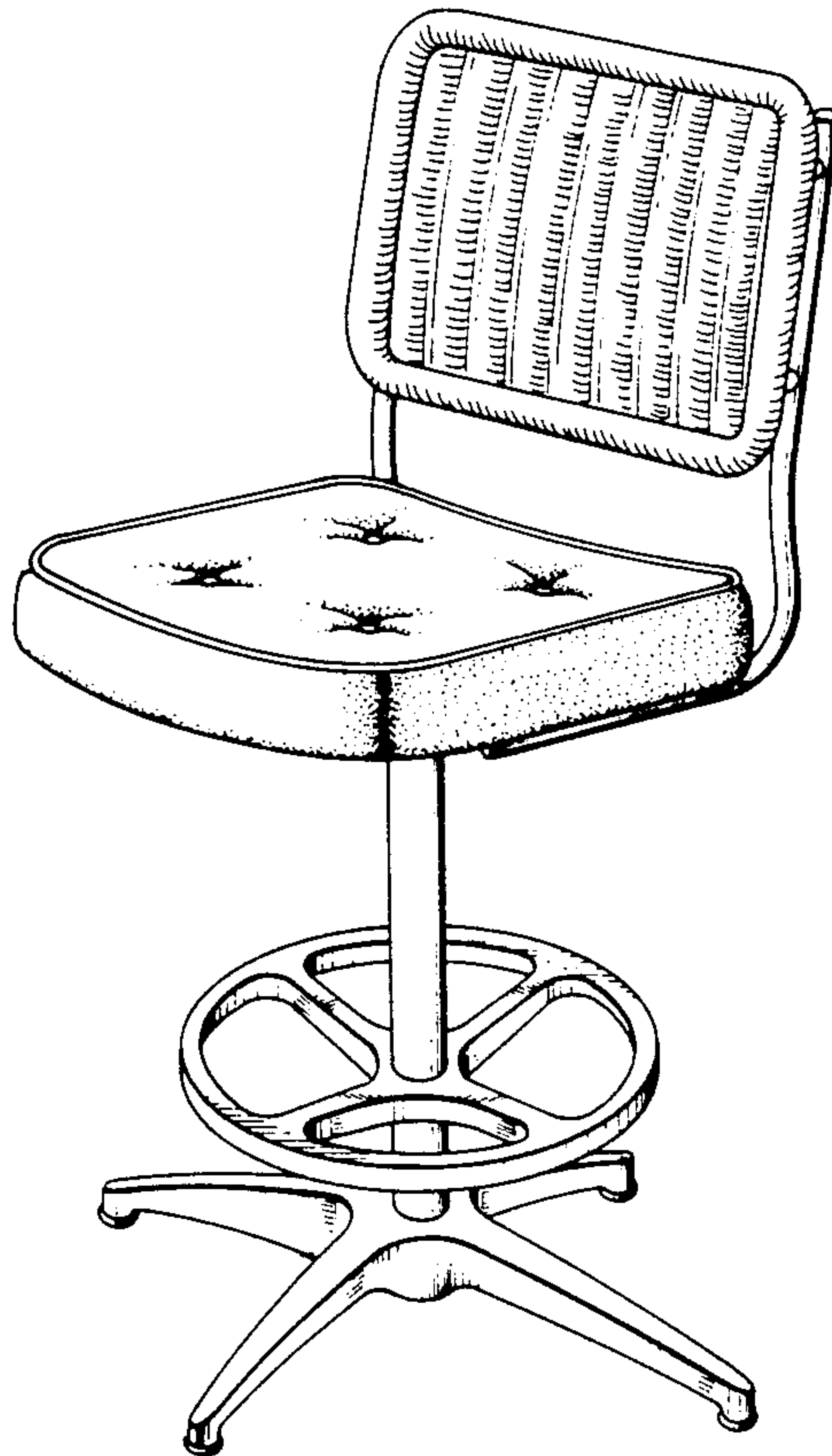
The ornamental design for a bar stool, as shown and described.

The design is characterized by the overall visual impact of the seat and backrest unit in combination with the relatively low position of the footrest.



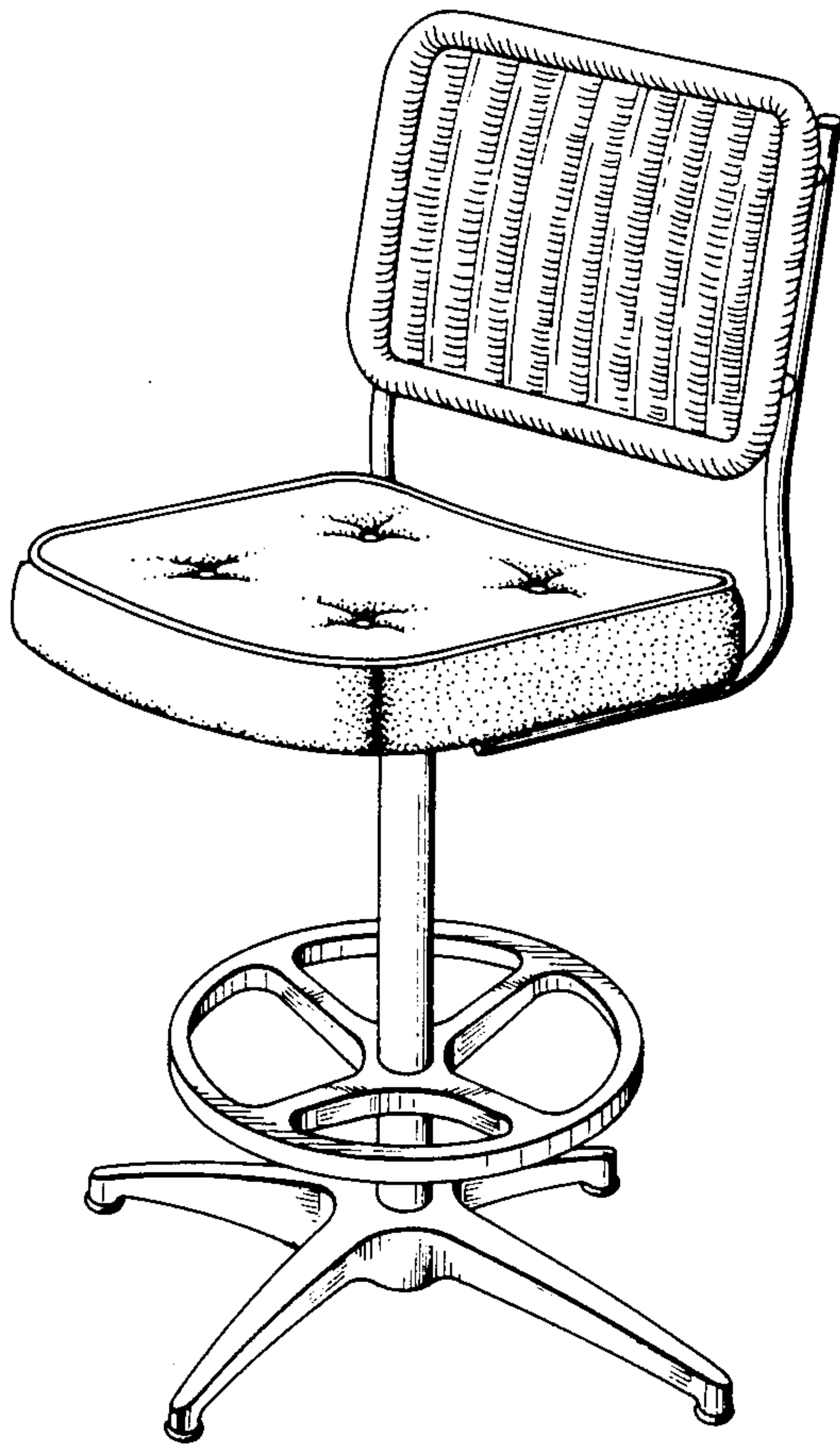

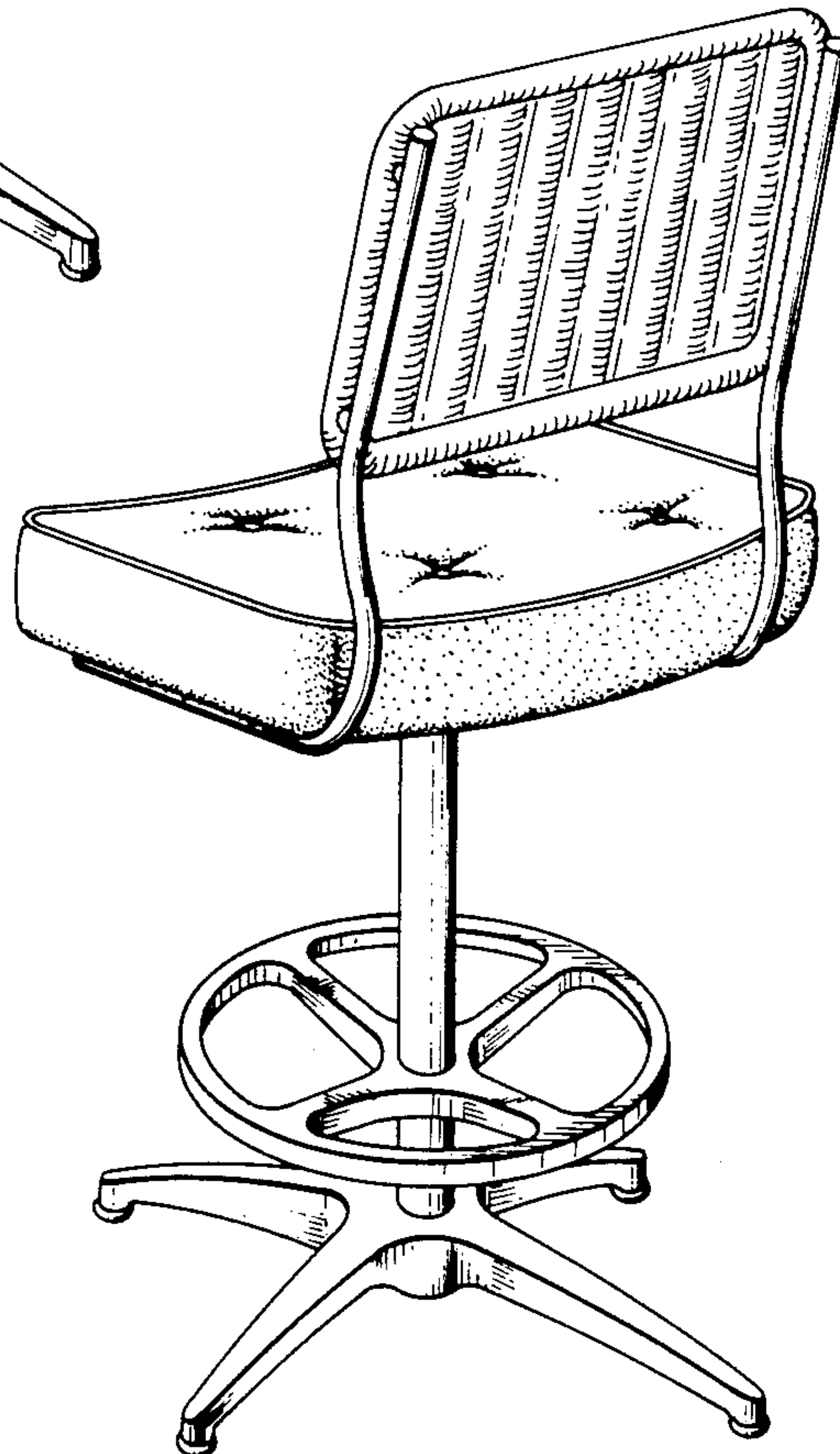
