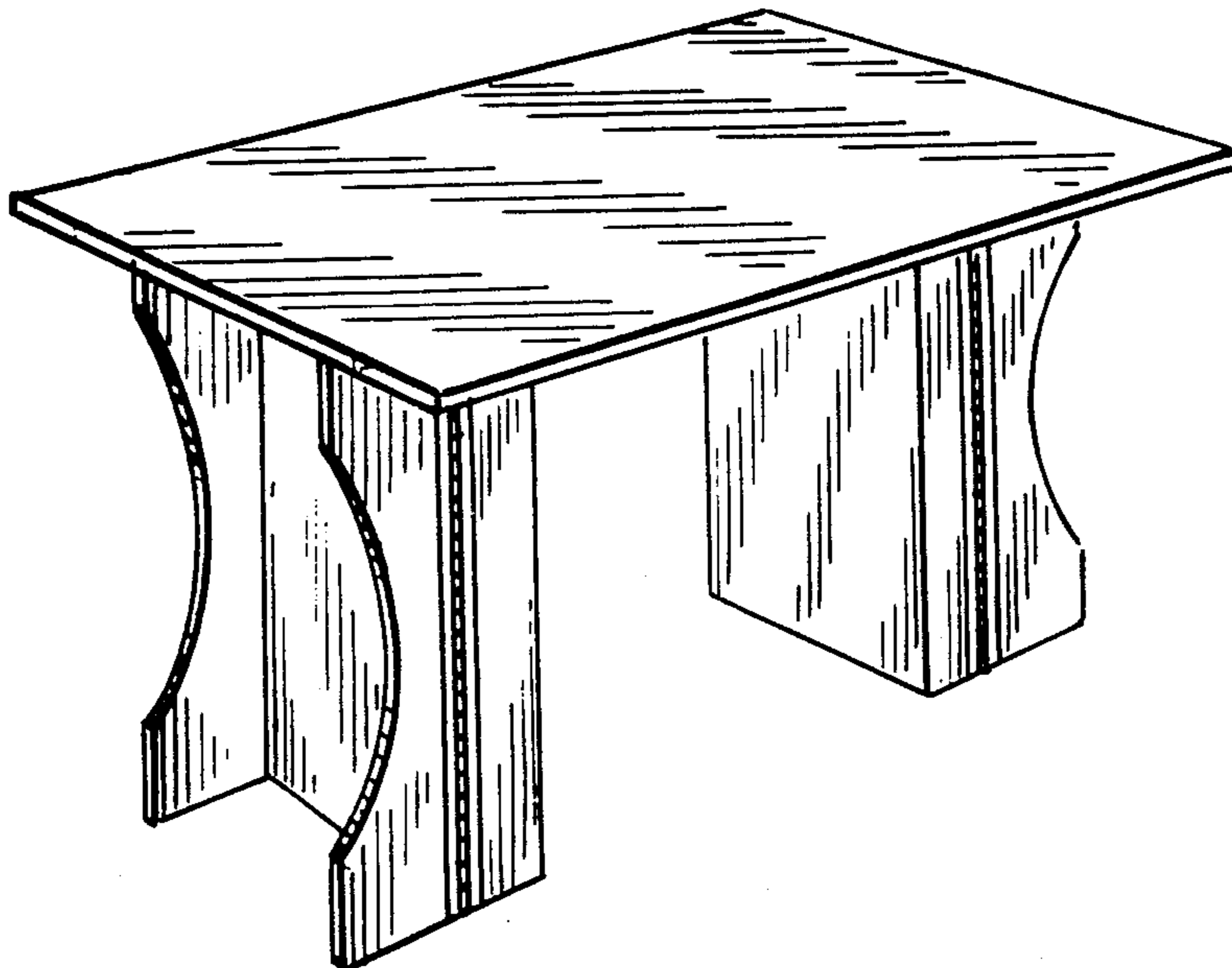

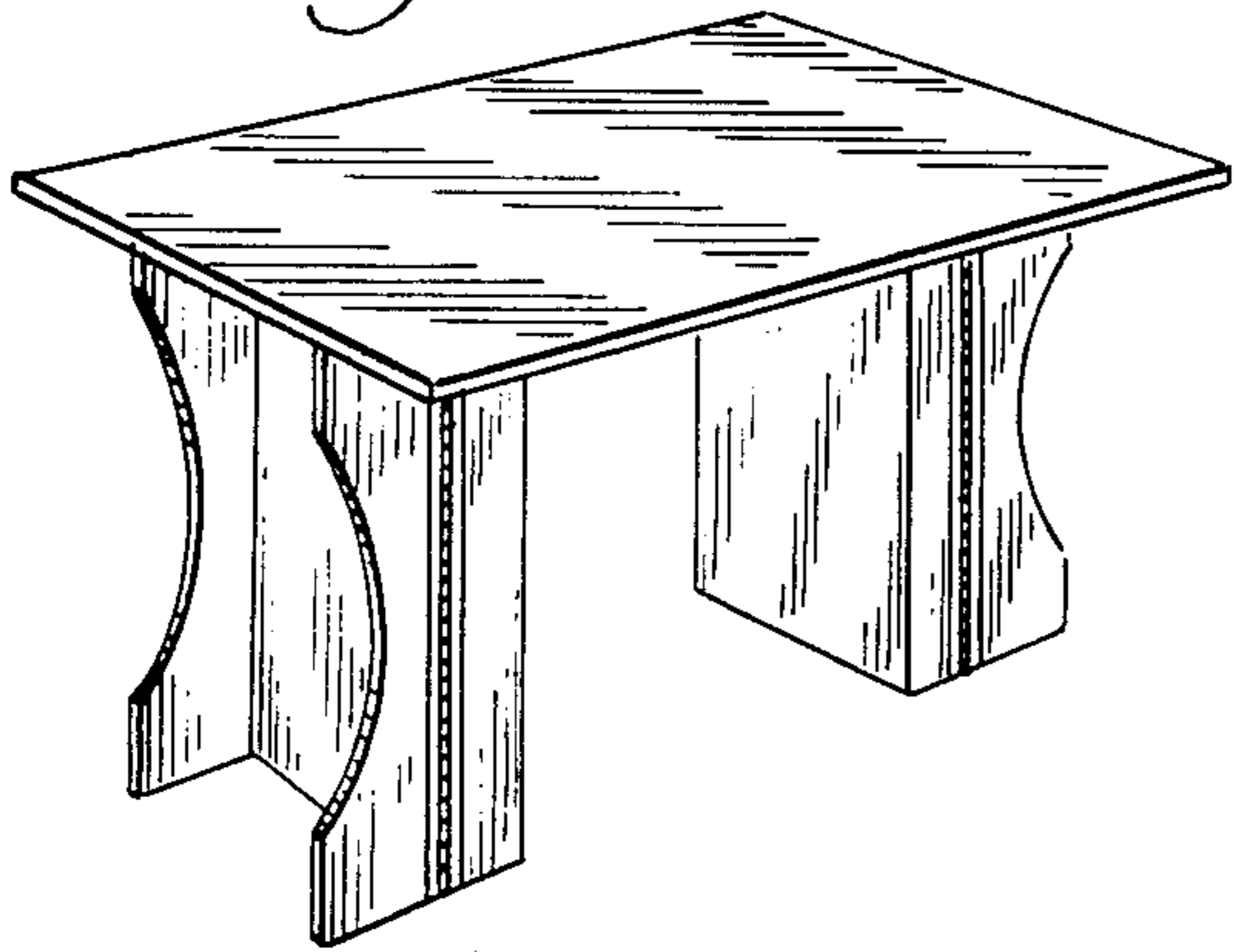
The ornamental design for a table having pivotal panels, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

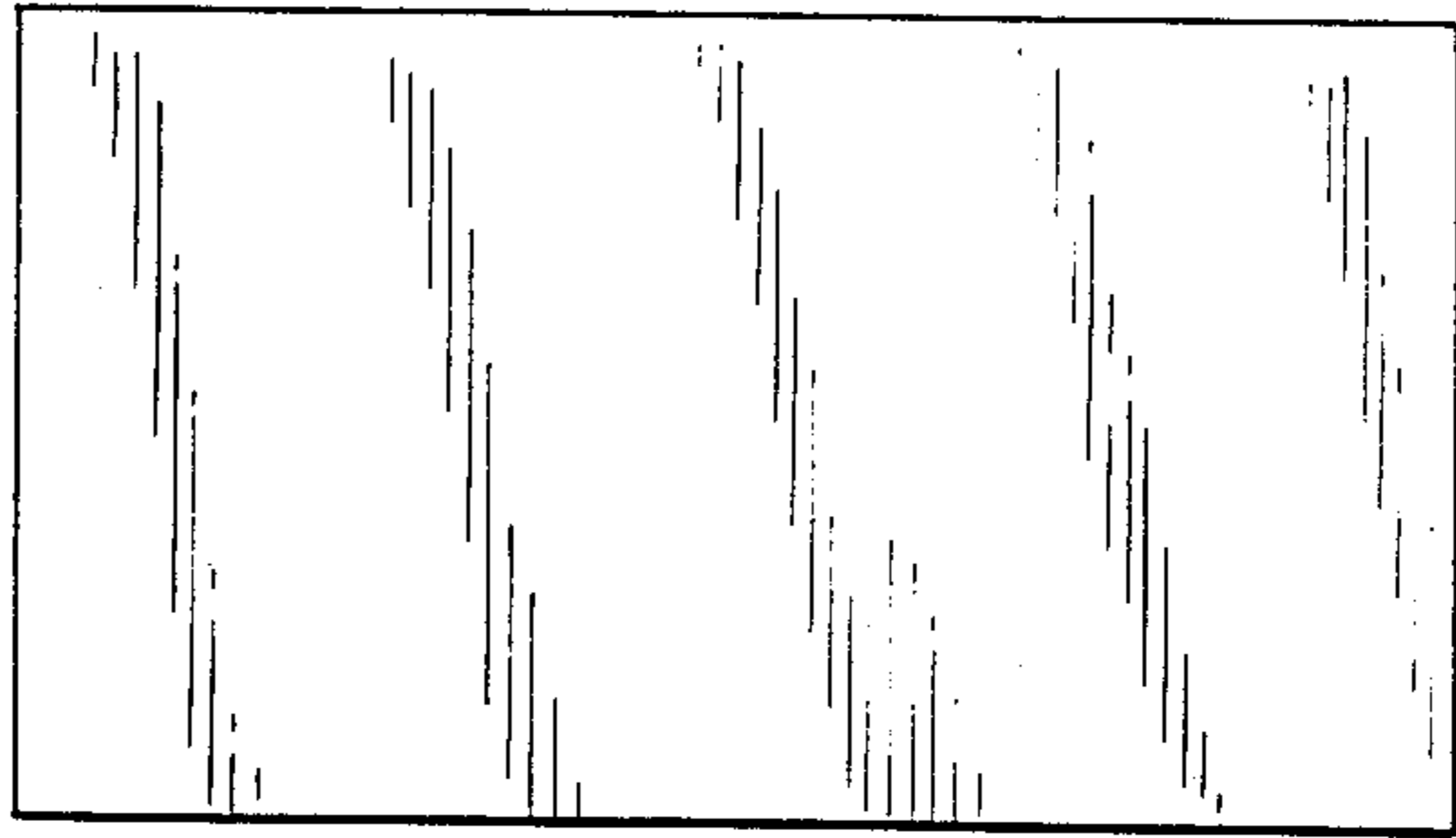
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the preferred embodiment of the invention;

 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of a second alternative embodiment of the invention.



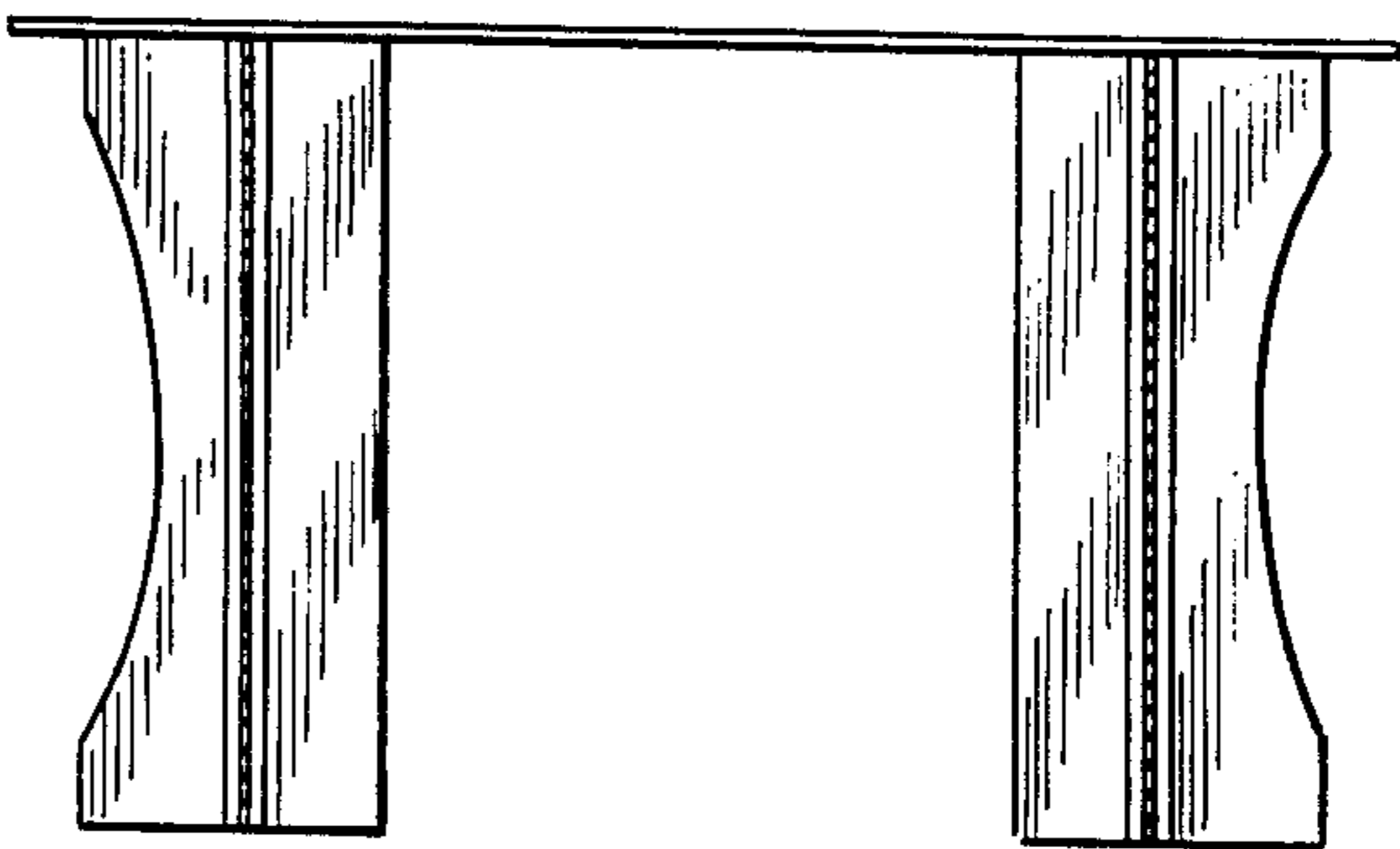

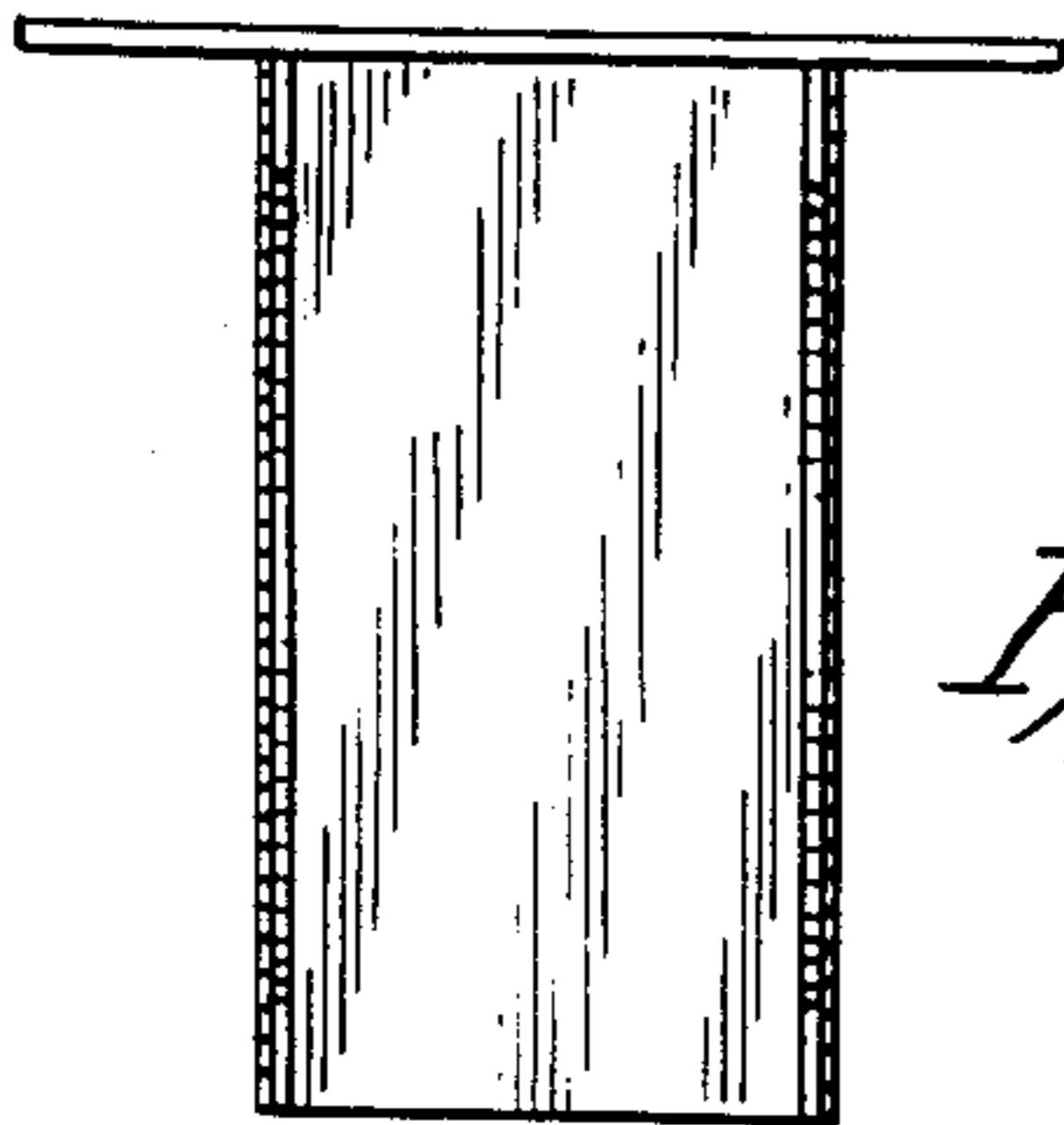

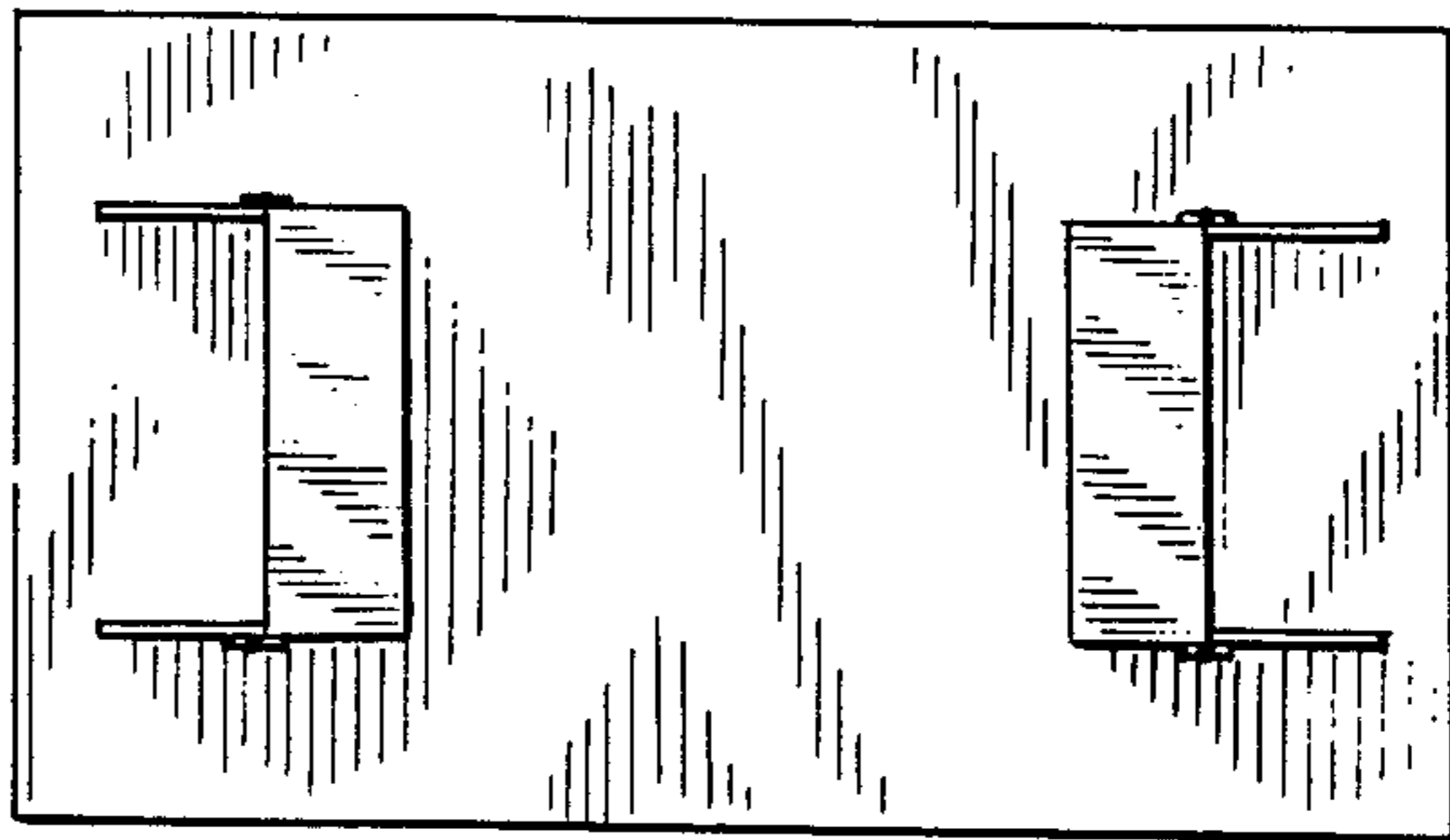

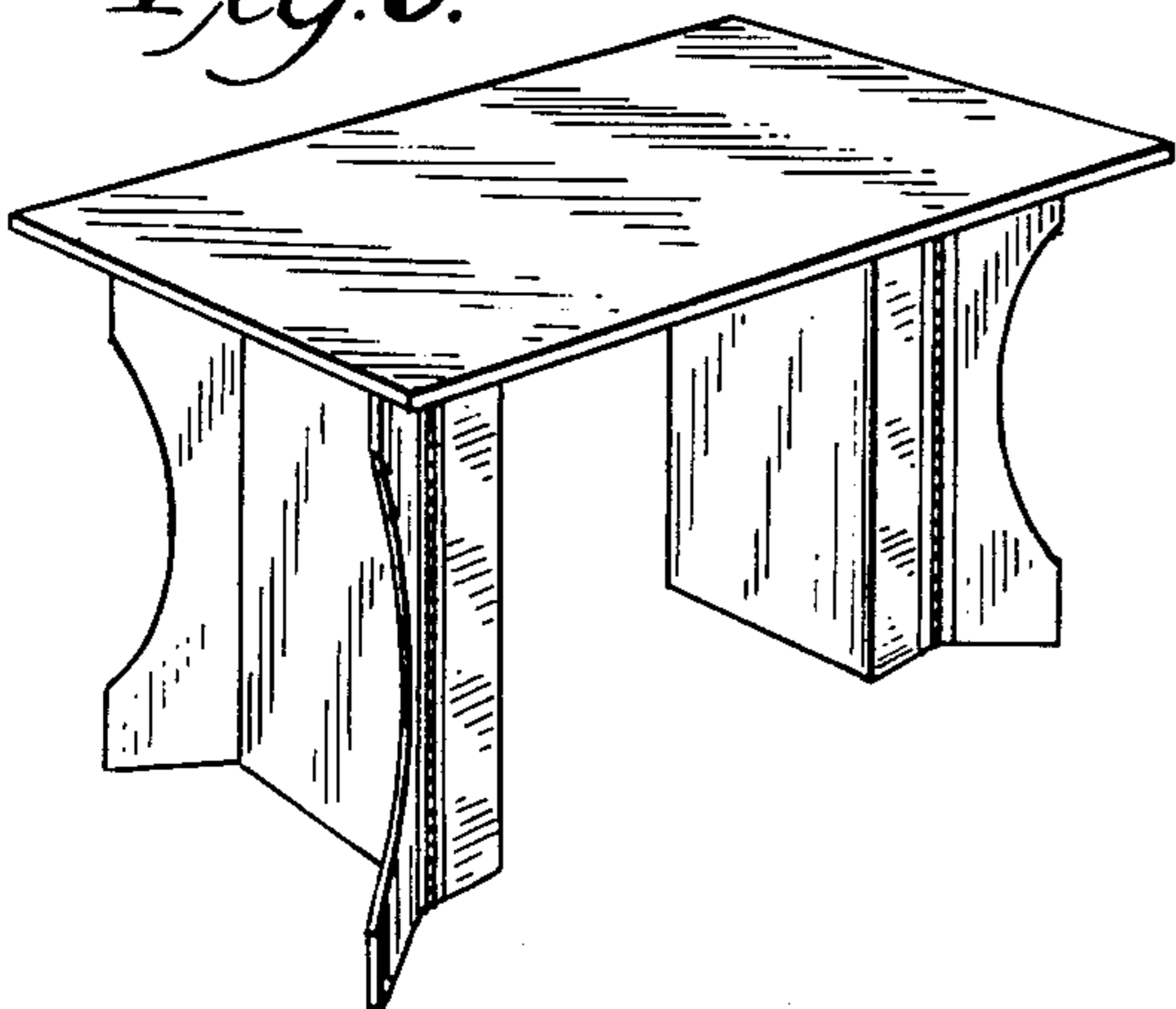

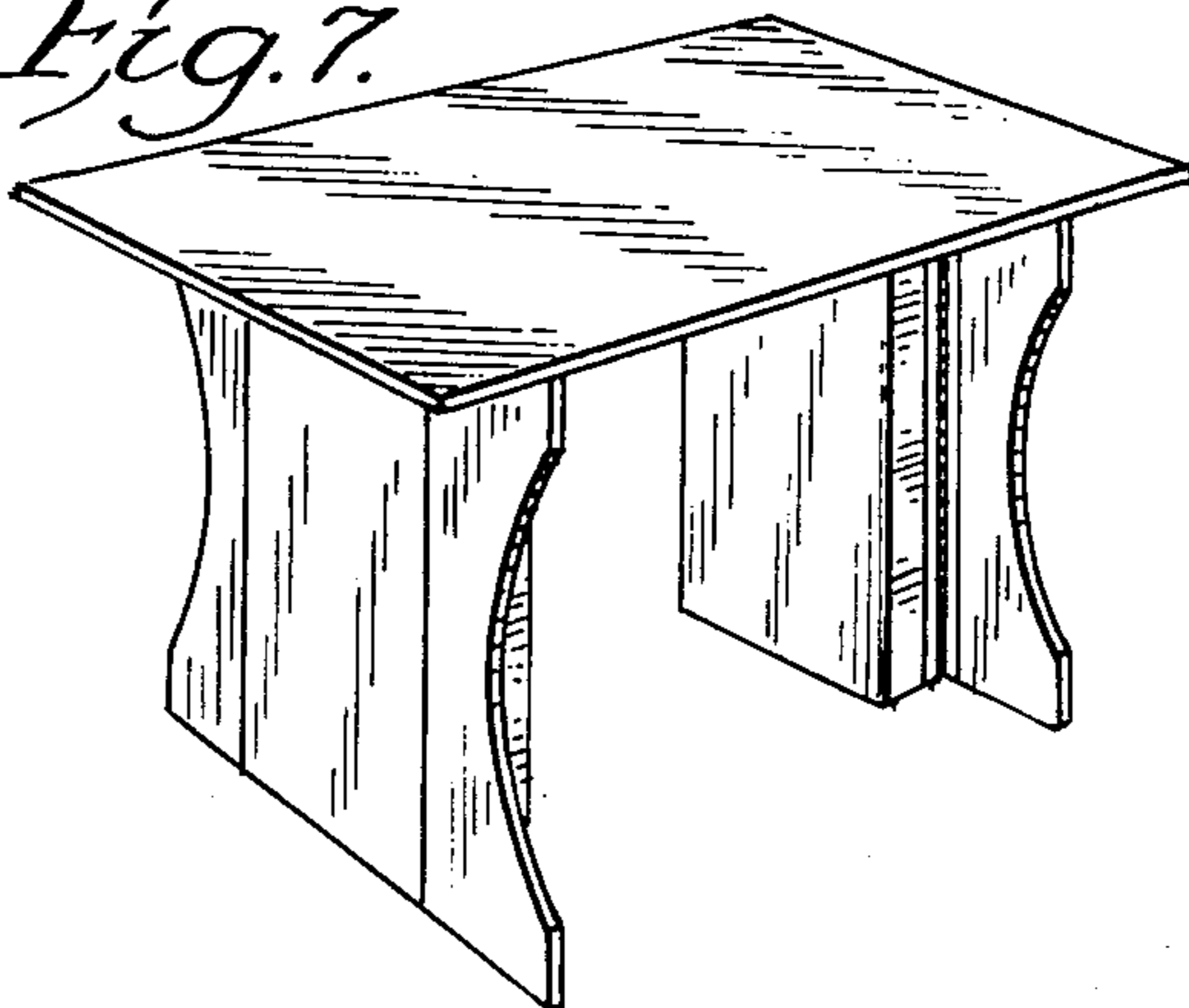

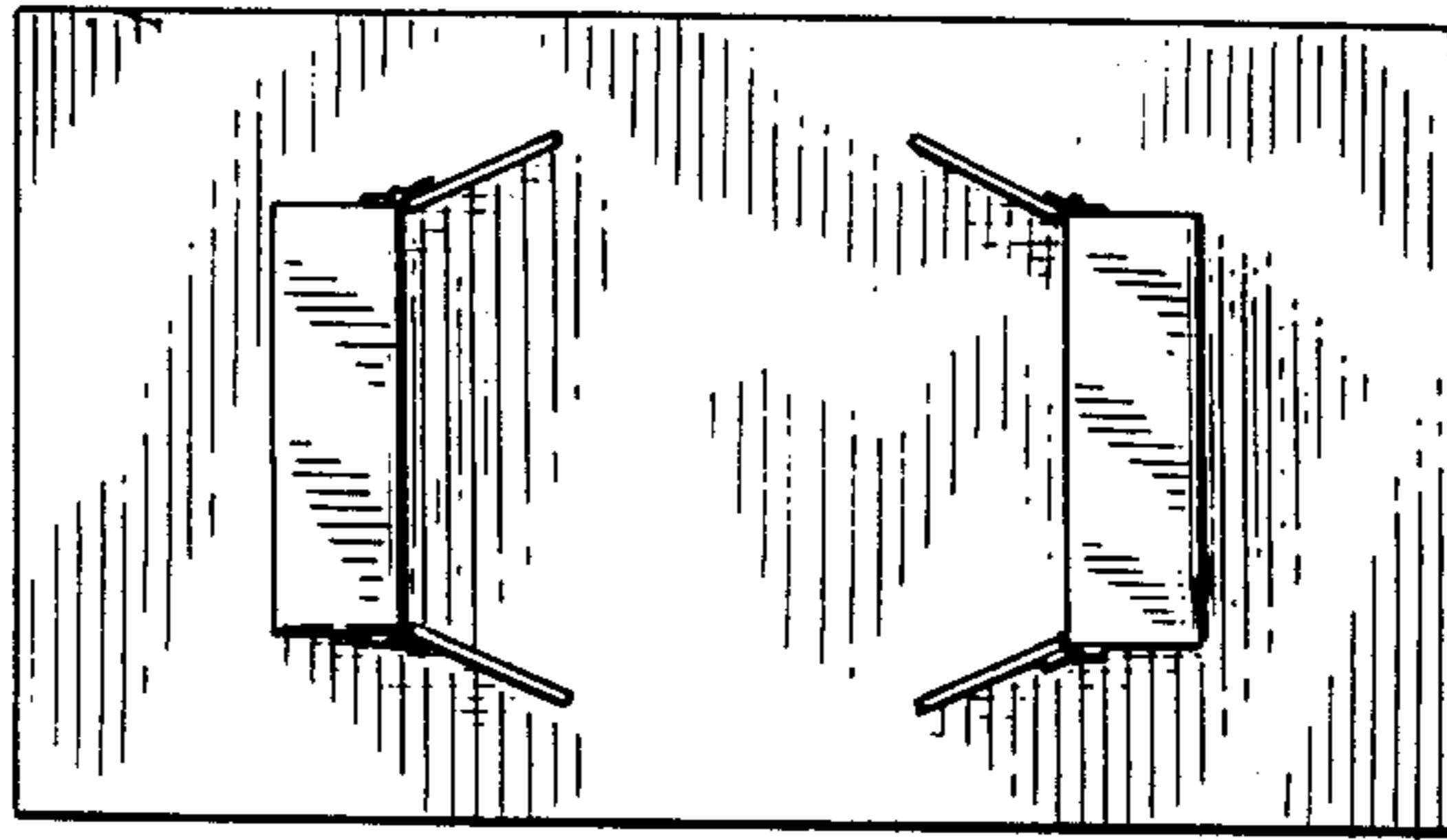

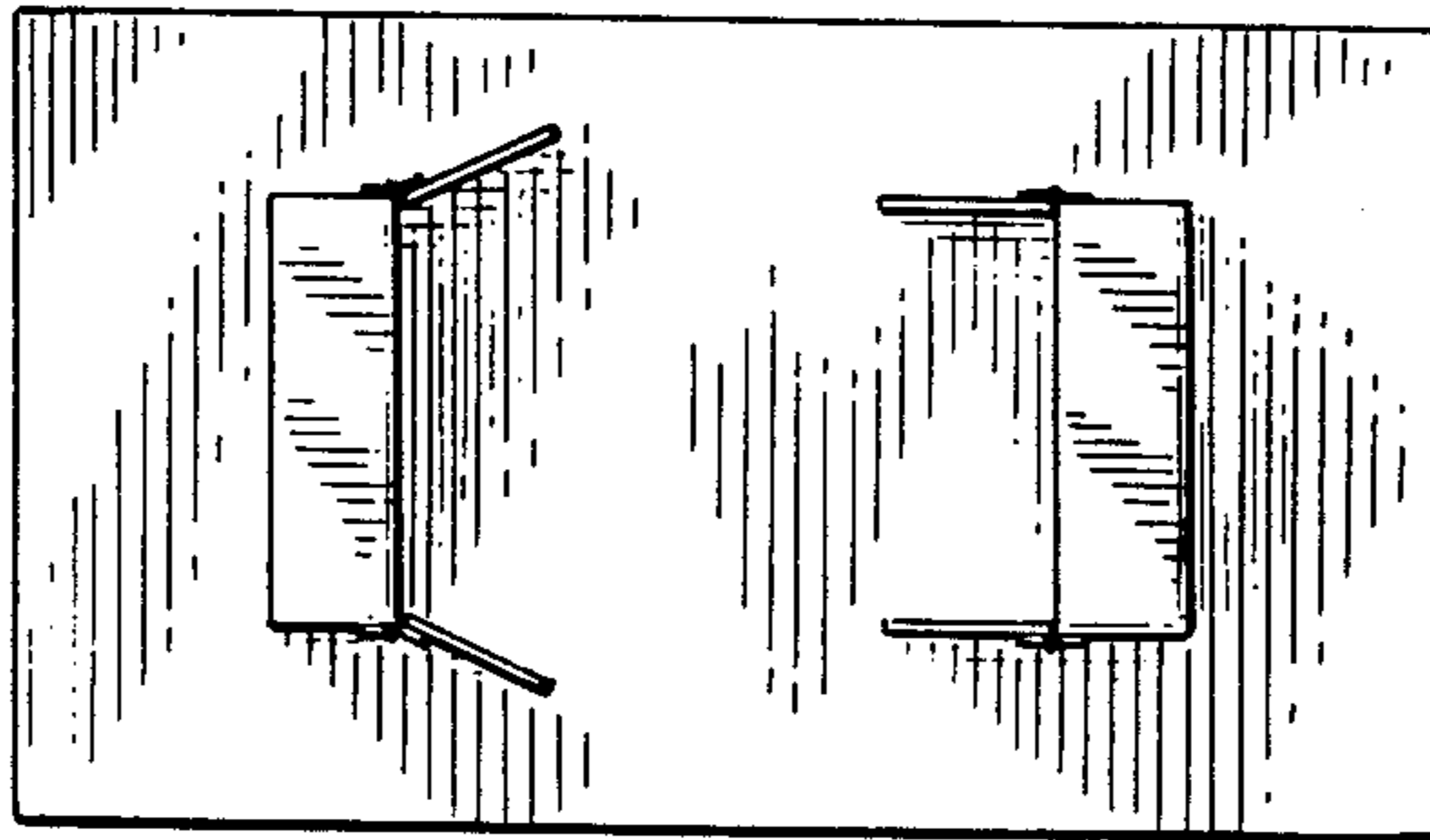
