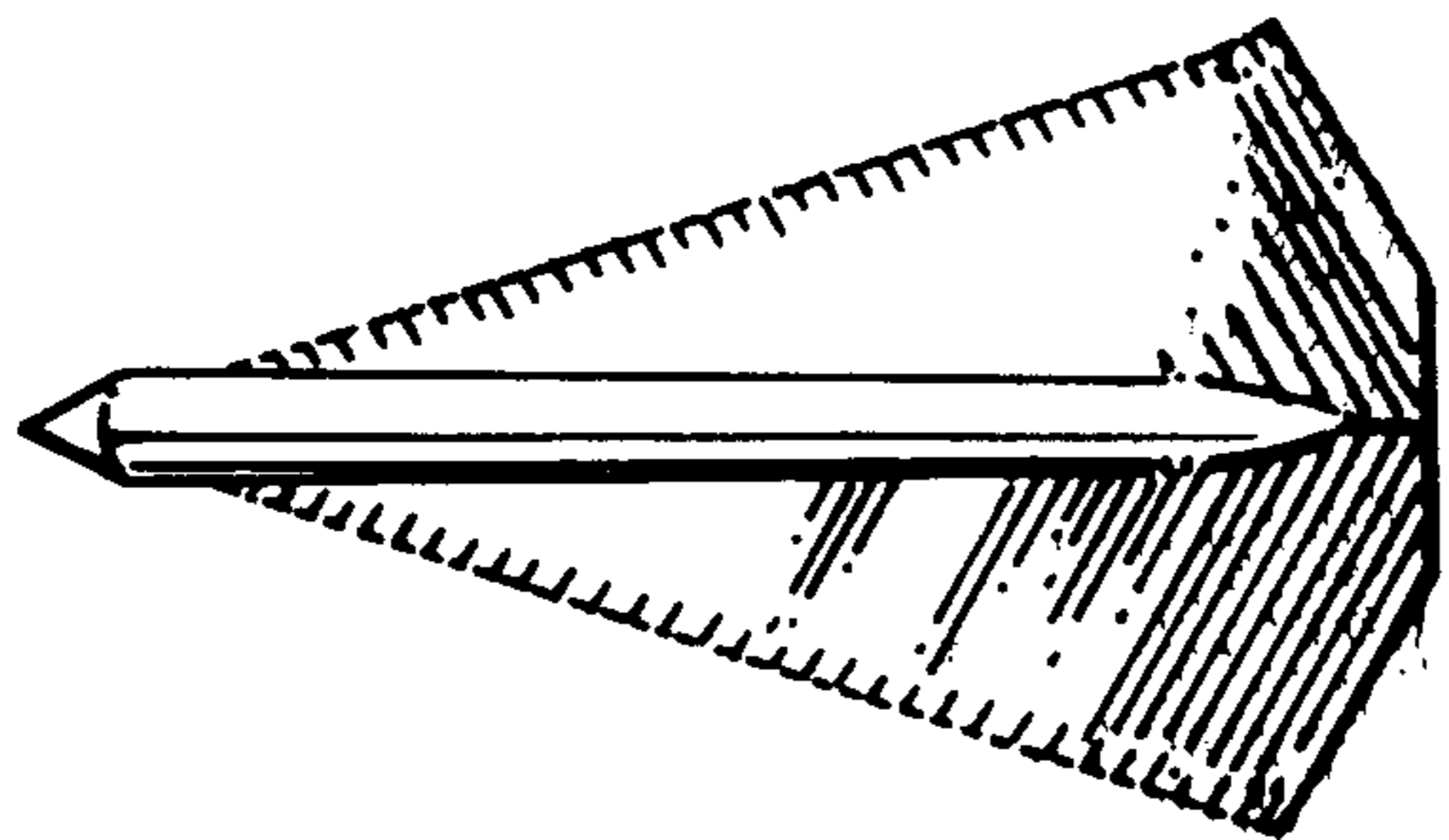

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a two-bladed arrow point, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a two-bladed arrow point embodying this invention;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation of the arrow point of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation of the arrow point of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation of the arrow point of FIG. 1.



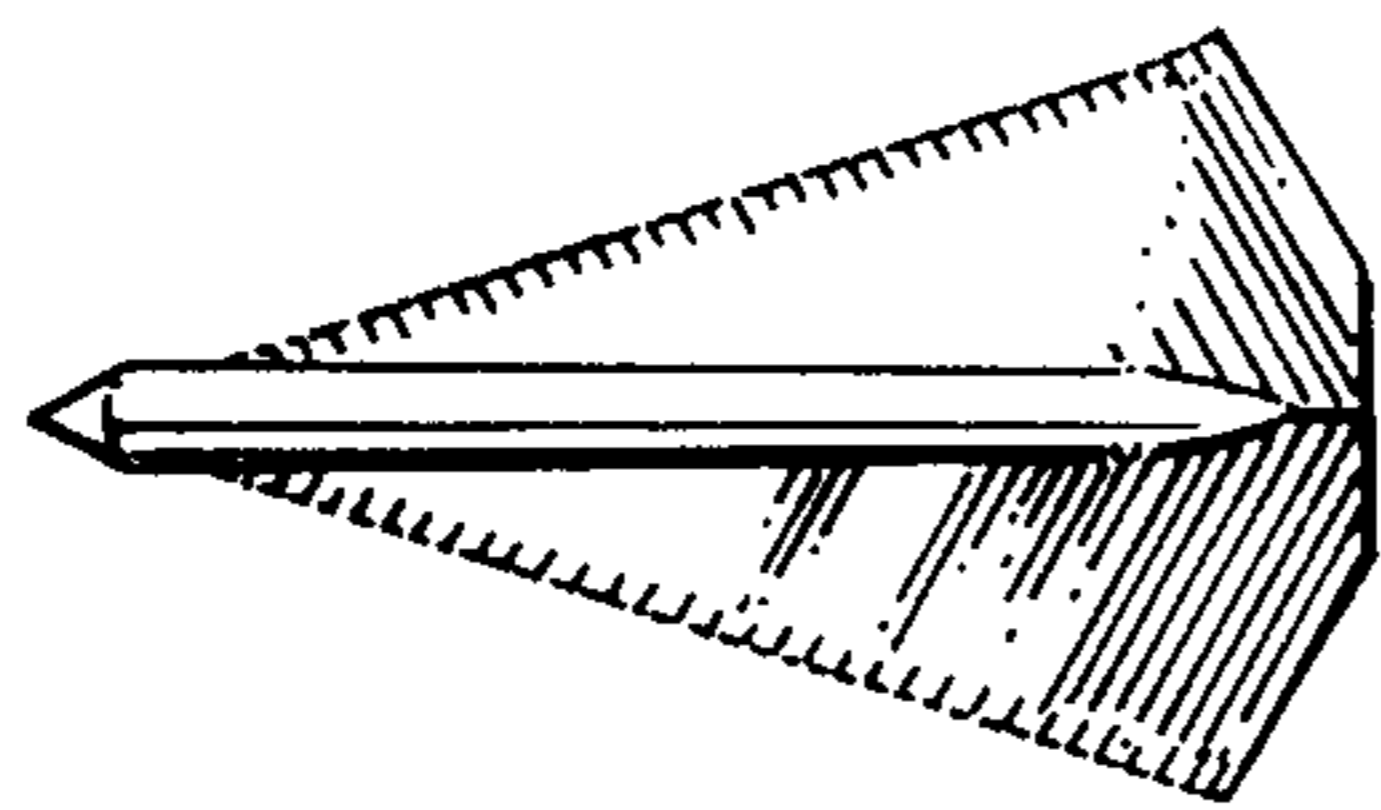
