[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a collapsible container suitable for medical fluids, substantially as shown in the drawing.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a collapsible container suitable for medical fluids;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the collapsible container suitable for medical fluids;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the collapsible container suitable for medical fluids;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the collapsible container suitable for medical fluids; and
 FIG. 5 is a fragmentary sectional view taken along plane 5—5 in FIG. 1 and showing groove configuration in the collapsible container suitable for medical fluids.

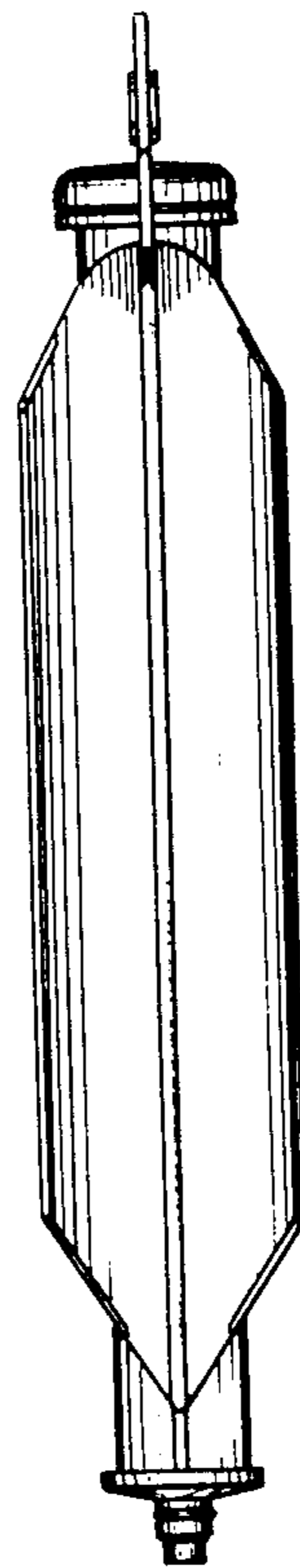
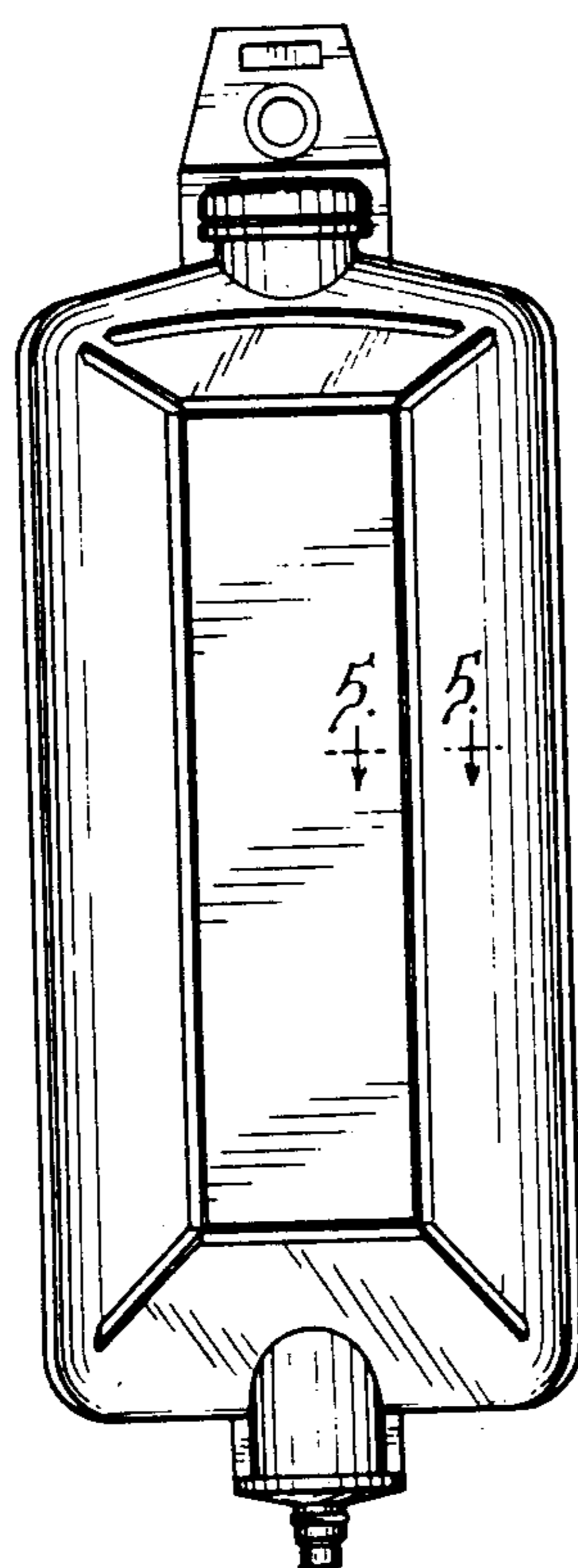

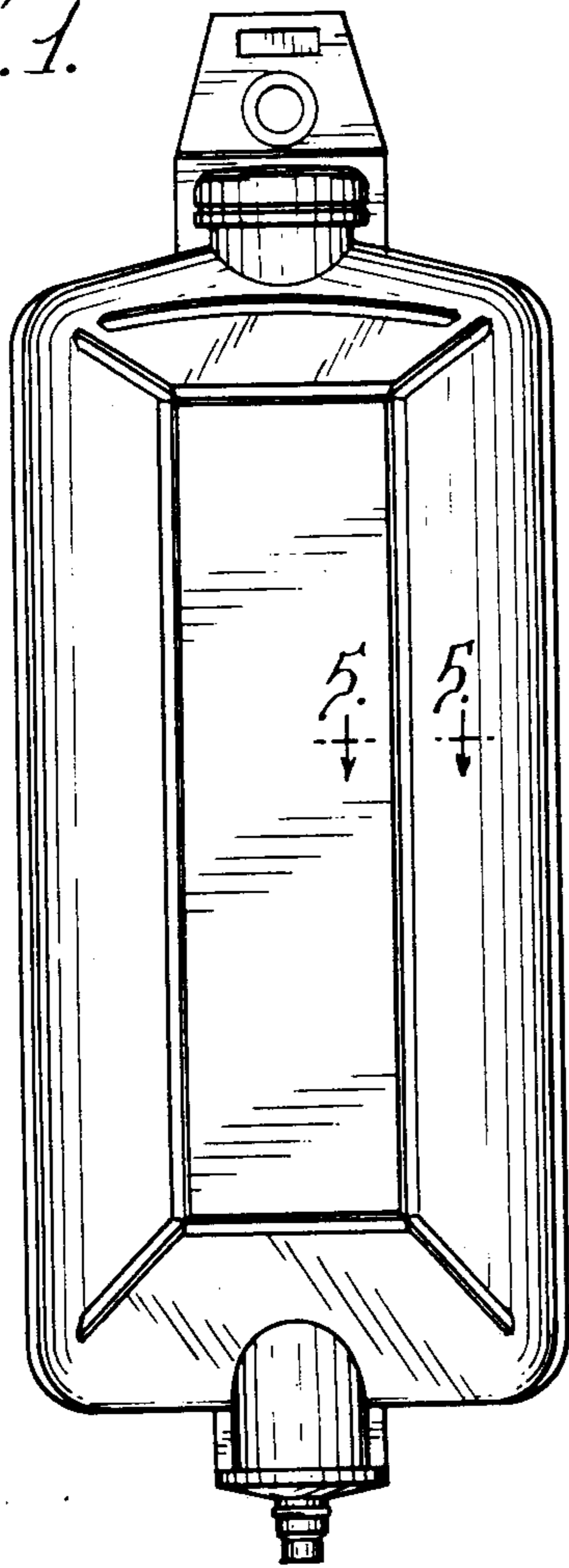

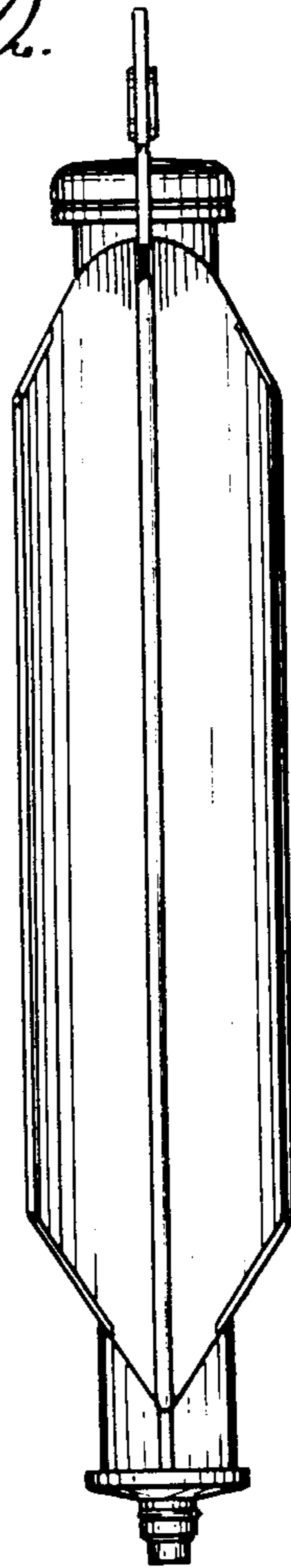

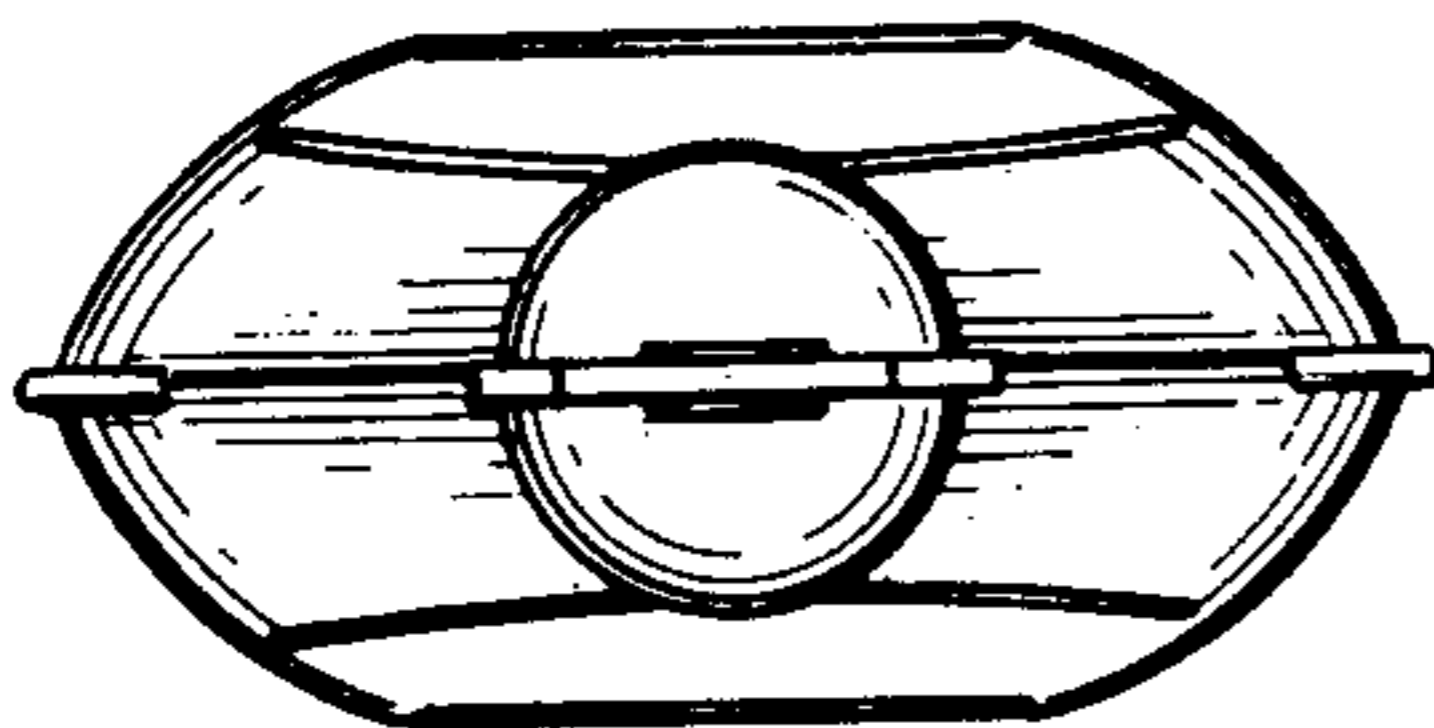

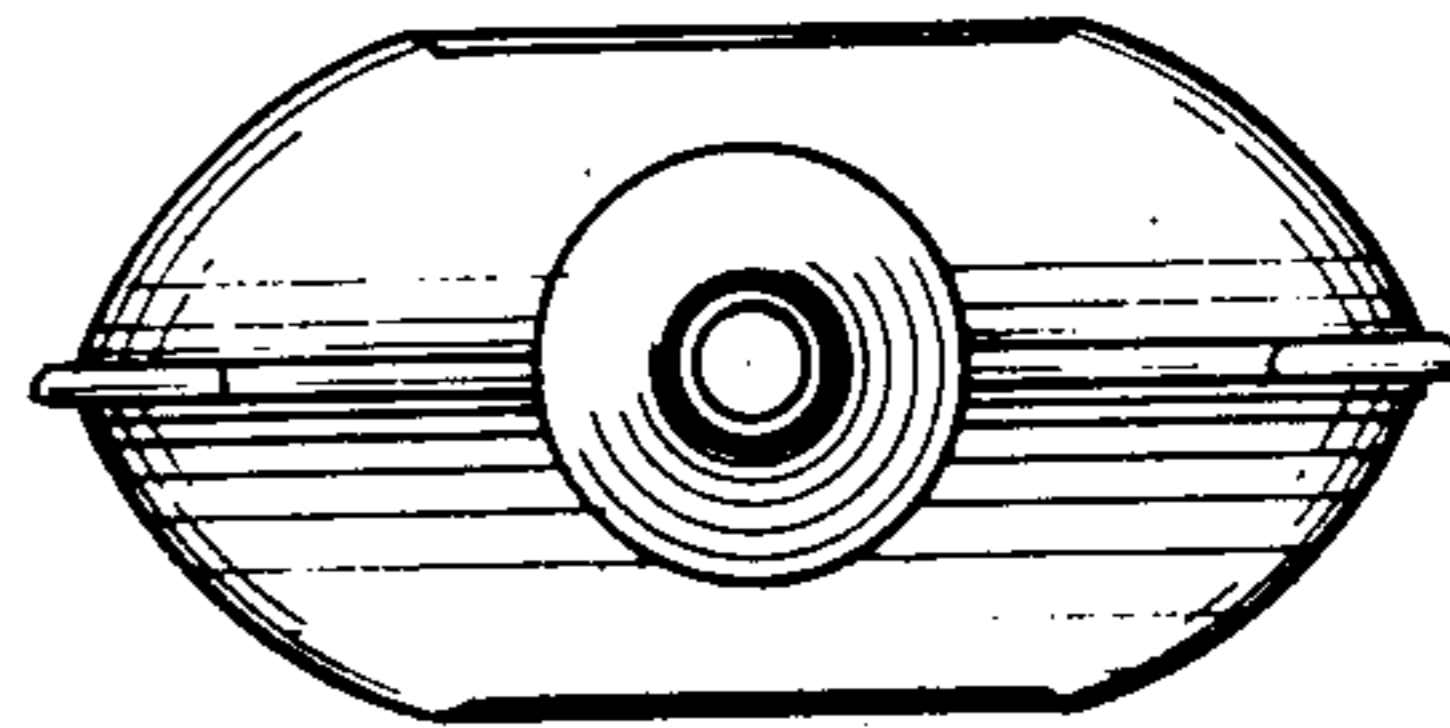
