FIG. 3 is a top edge view thereof.

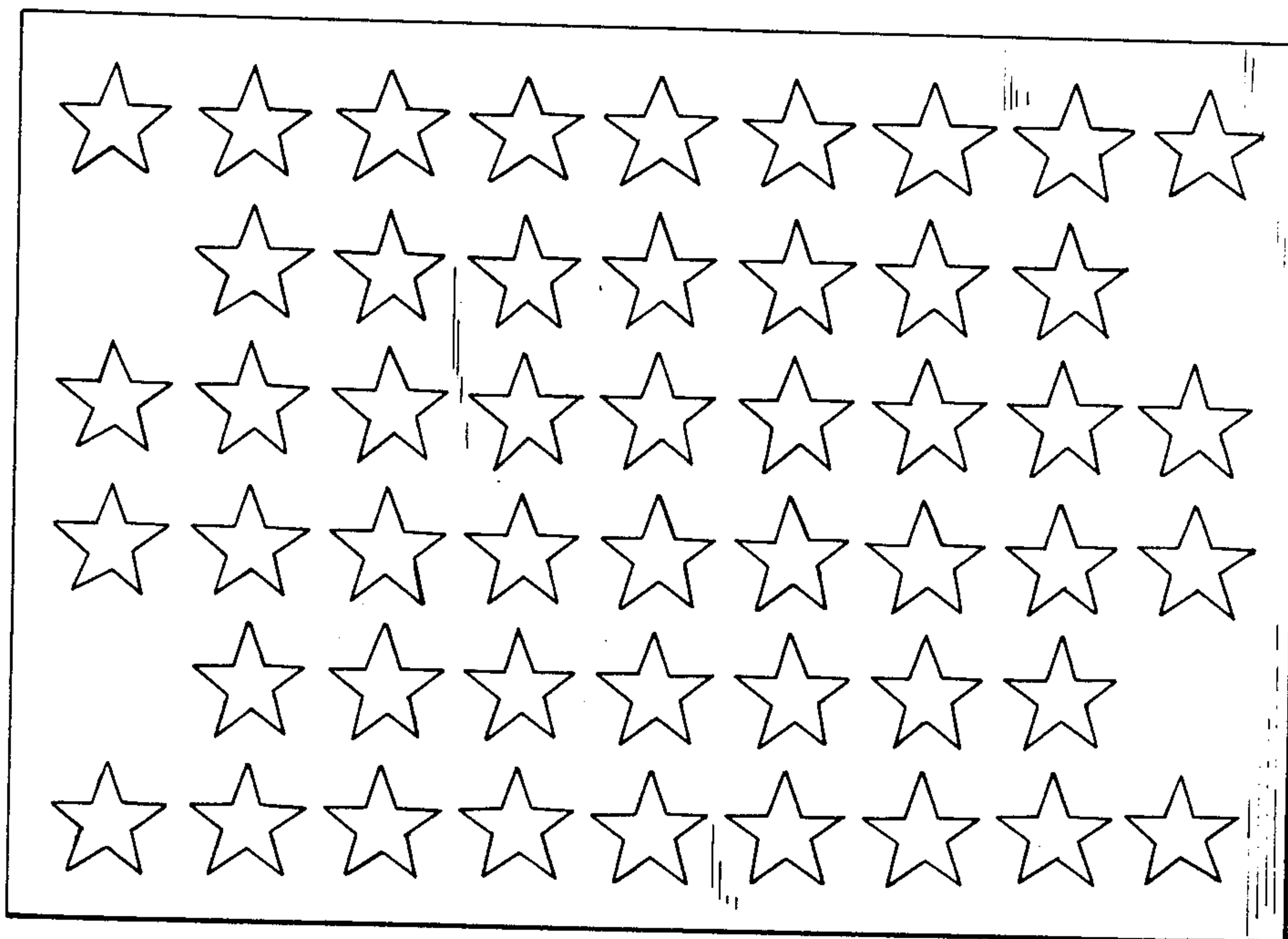

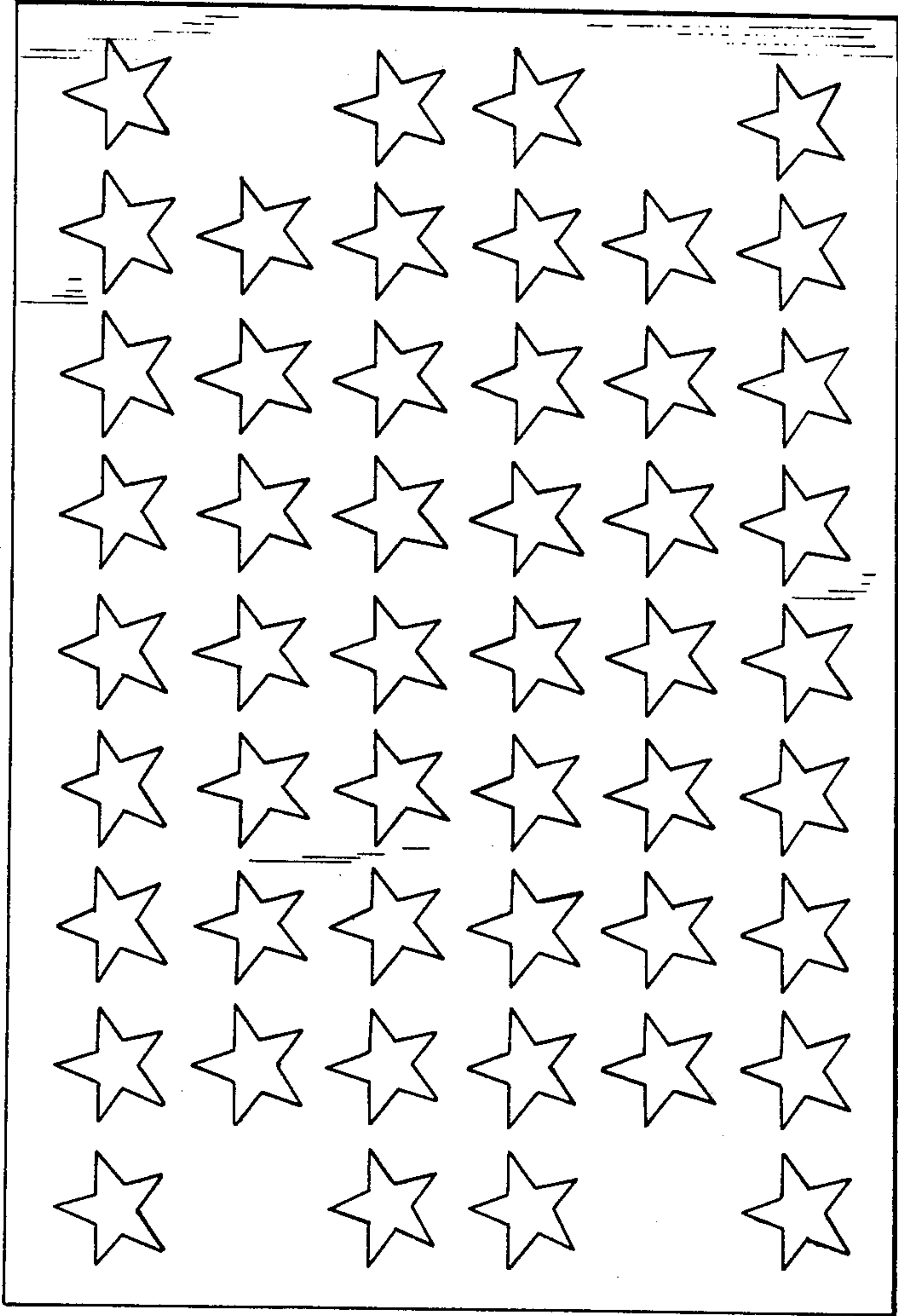

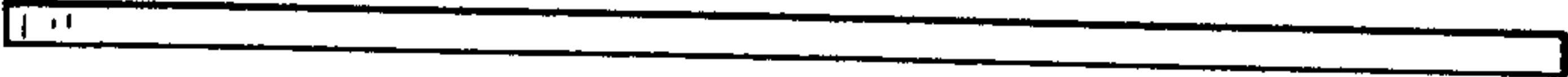
