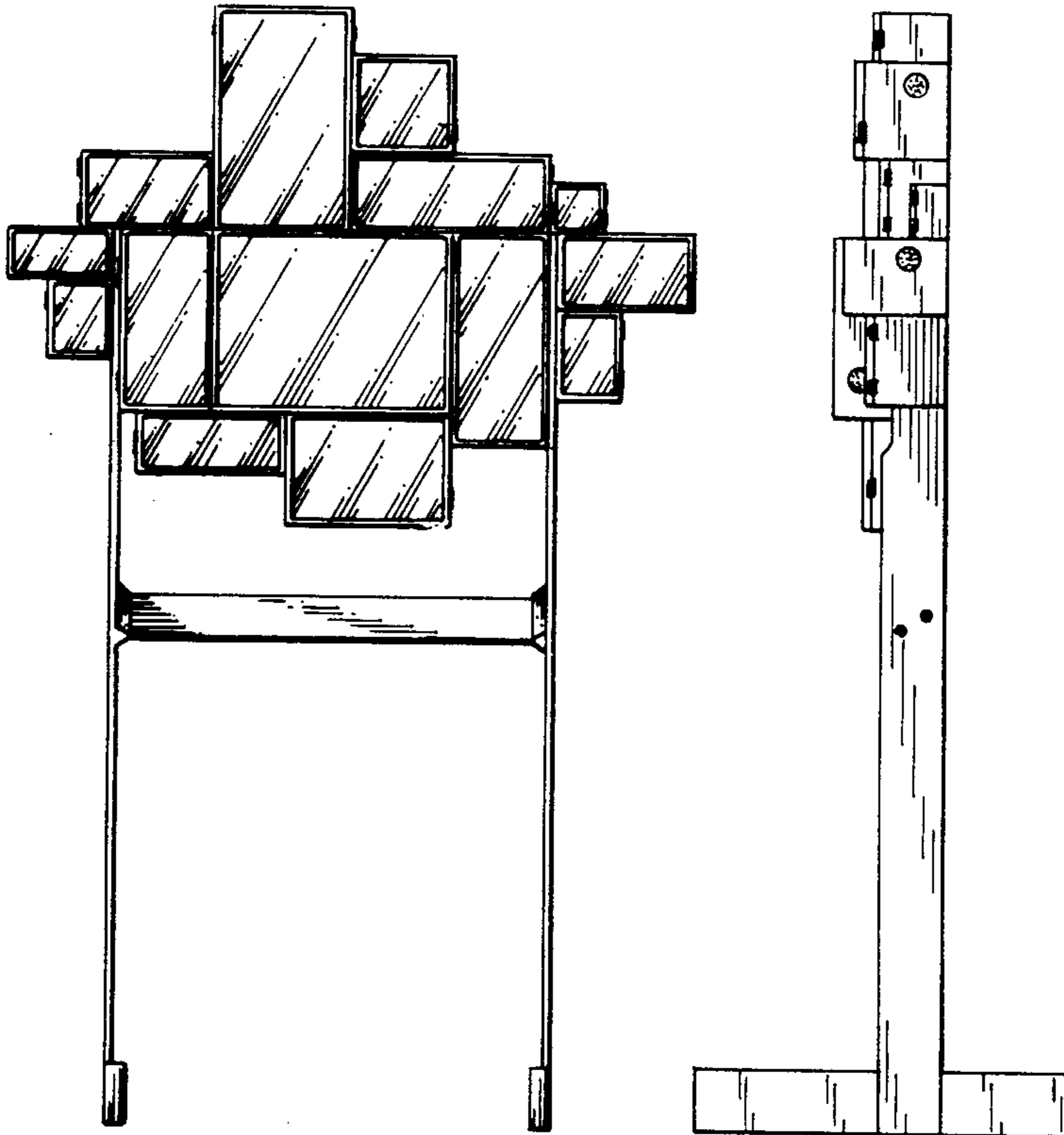

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a modular house for small pets embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation thereof; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevation thereof.



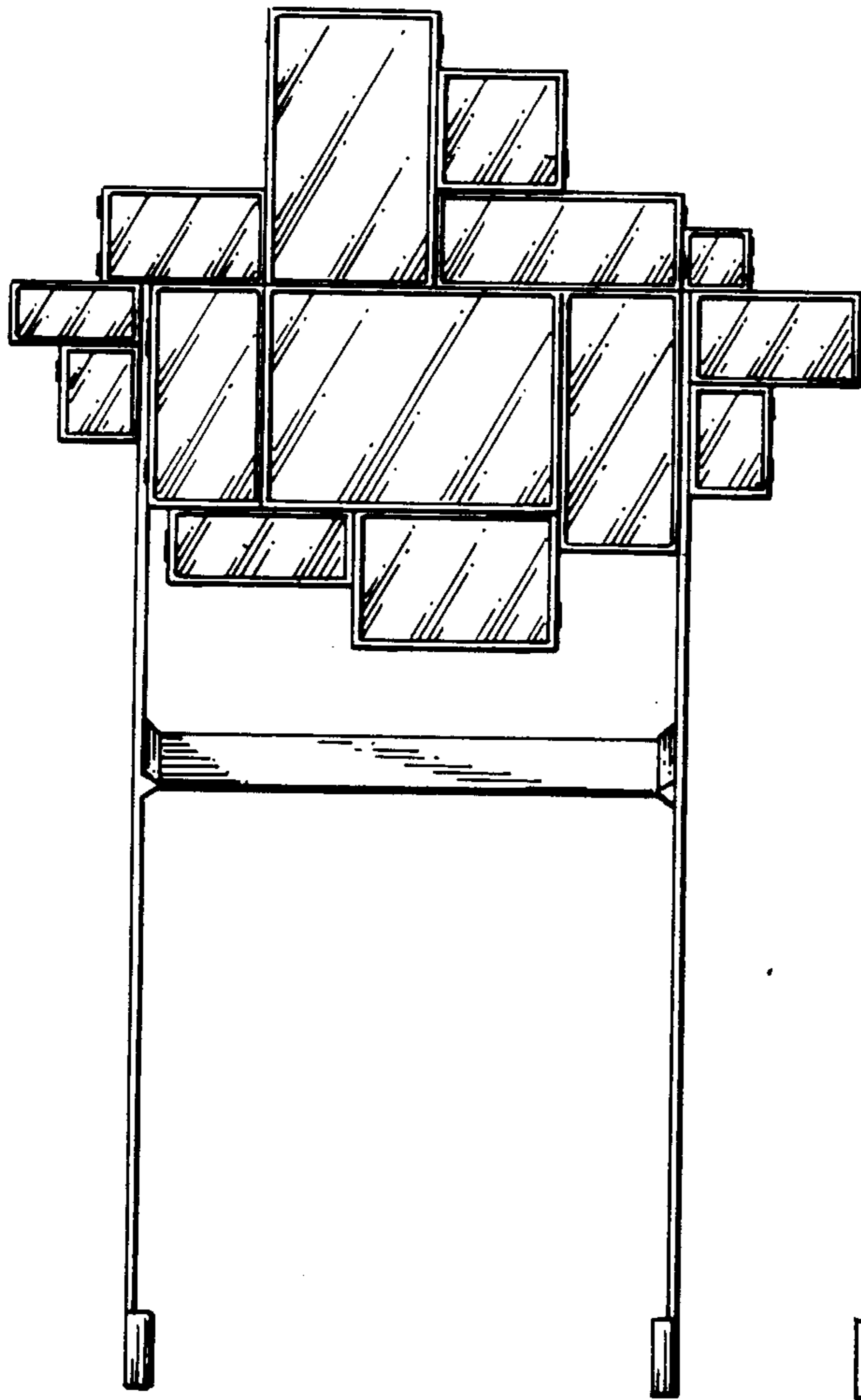

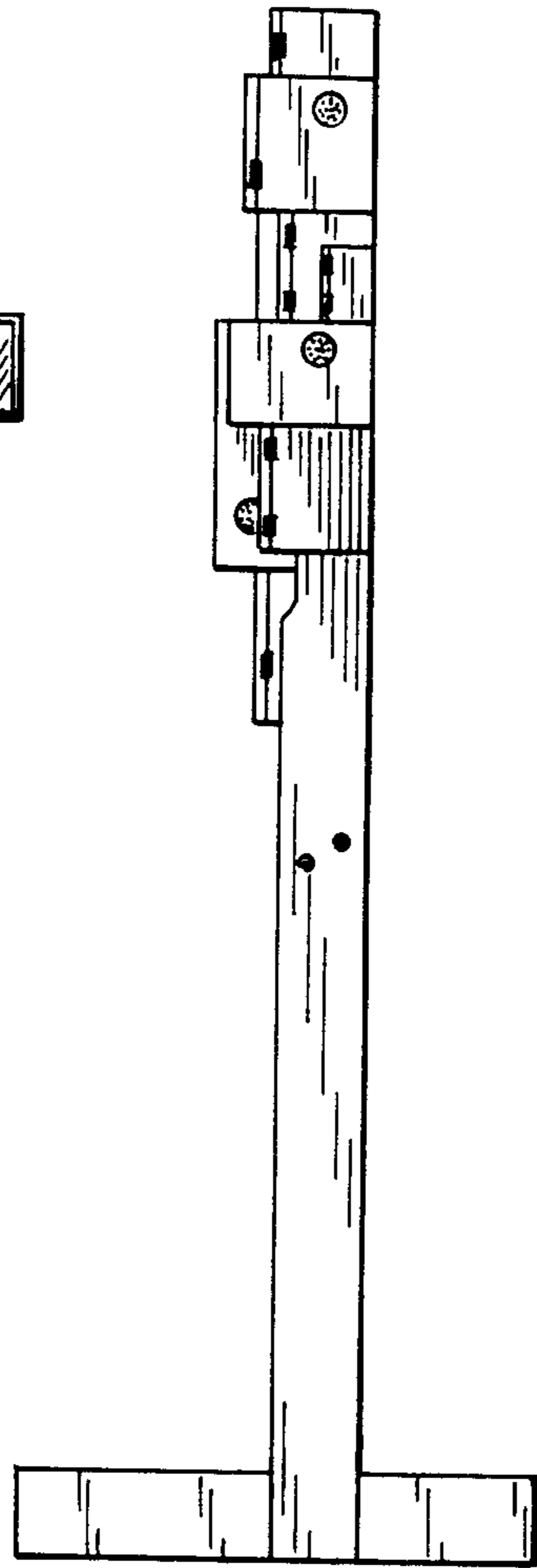

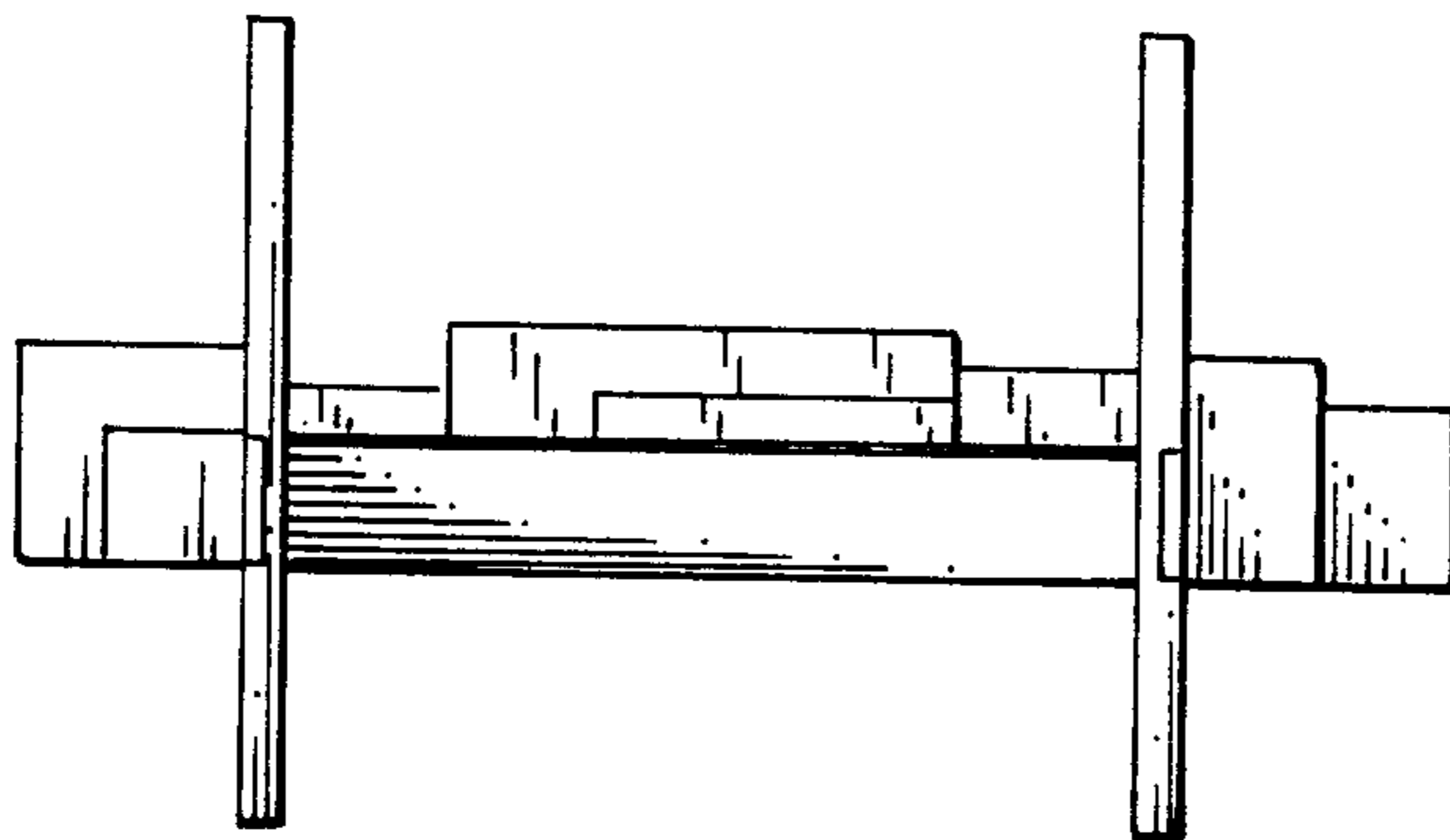

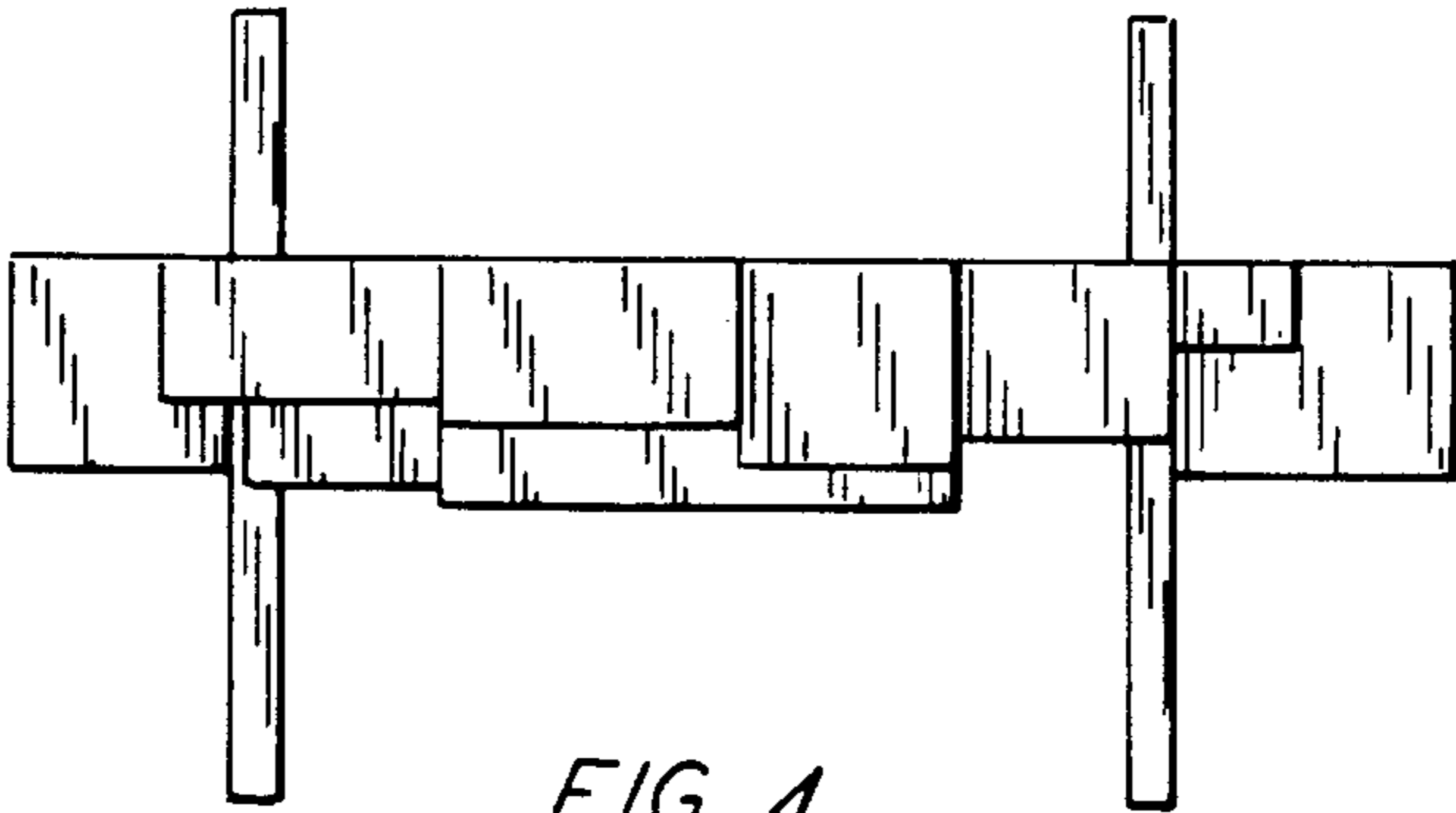

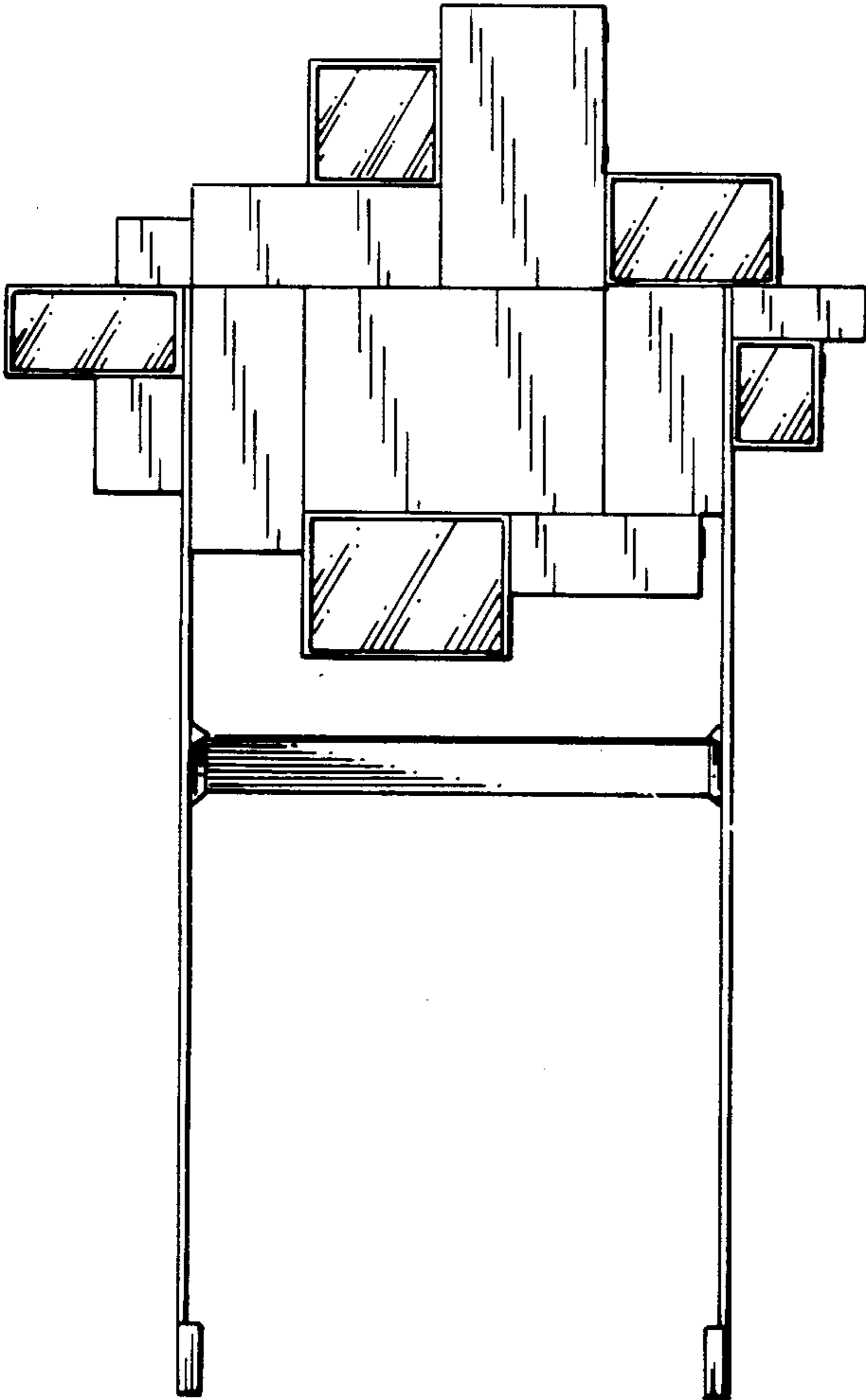

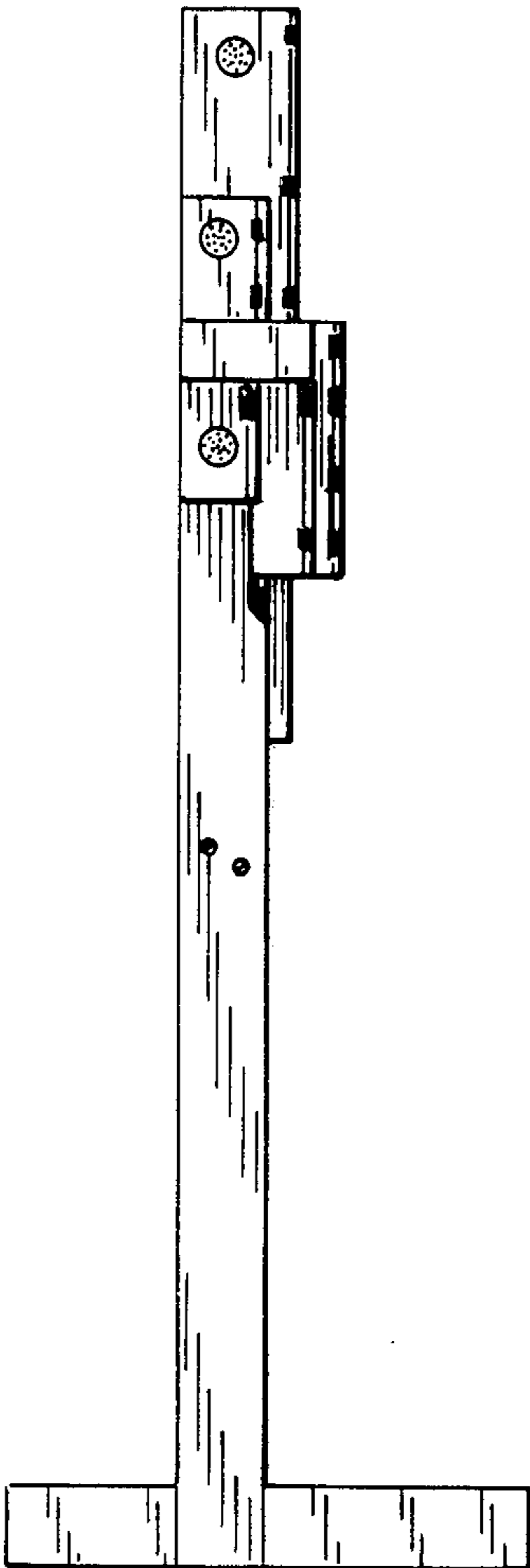
