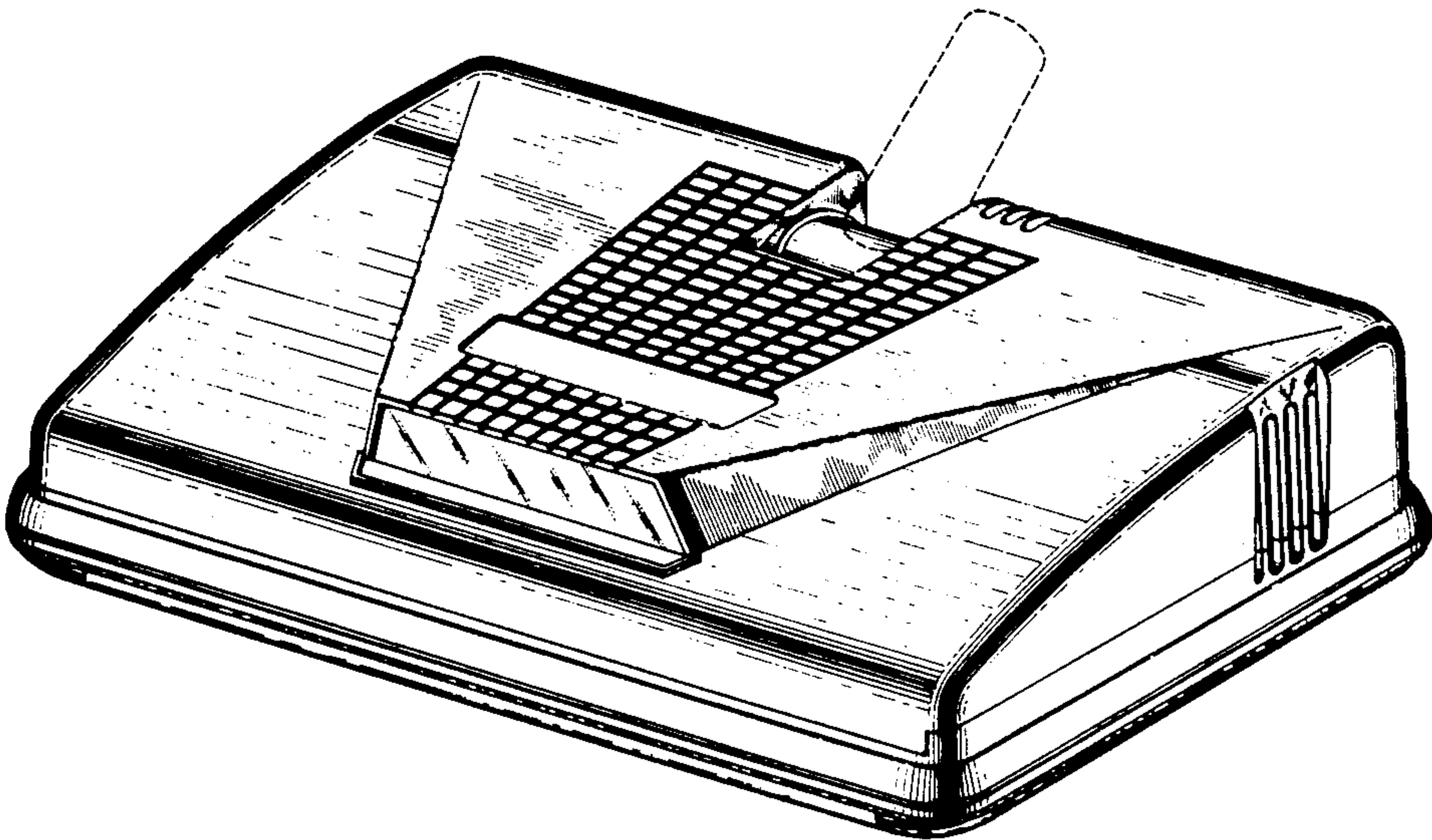

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a powered suction cleaner nozzle, showing my new design;

The broken line disclosure of a nozzle coupling in all views is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



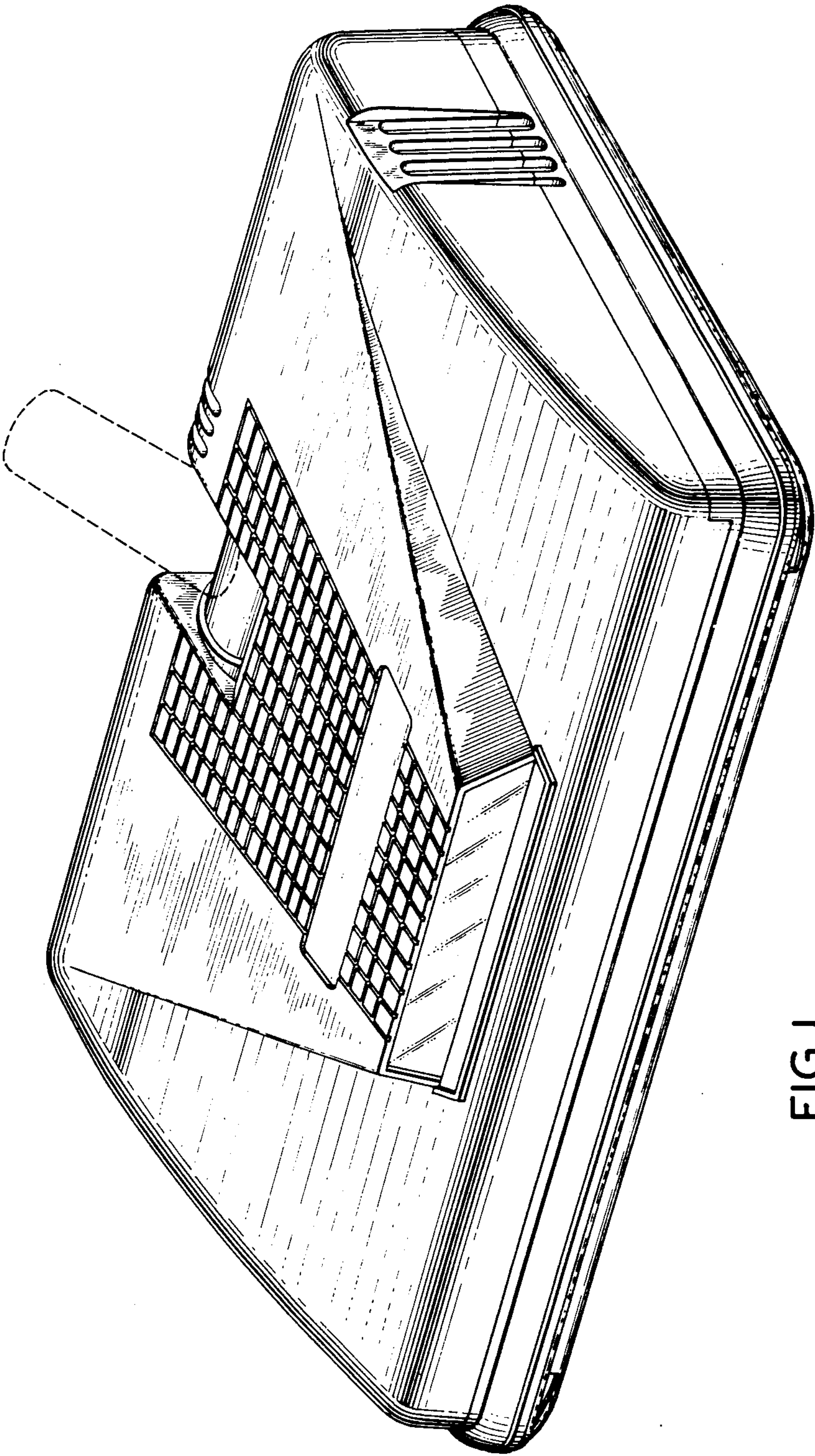

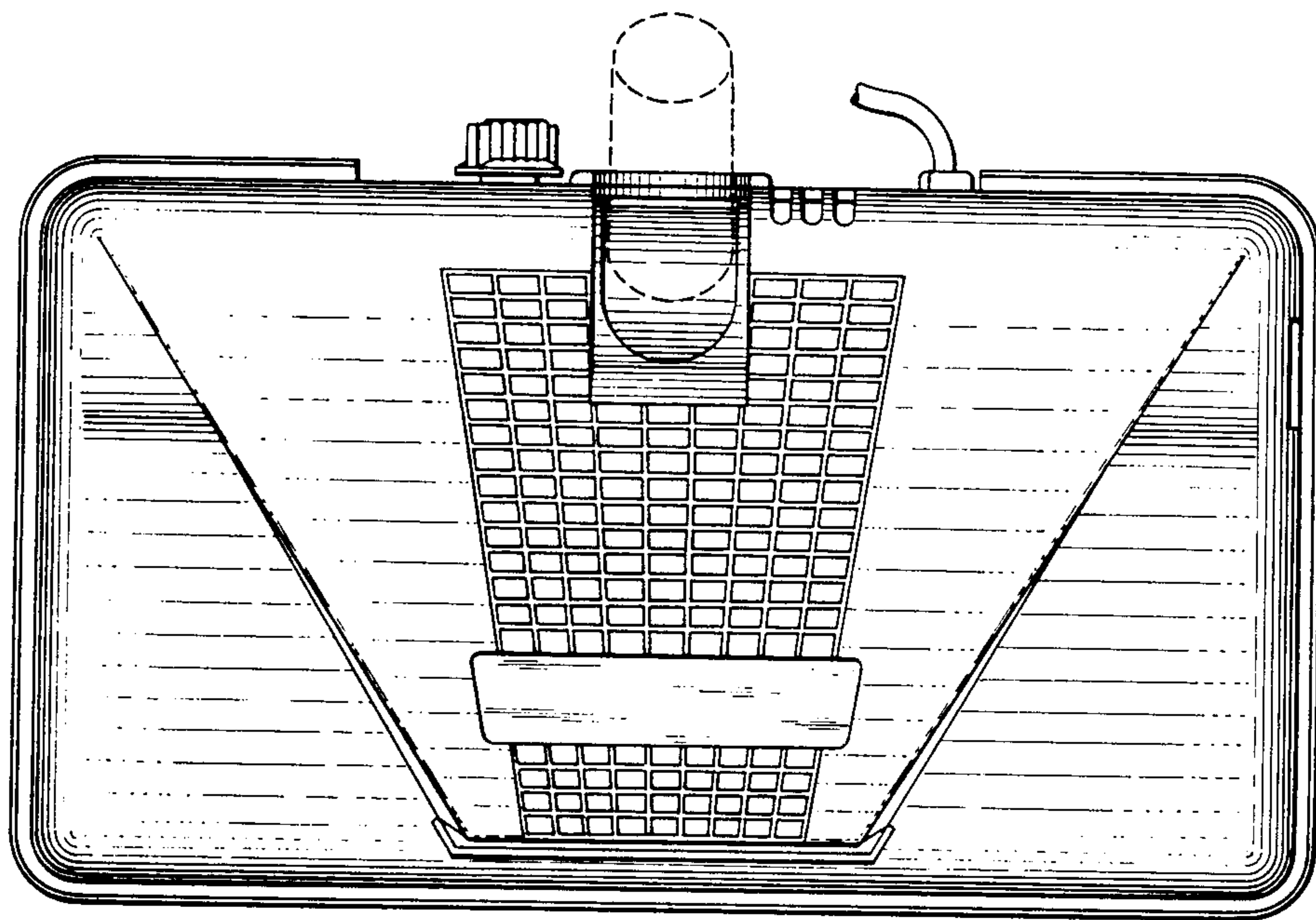

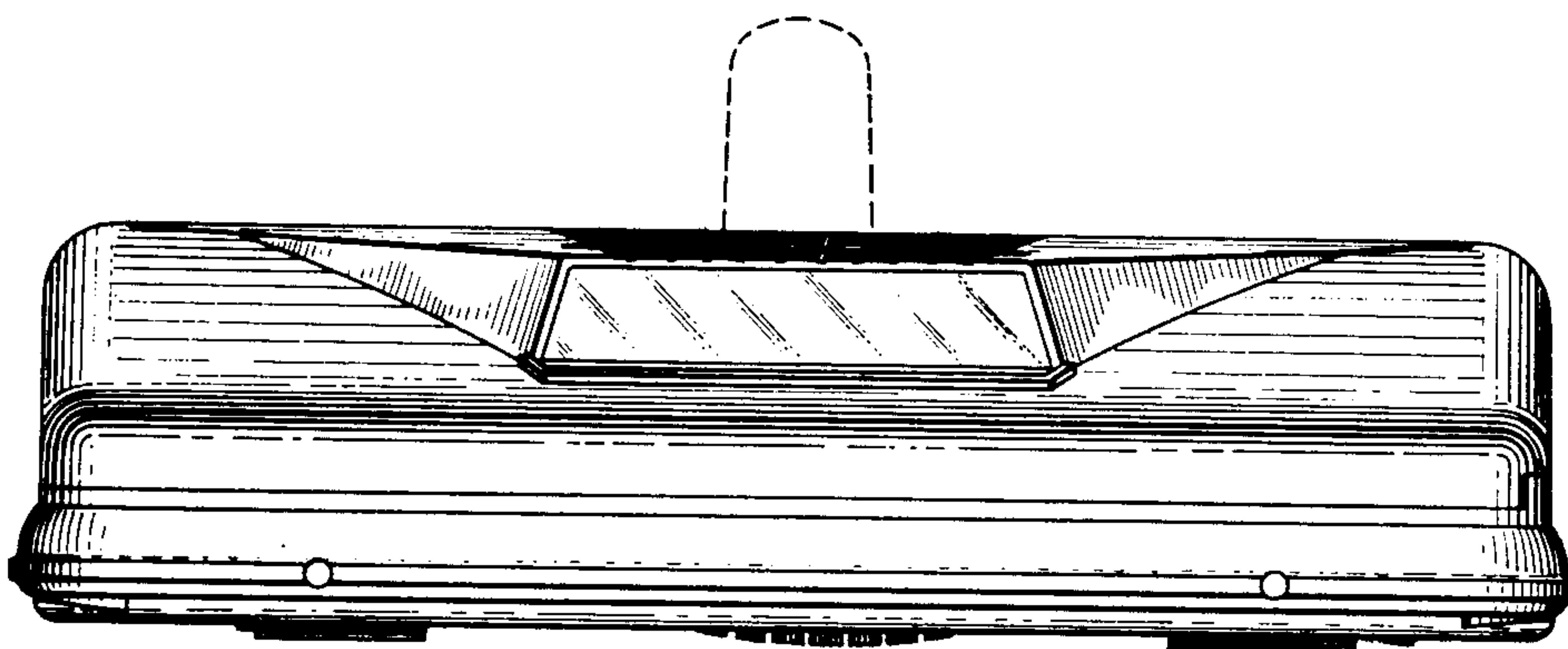

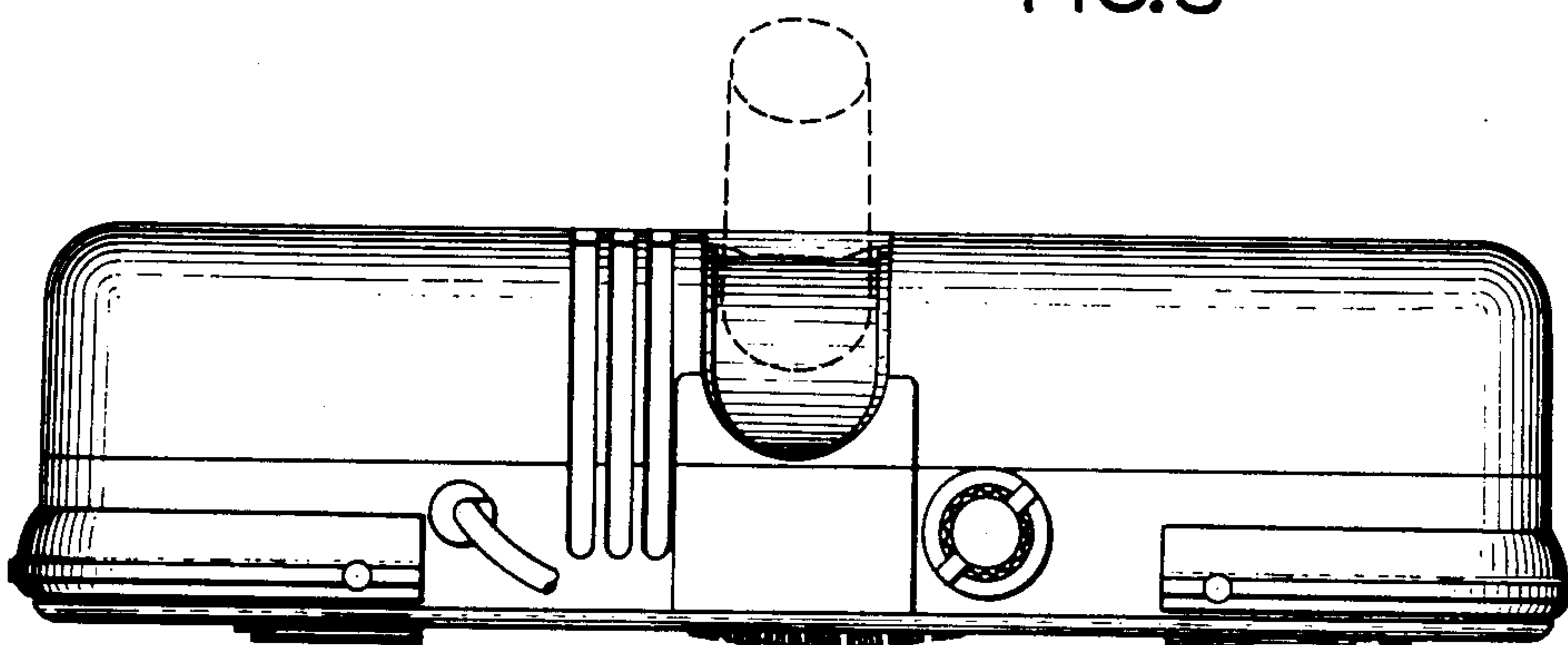

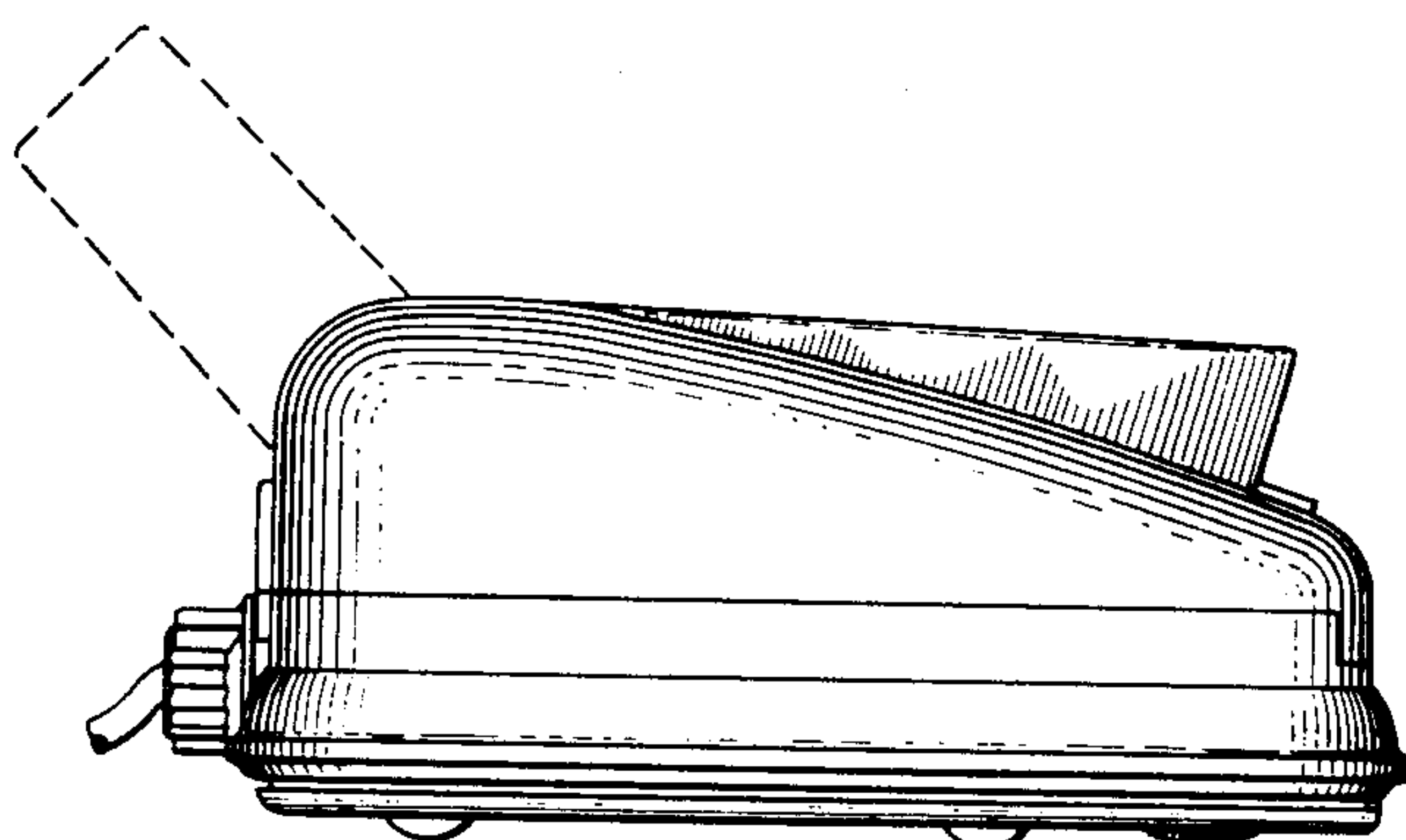

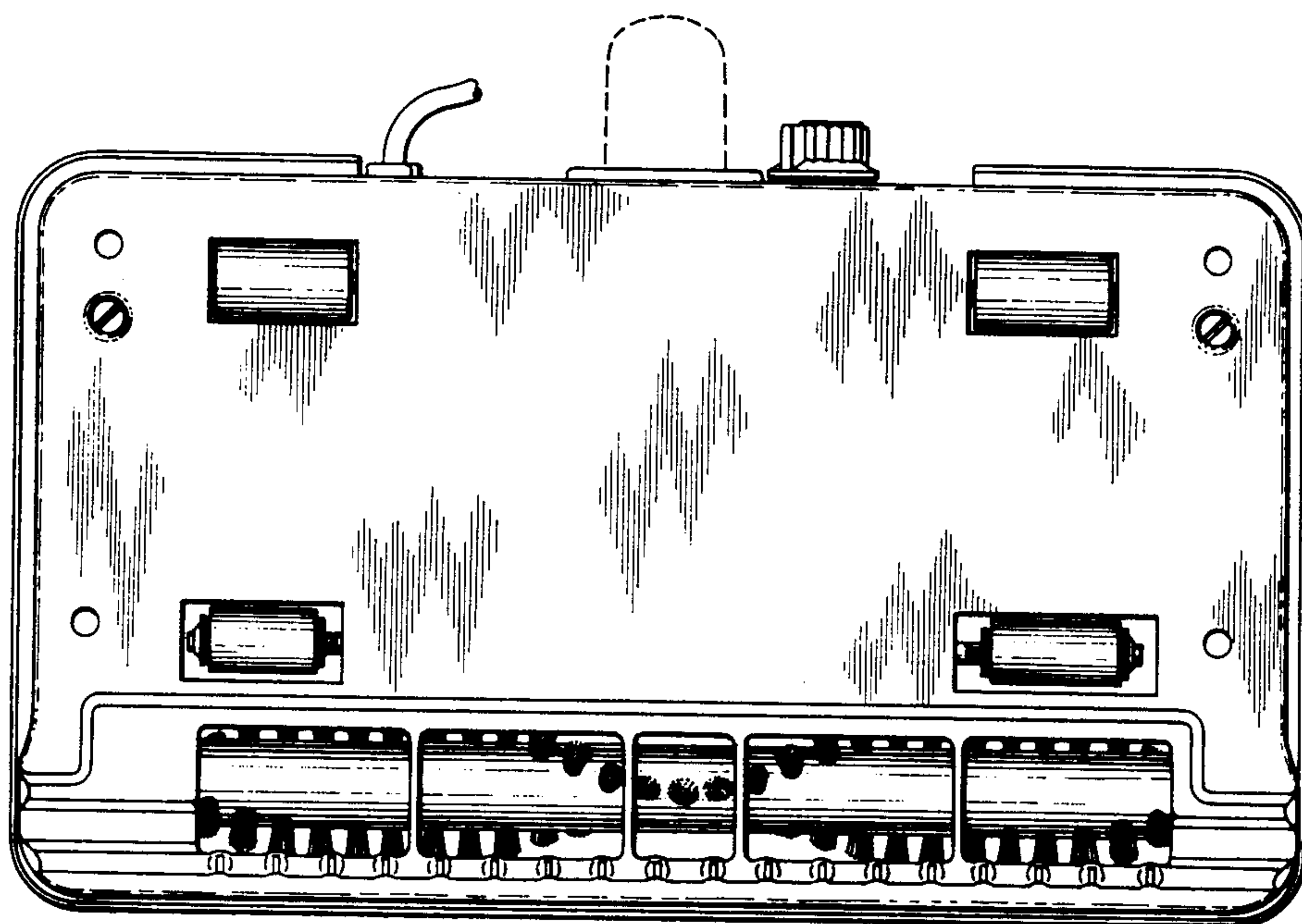
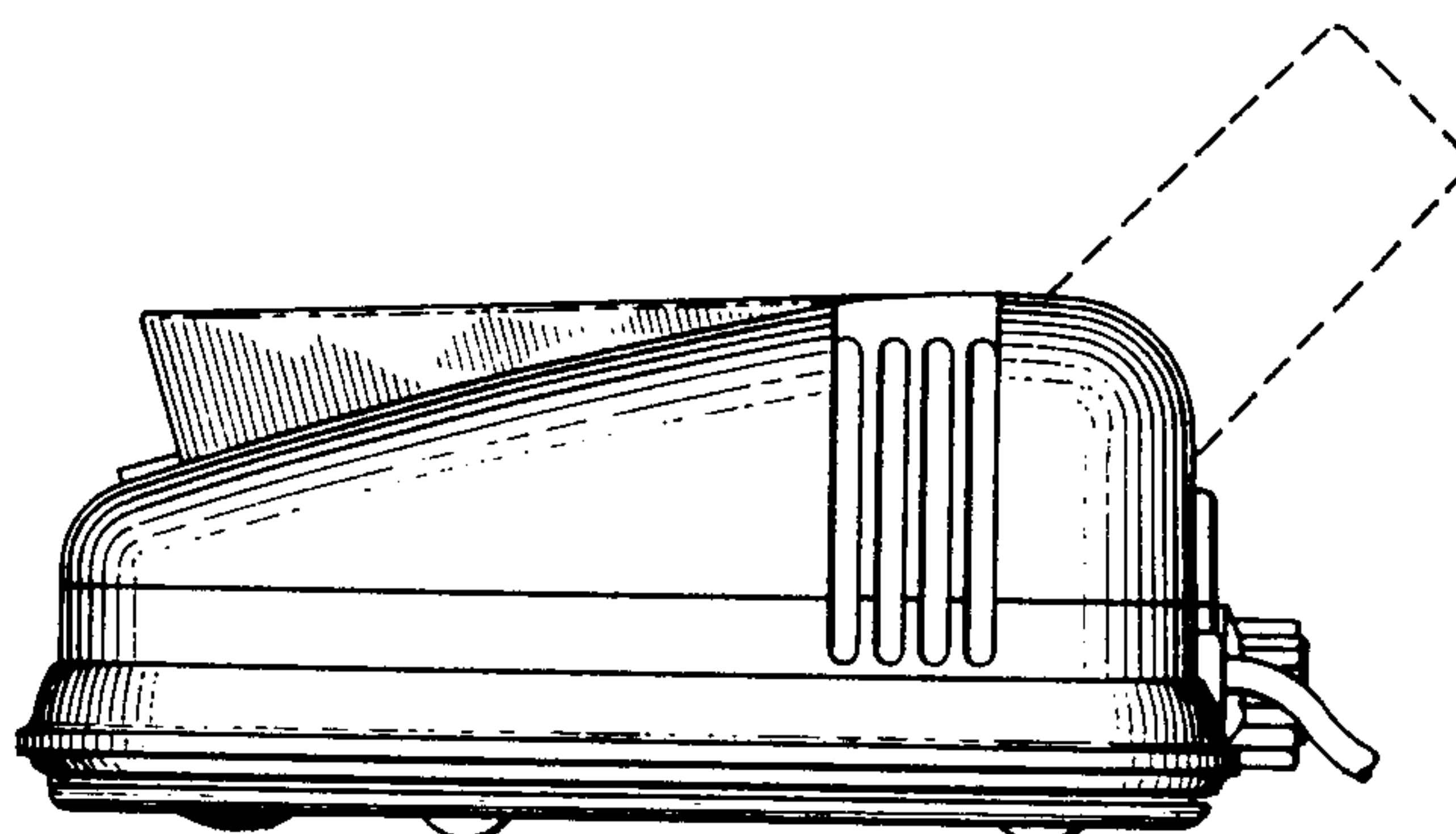
