FIG. 2 is a perspective view from the left rear thereof;

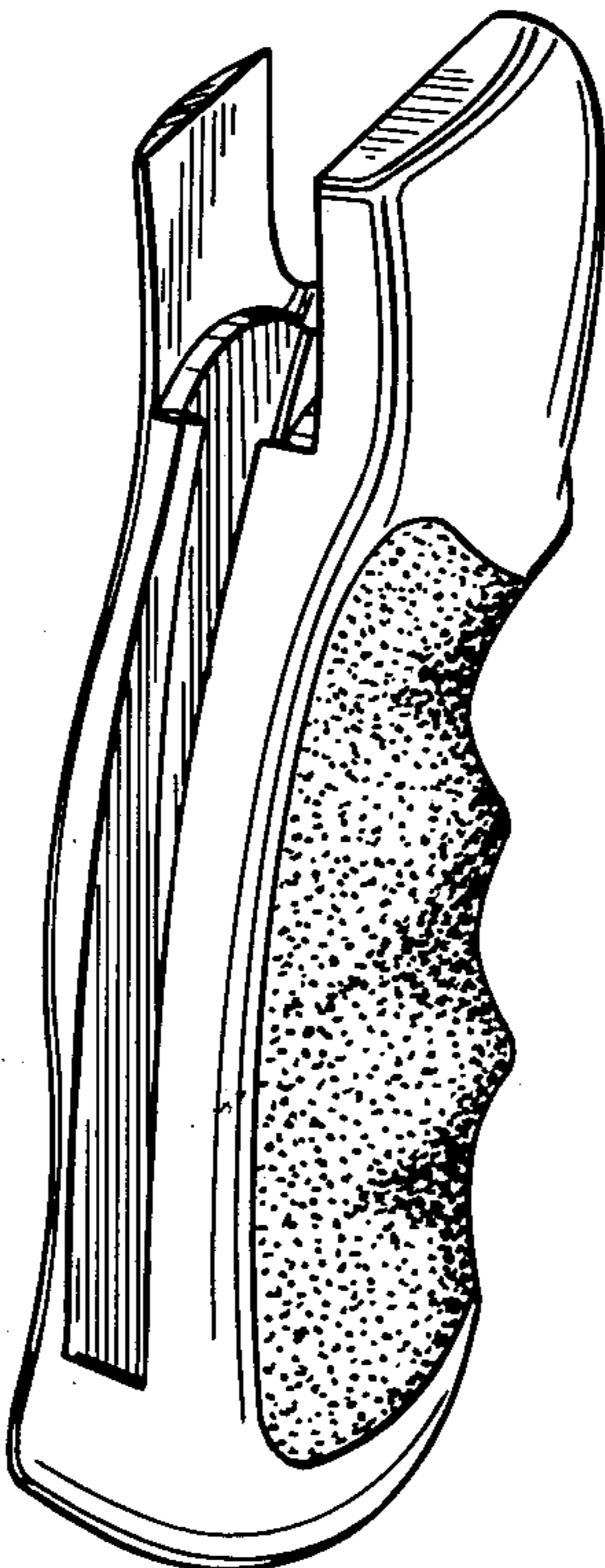
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

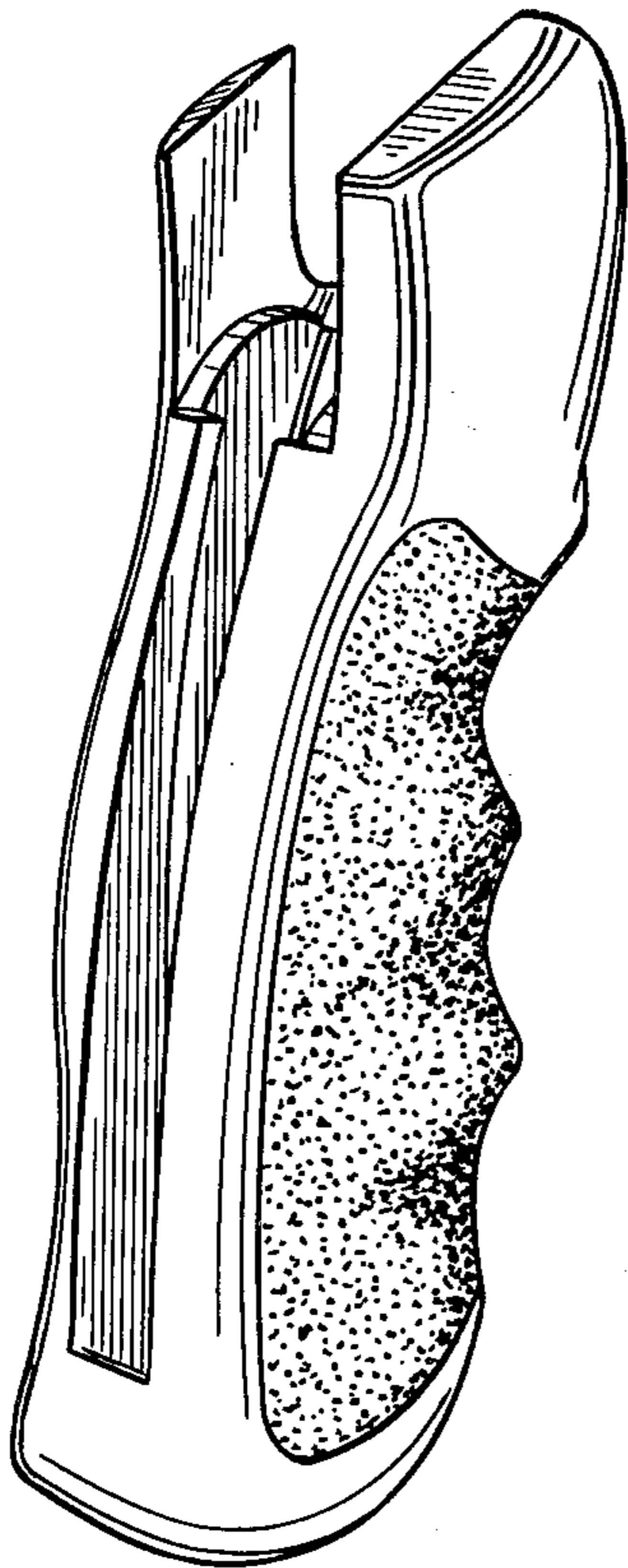

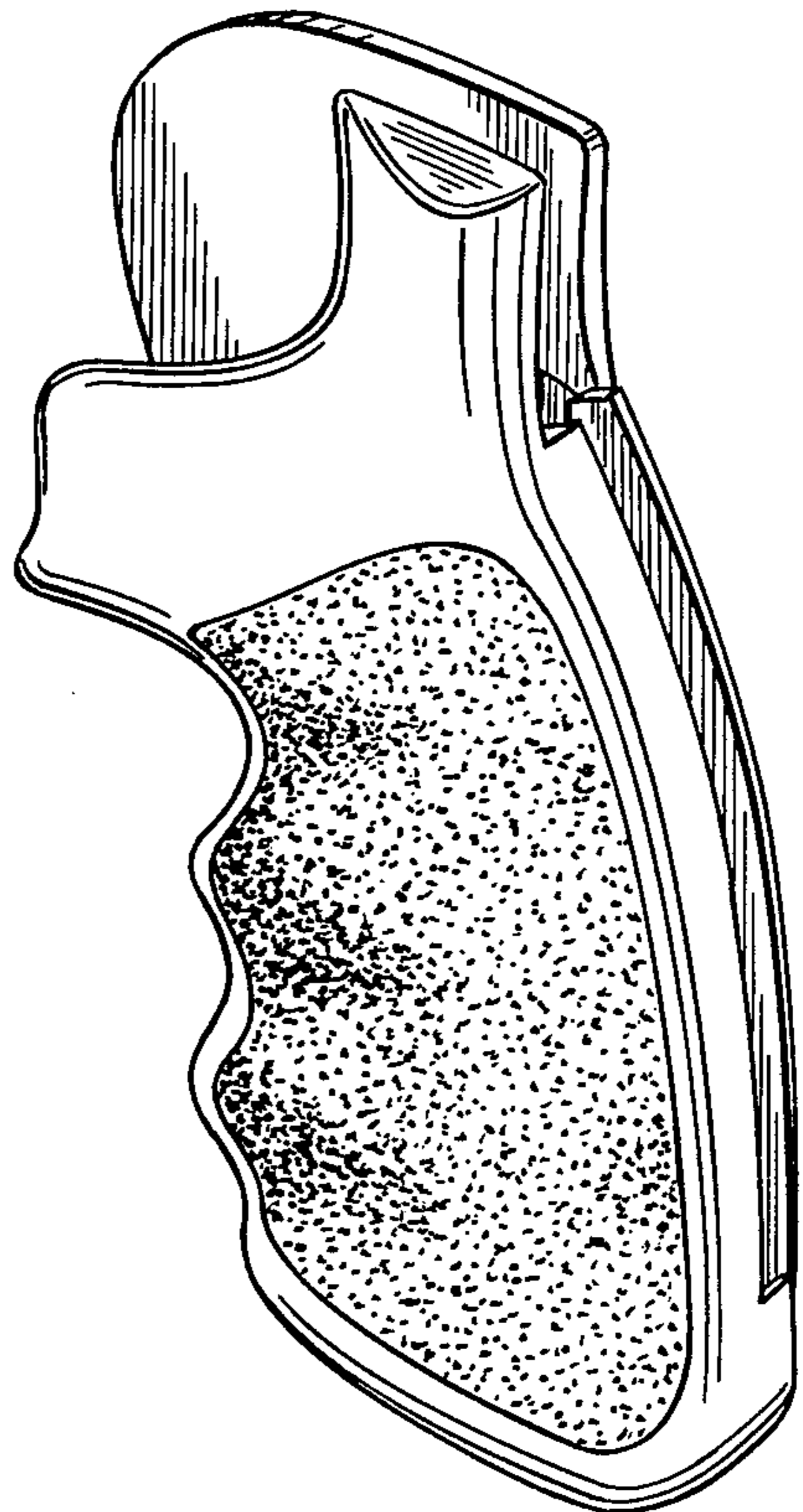

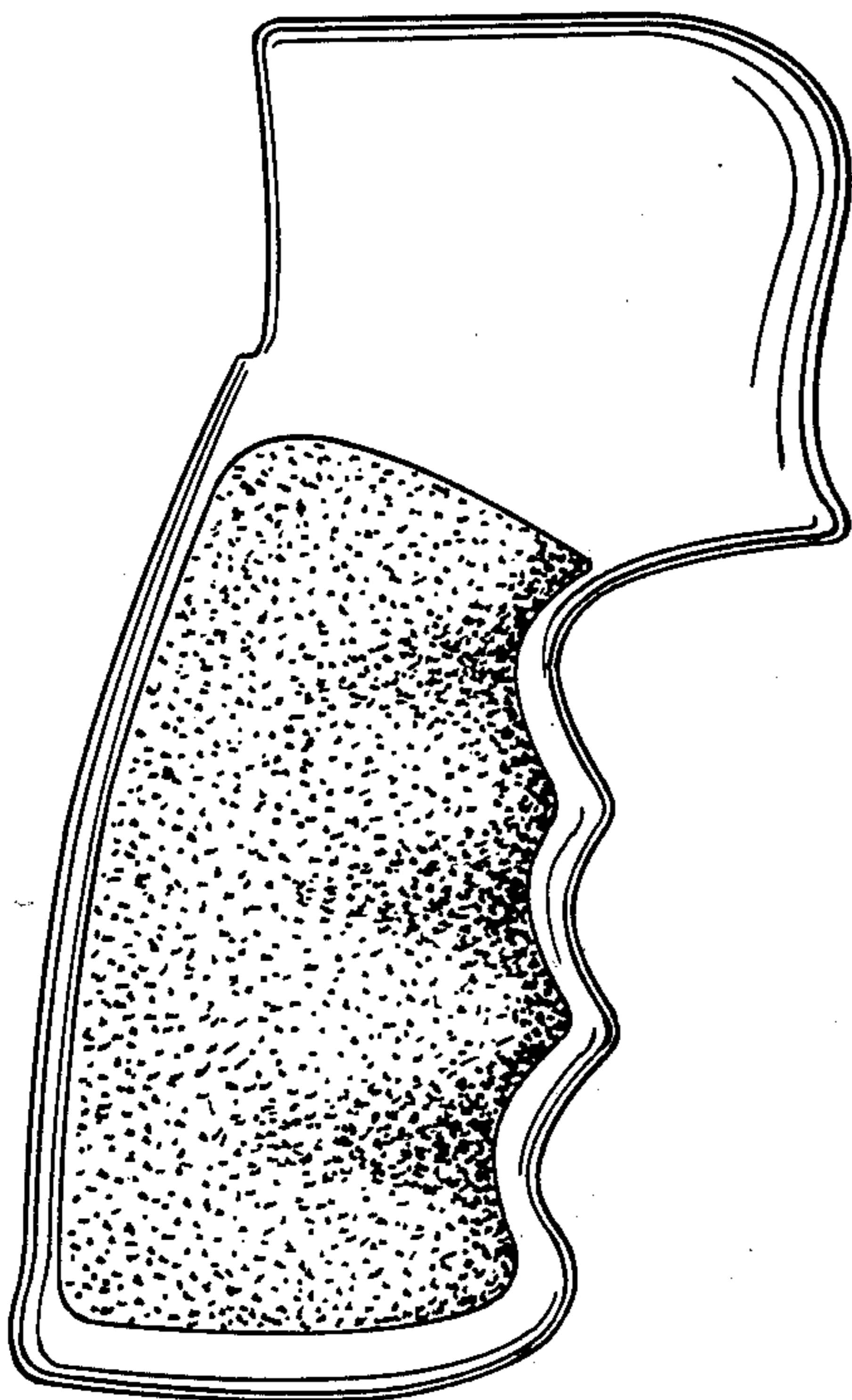

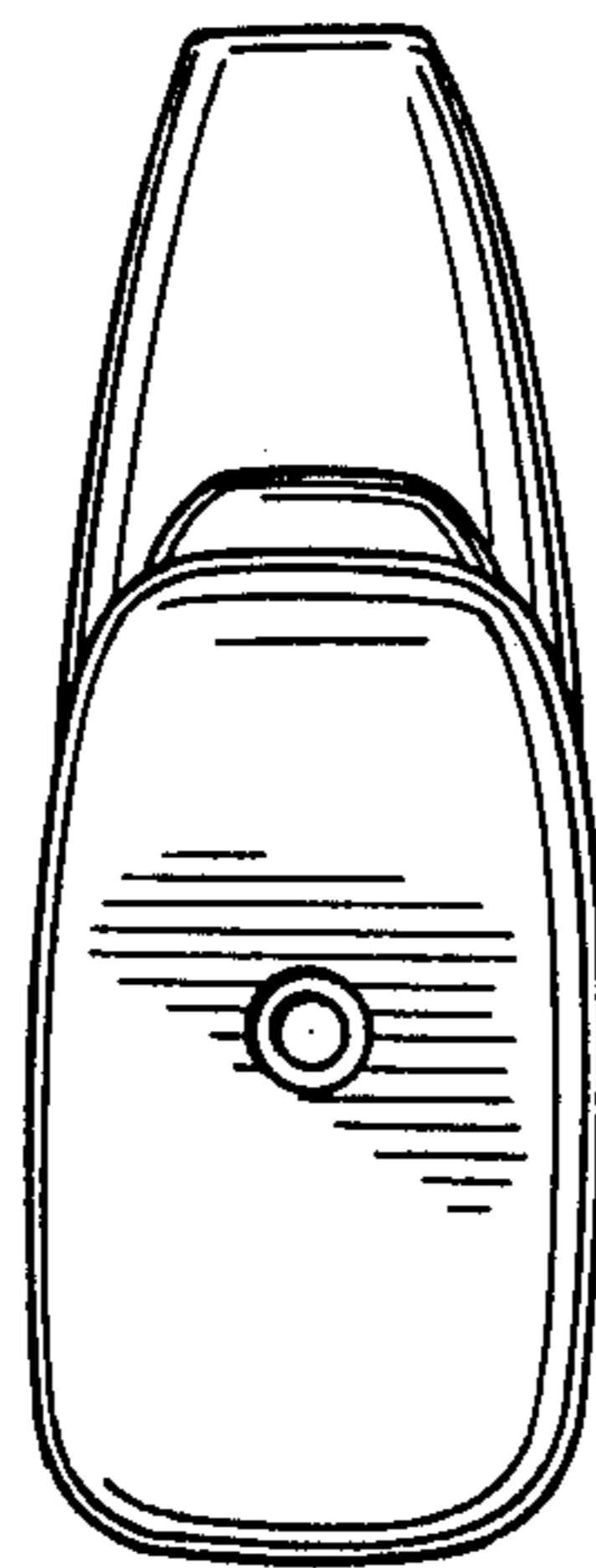

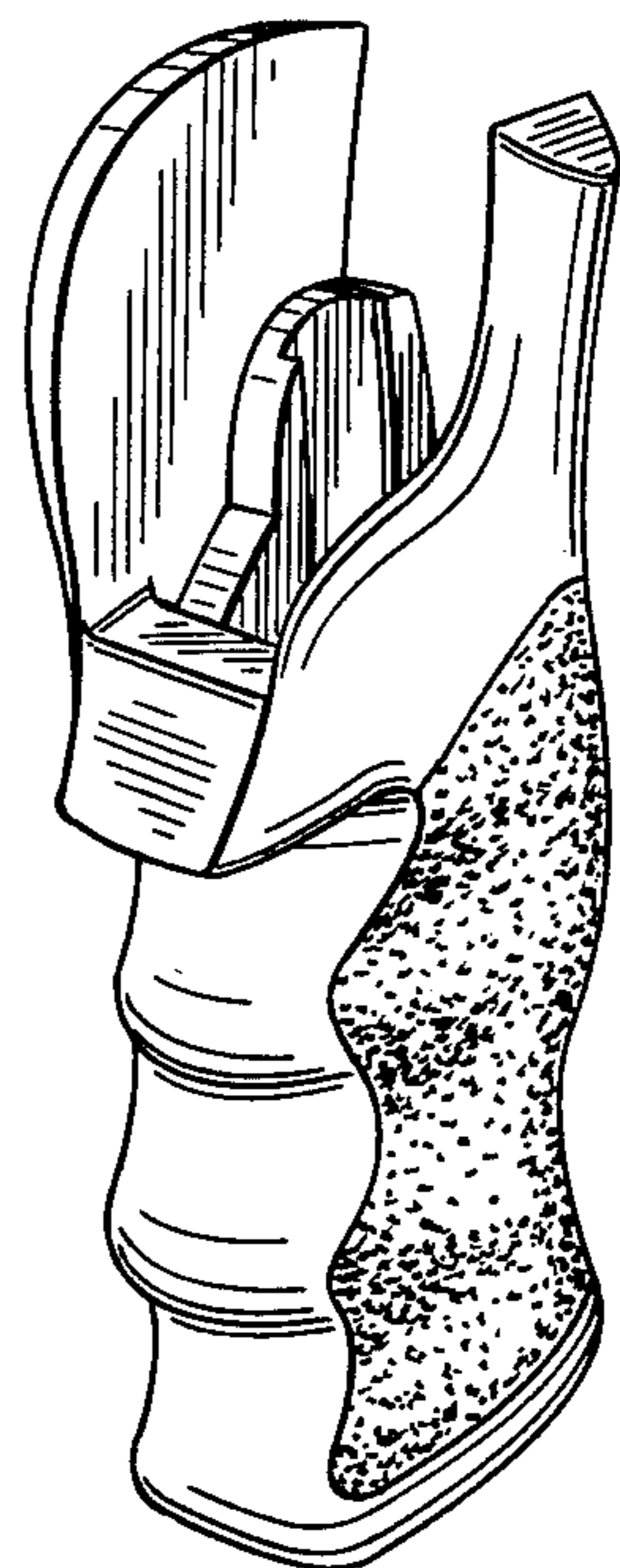
