[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an automobile wheel, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an automobile wheel showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along lines 5—5 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along lines 6—6 of FIG. 1.

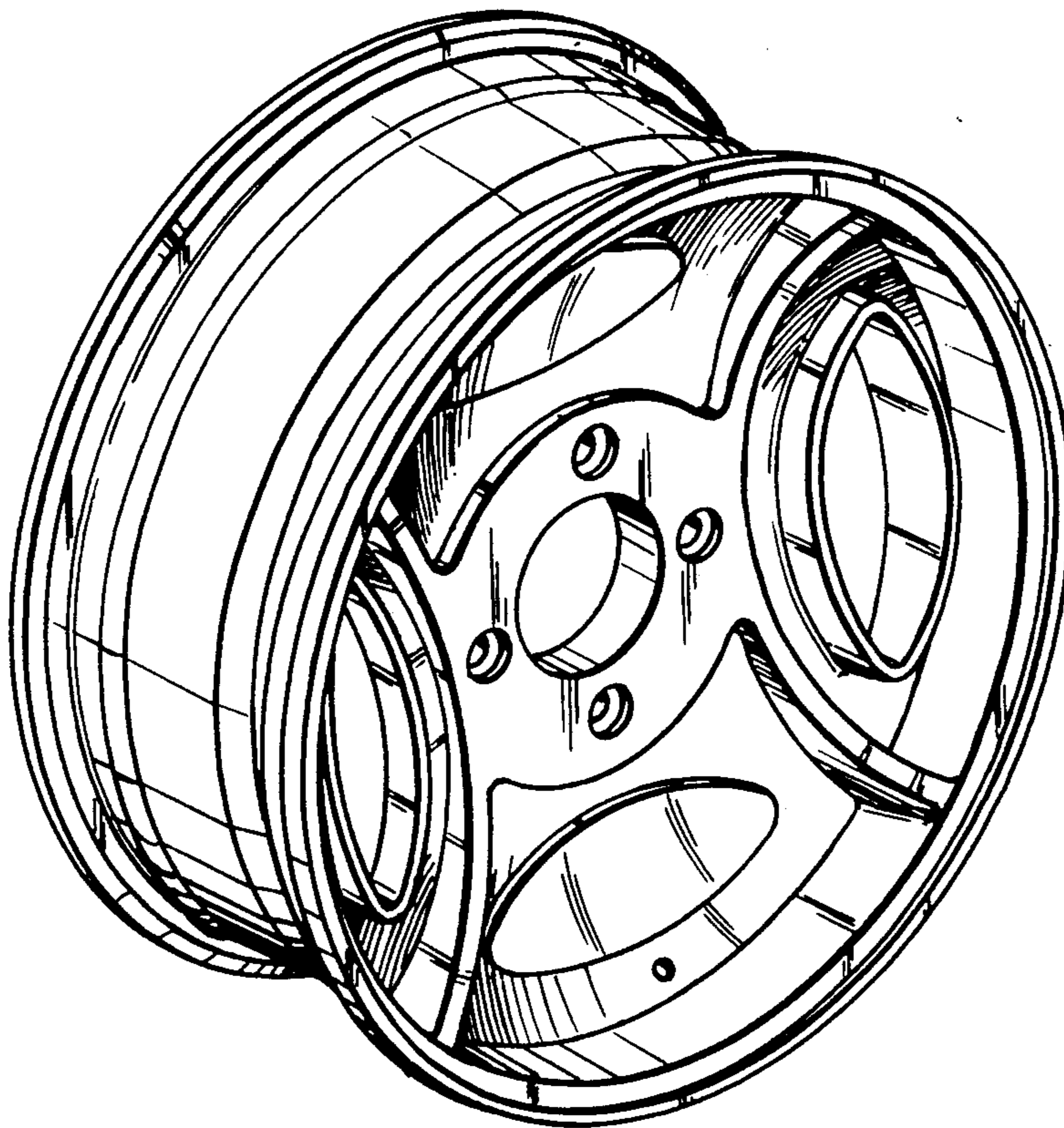

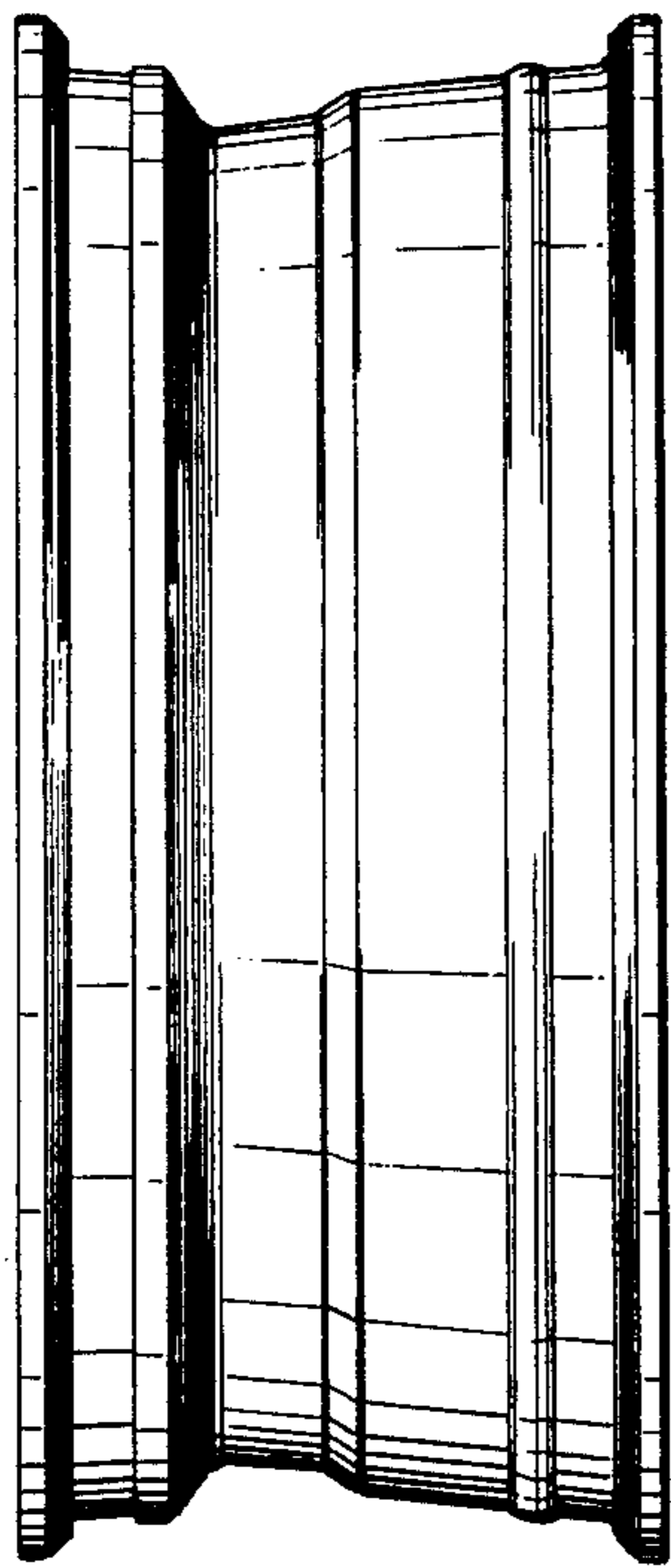
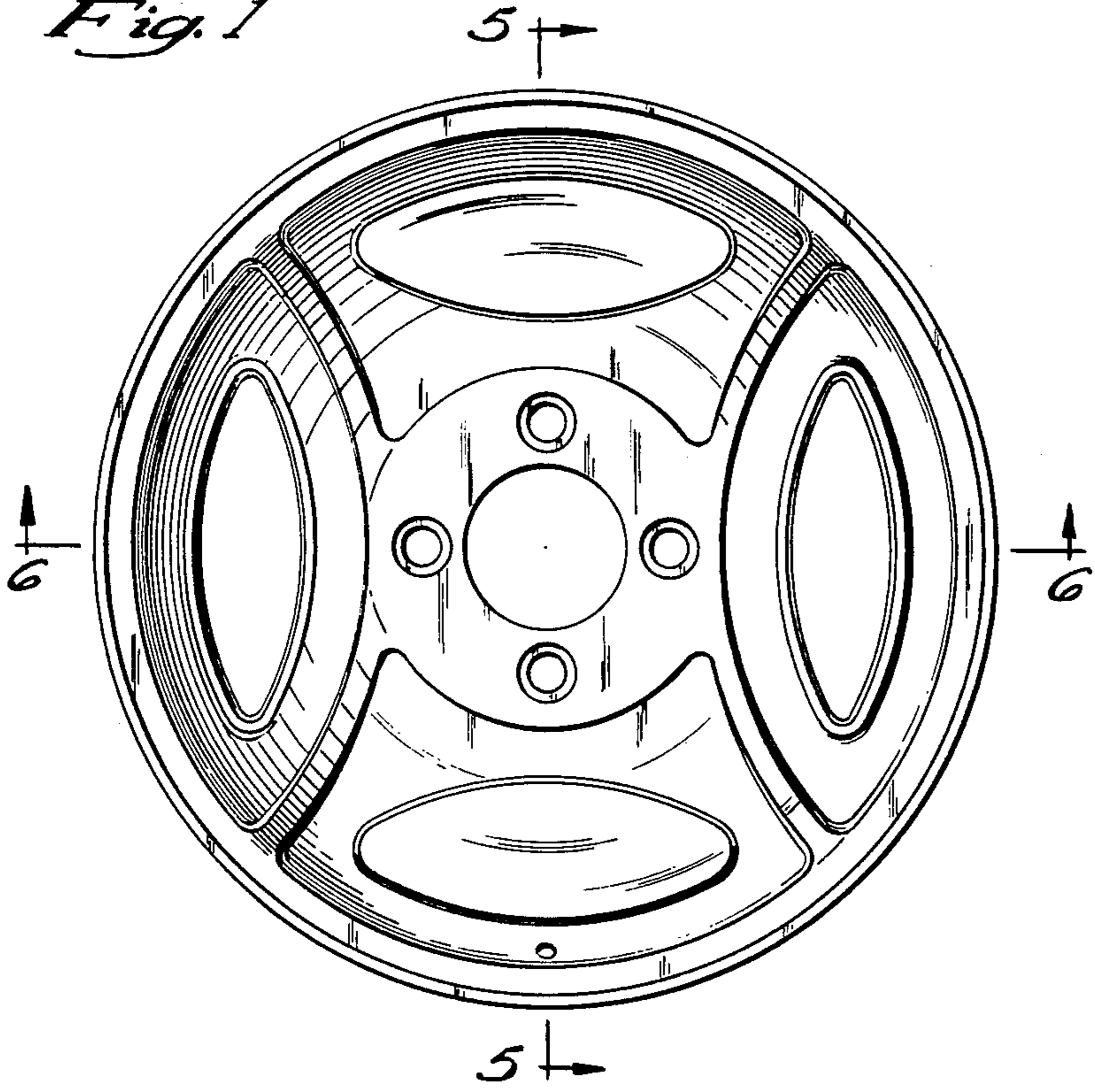

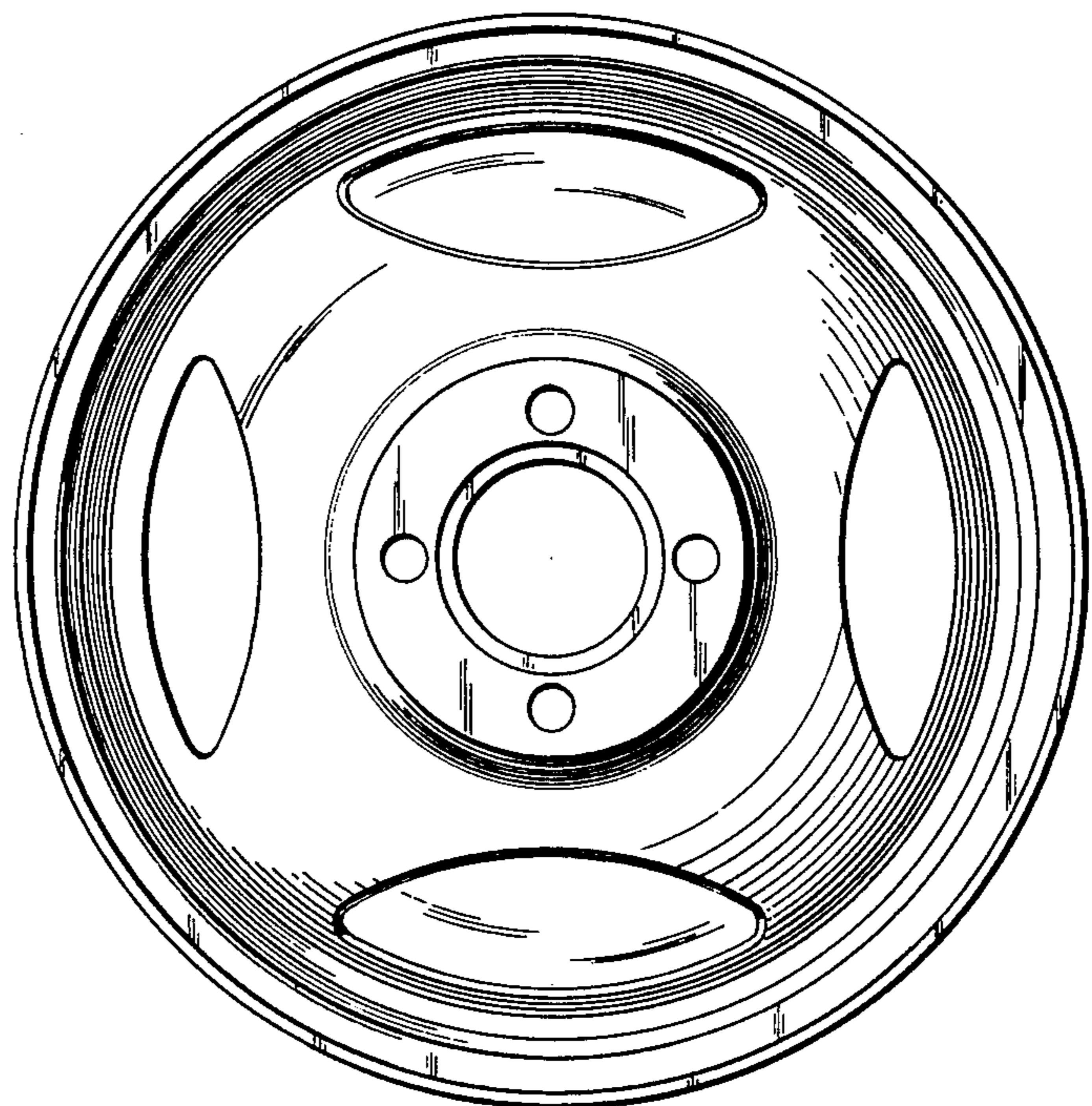

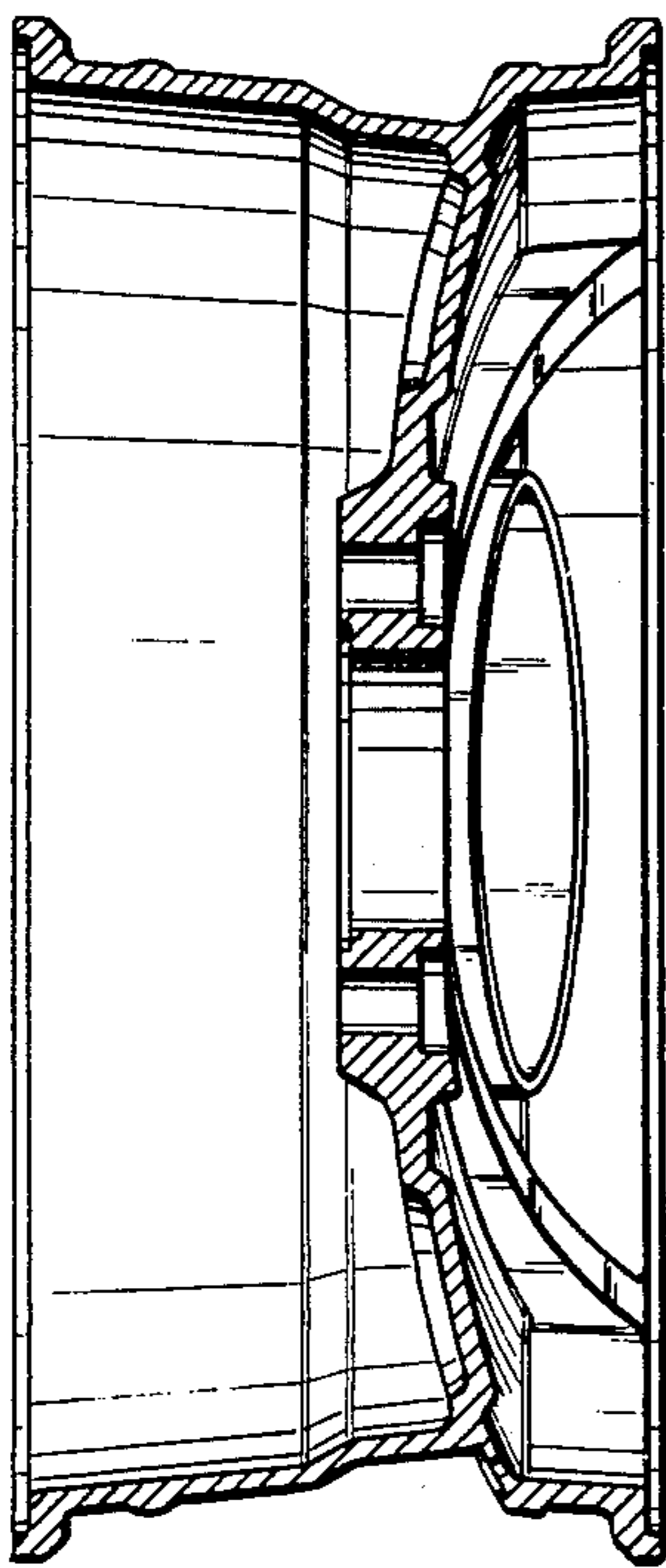
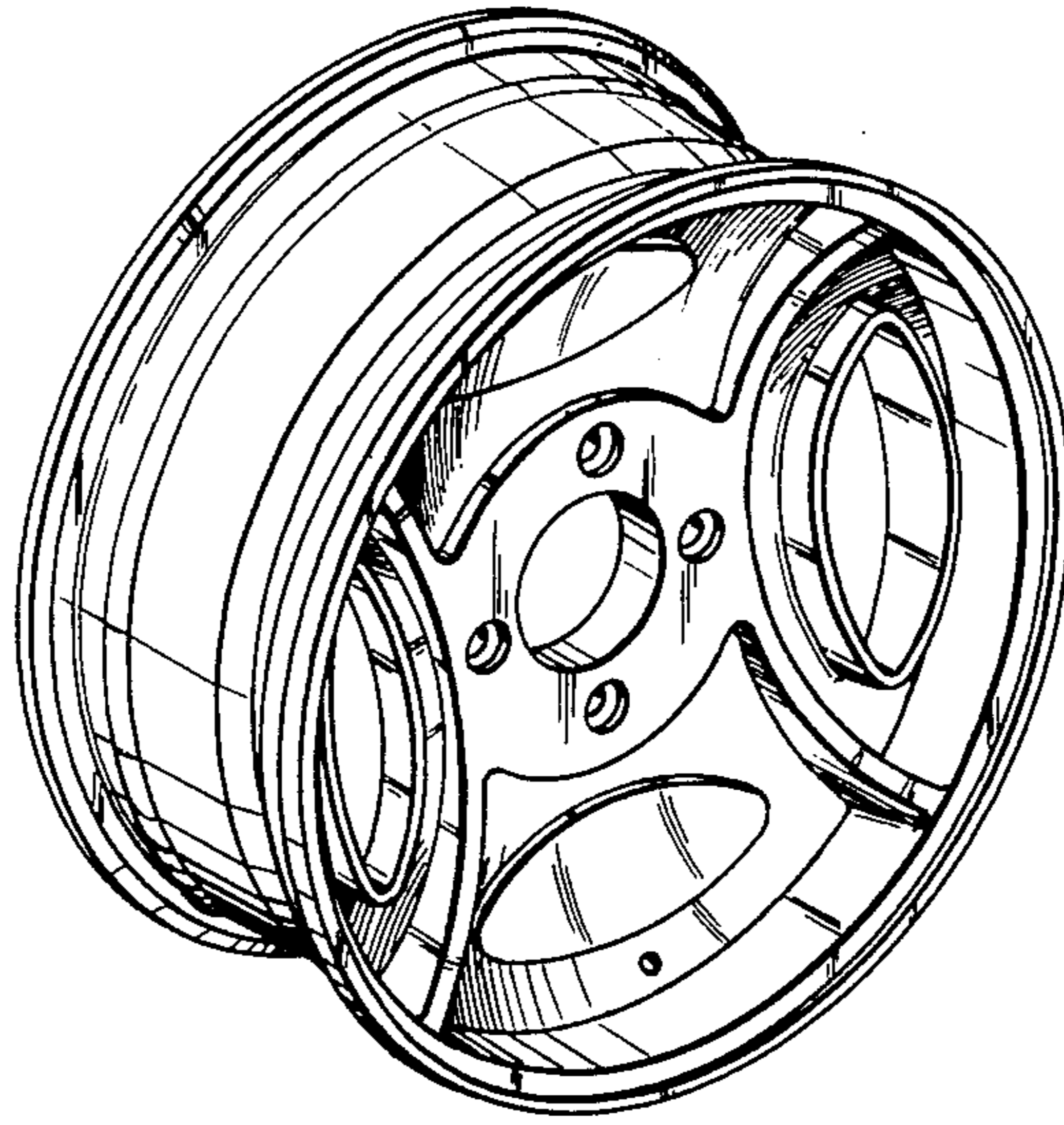

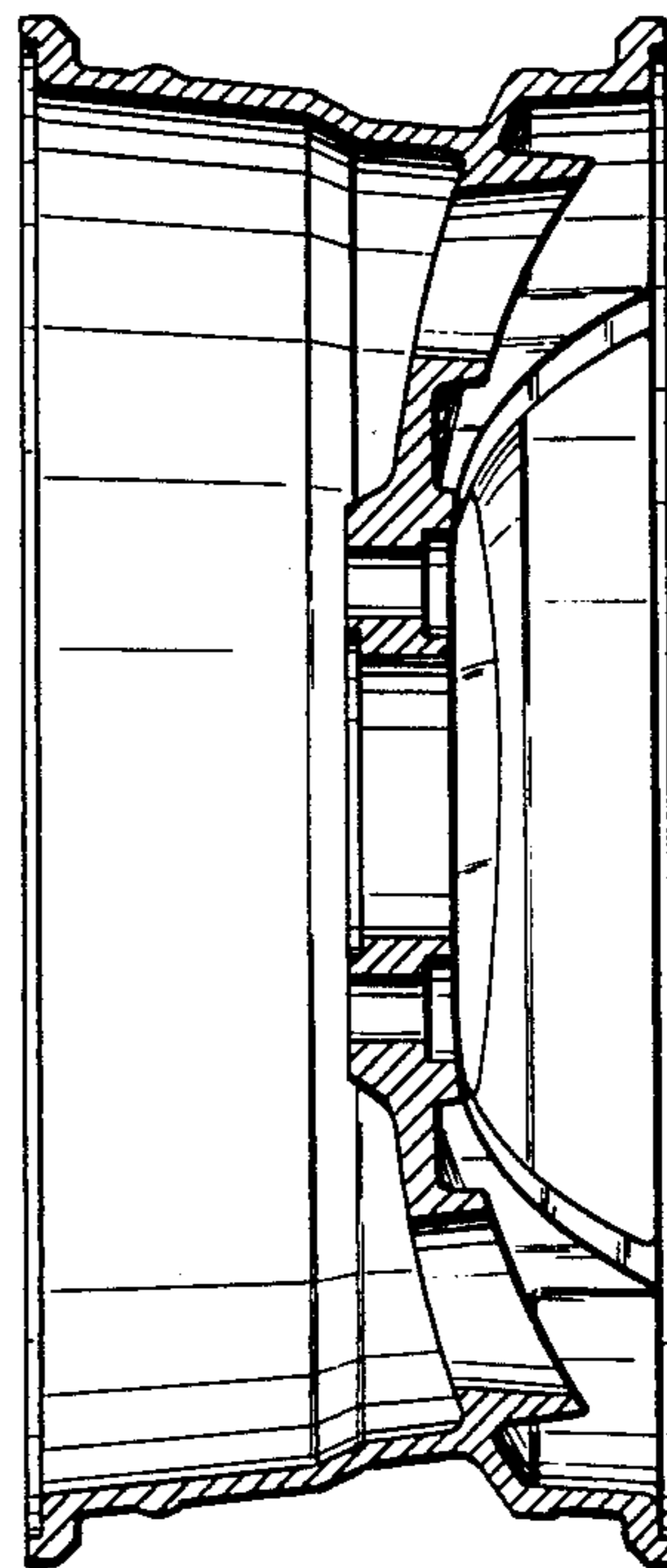
