[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy house, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy house with the door in an opened condition showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view with the door in a closed condition shown on a slightly enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



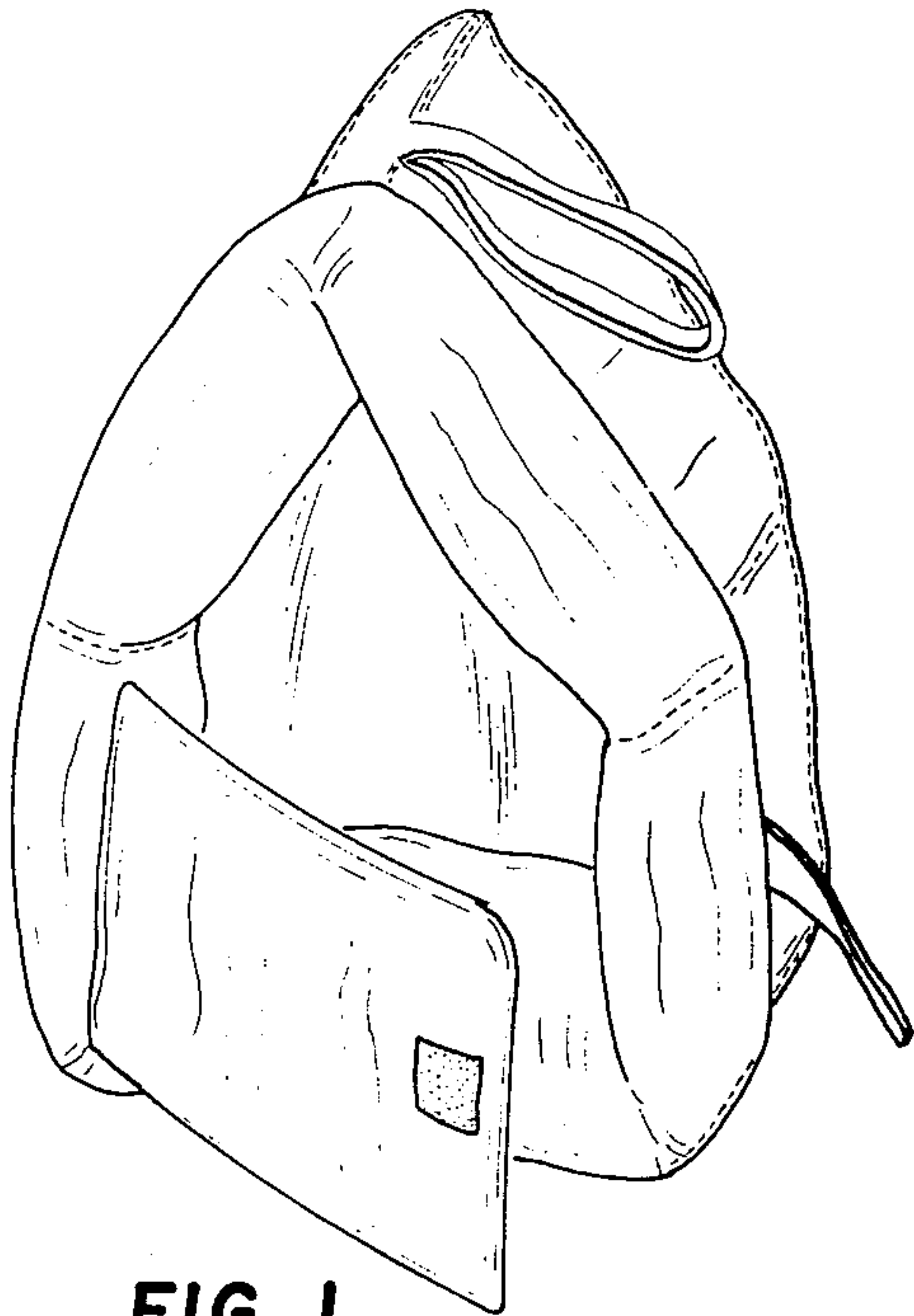

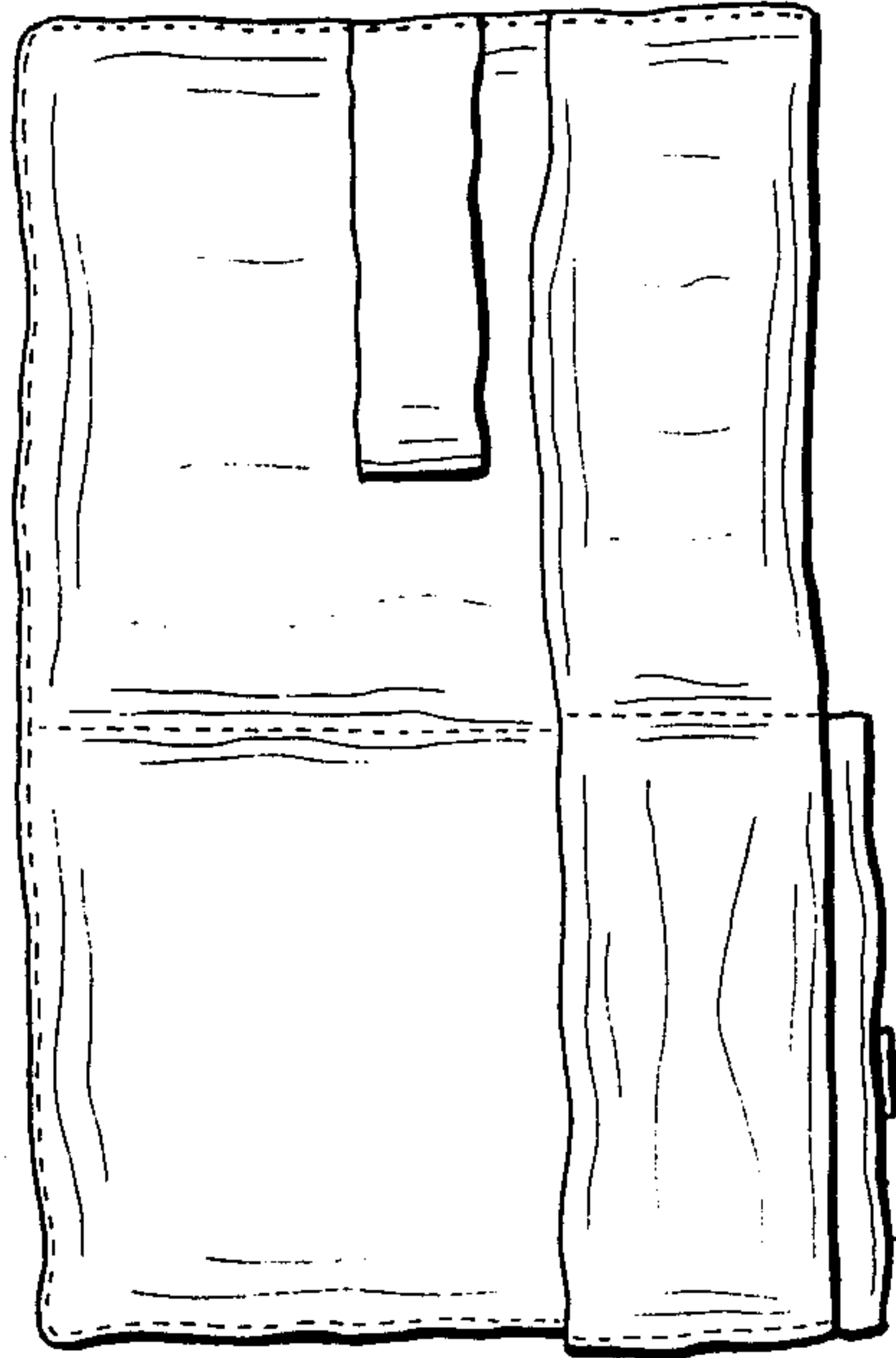

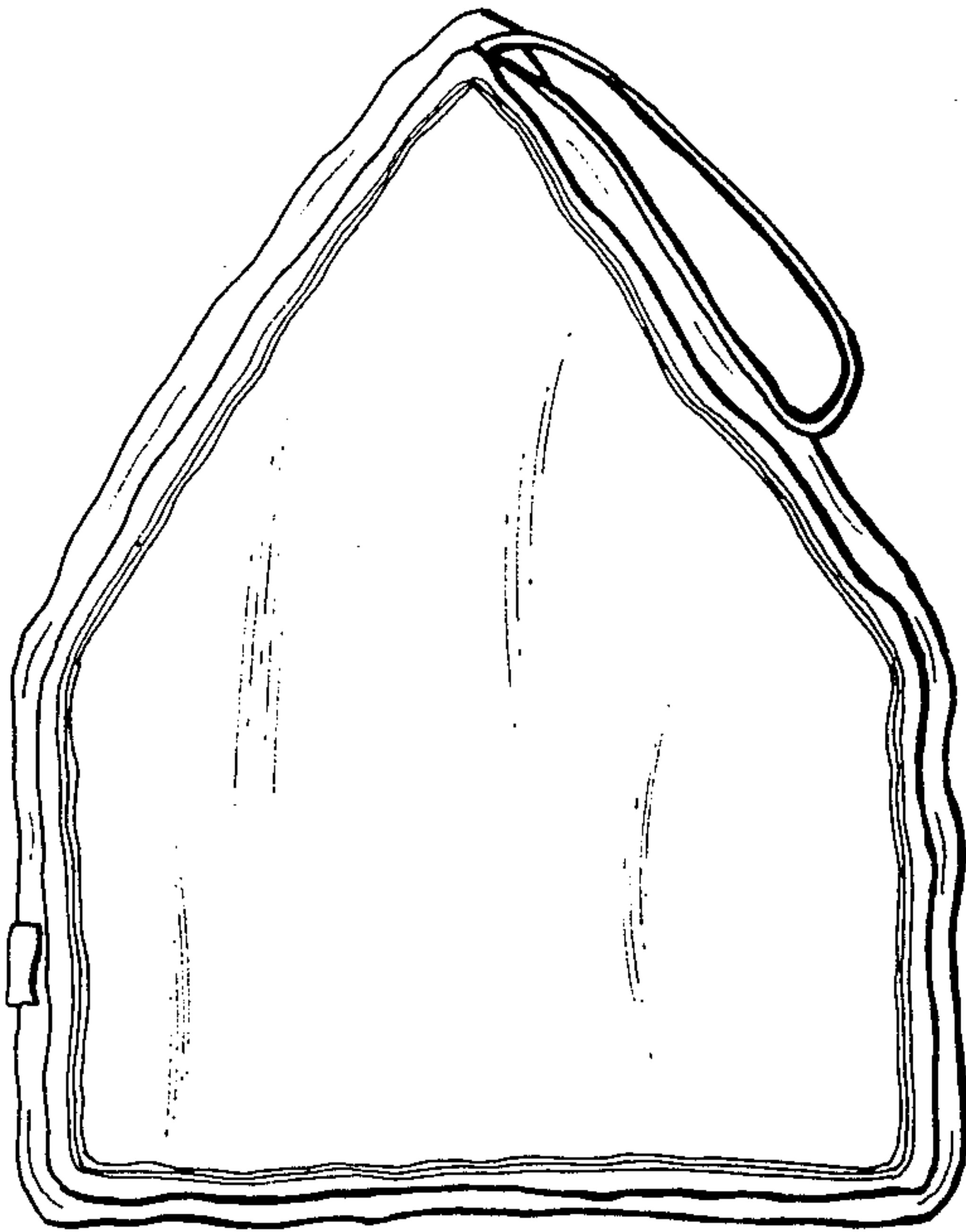

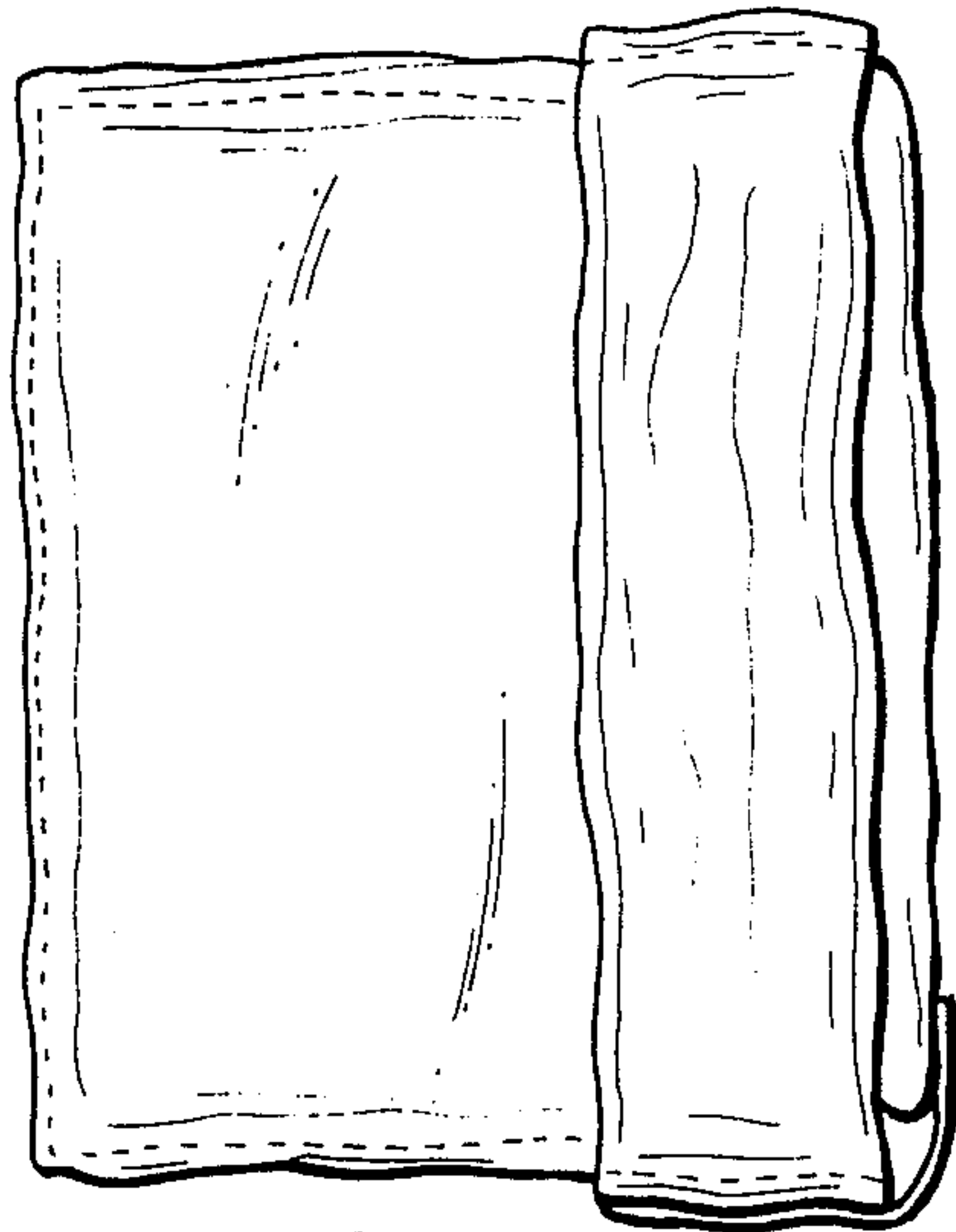
