

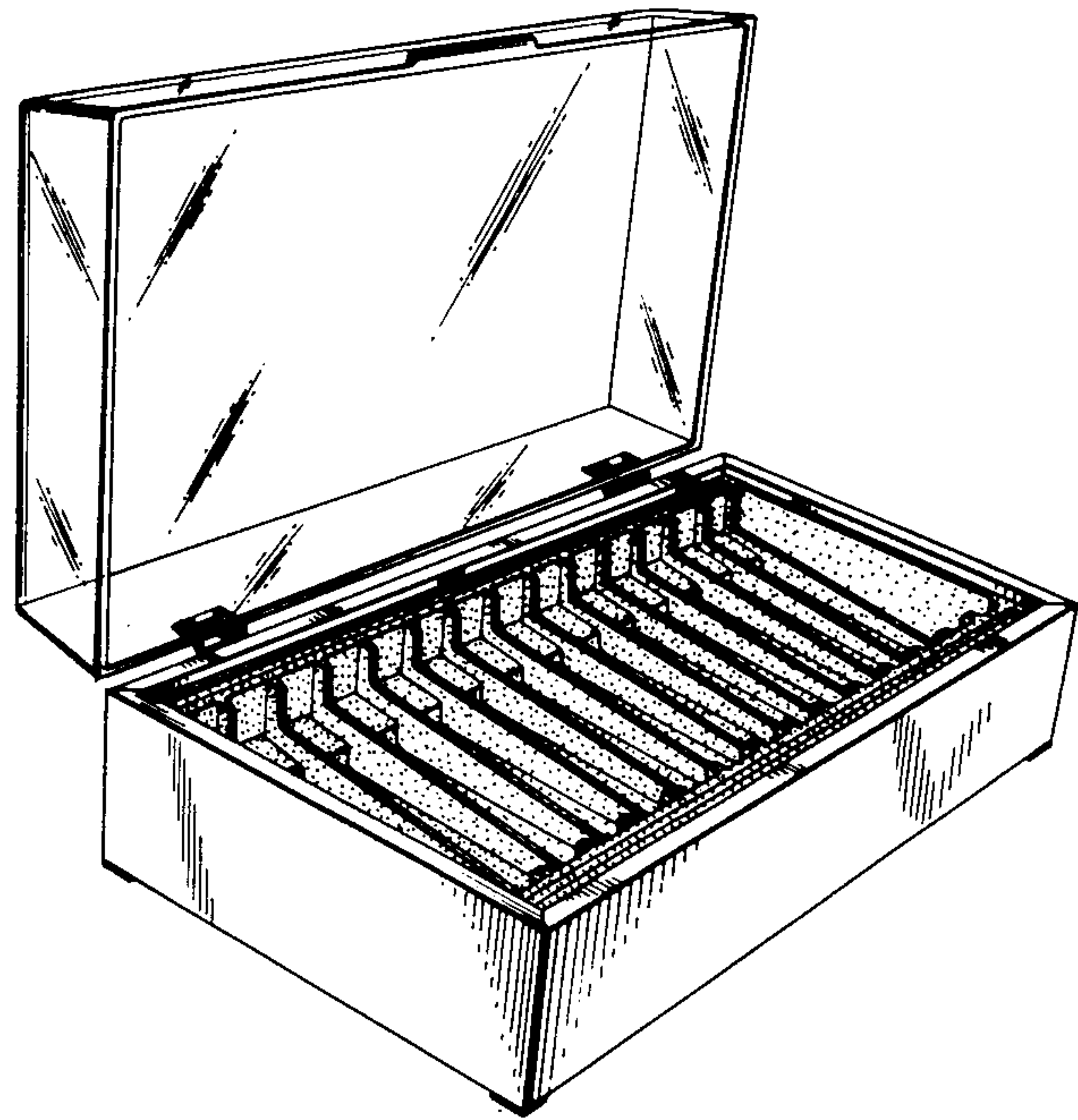

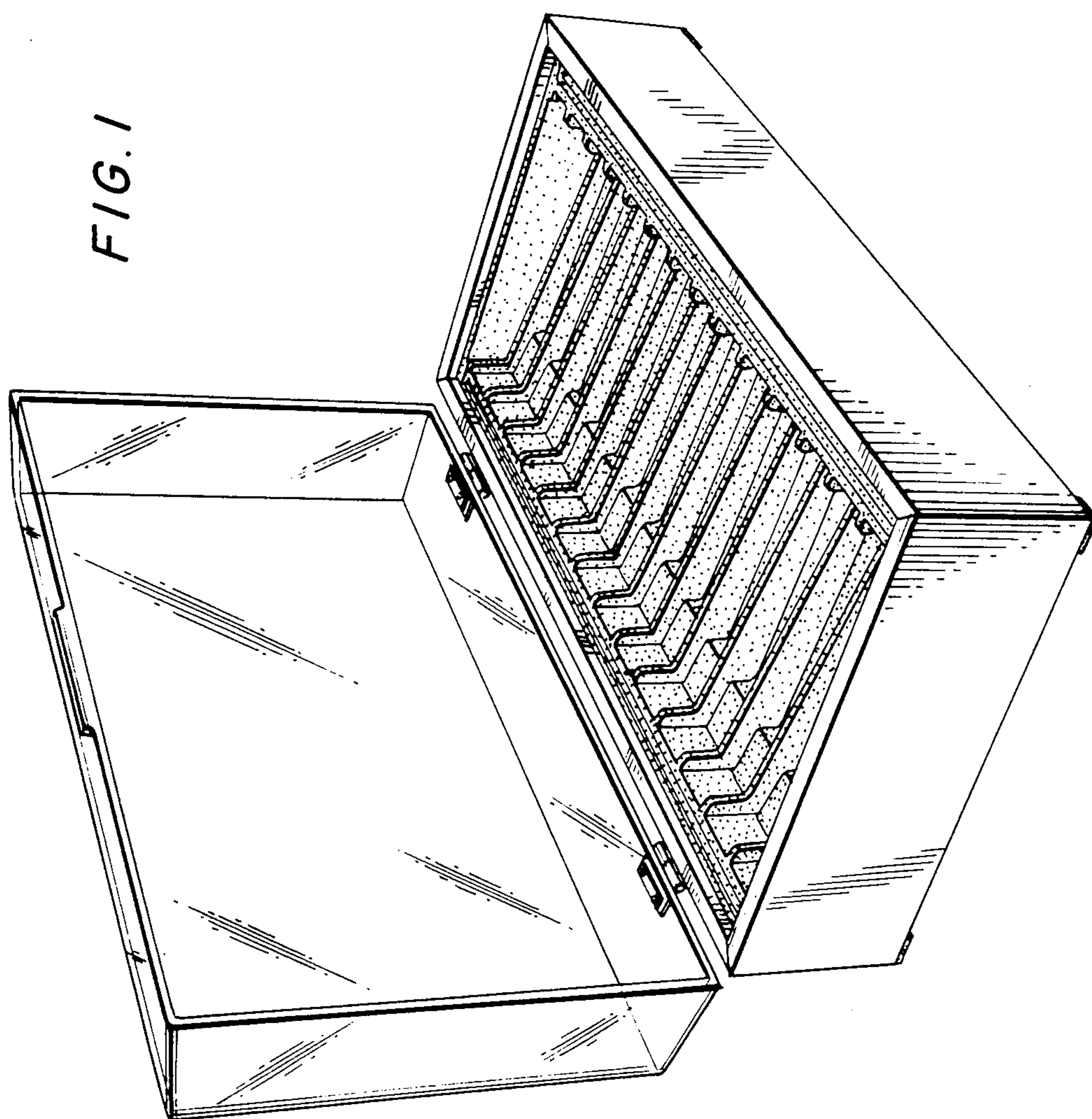

DESCRIPTION  
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a video-tape cabinet  
showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, with the cover in a  
closed position;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left  
side being a mirror image thereof.





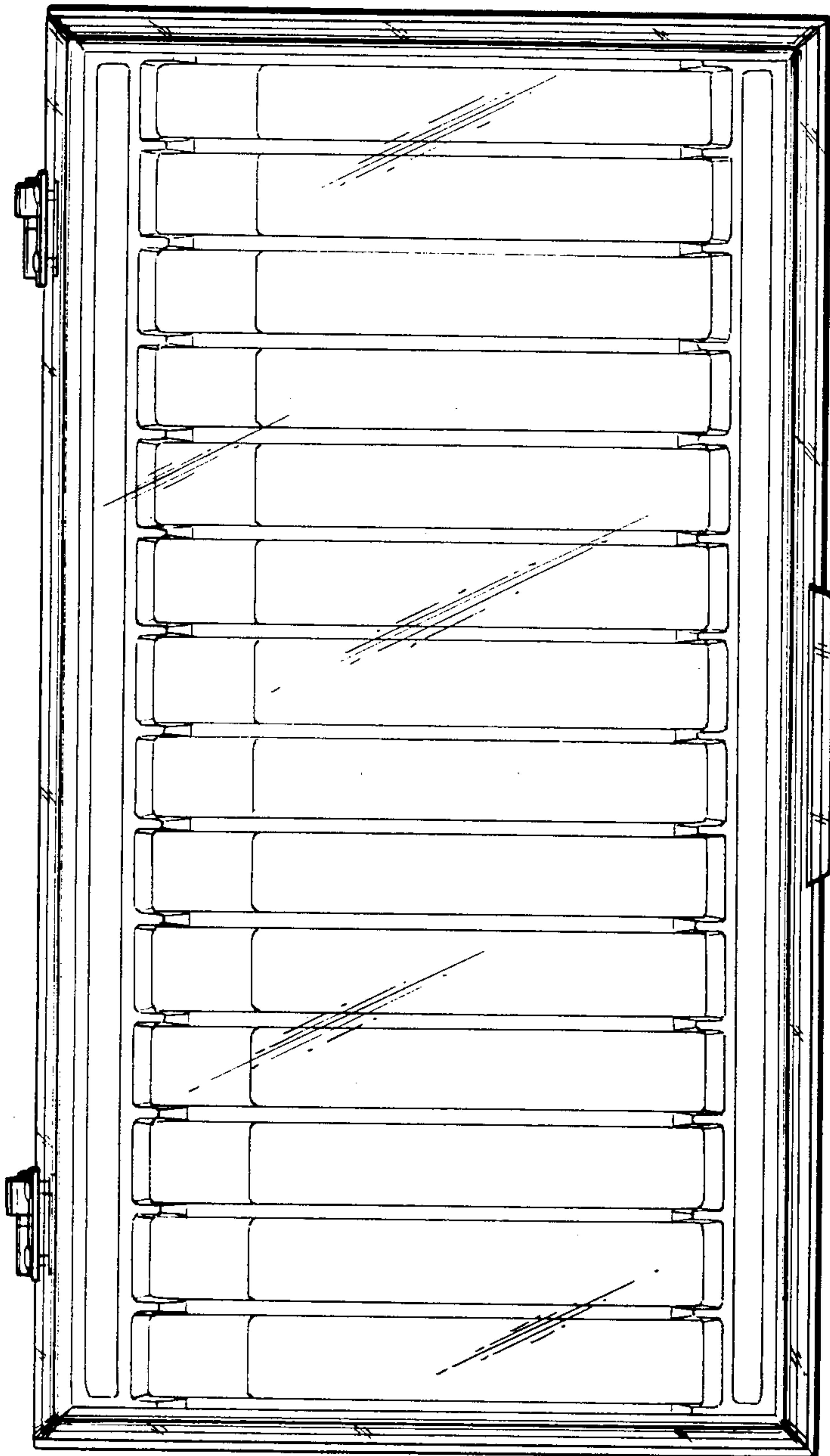

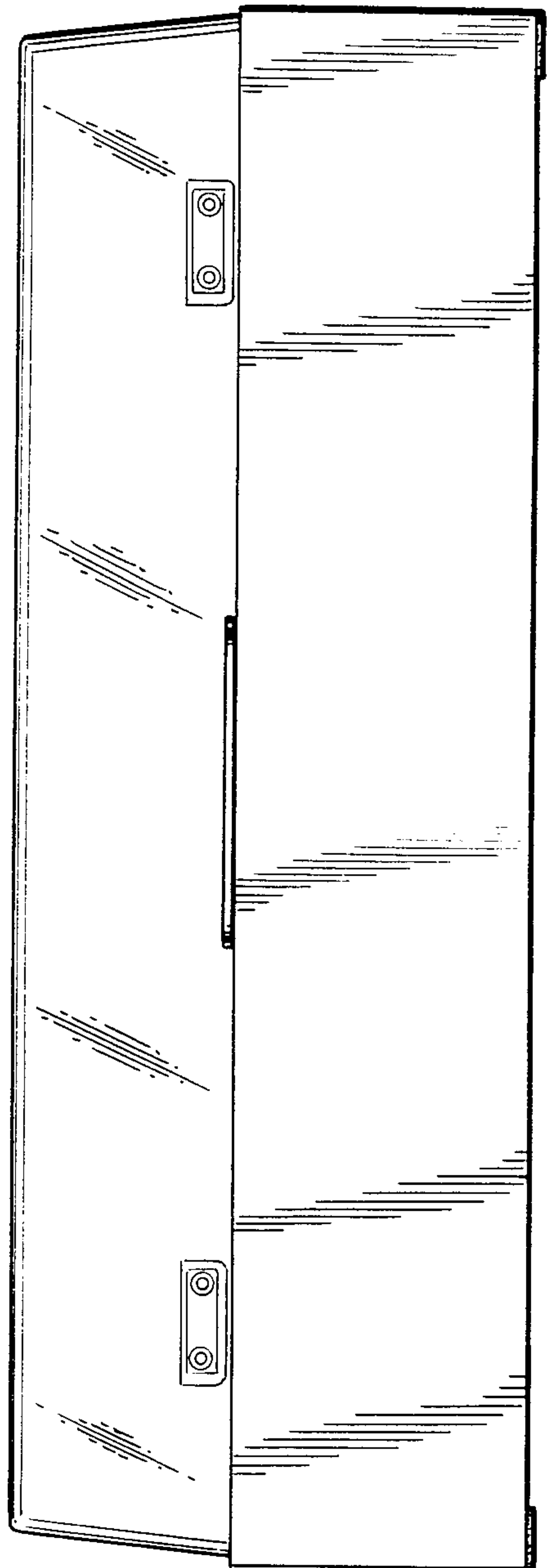

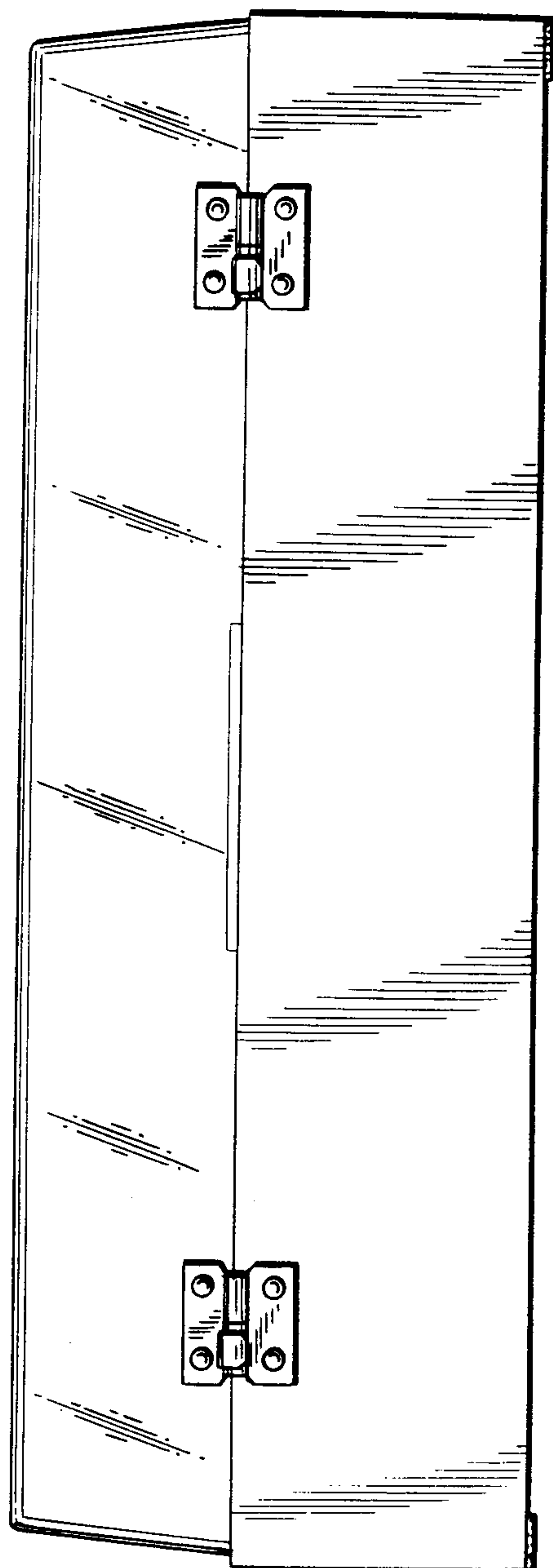

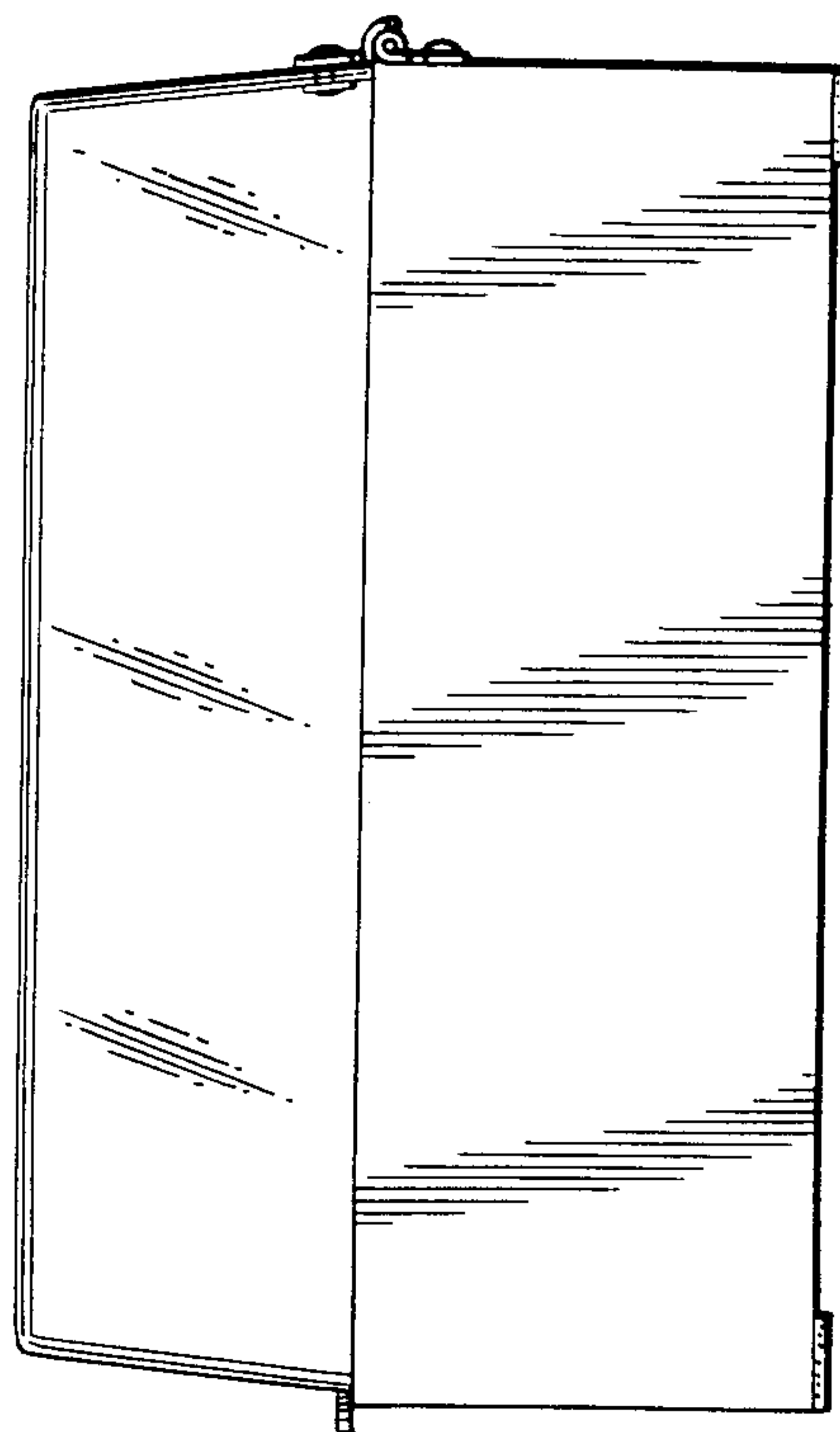
