DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a combined perpetual calendar and container for stationery articles and the like showing my new design;

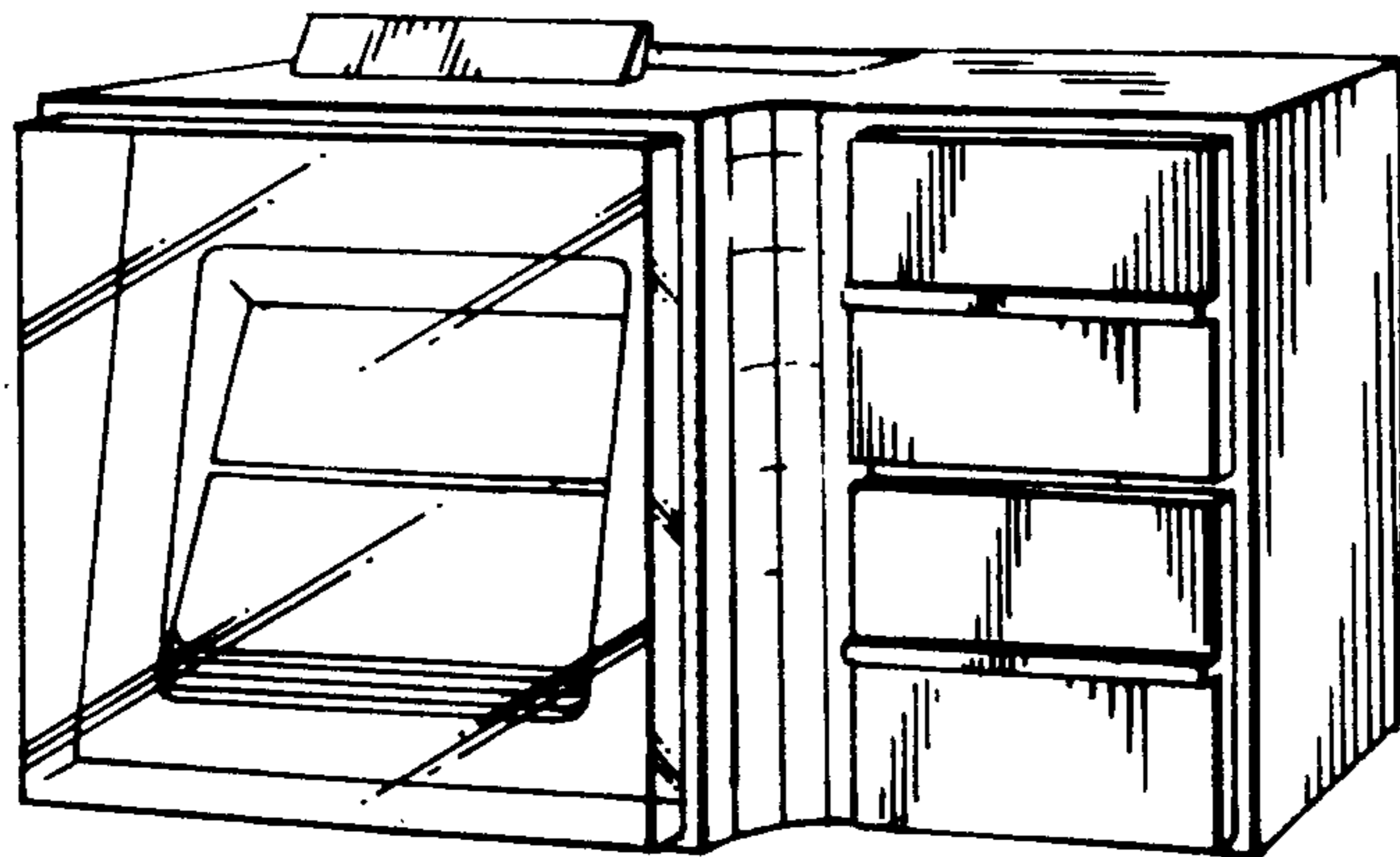
FIG. 2 is a left front perspective view thereof with the drawers partly open;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



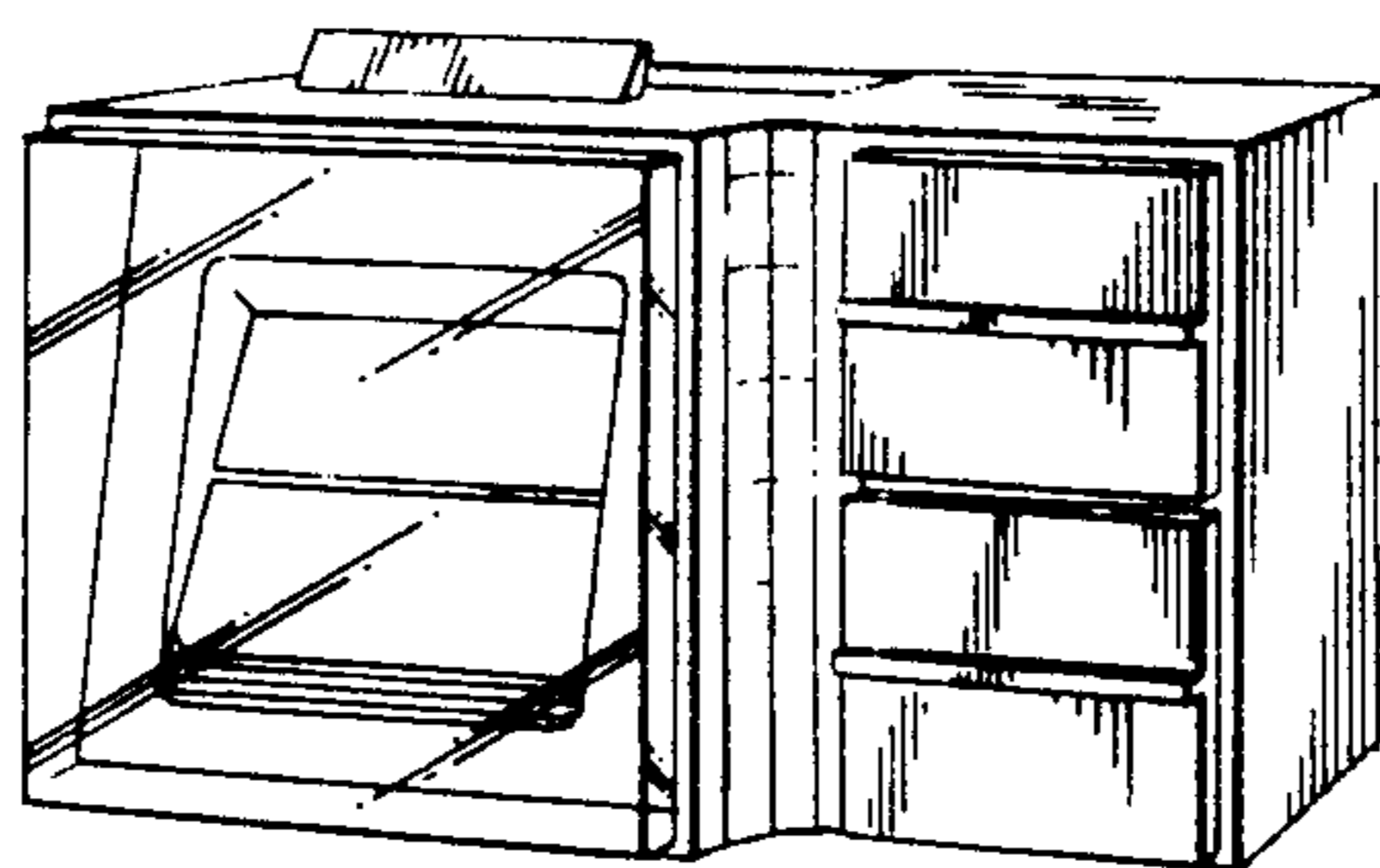

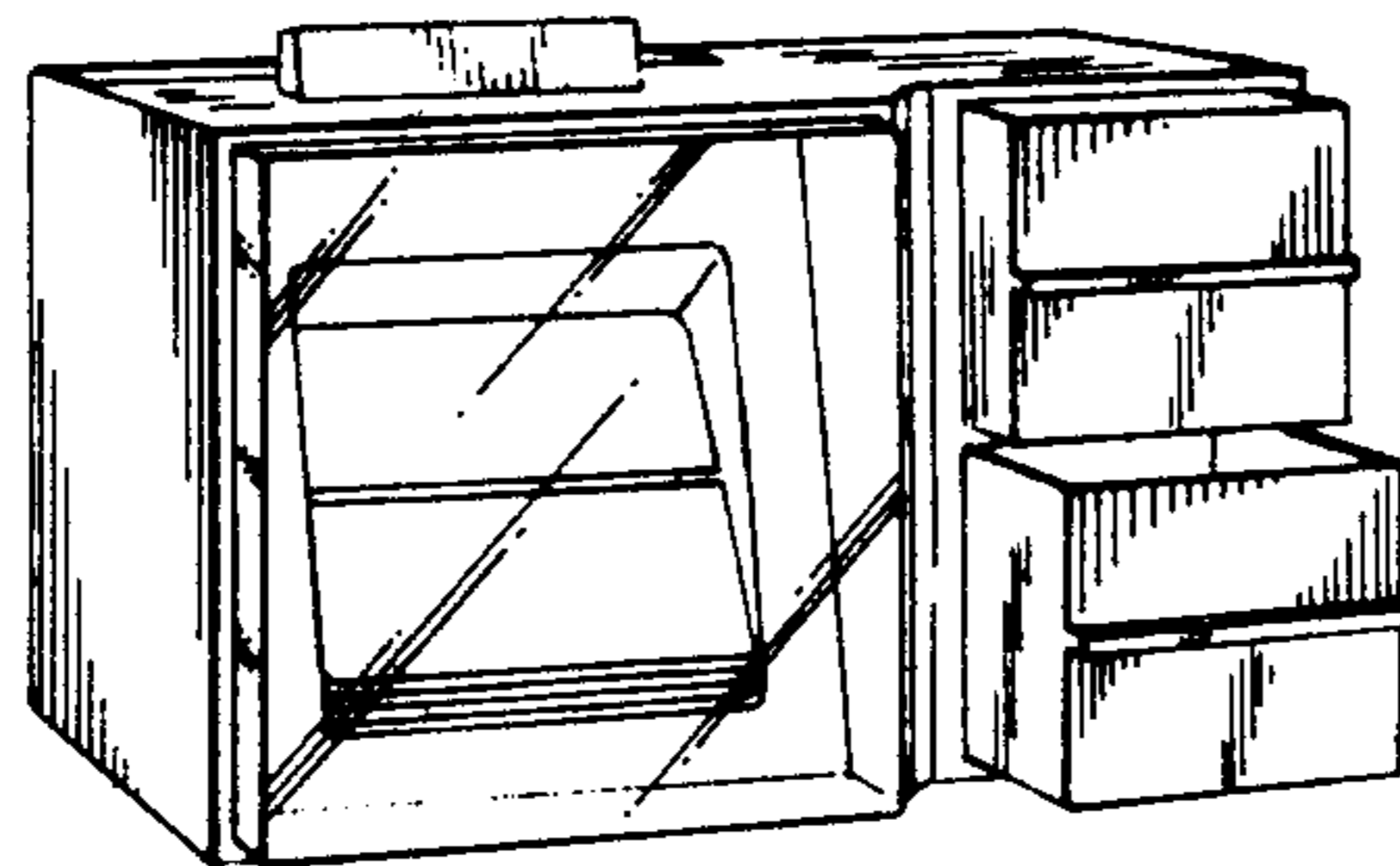

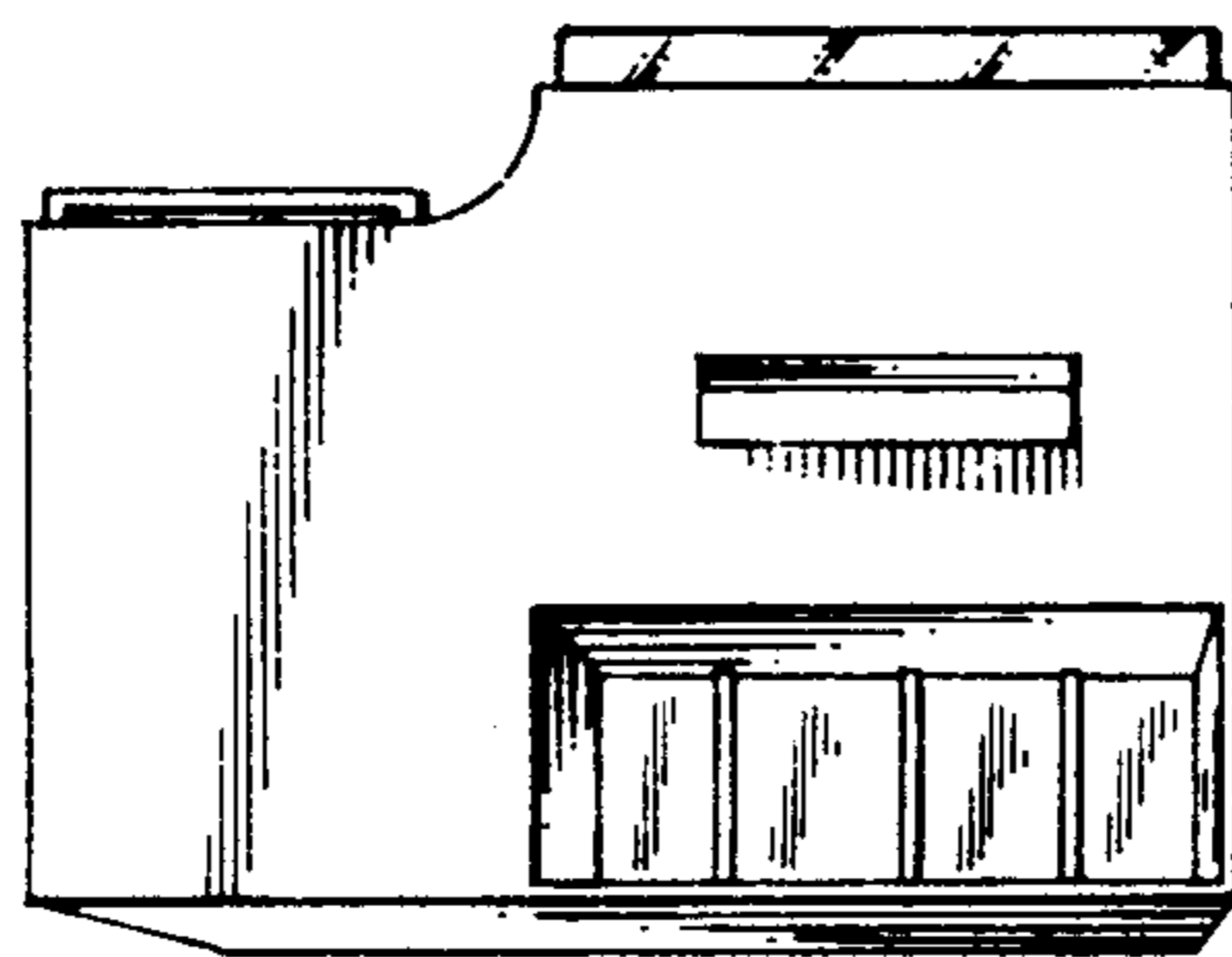

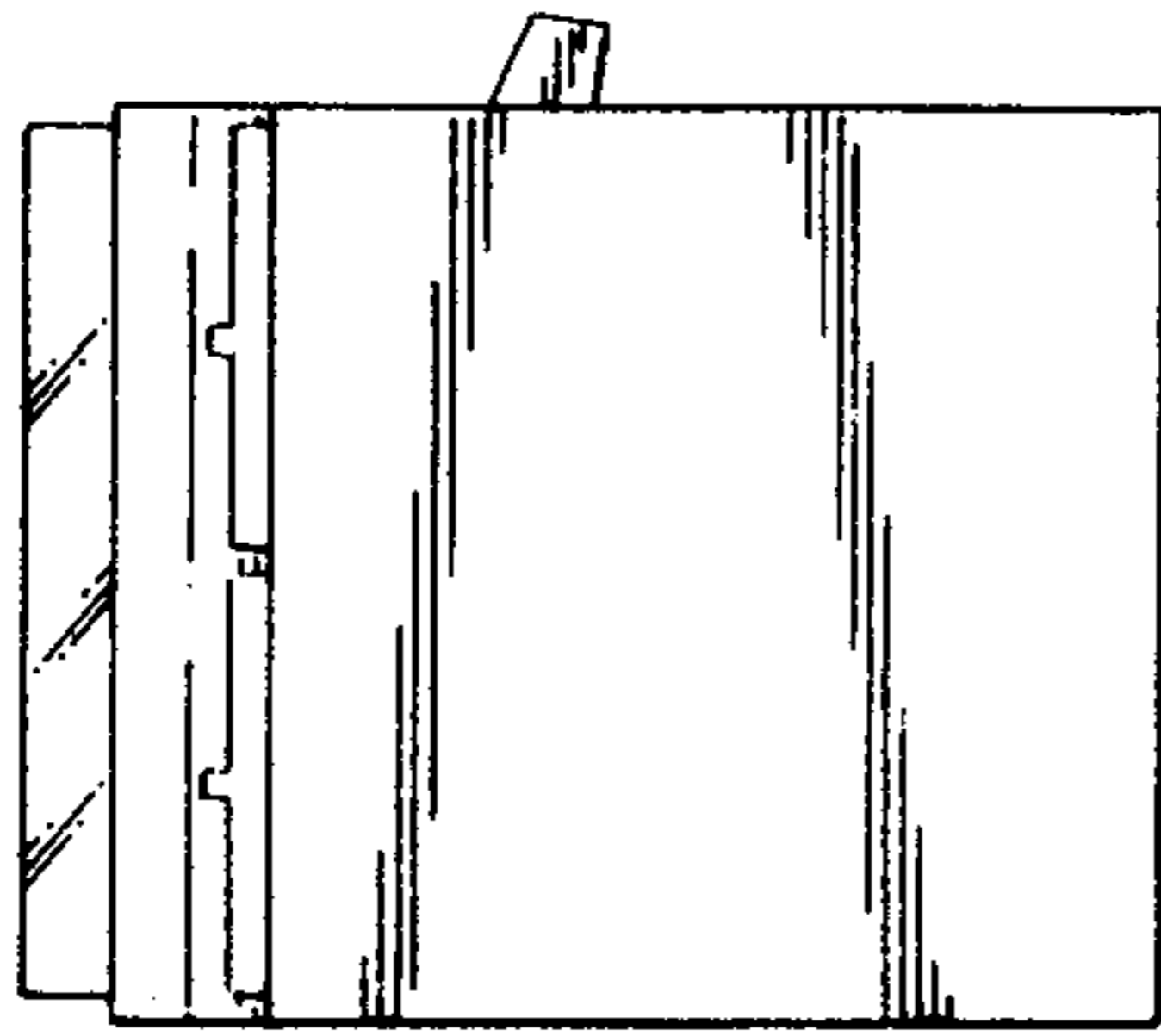

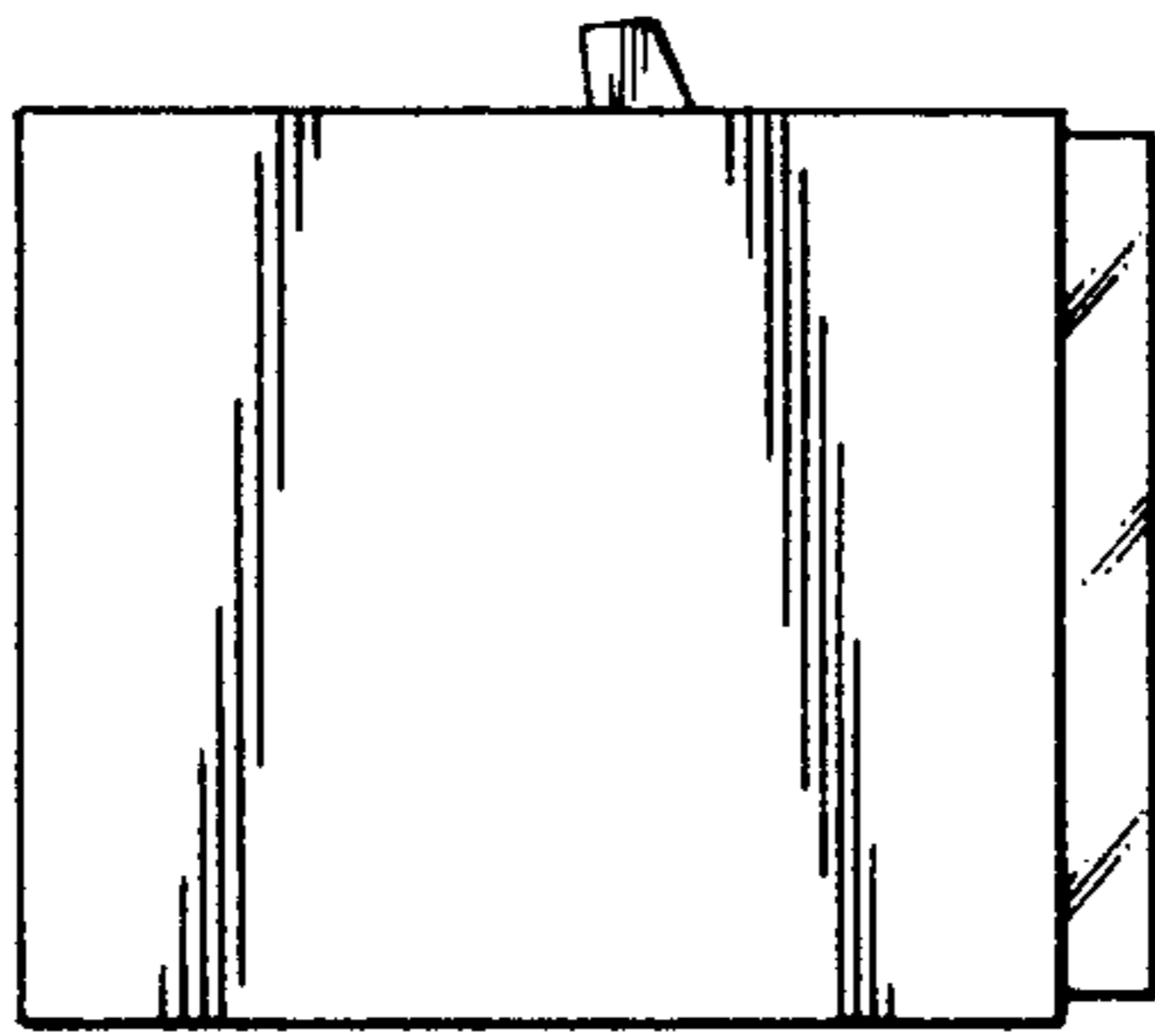

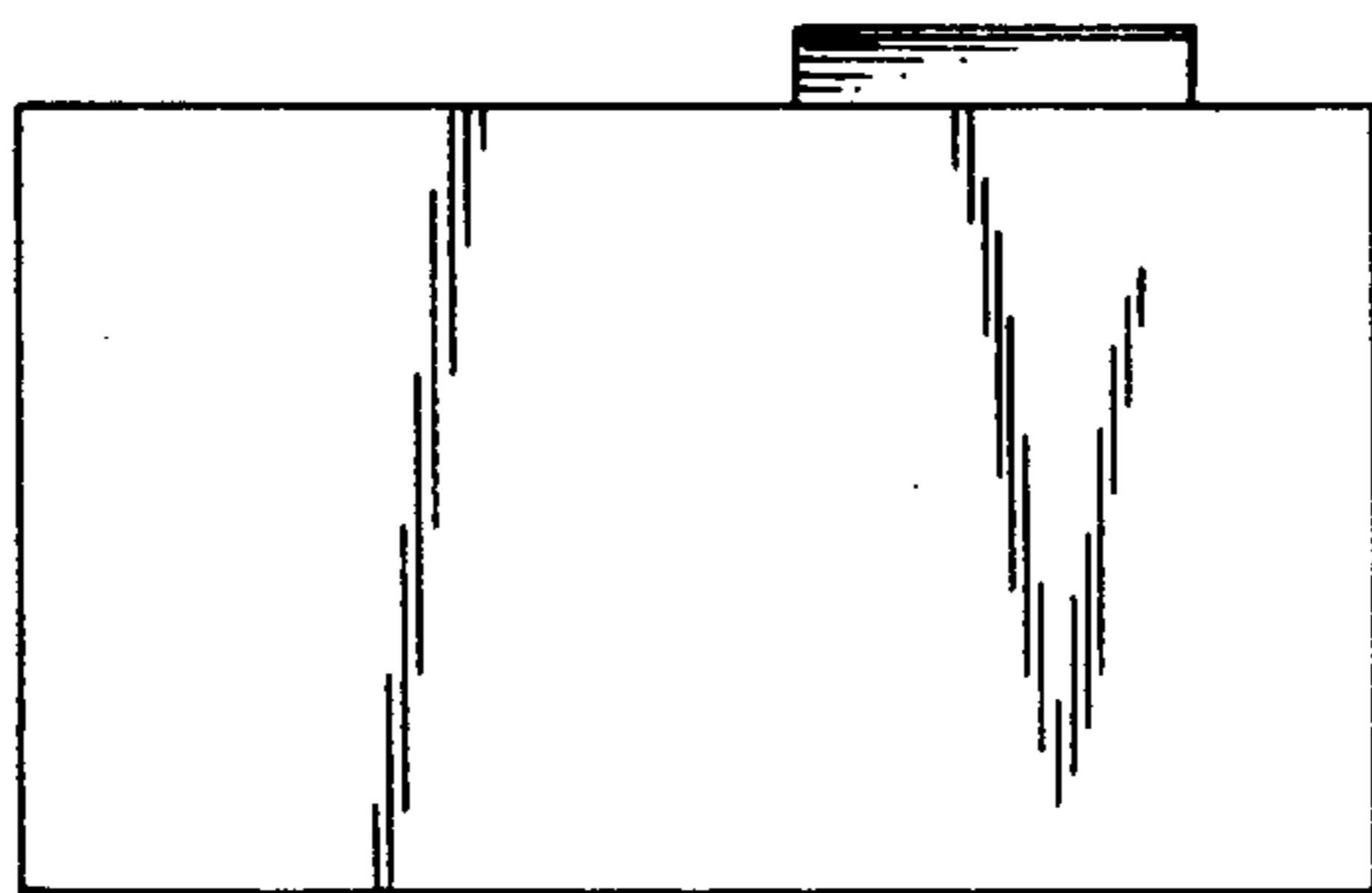
