The ornamental design for a motor housing and handle for a portable bag closing sewing machine, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a motor housing and handle for a portable bag closing sewing machine showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevation view taken from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an end elevation view taken from the right of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The power cord is fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration.

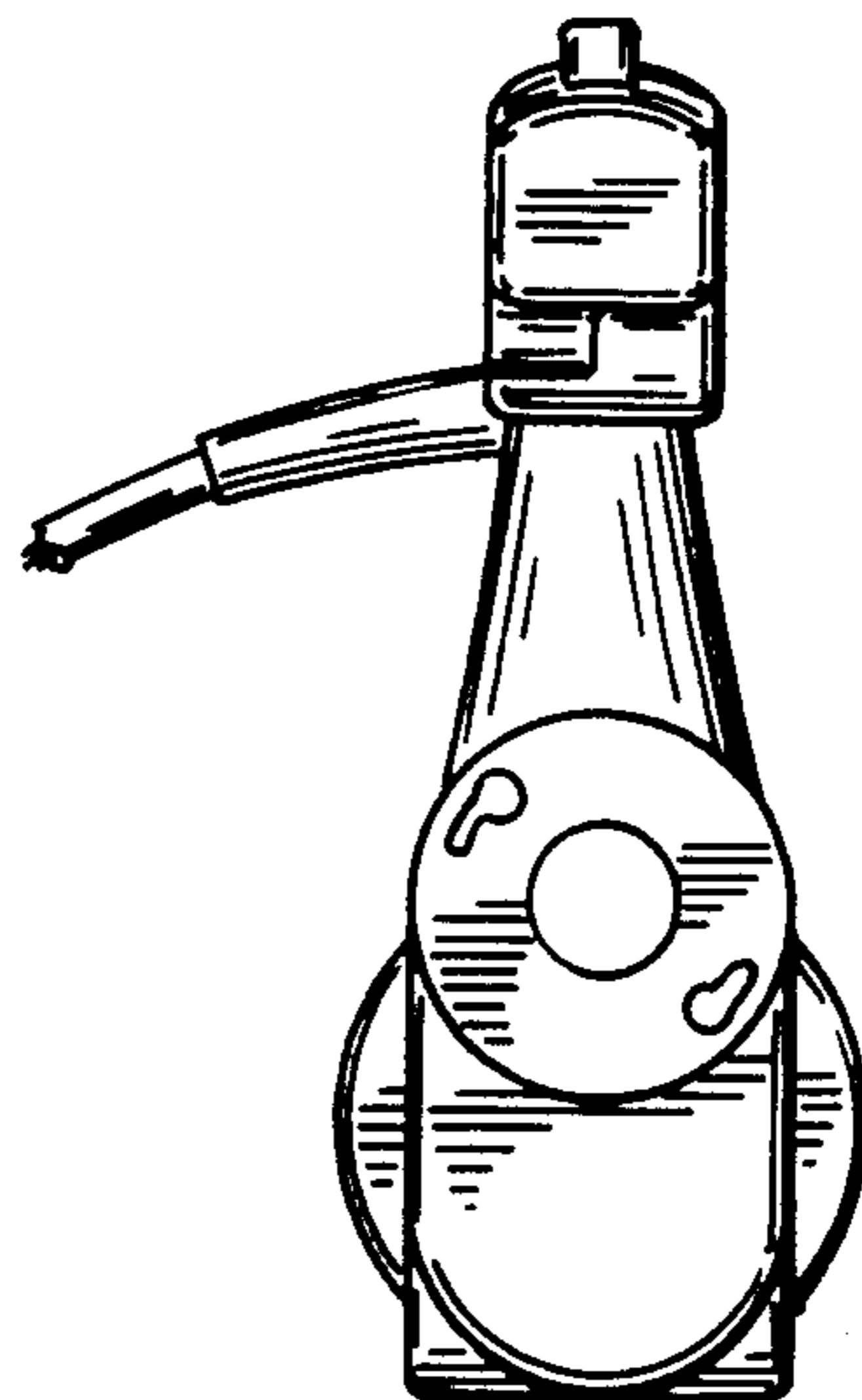
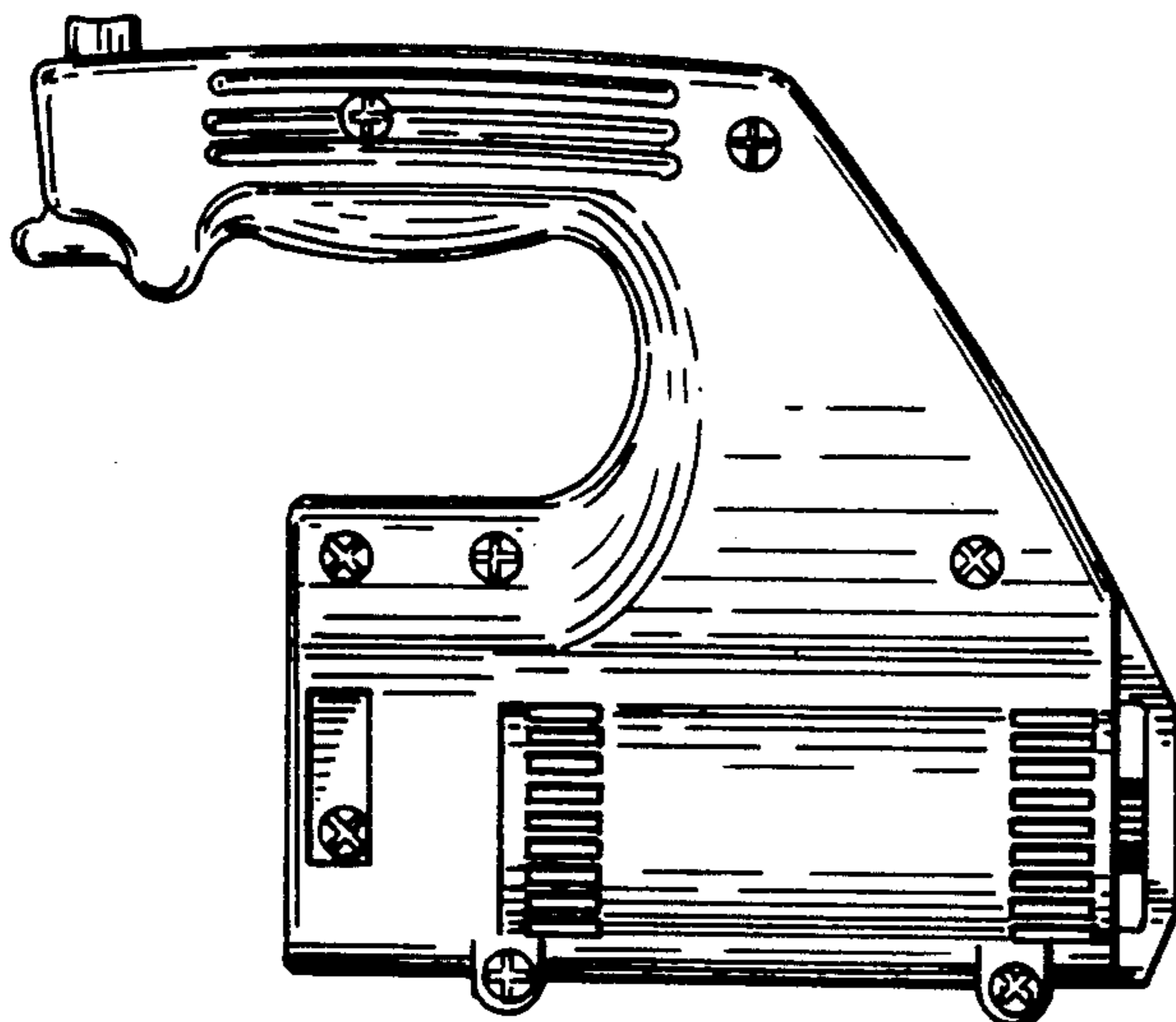

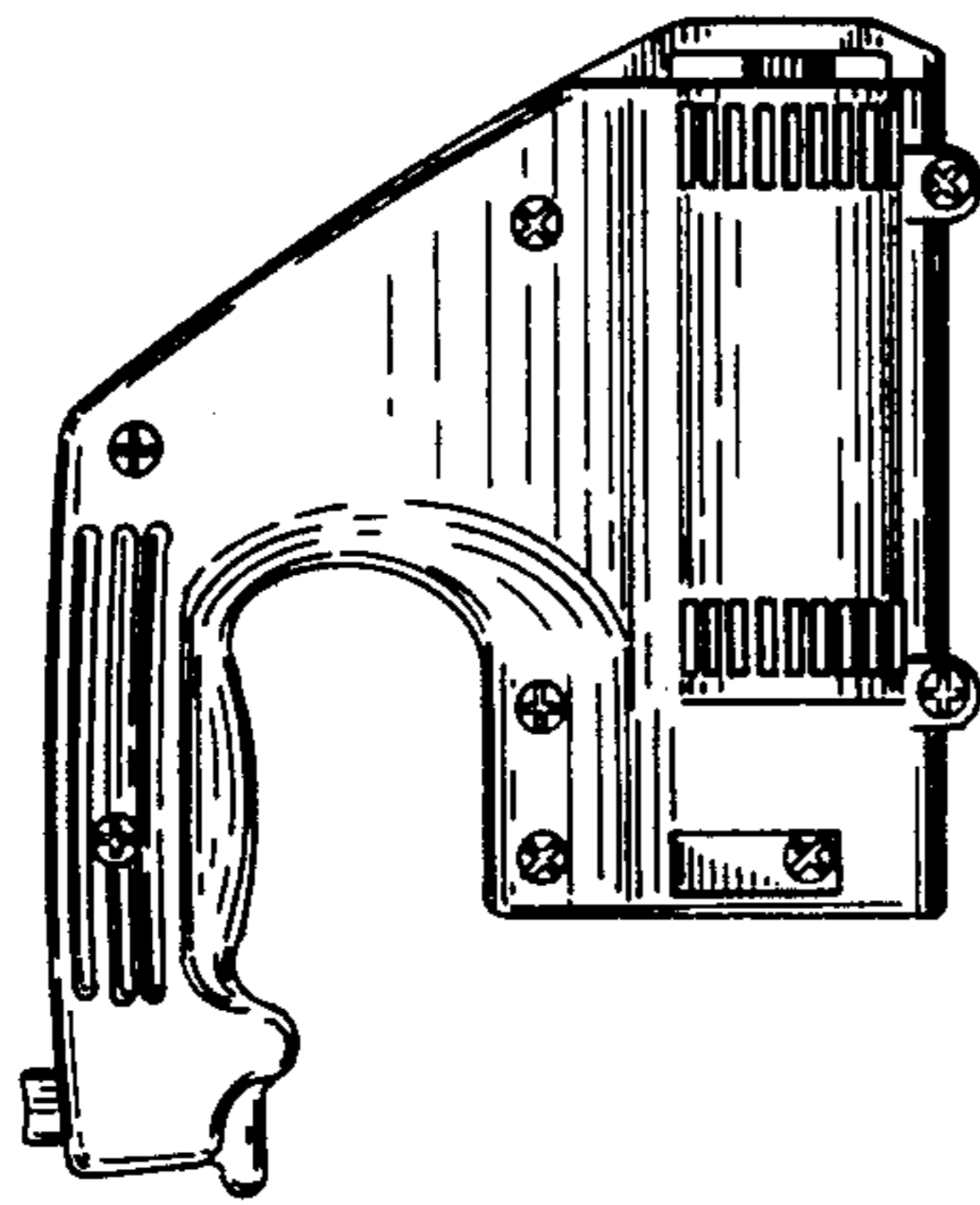

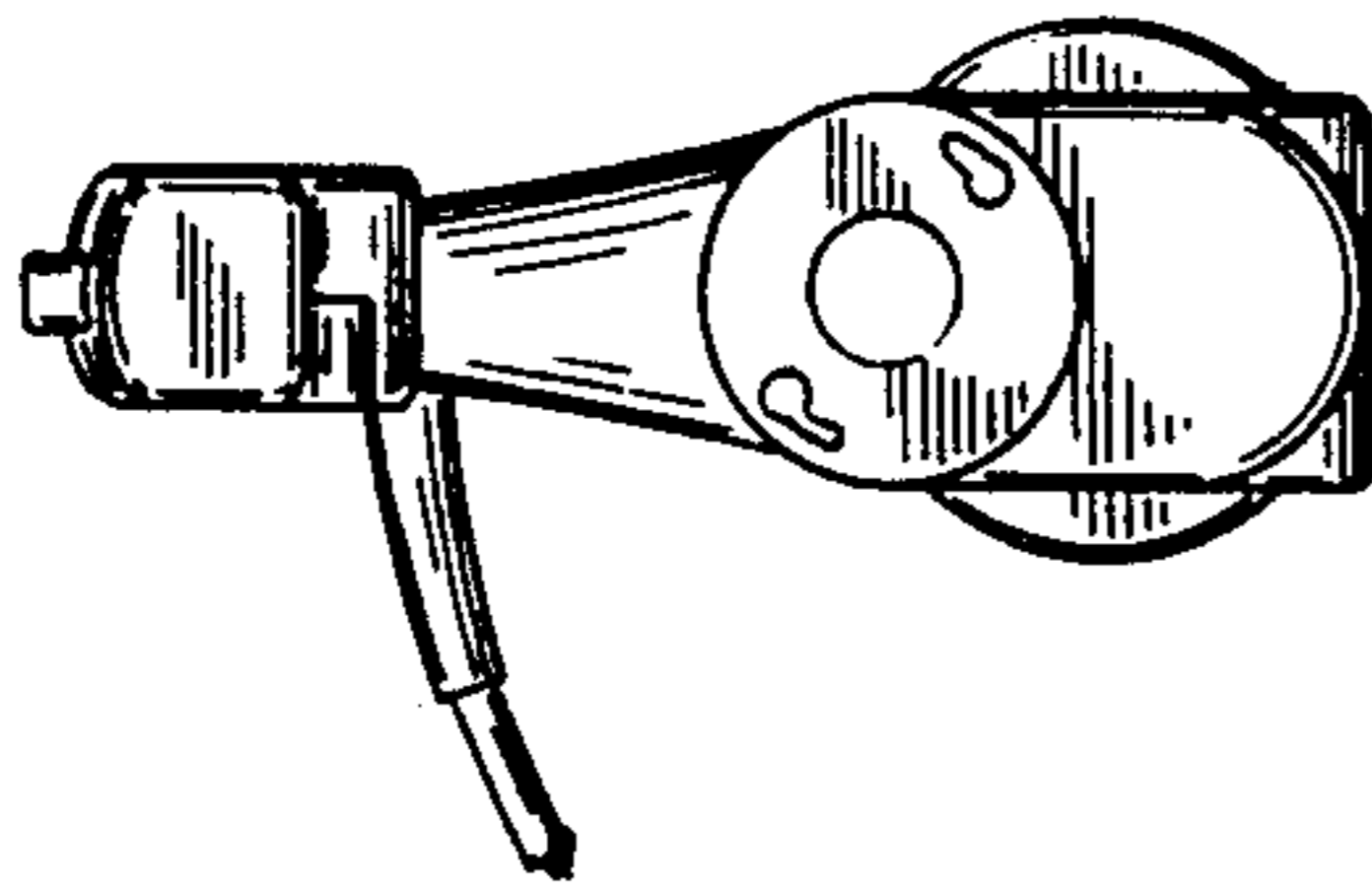

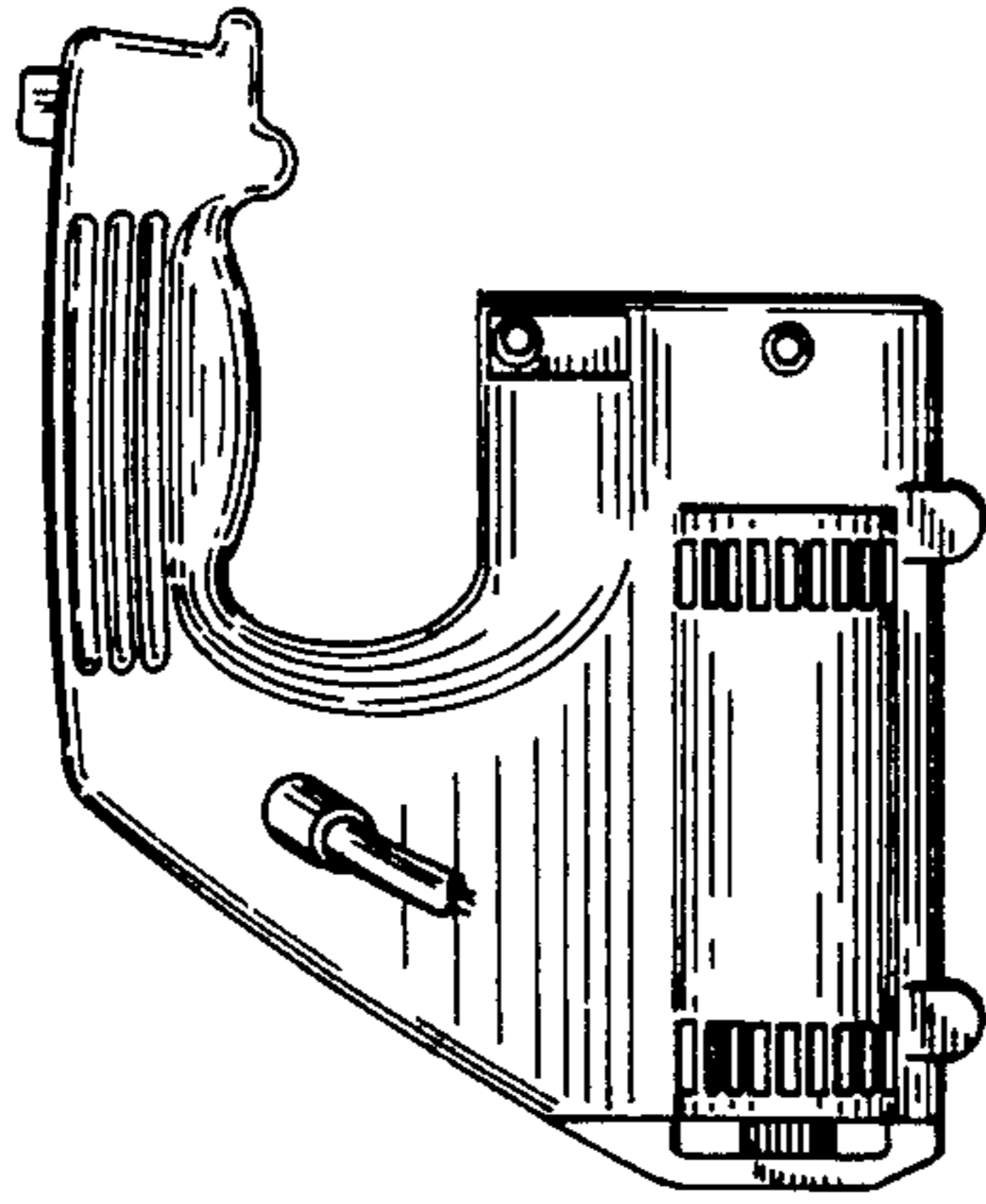

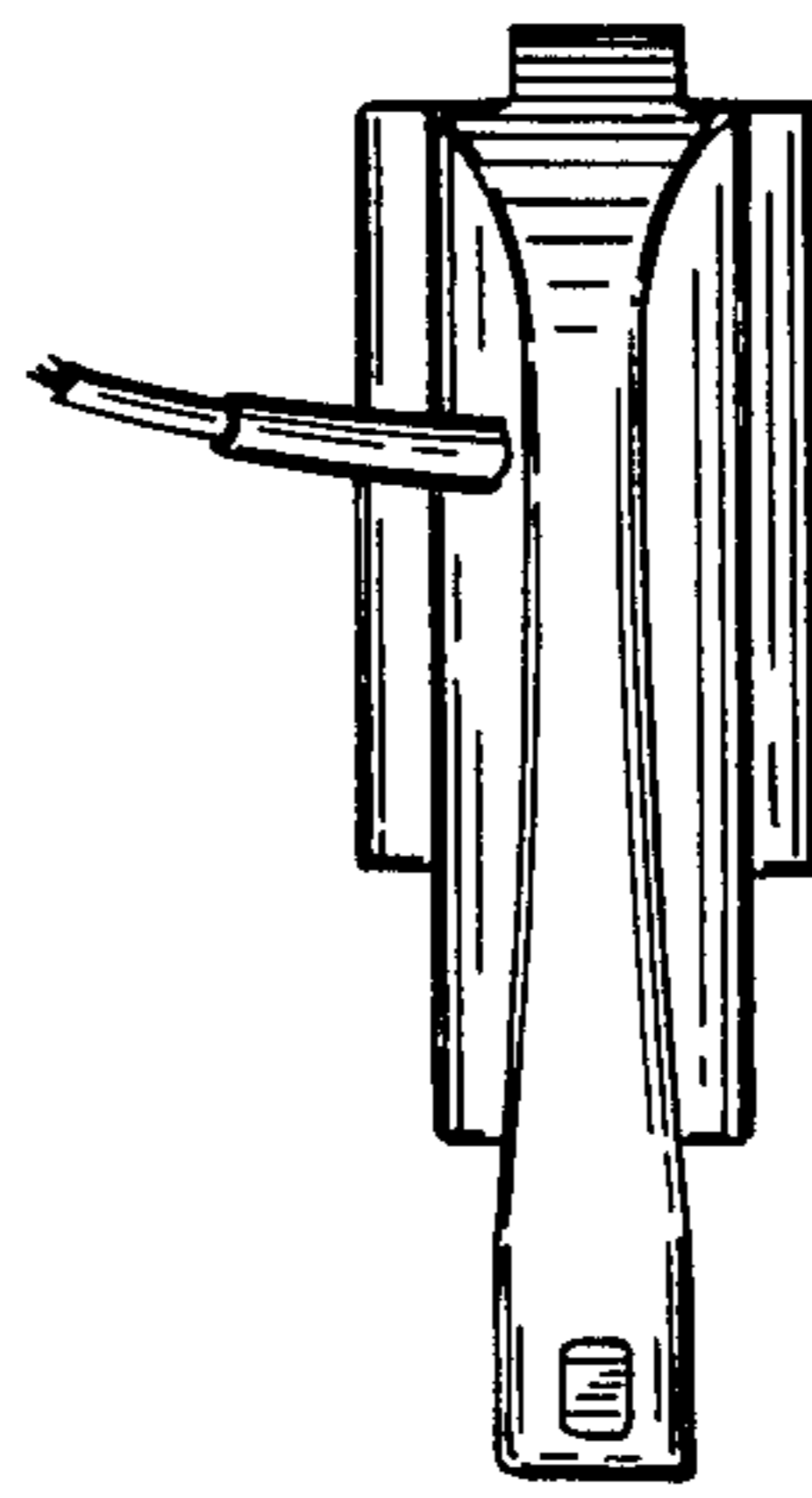

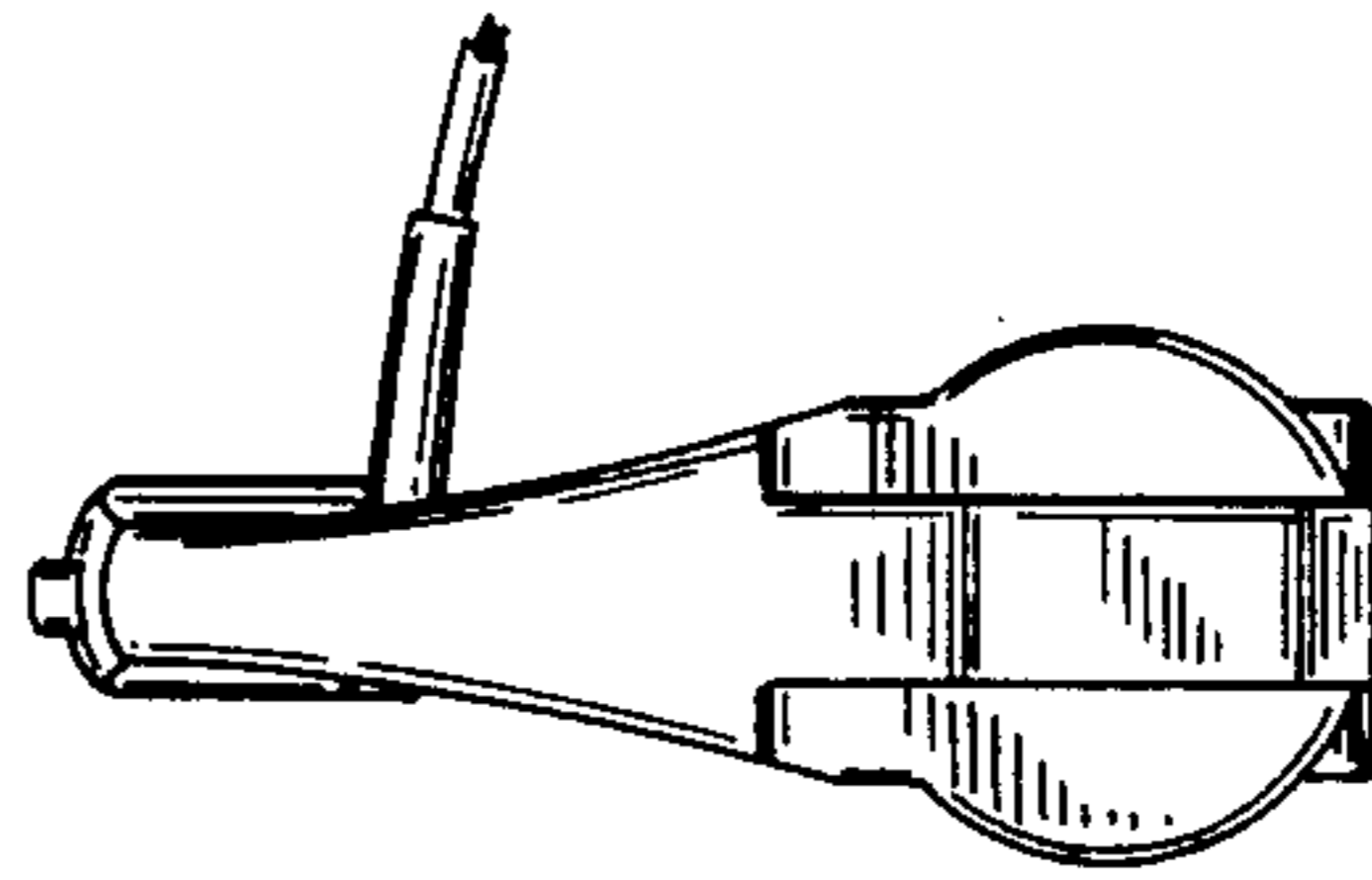
