[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my new design in the form of a sofa, and FIG. 2 is a side perspective view of the design of FIG. 1 shown in the form of a loveseat.

The end of the seat, not shown, is a mirror image of the end shown while the rear thereof is conventionally flat and unornamented.

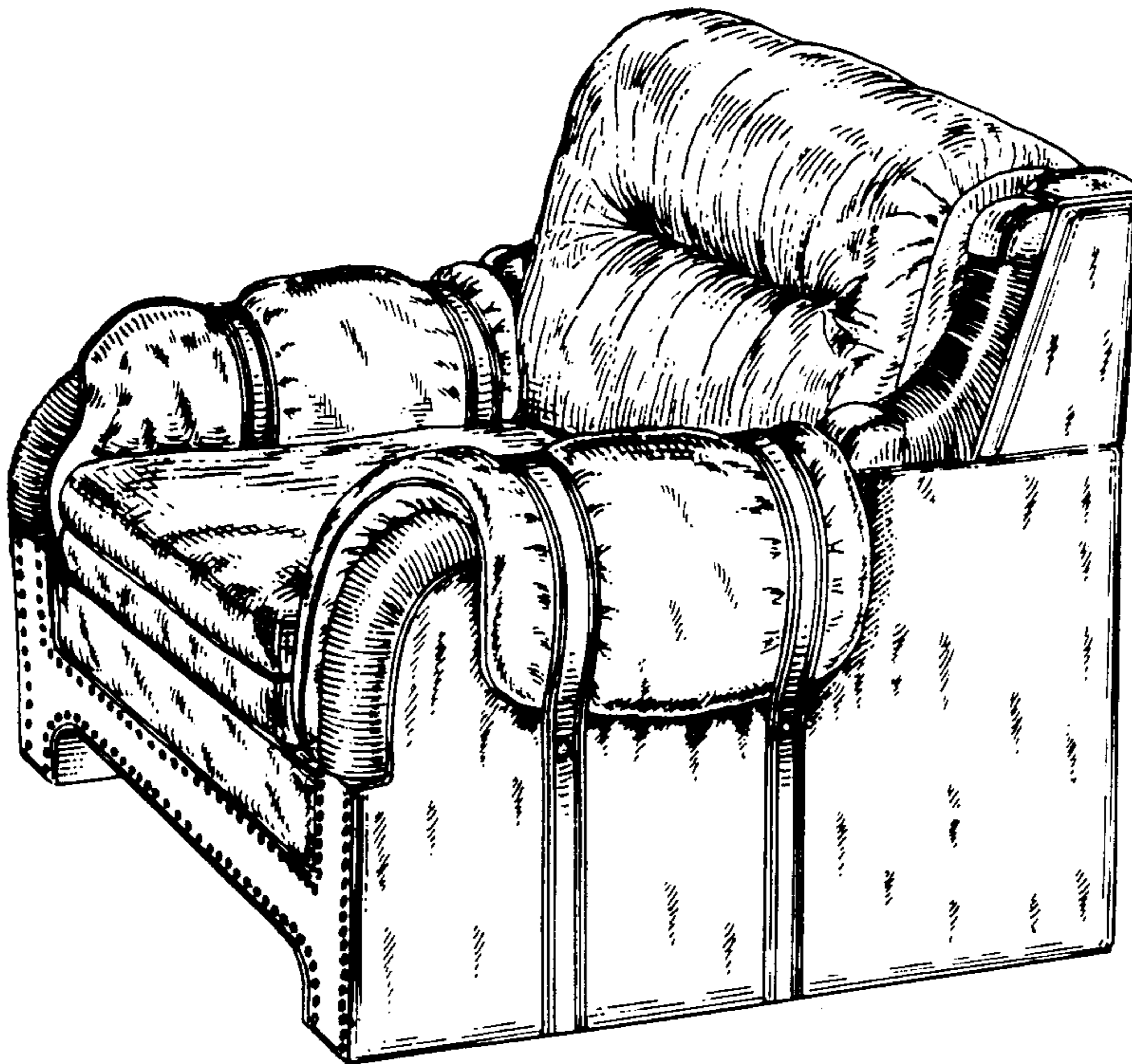

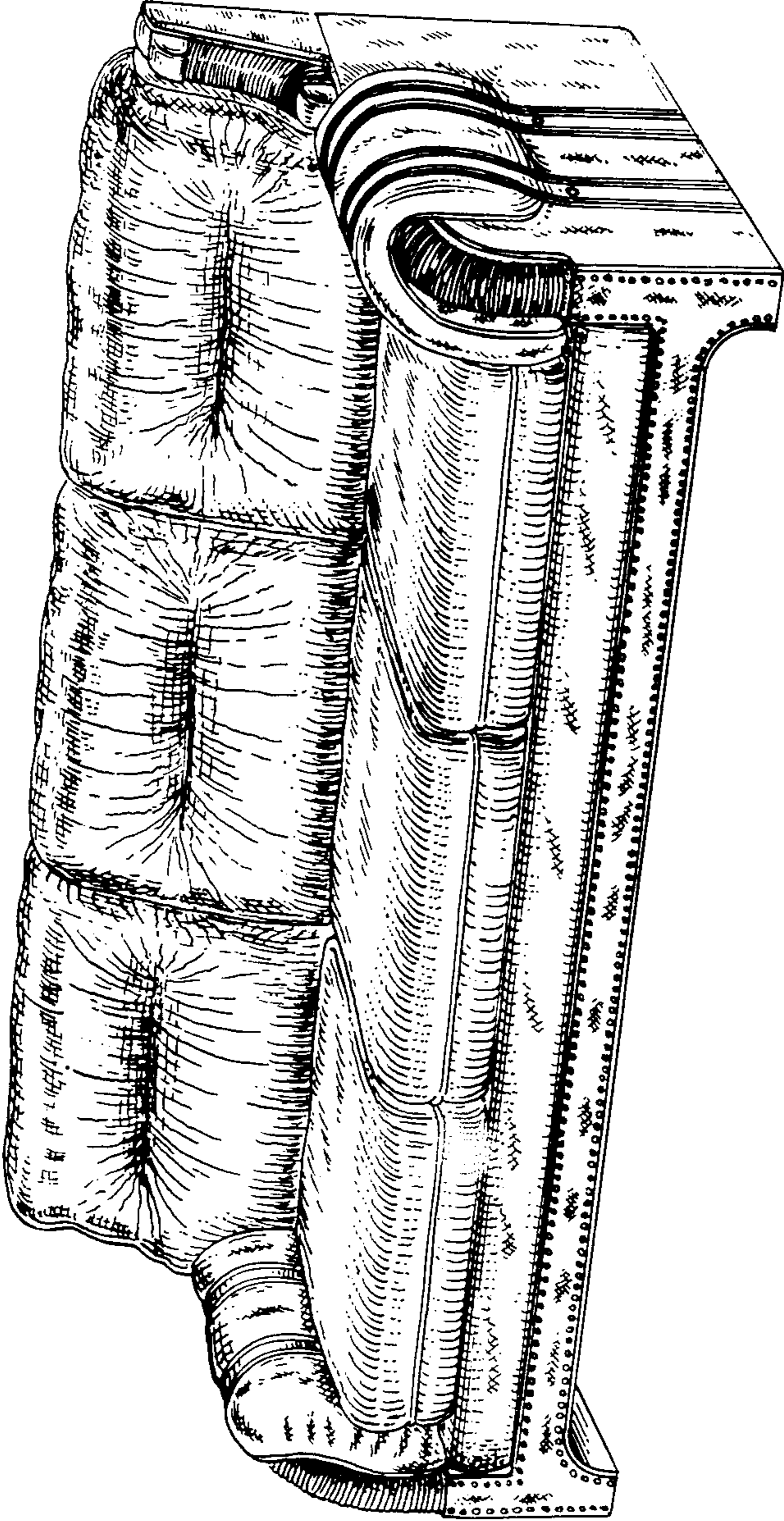
