The ornamental design for a table having pivotal panels, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the preferred embodiment of the invention;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the preferred embodiment;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the preferred embodiment;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the preferred embodiment;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the preferred embodiment;
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the invention with the table leg panels in a different position;
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the invention with the table leg panels in a different positions;
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of a first alternative embodiment of the invention;
 FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the first alternative embodiment of the invention with the table leg panels in a different position; and
 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of a second alternative embodiment of the invention.

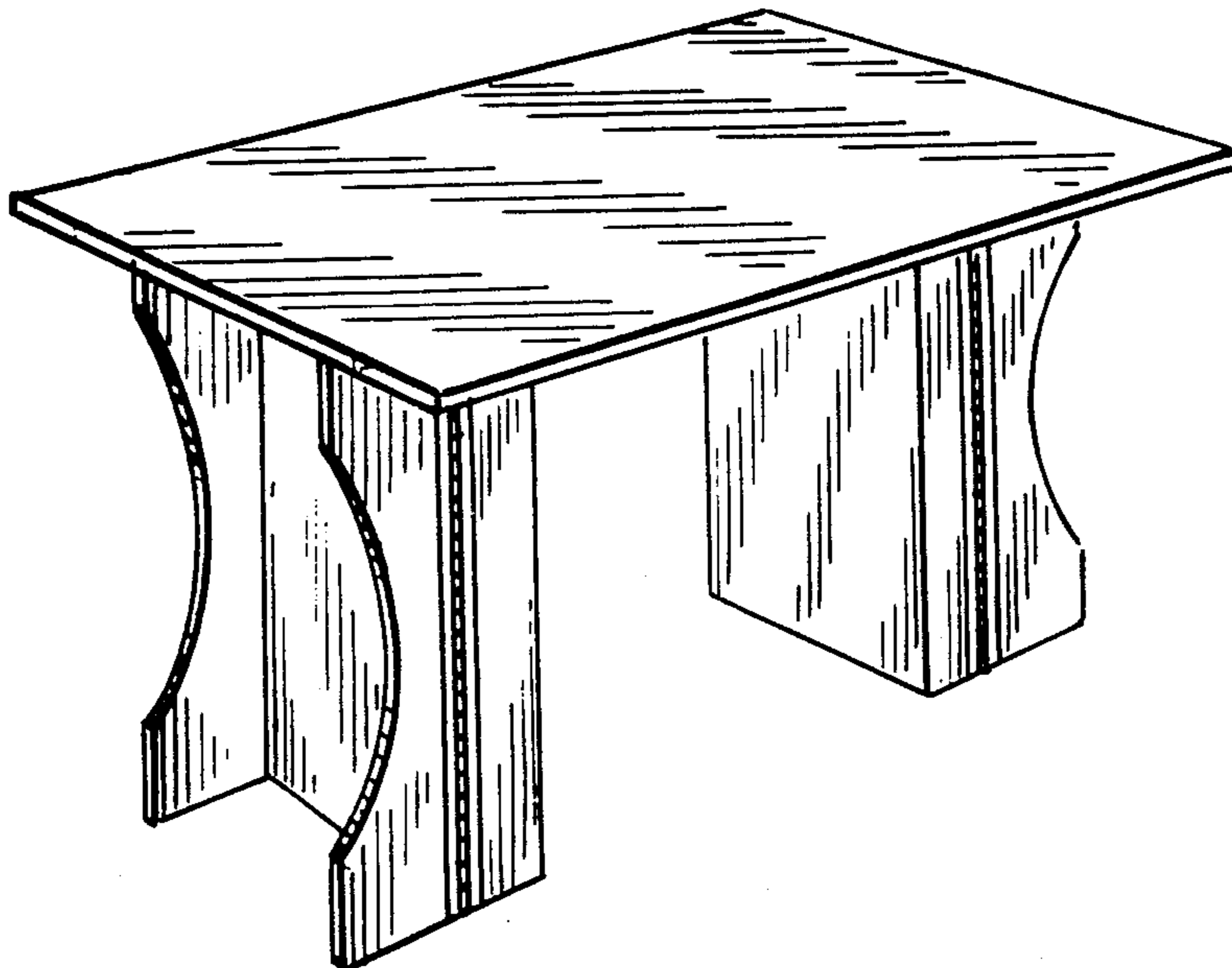

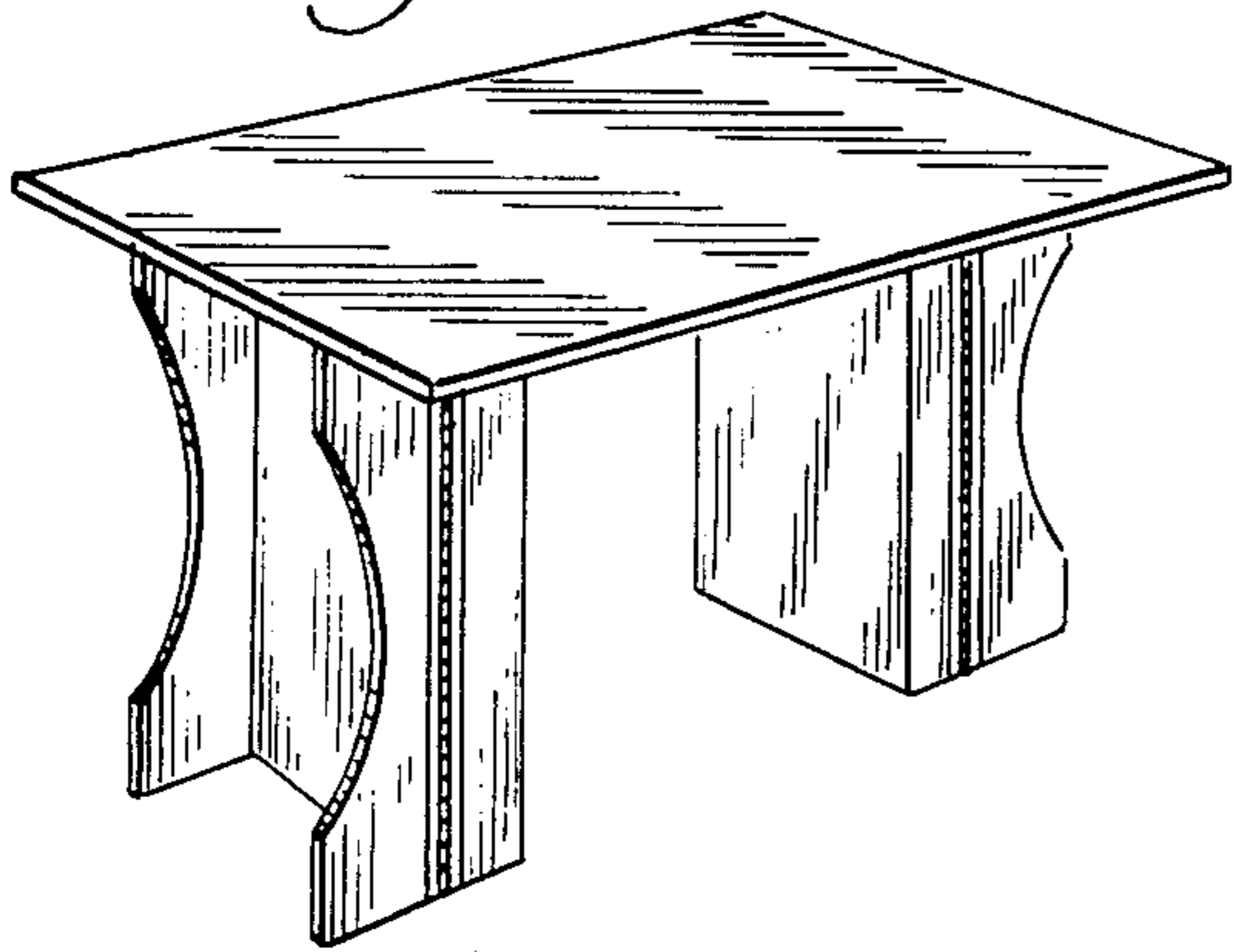

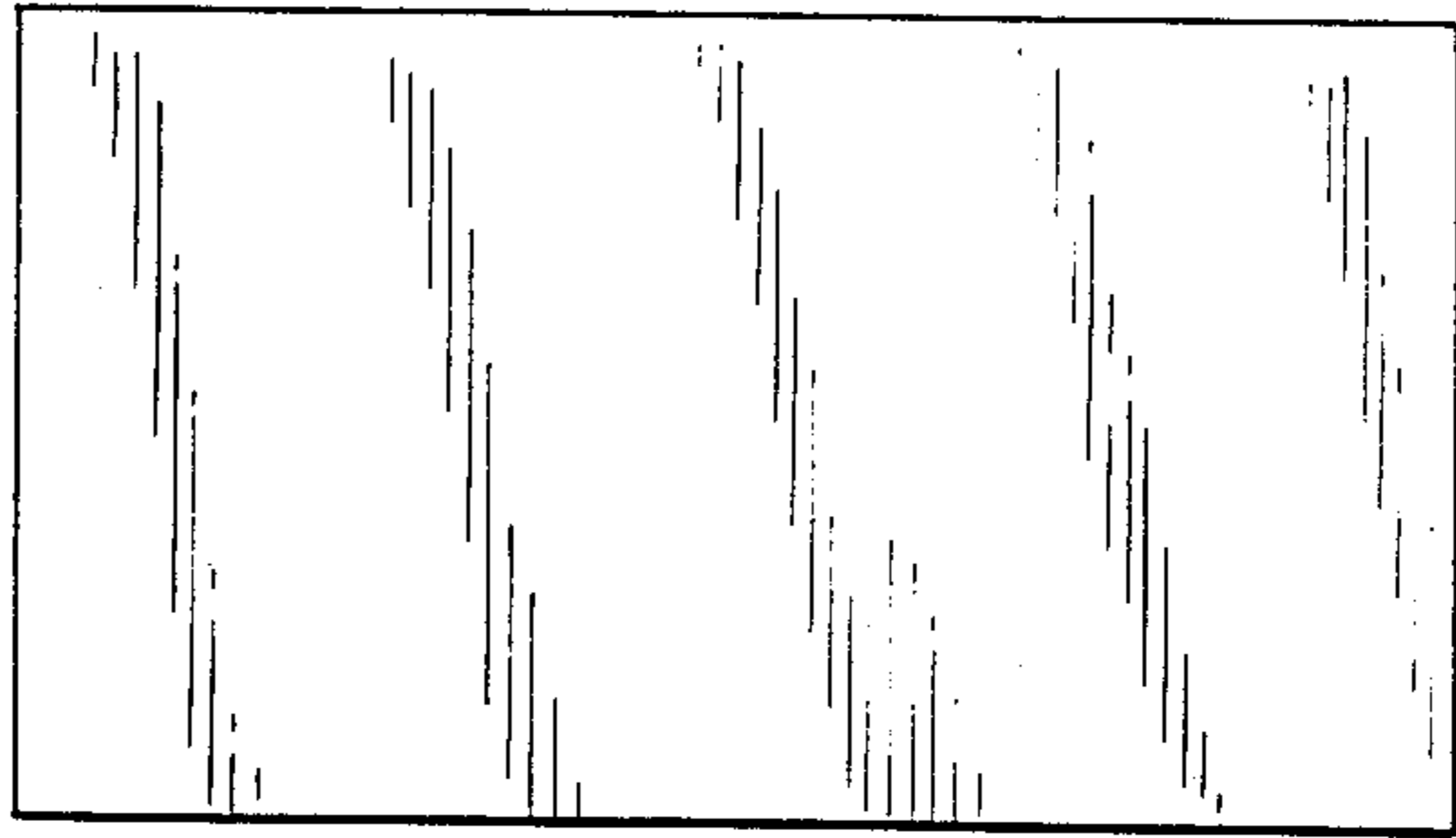

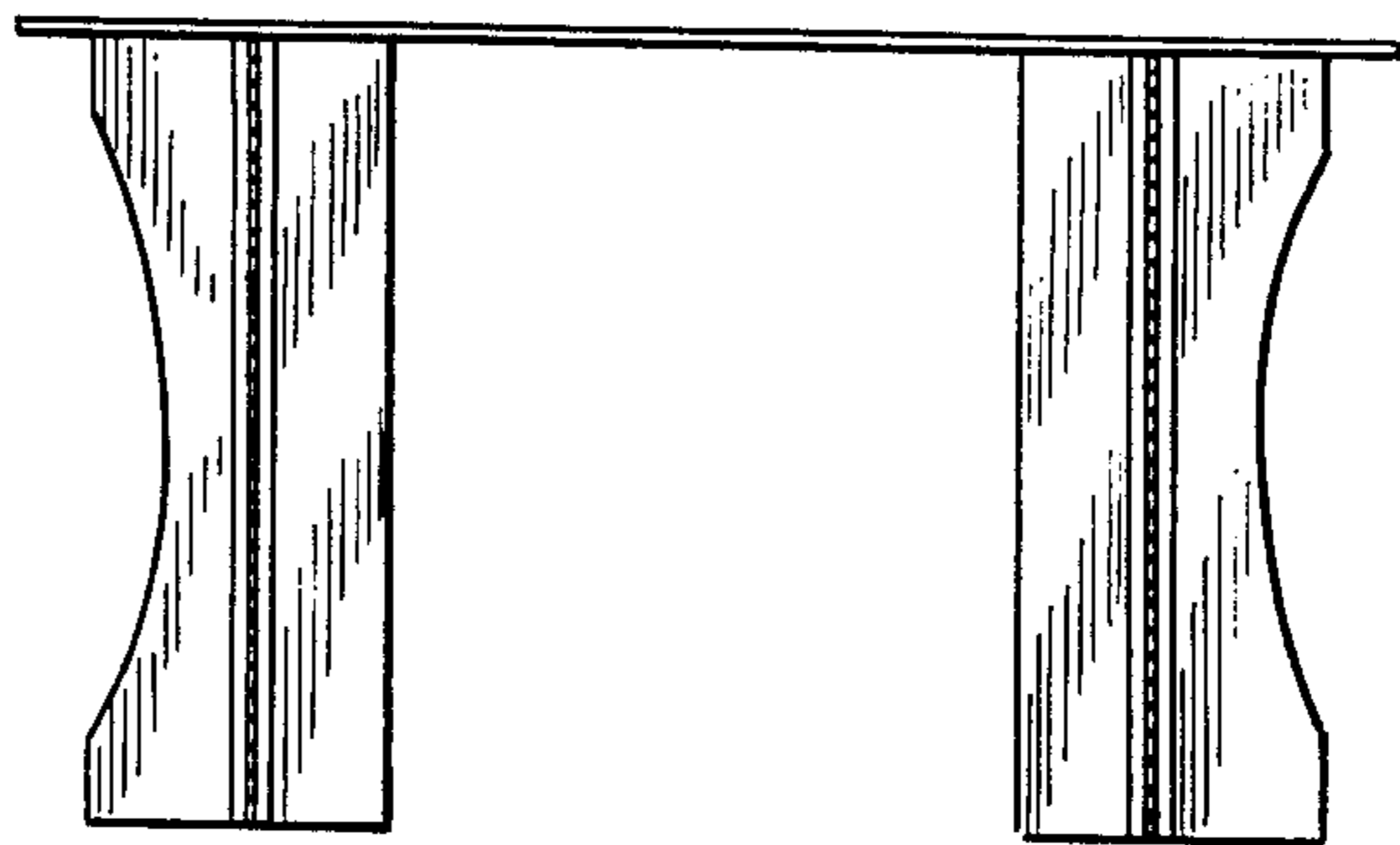

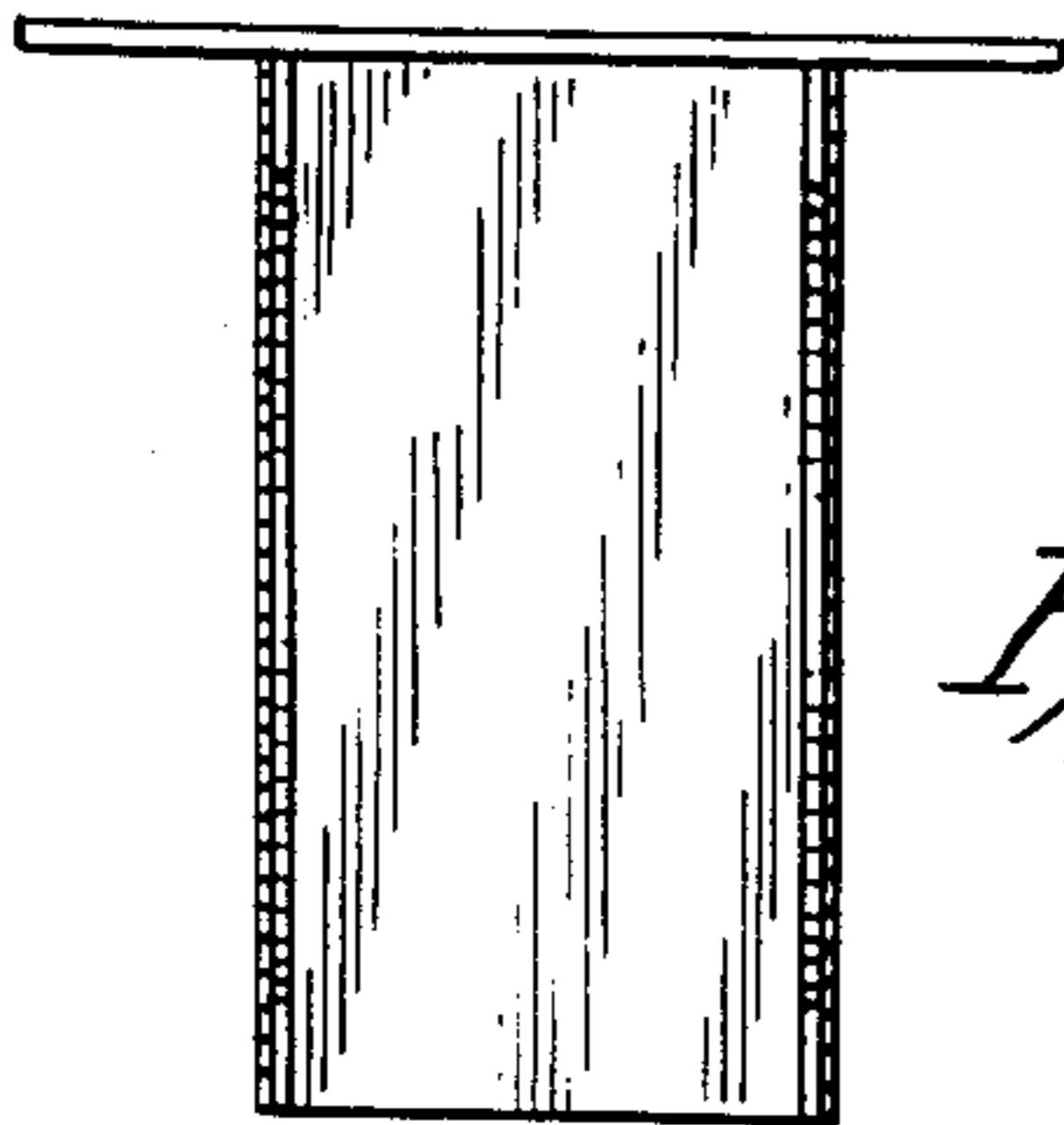

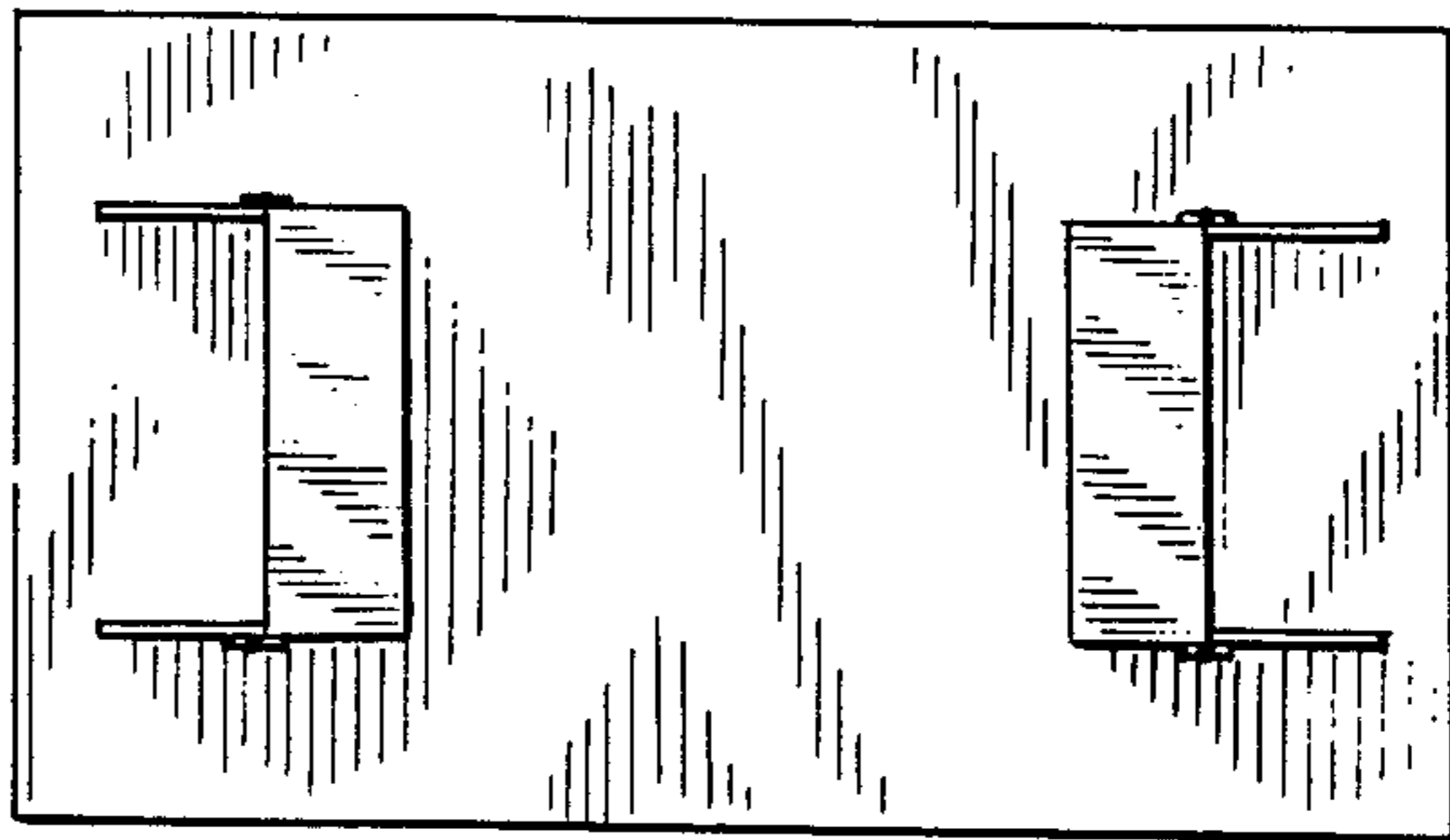

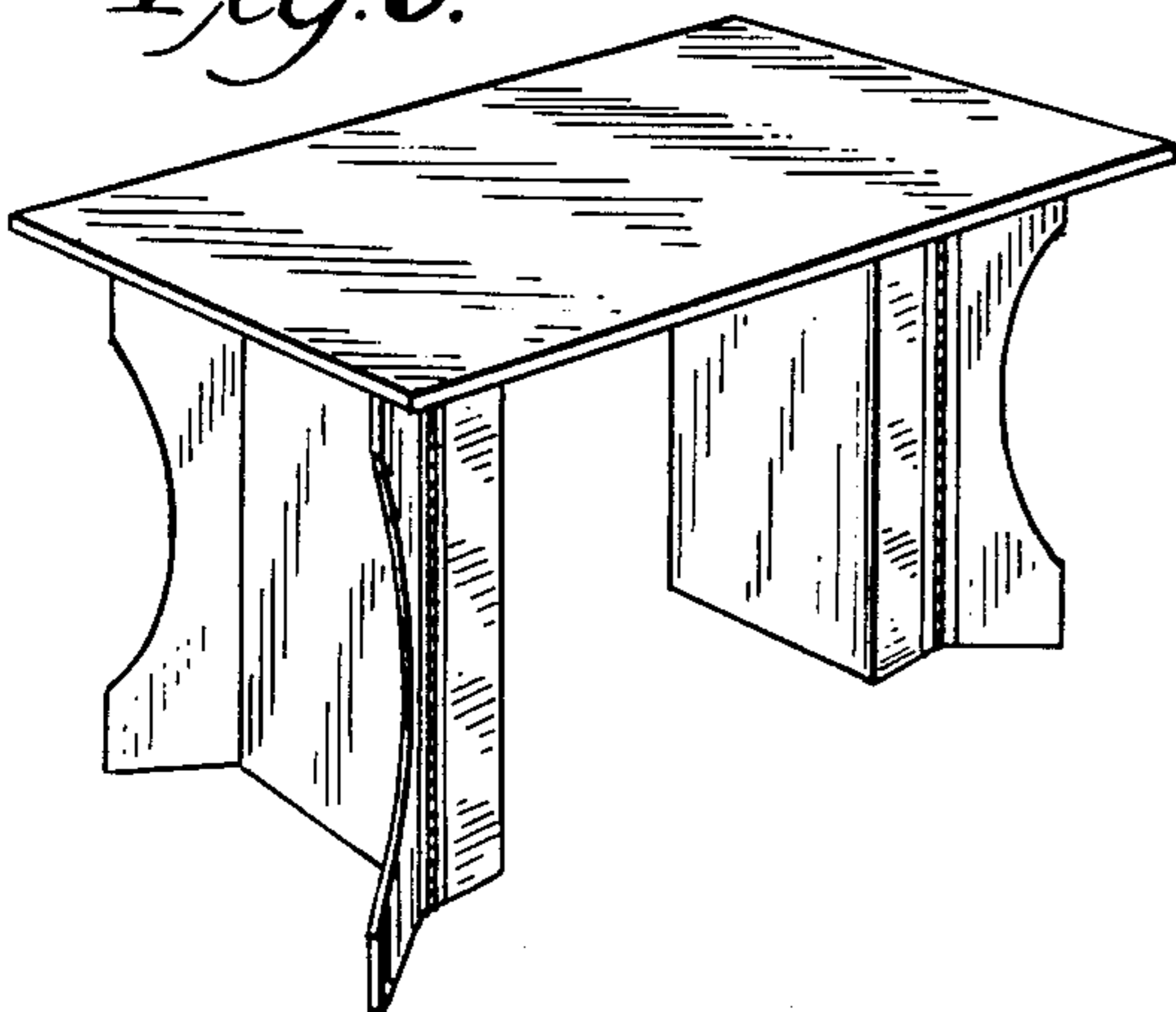

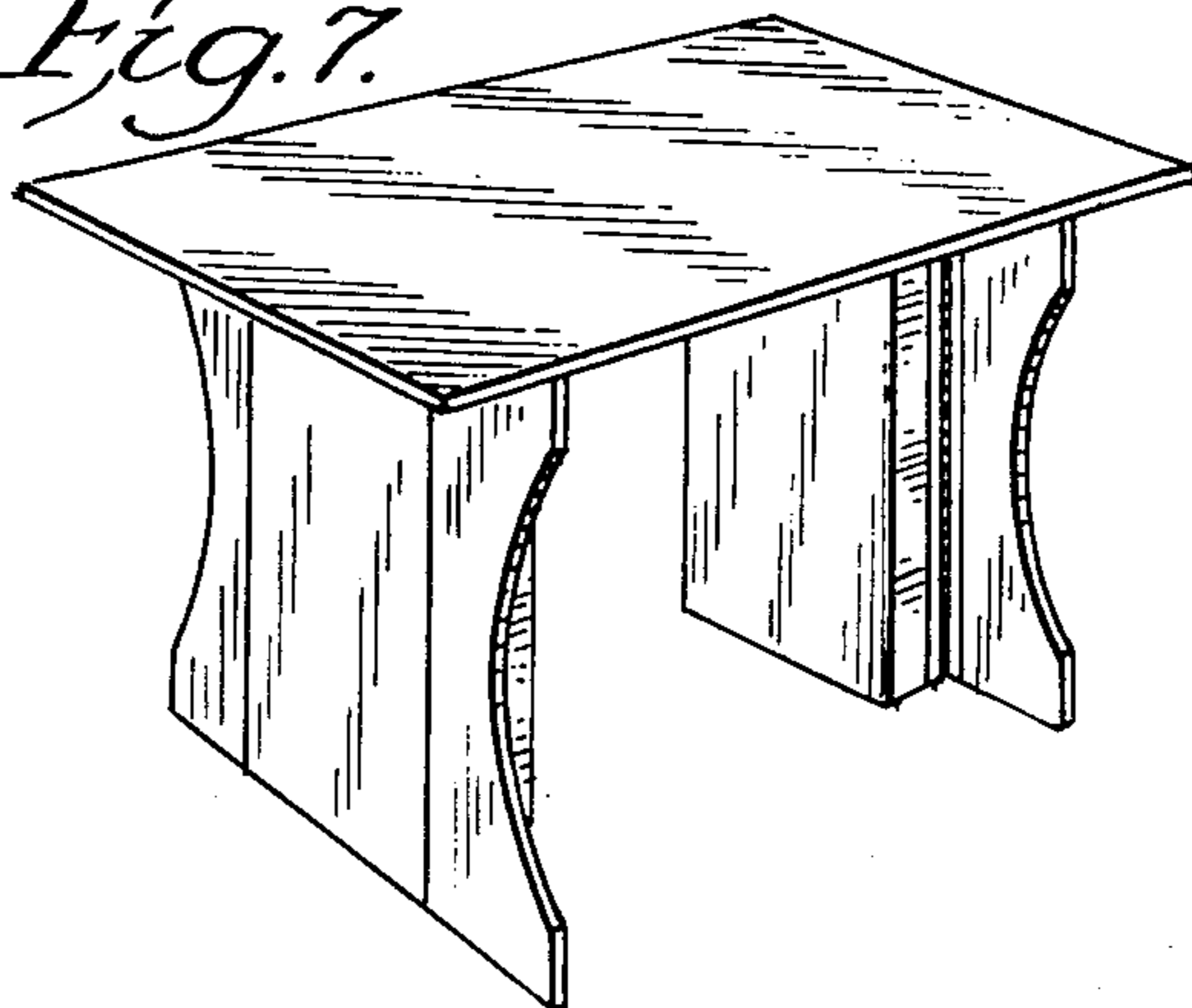

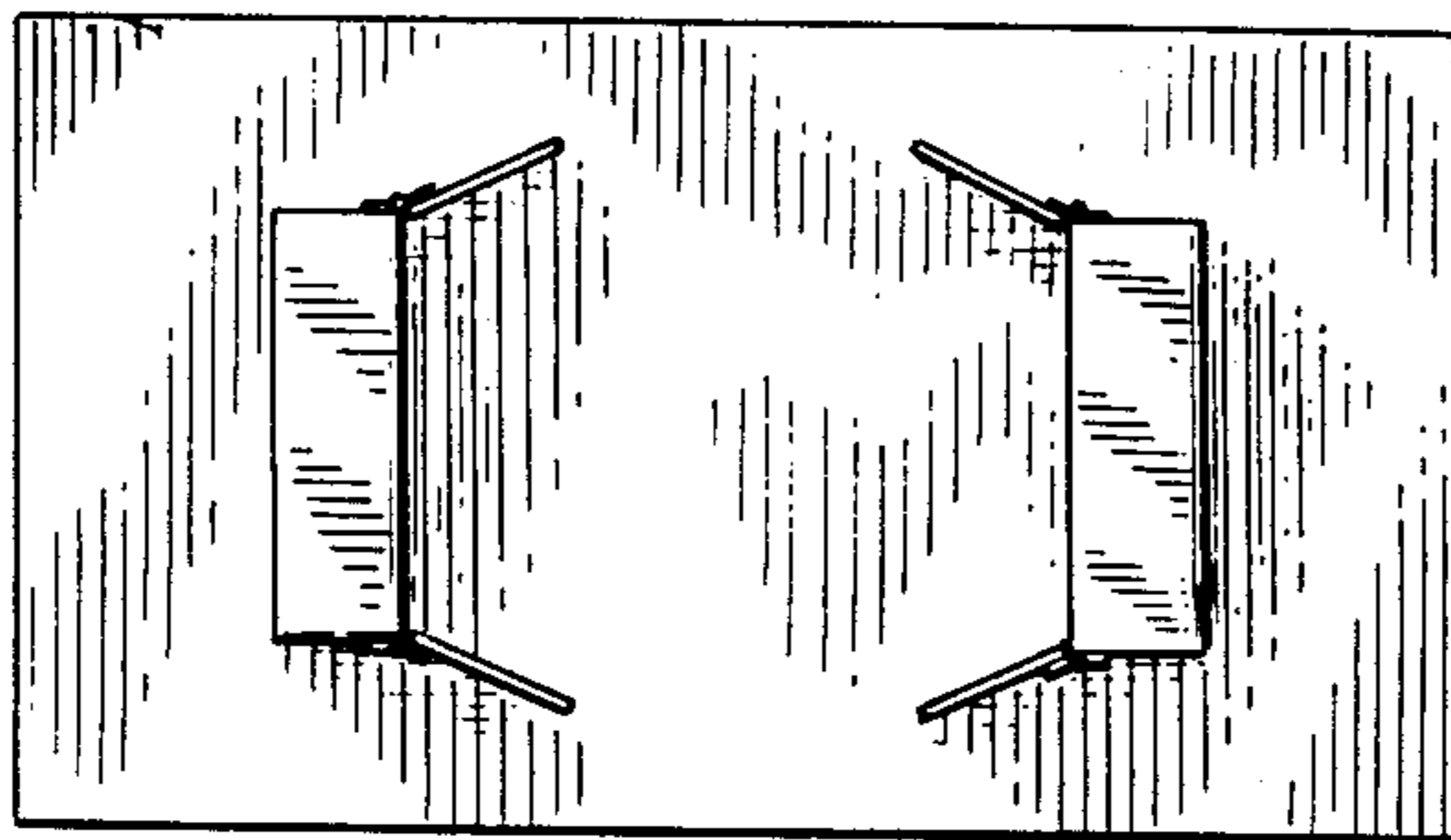

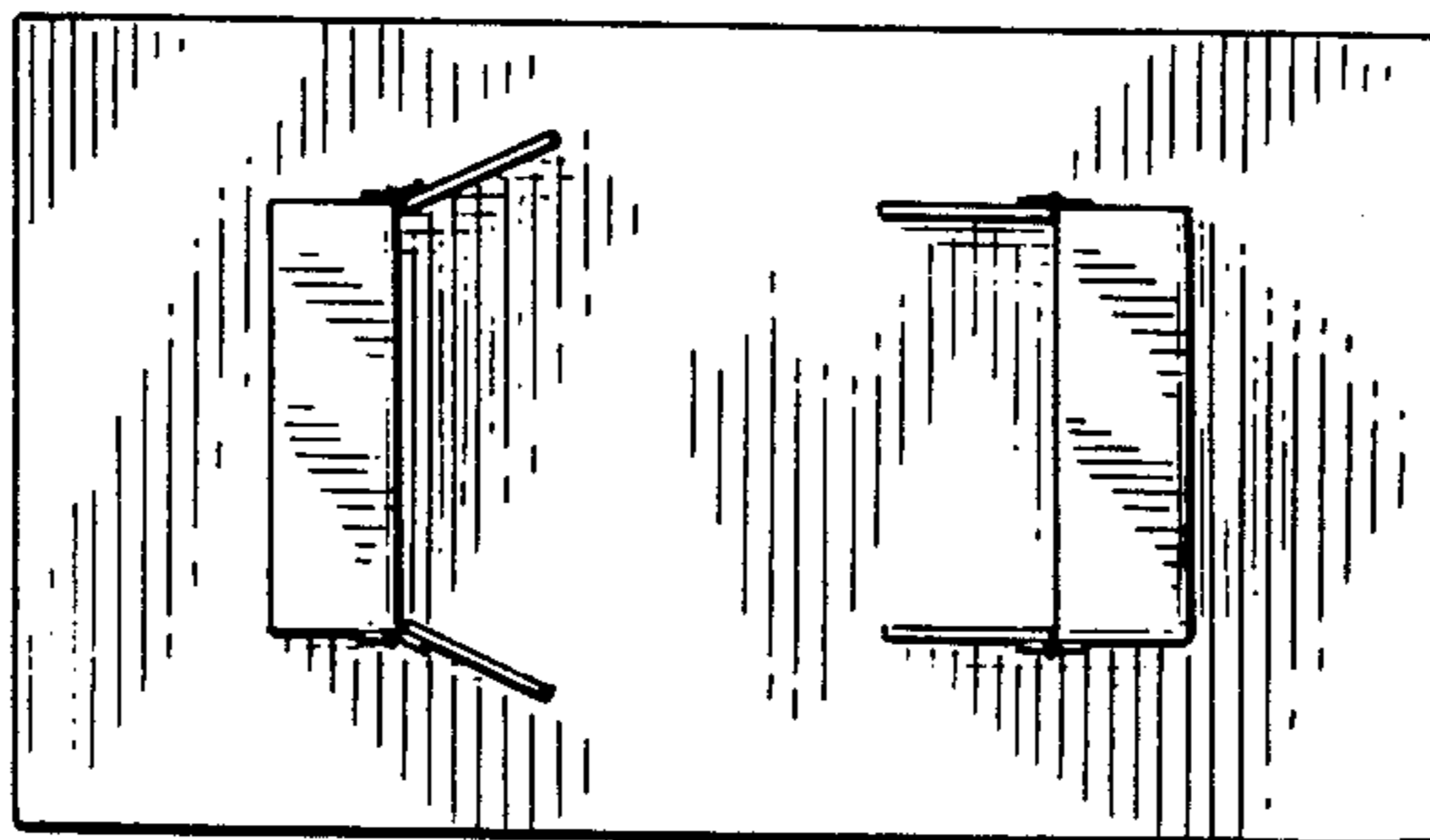
