[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable container for a pick-up truck or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an adjustable container for a pick-up truck showing my new design in a longitudinally extended condition; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a modified form of FIG. 1, but in a longitudinally compressed condition; and FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of FIG. 6.

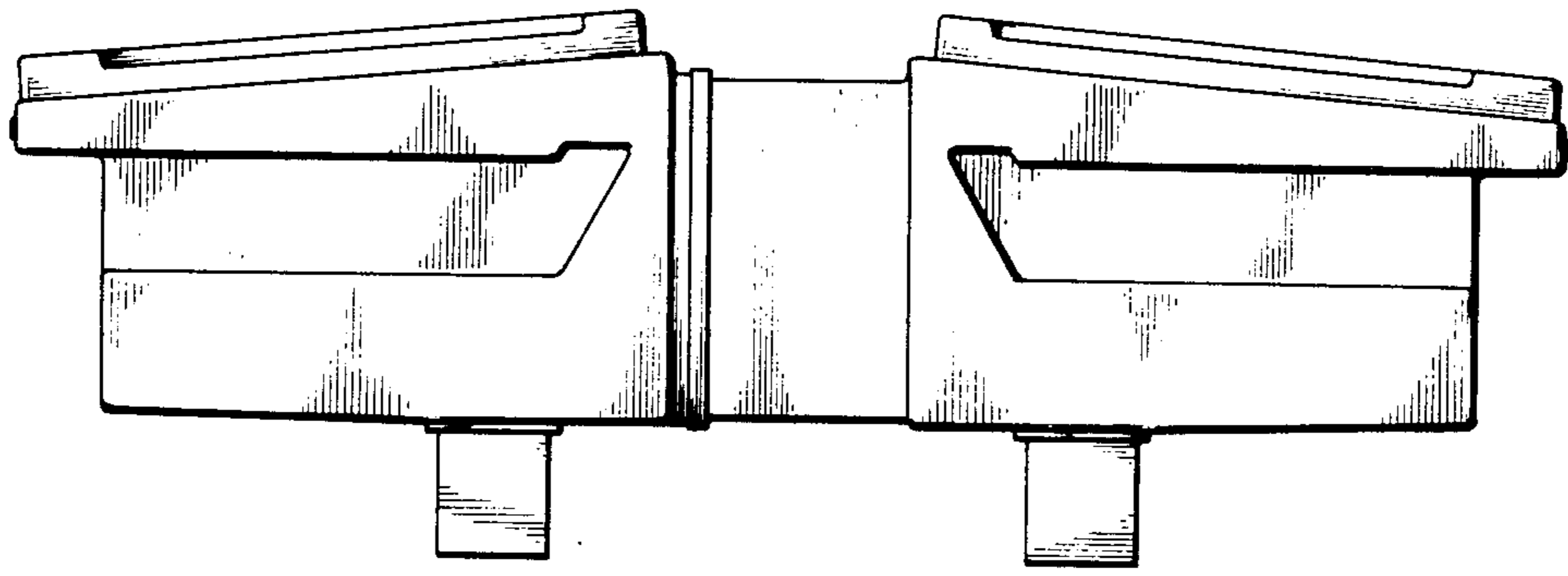

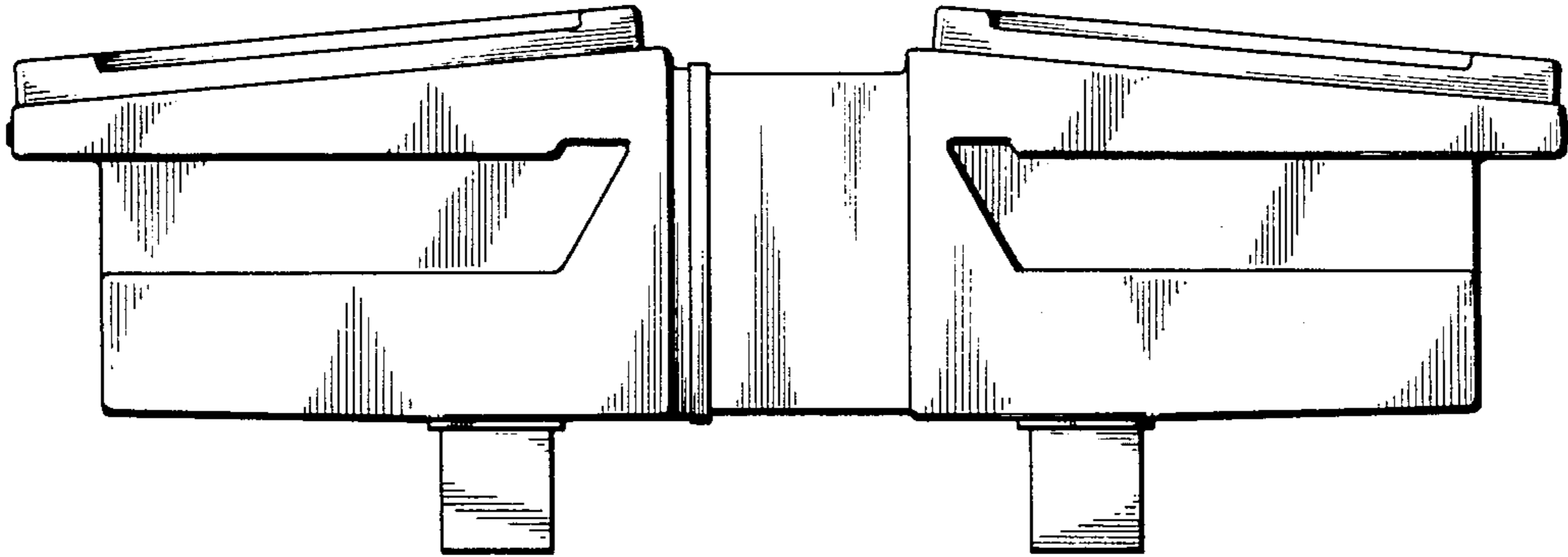

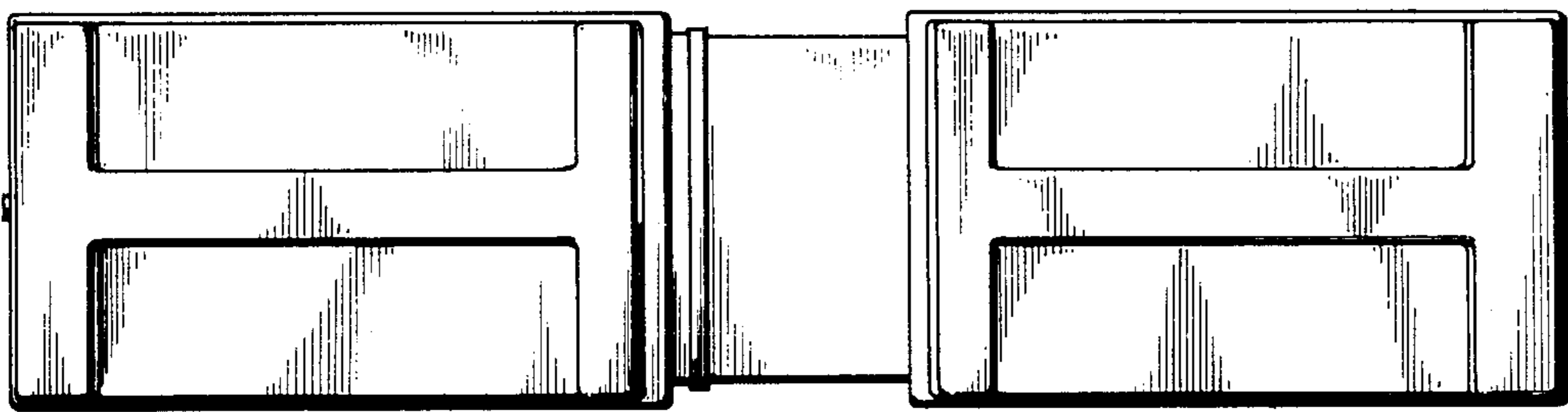

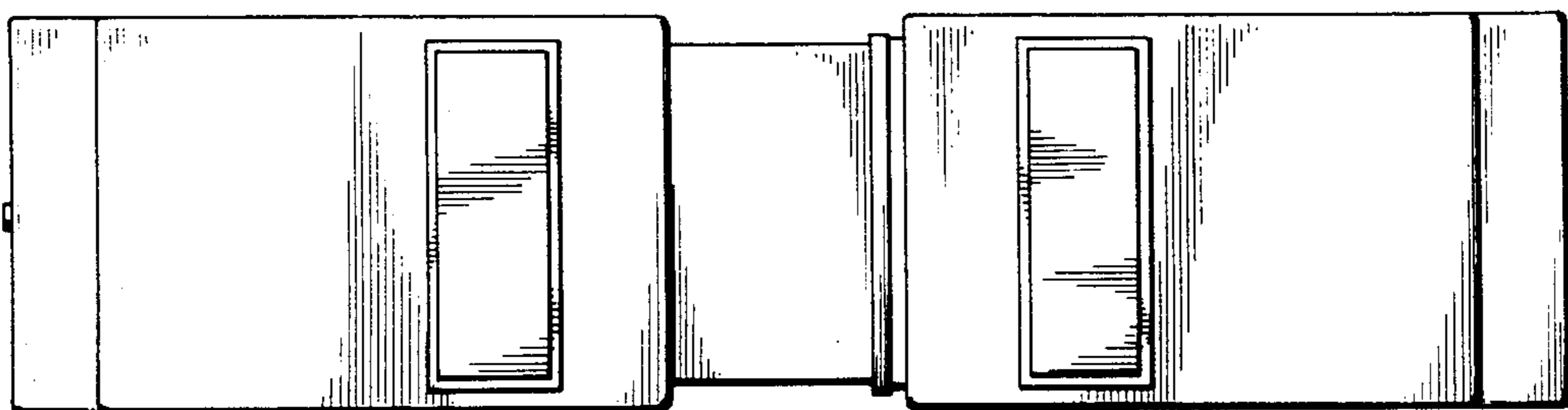

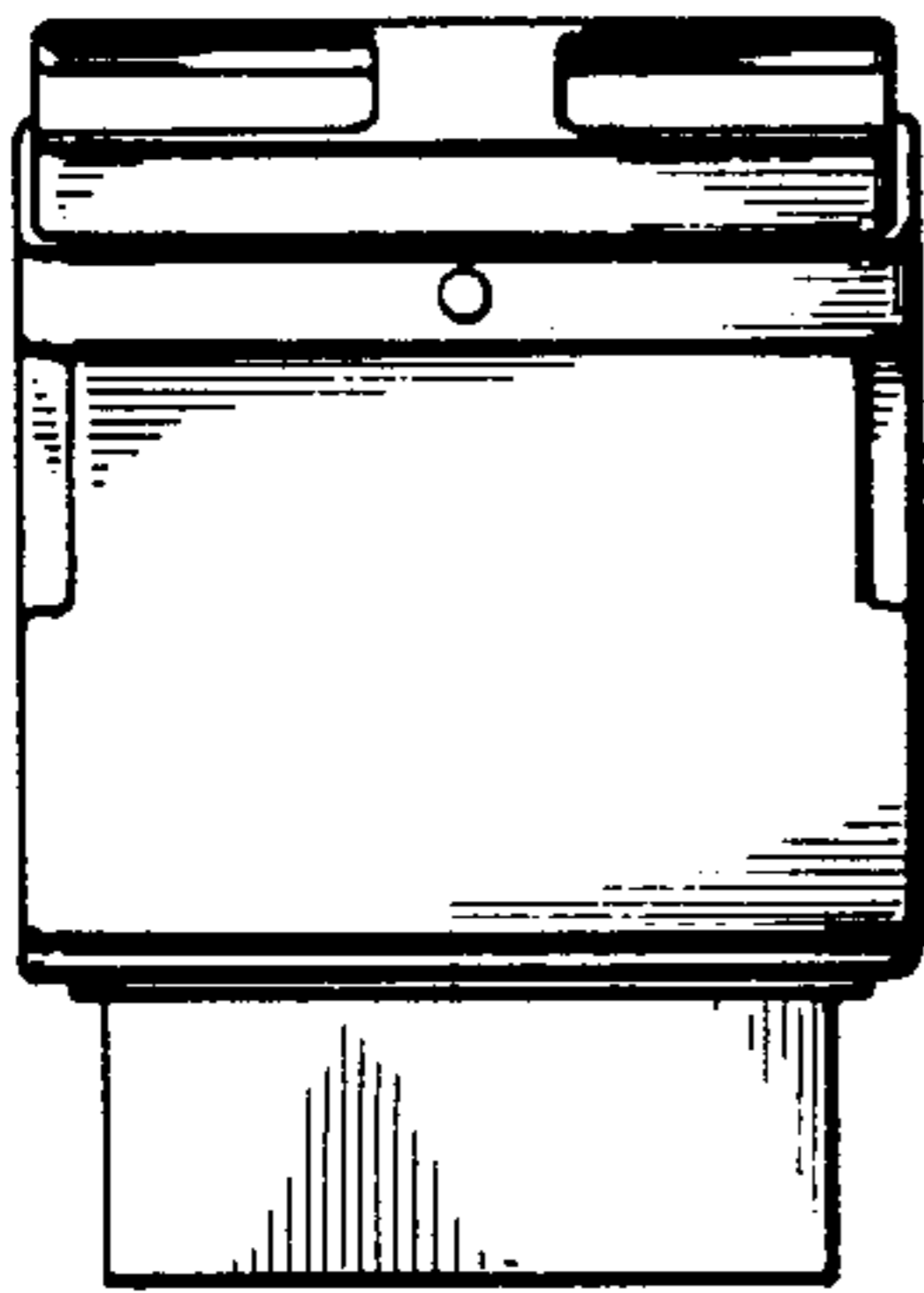
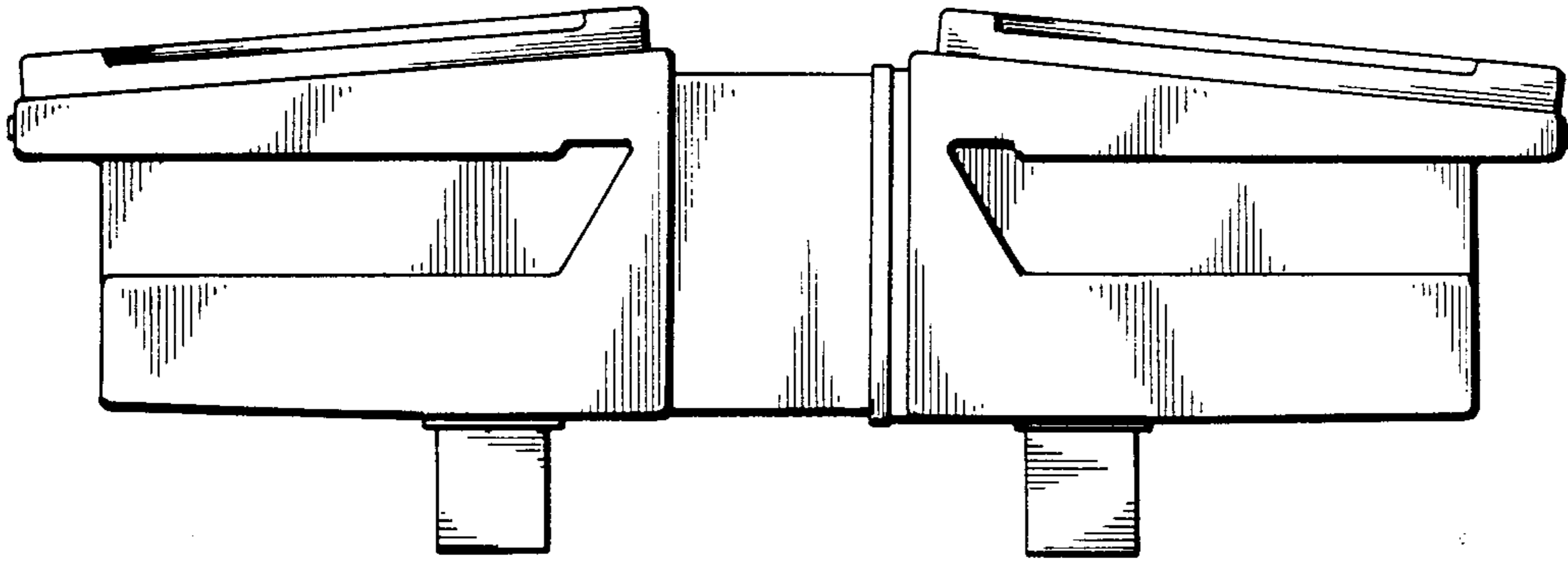

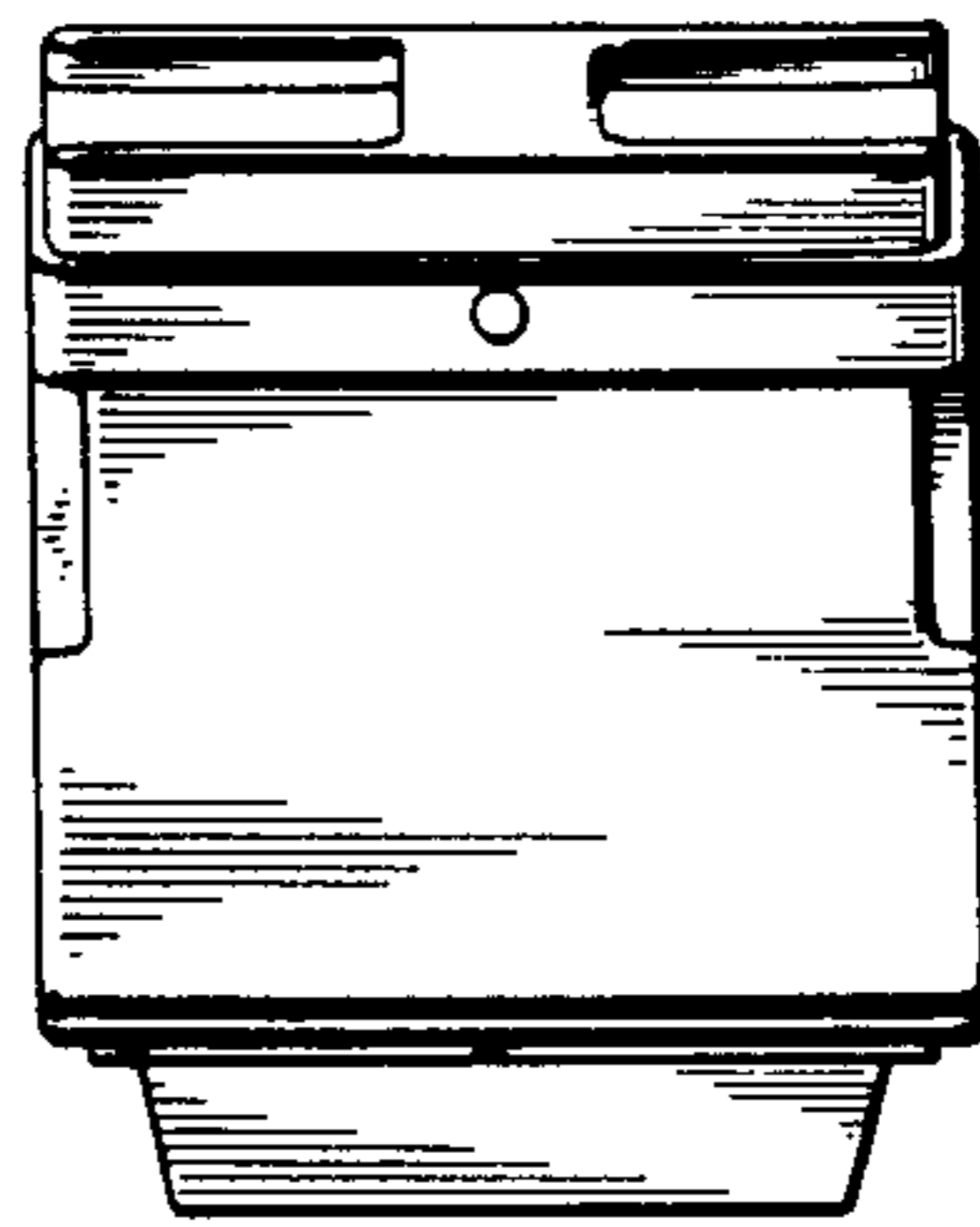

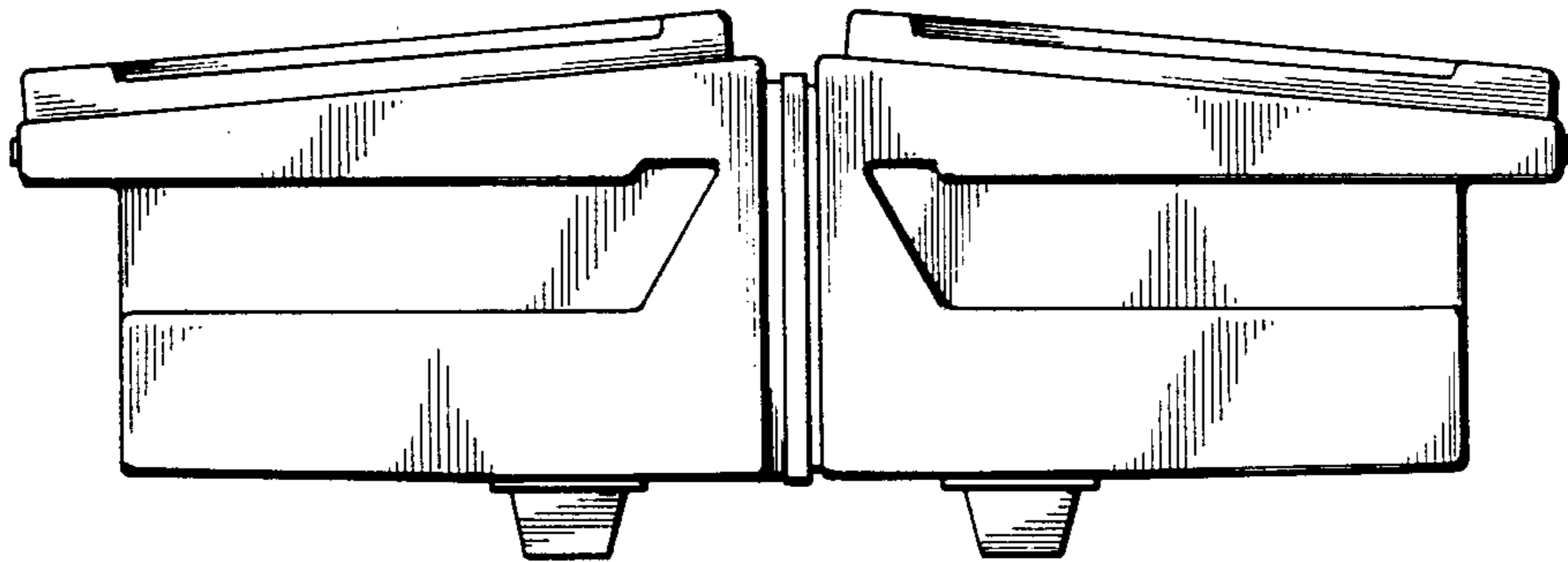
