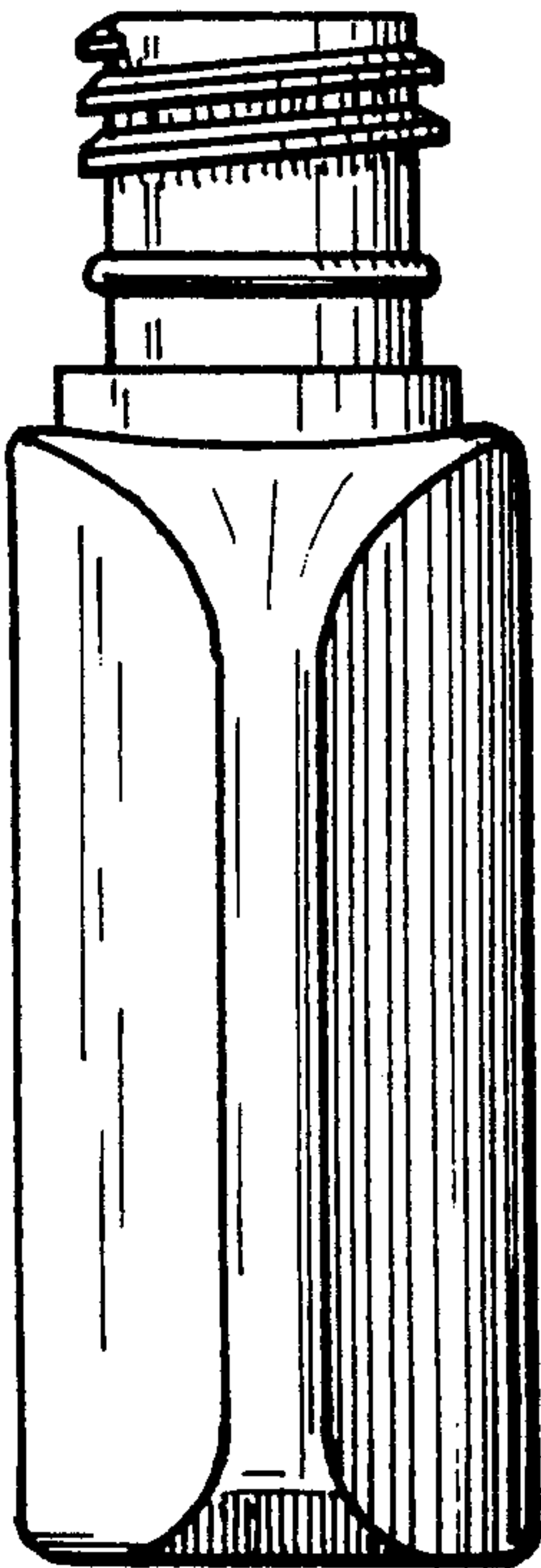

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bottle showing my
new design, the opposite side being substantially the
same in appearance;
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view, the opposite end
being substantially the same in appearance;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary sectional view taken on the line
5—5 of FIG. 1.



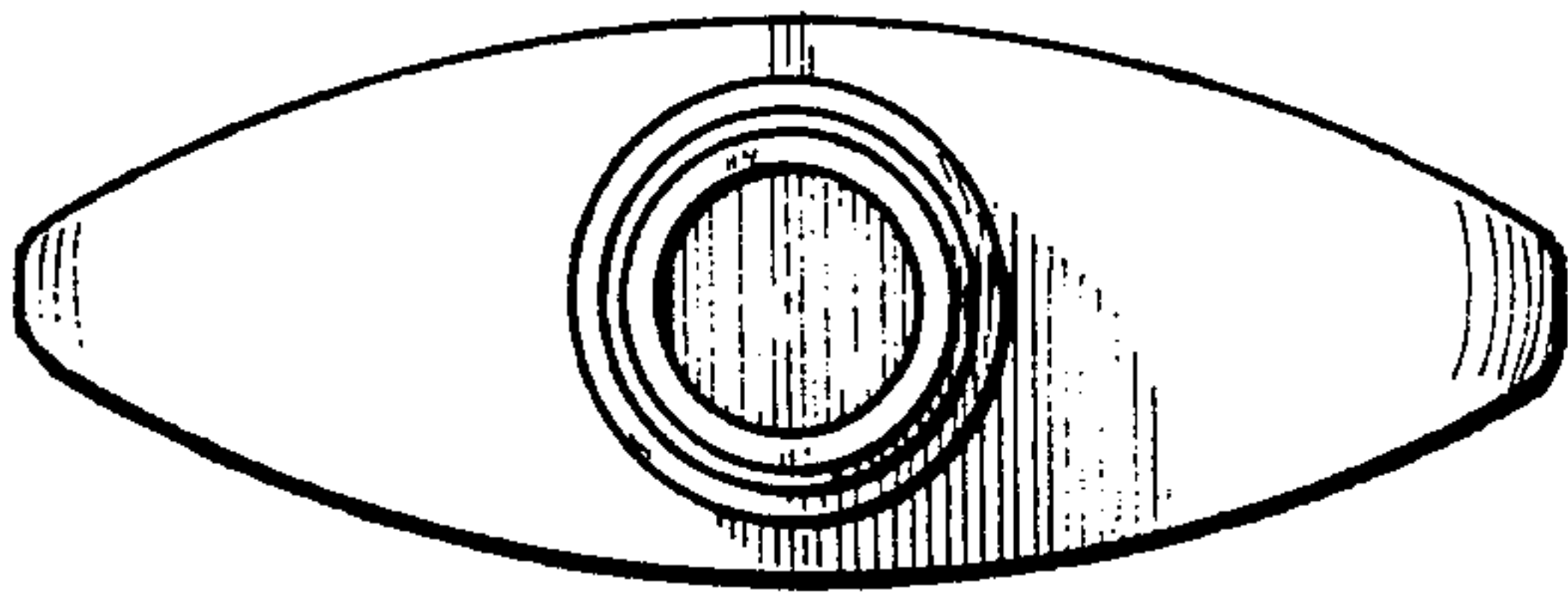

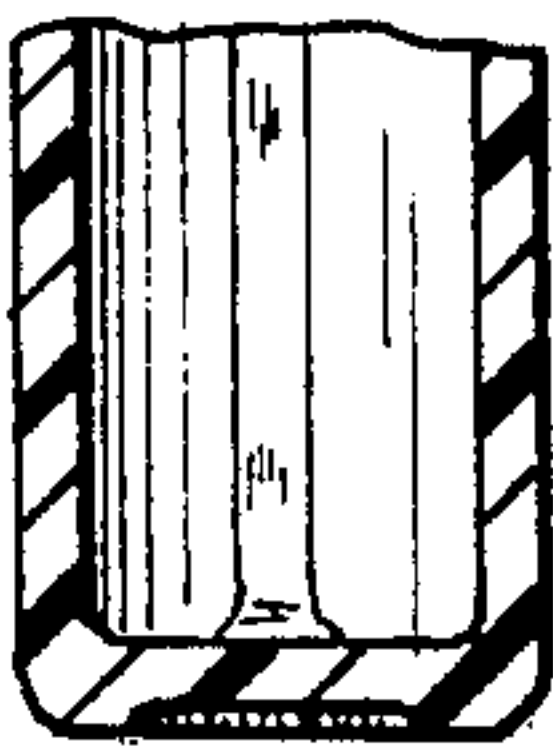

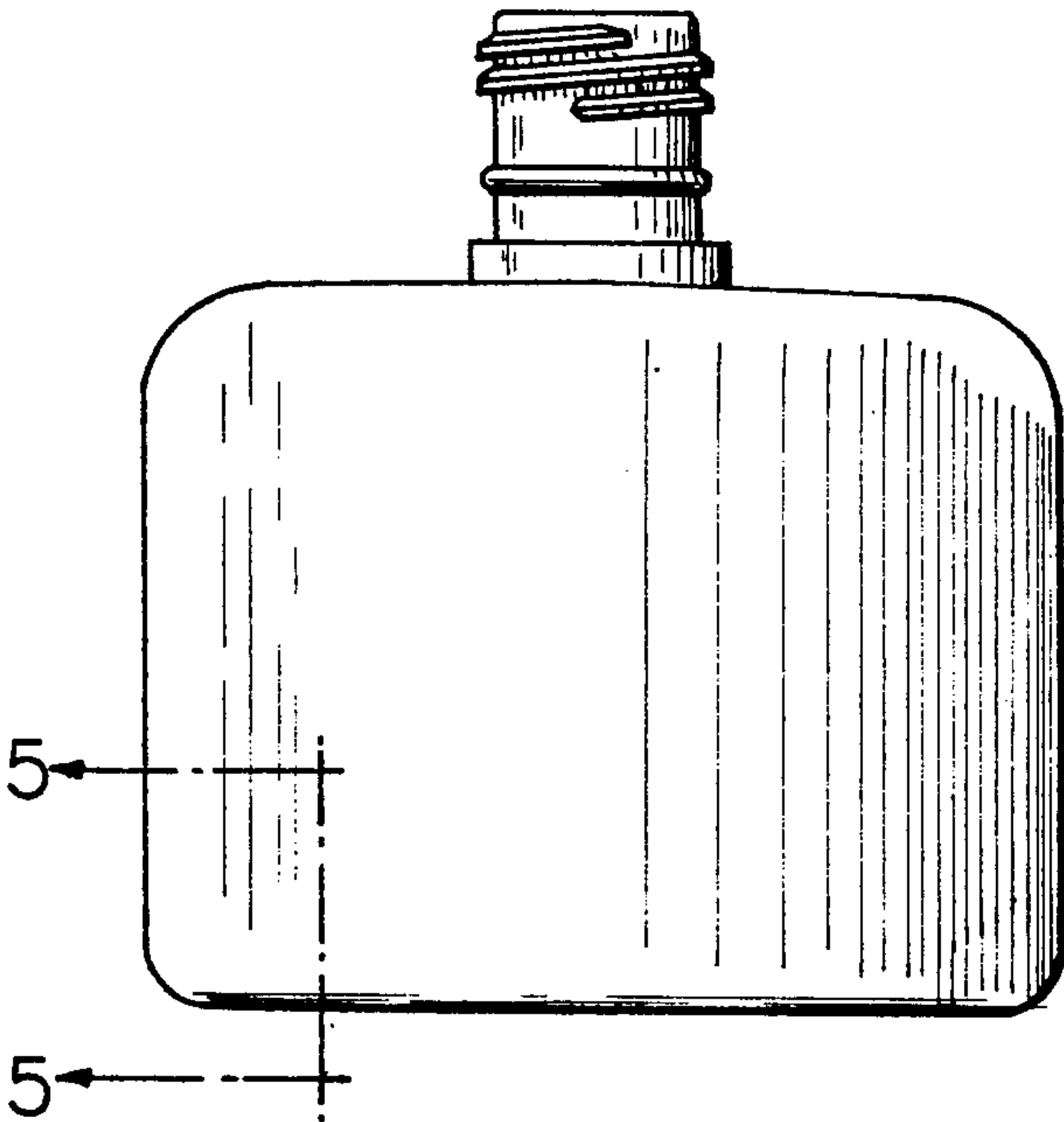

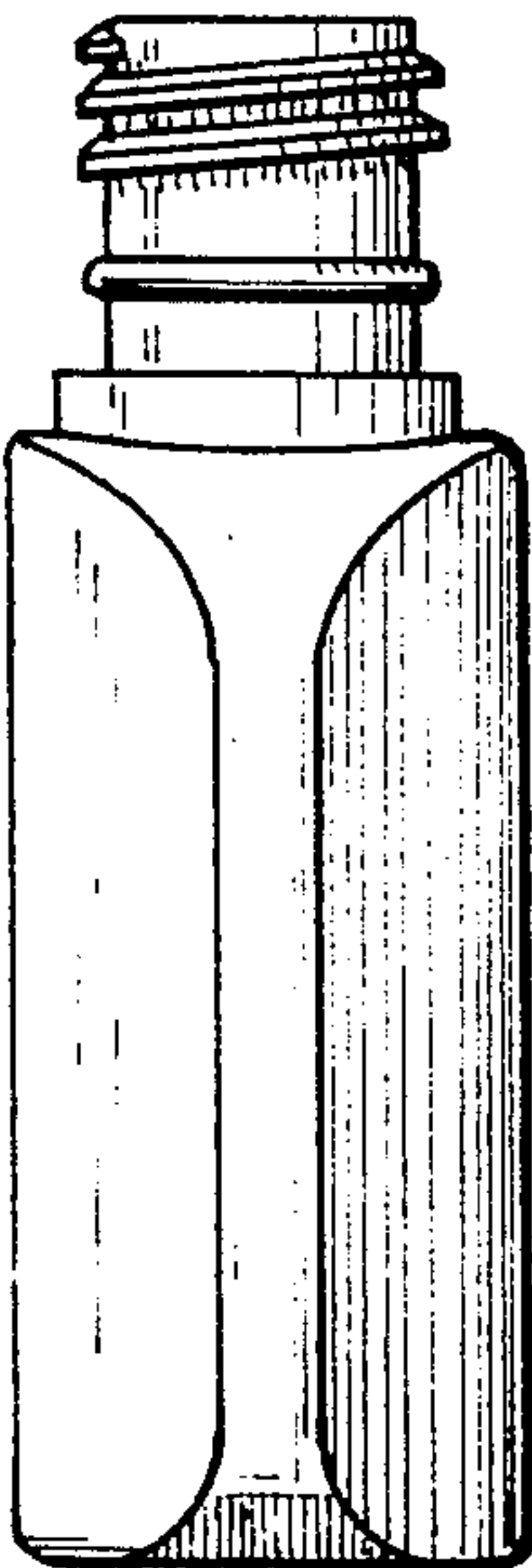

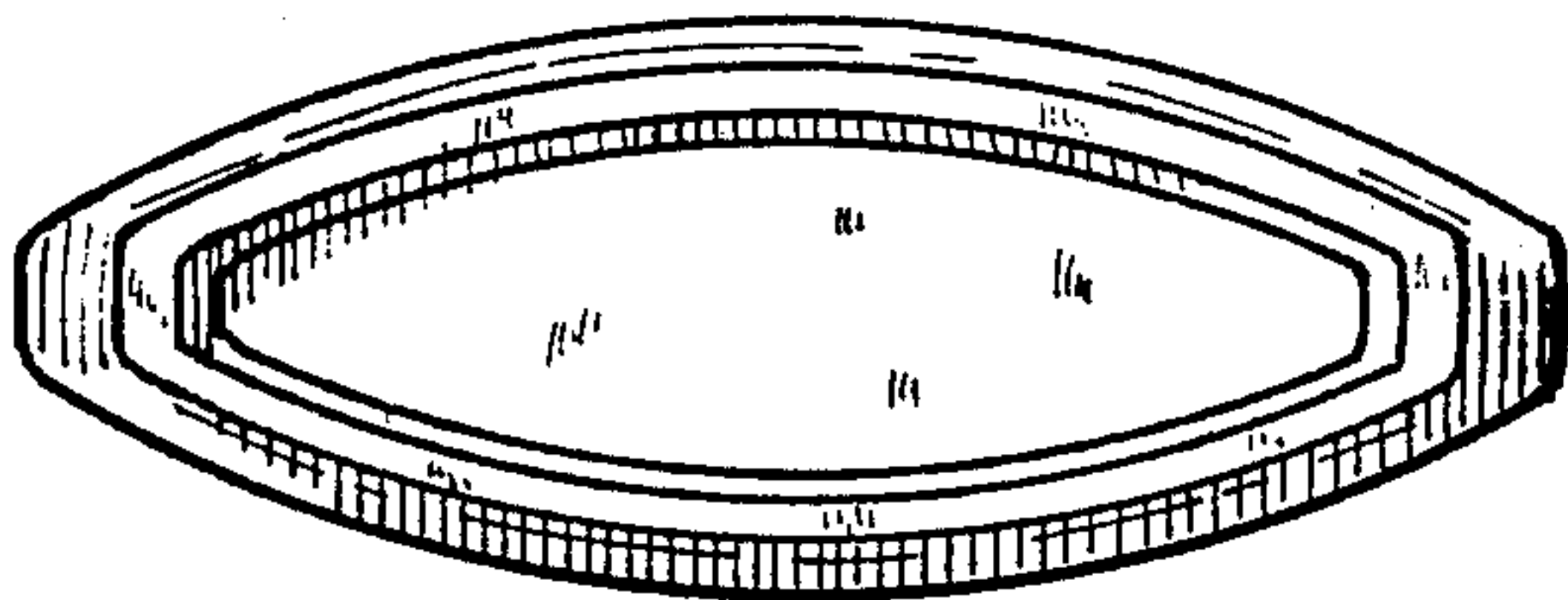
