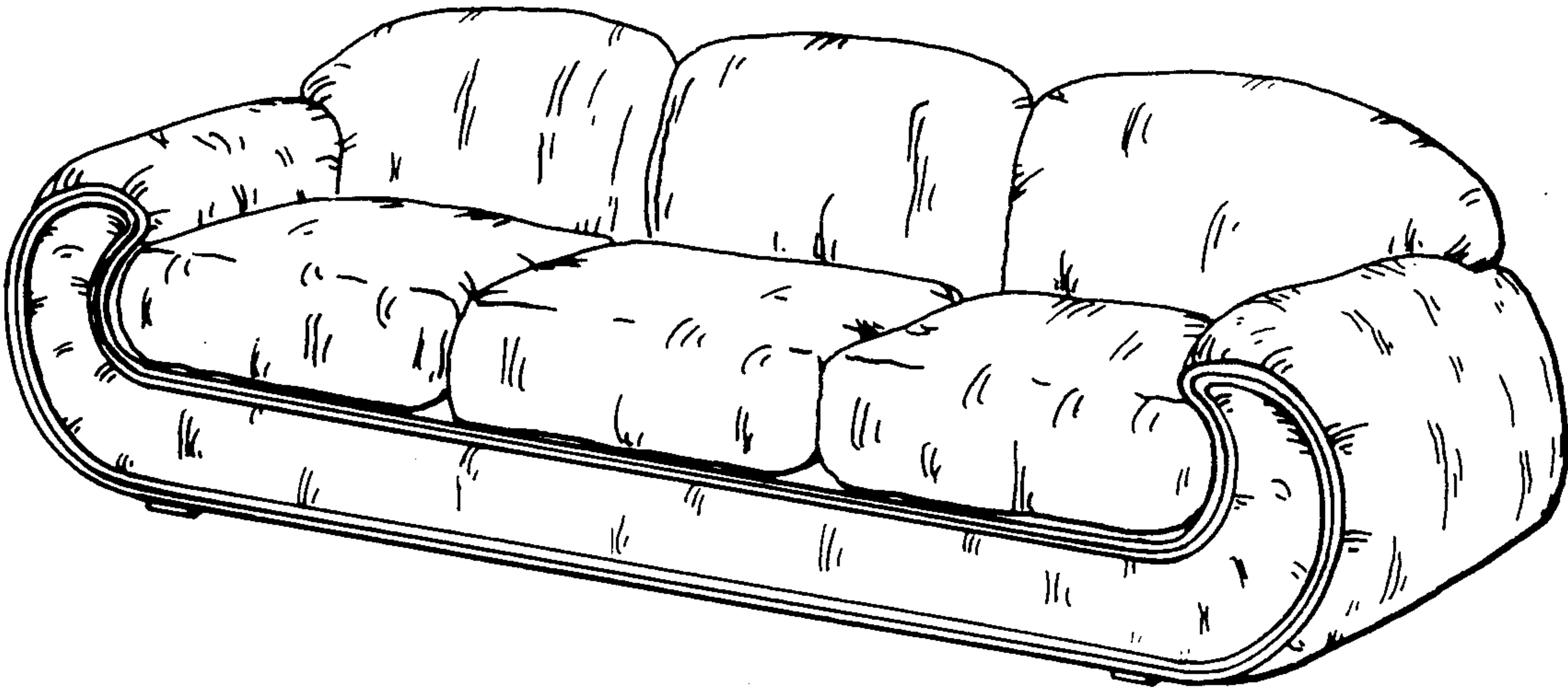

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing the design in the form of a sofa;

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the design in the form of an armchair.



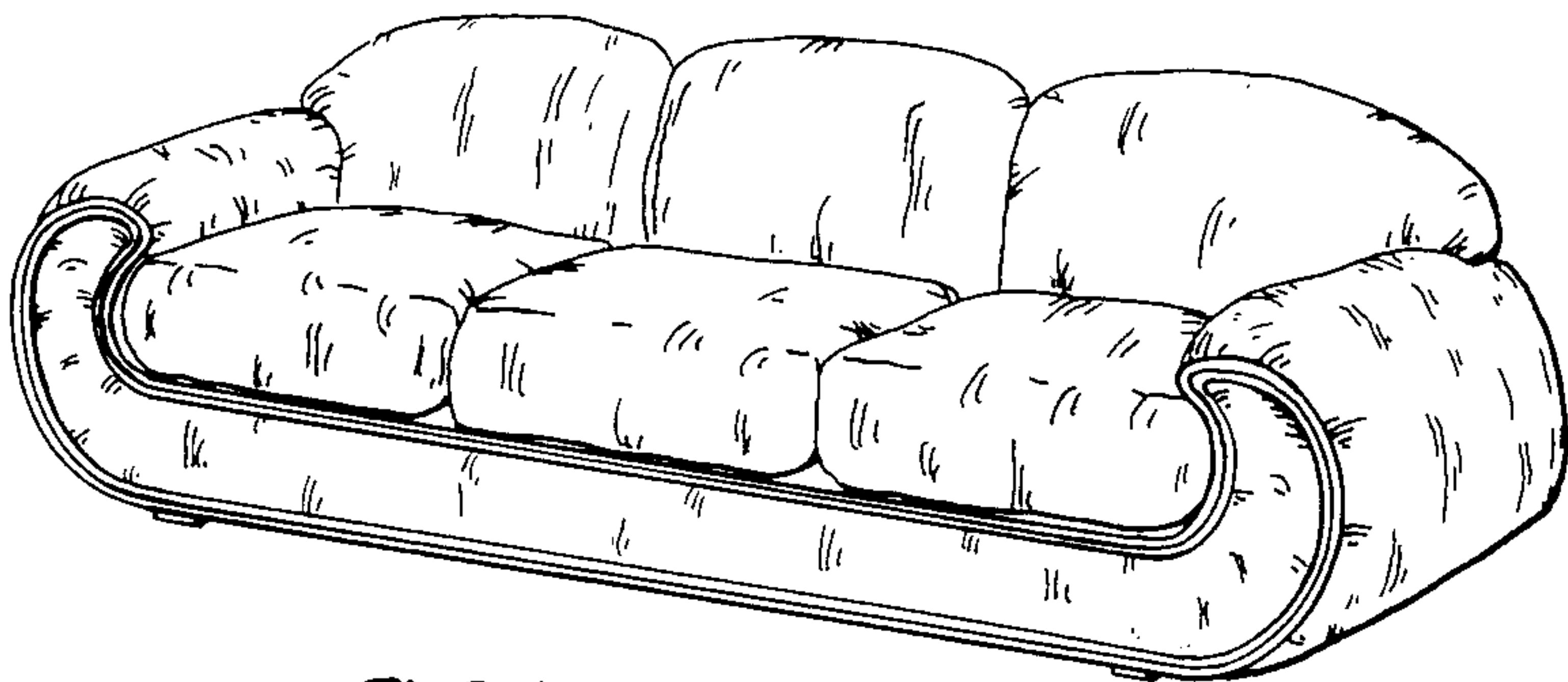

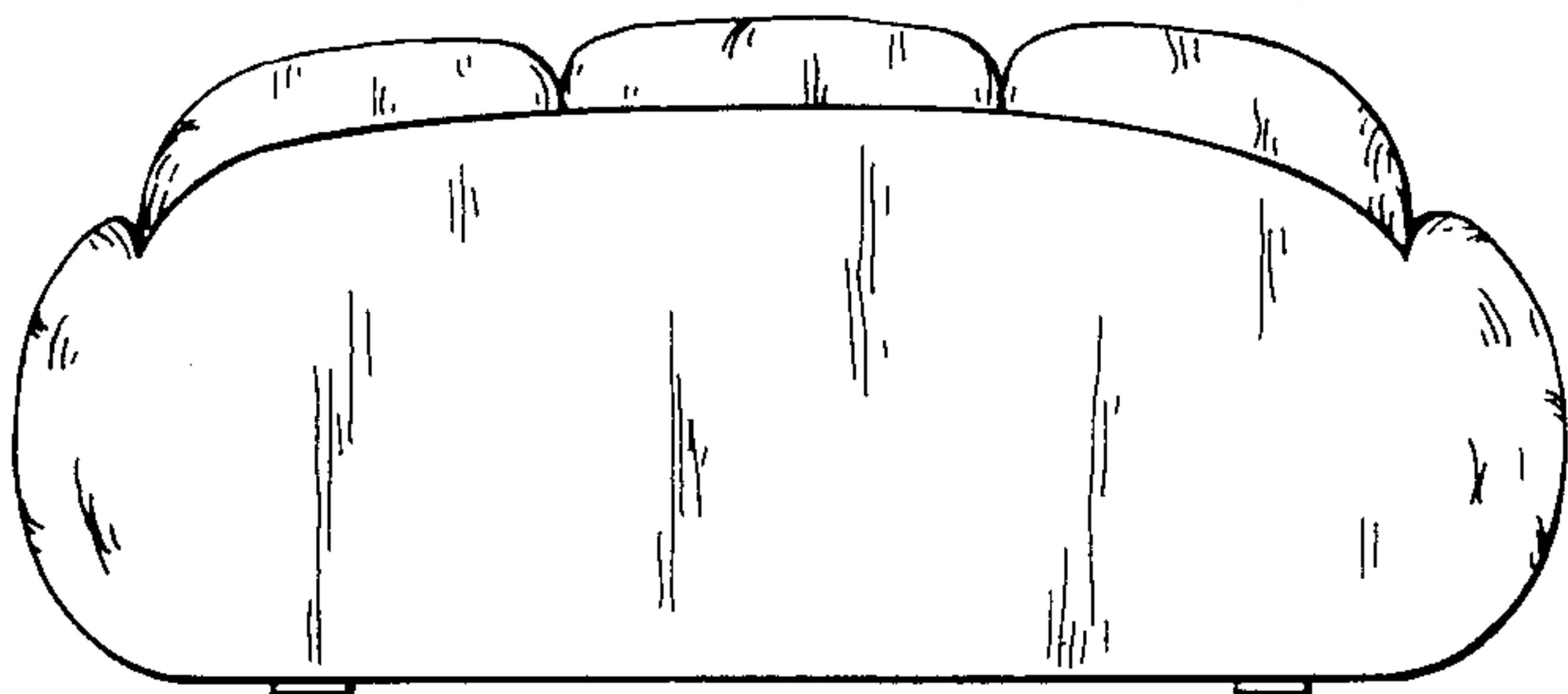

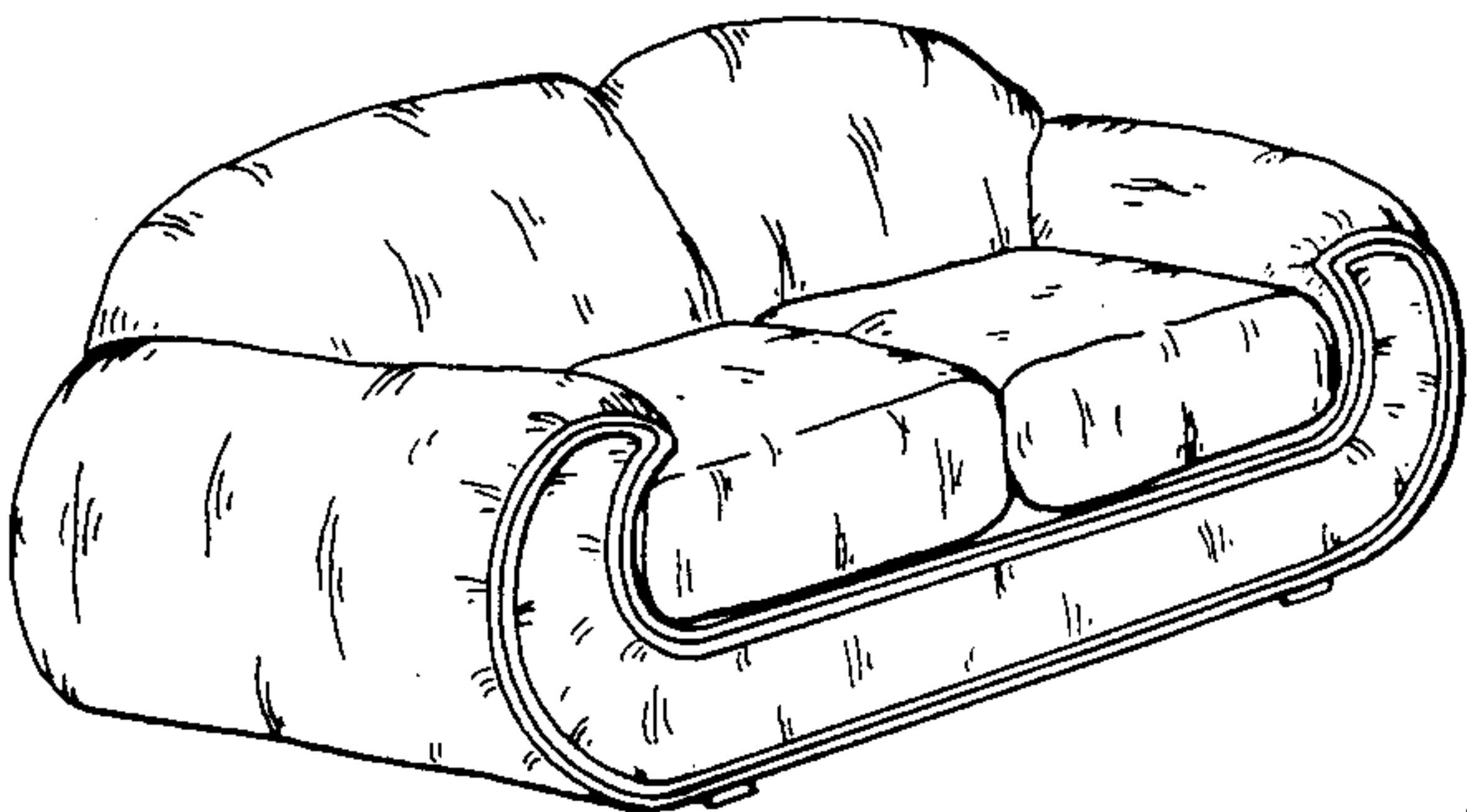

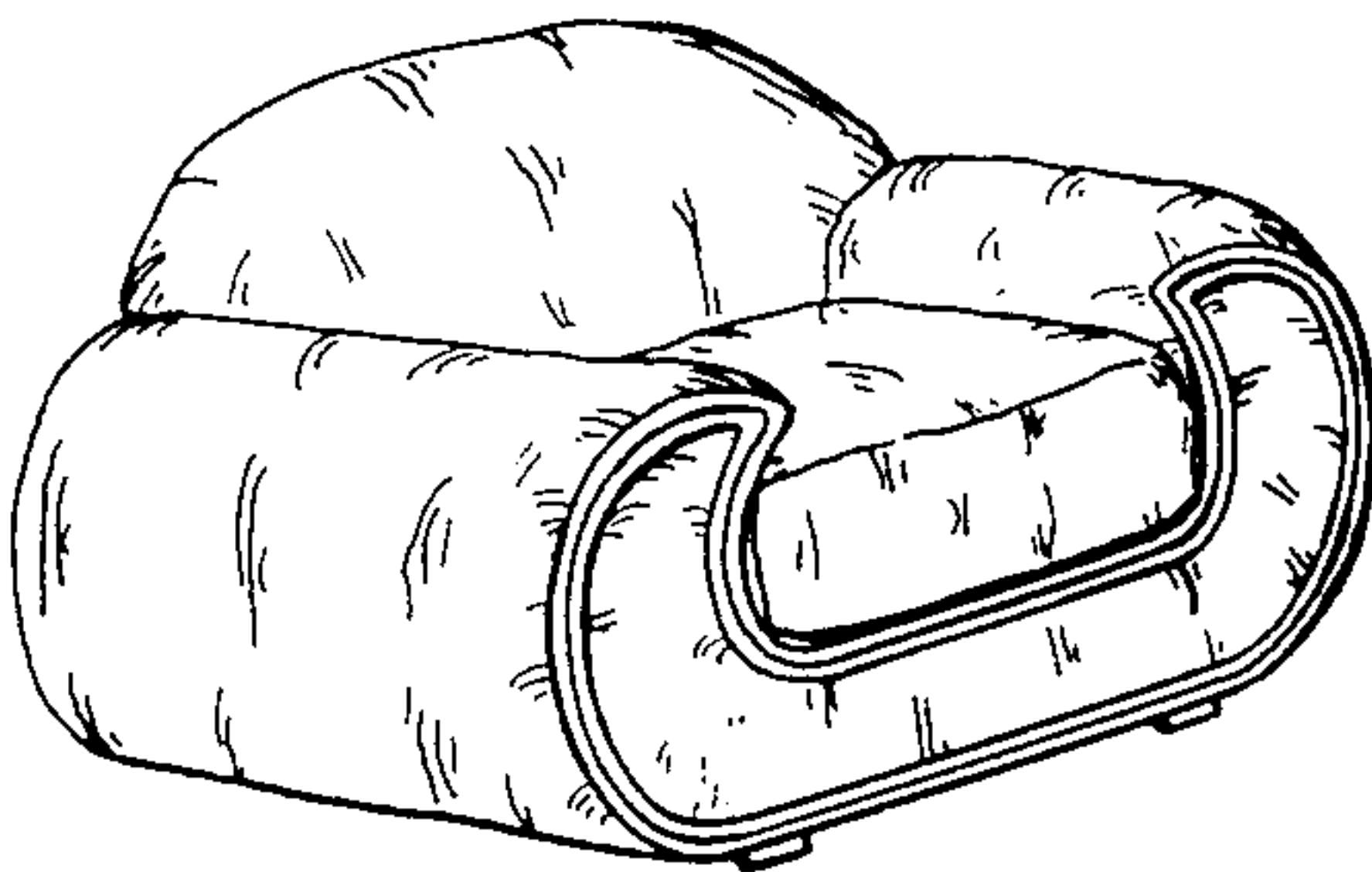
