The ornamental design for a television image projector, as shown.

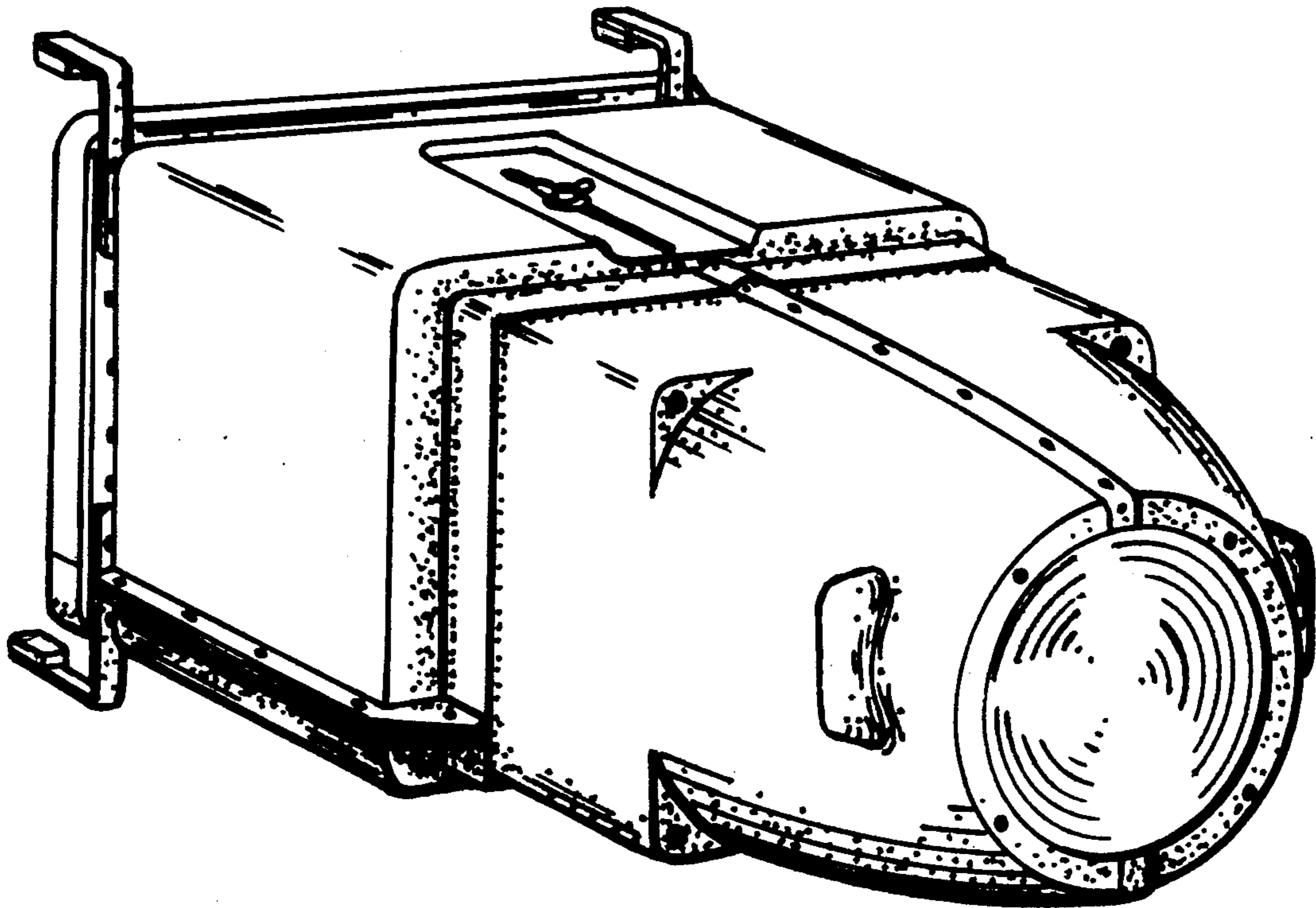
DESCRIPTION

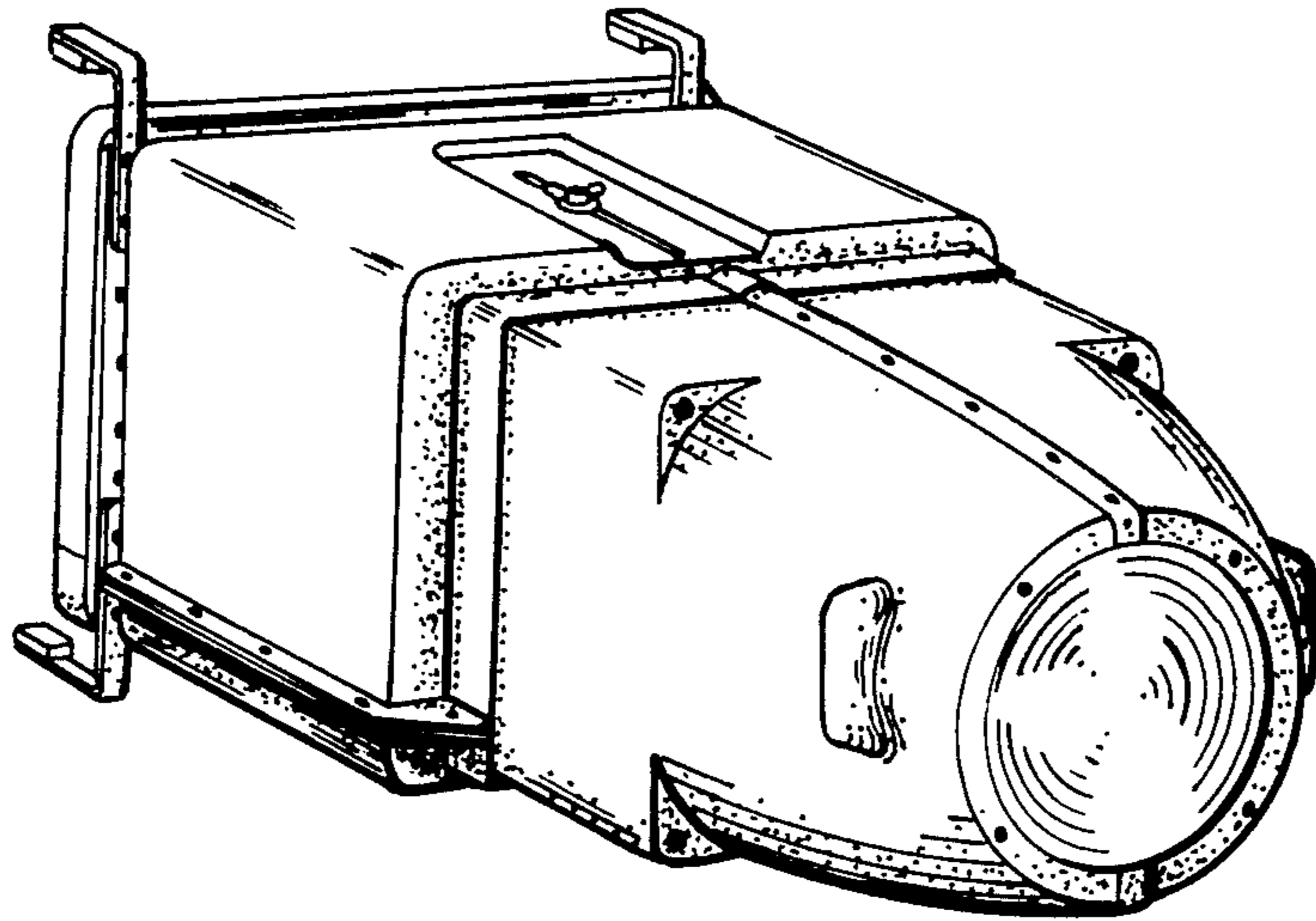

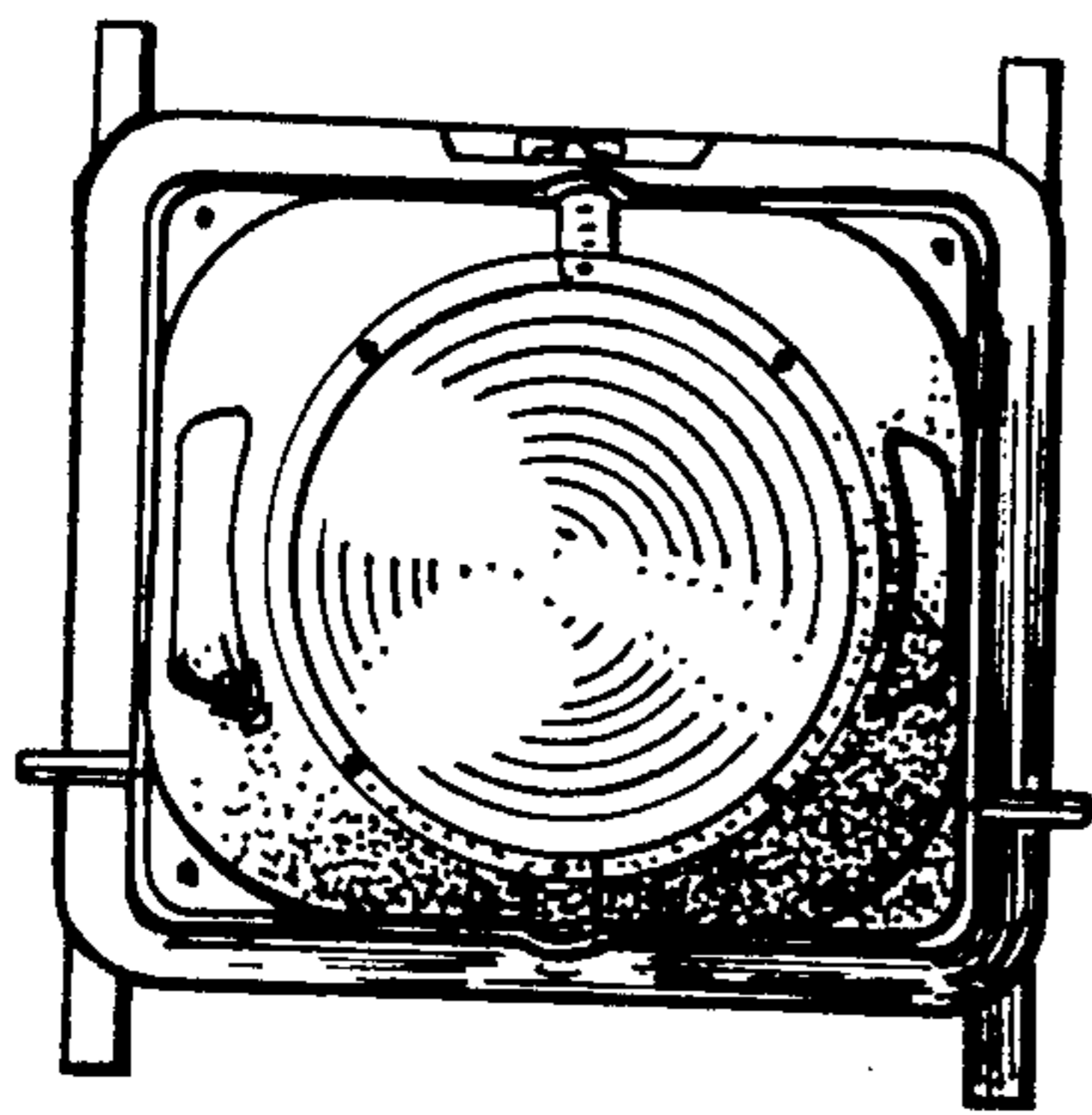

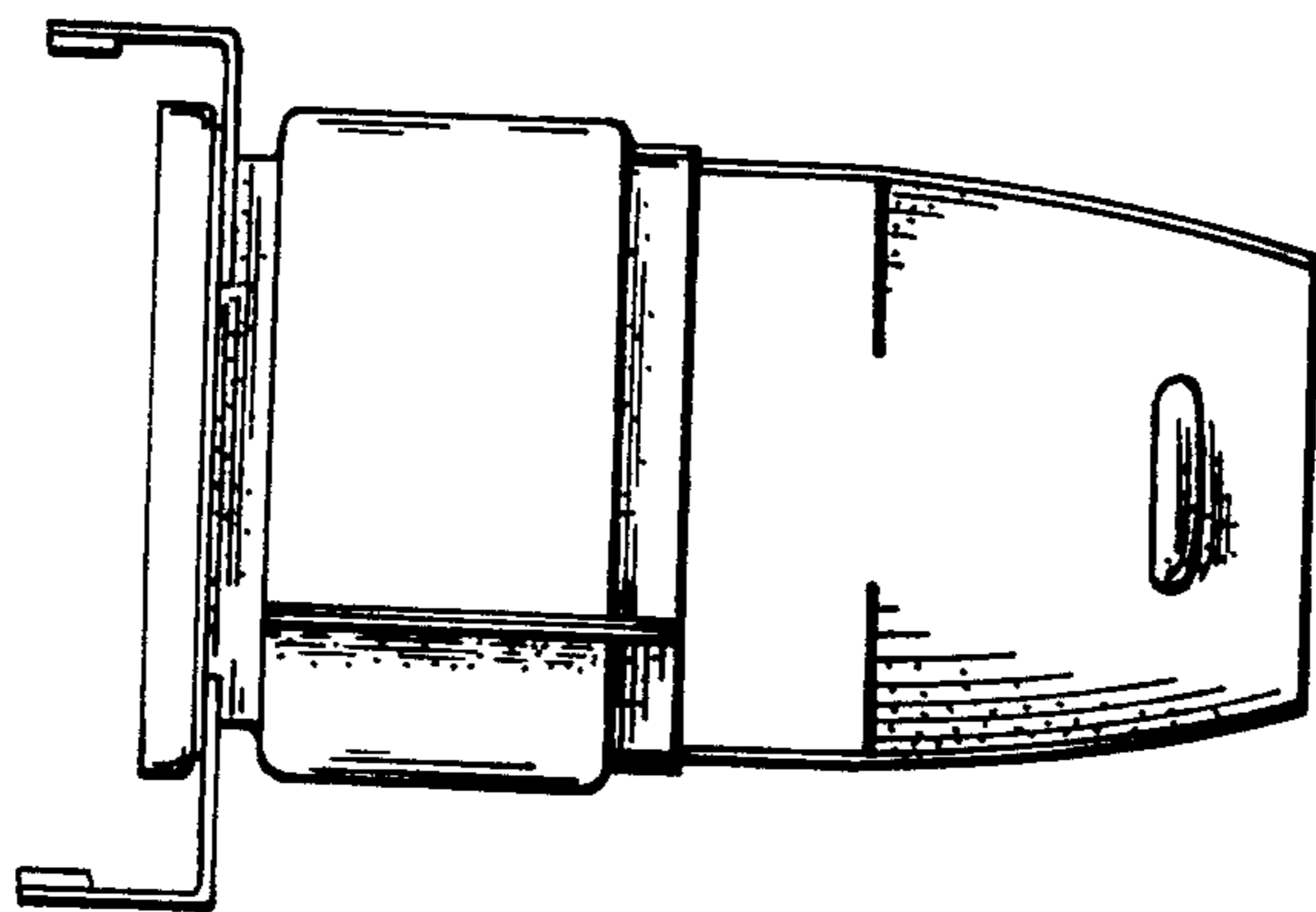

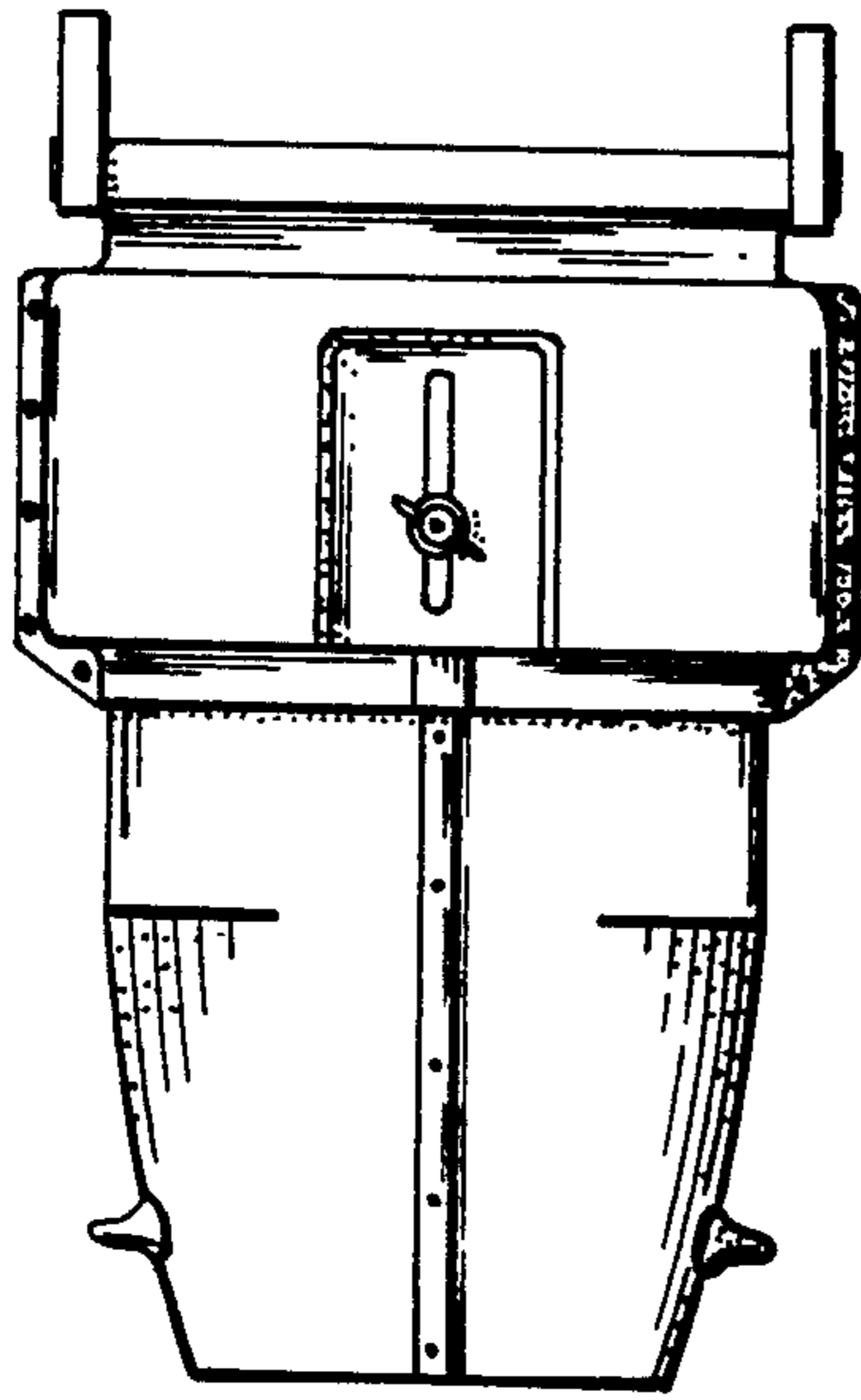

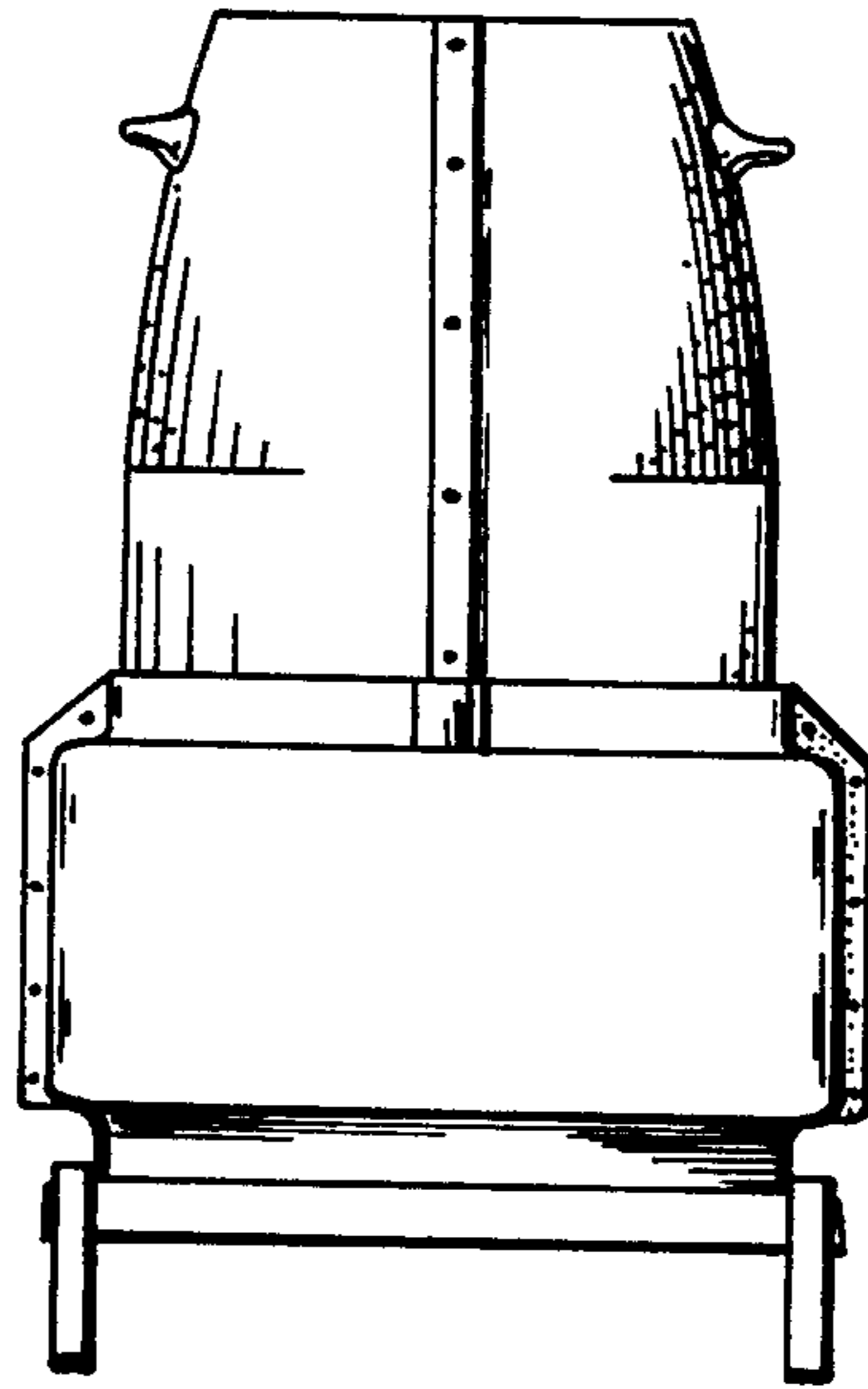

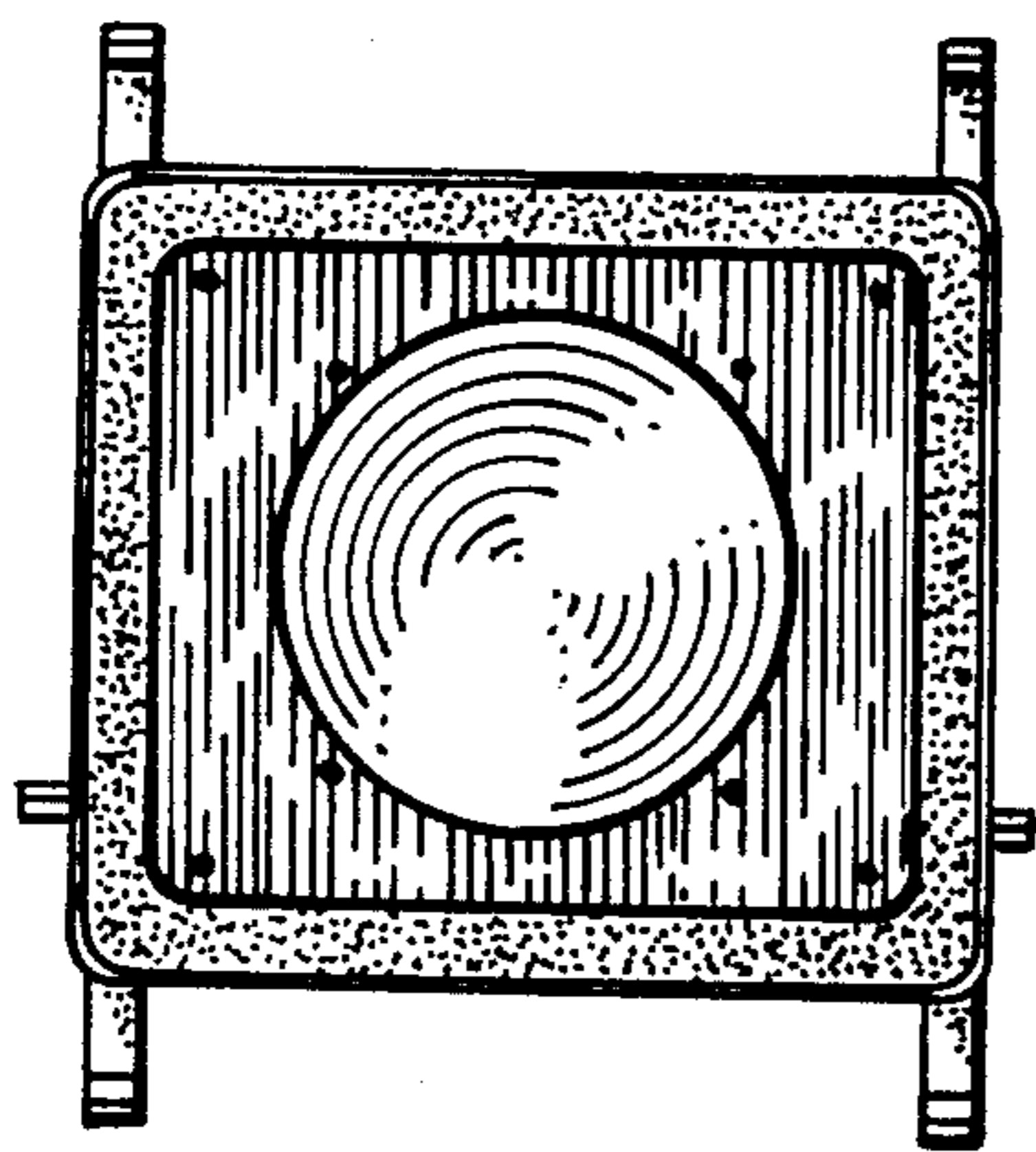
