[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a heart-shaped dish, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the heart-shaped dish embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the bottom of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the left side of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the right side of FIG. 3; and

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the right side of FIG. 4.
