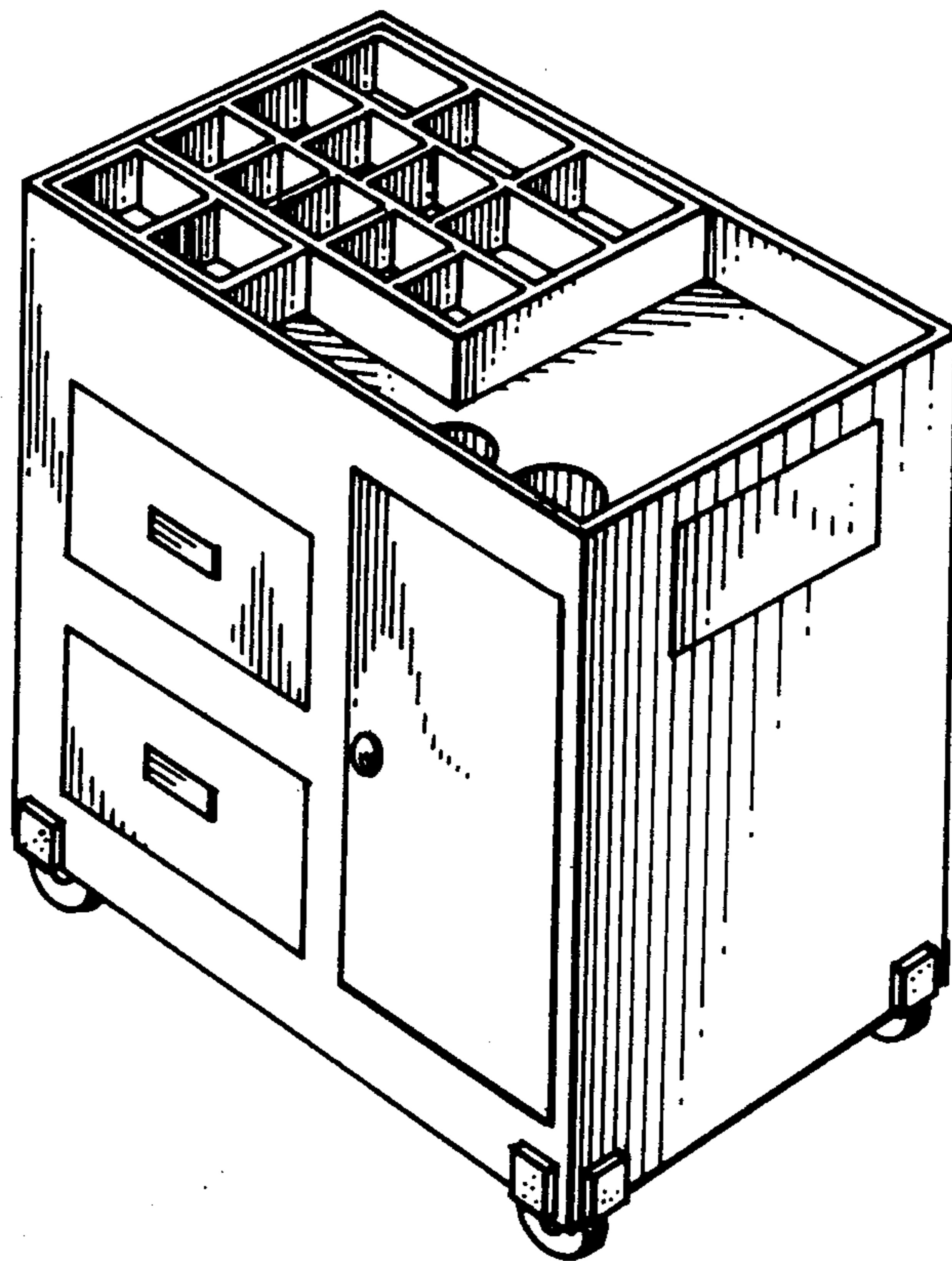

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a blood specimen supply cart, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a blood specimen supply cart showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof illustrating the side not visible in FIGS. 1 and 2; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



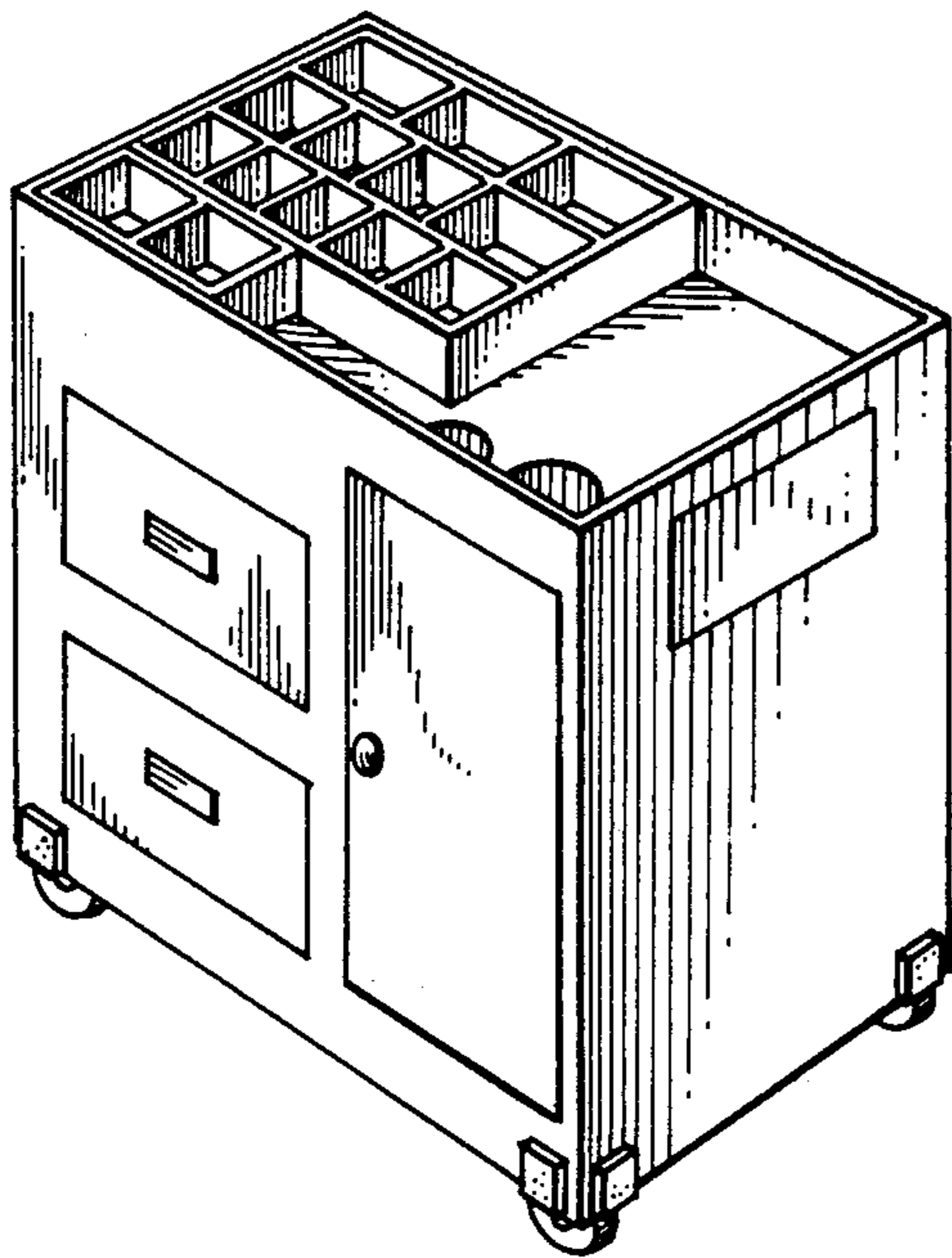

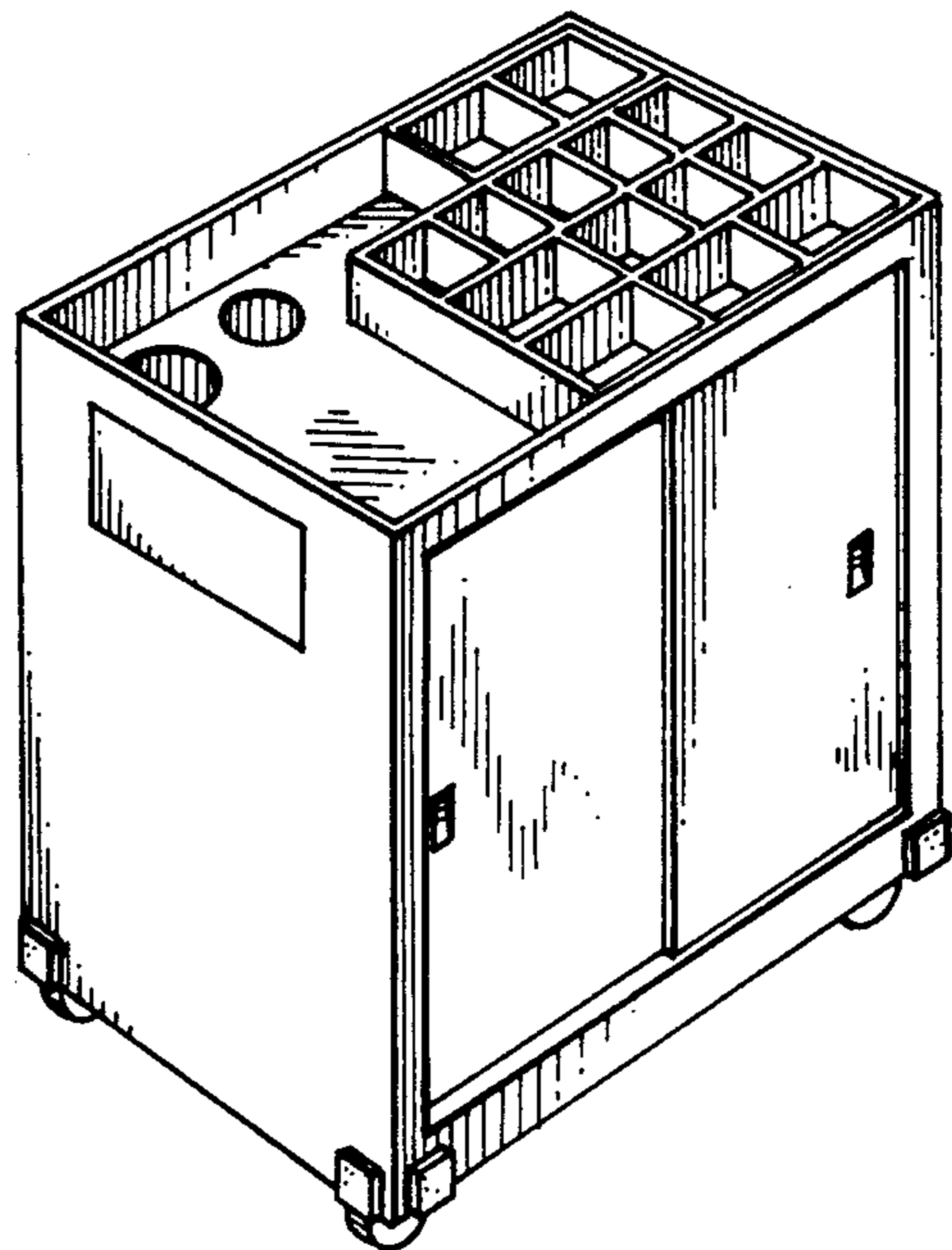

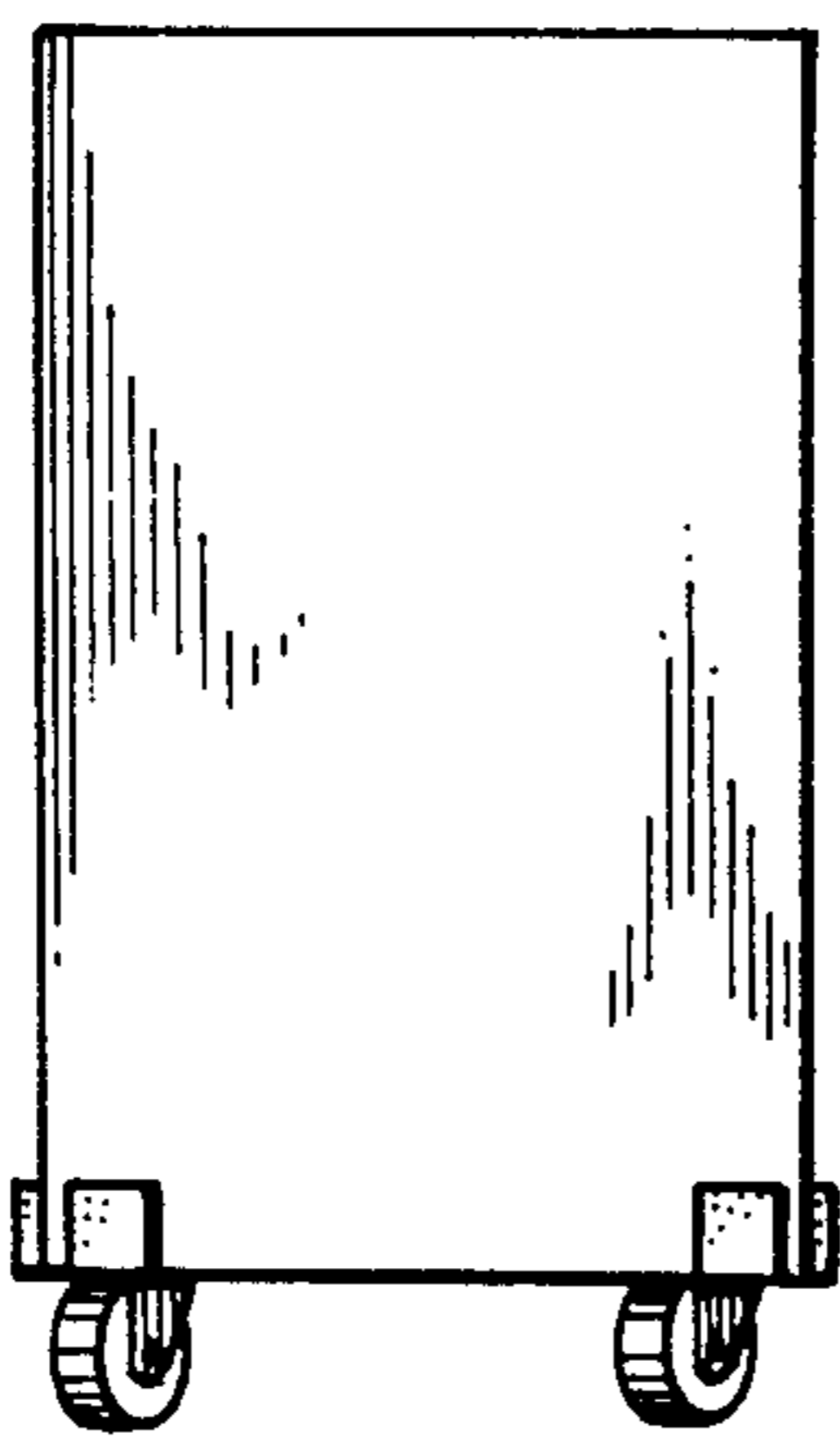

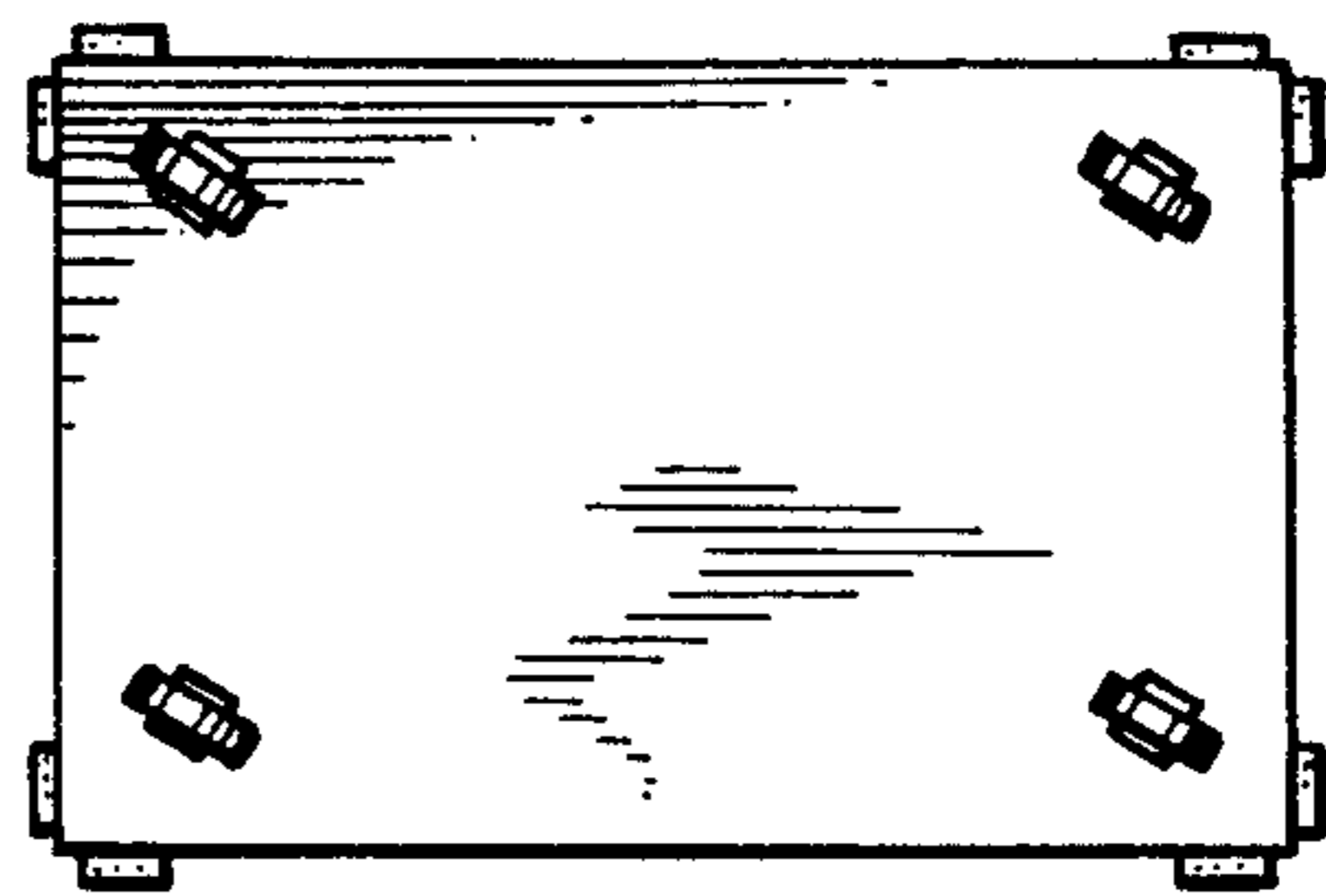
