[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a serving tray, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a first embodiment of a serving tray showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken along the line 4-4 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof.

The second embodiment is identical to the embodiment of FIGS. 1-5 except for the raised central portion of the upper surface which is fully disclosed in Fig 6.

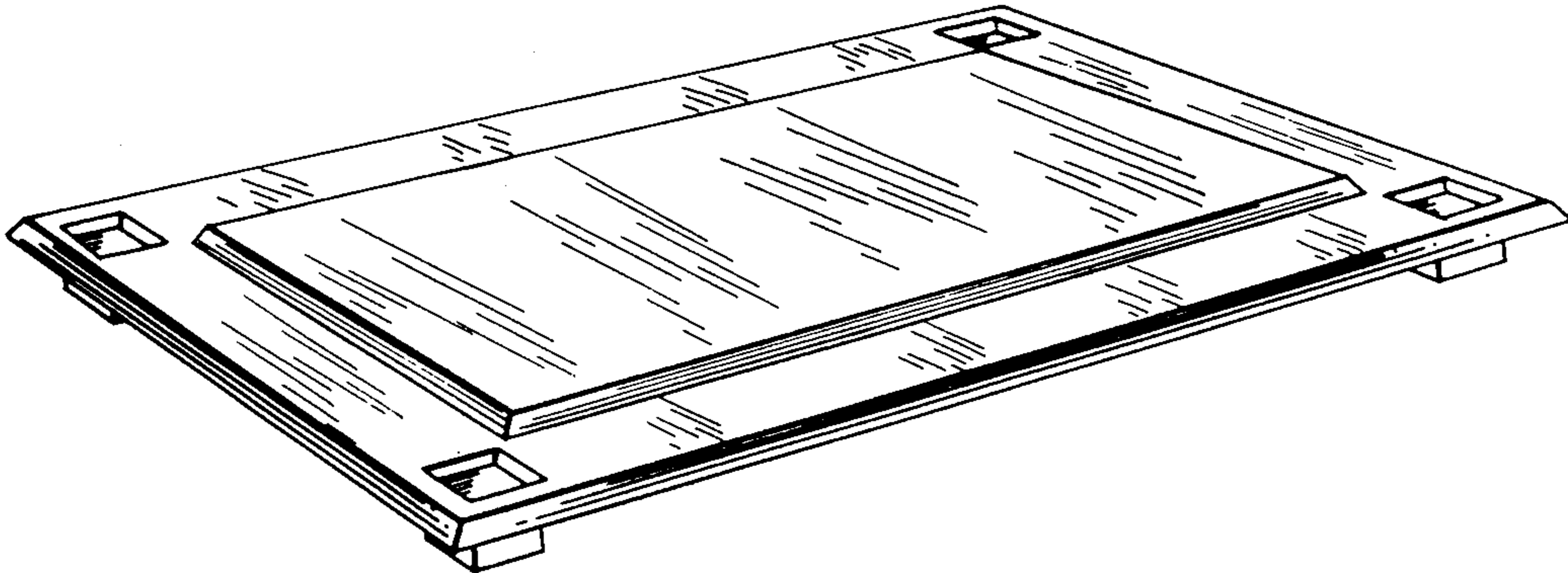
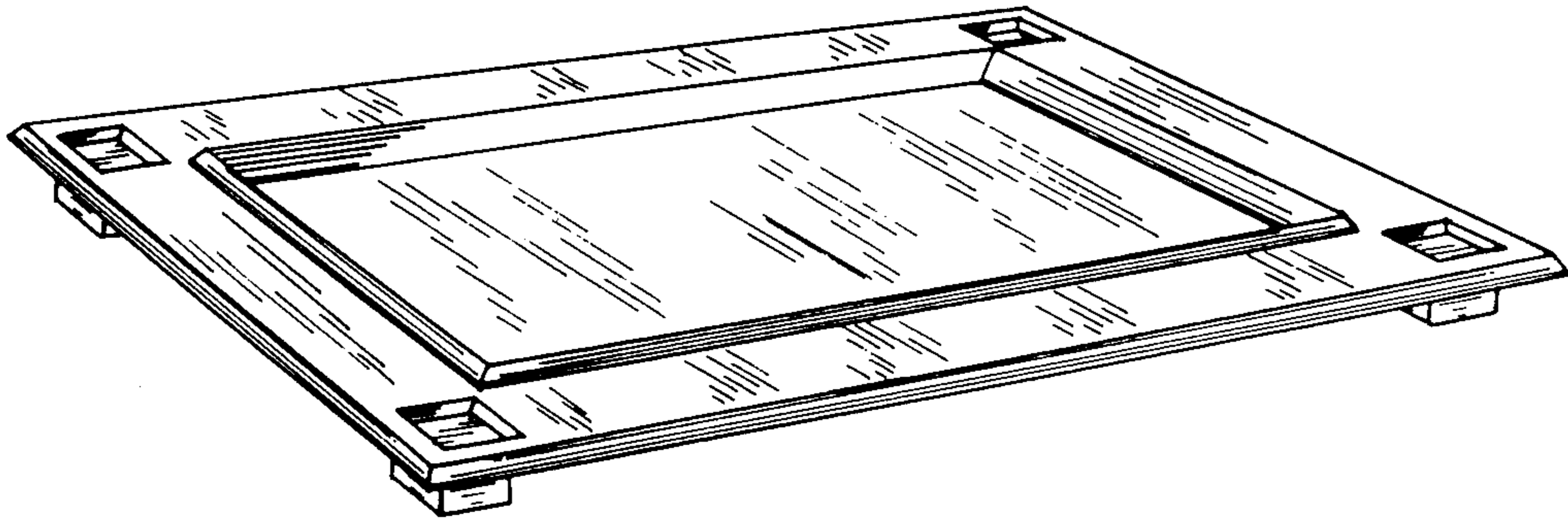
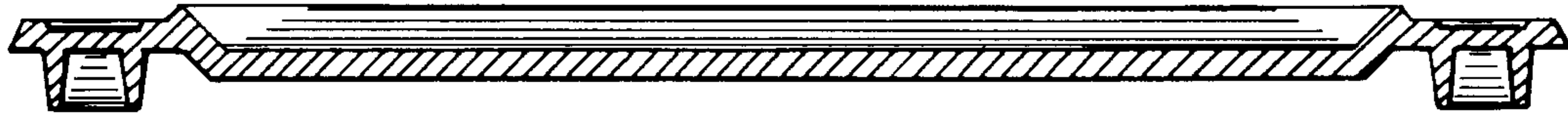

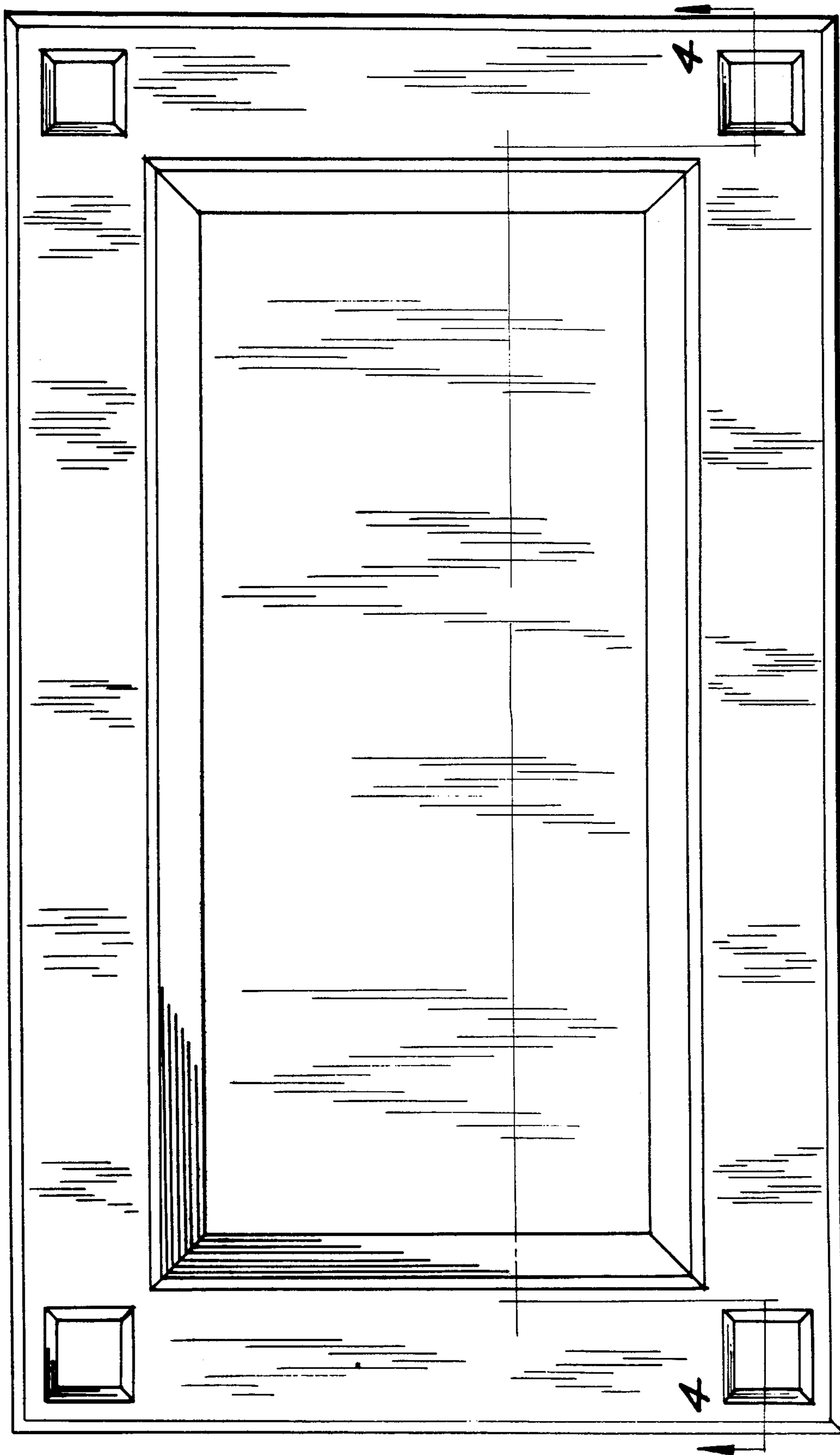

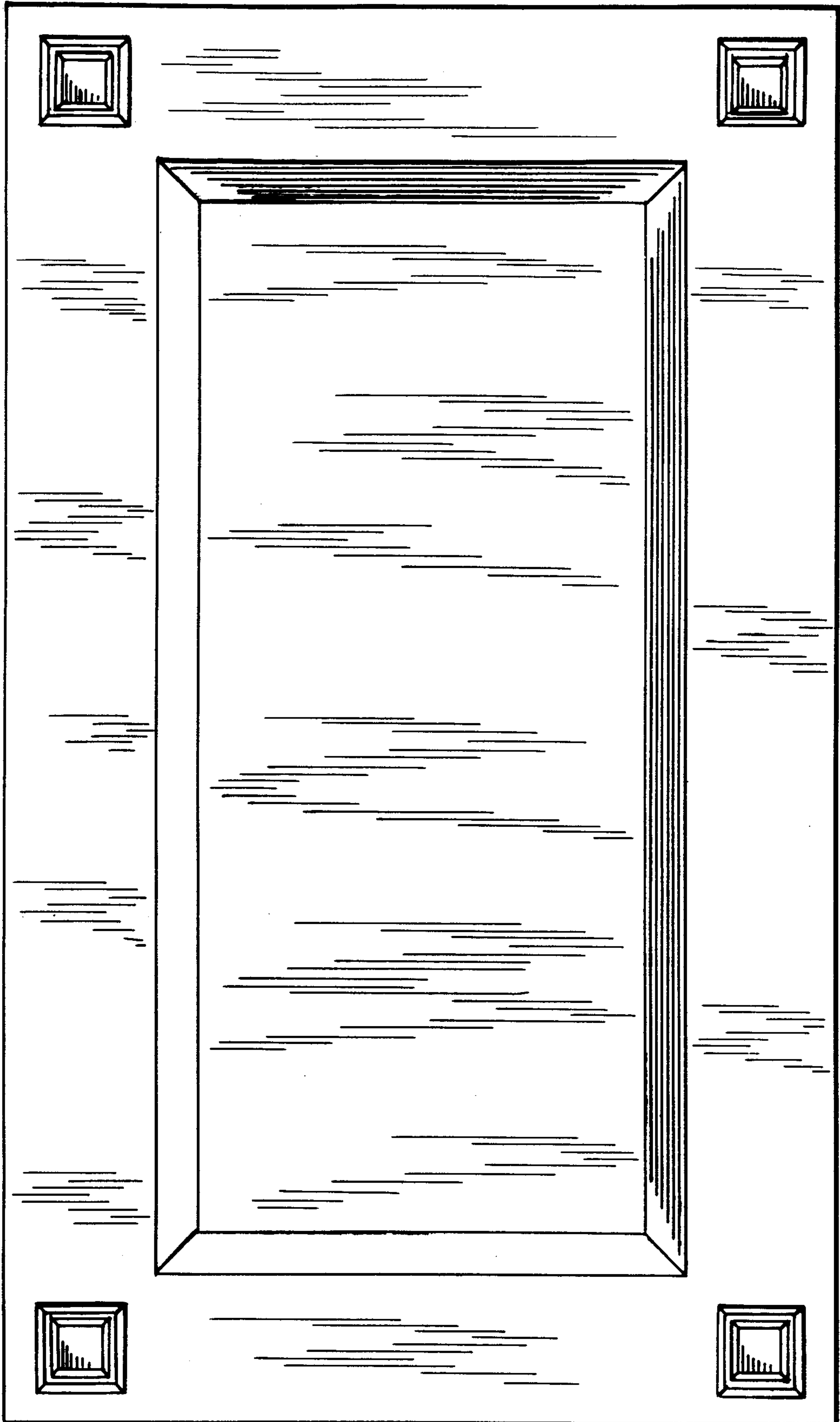

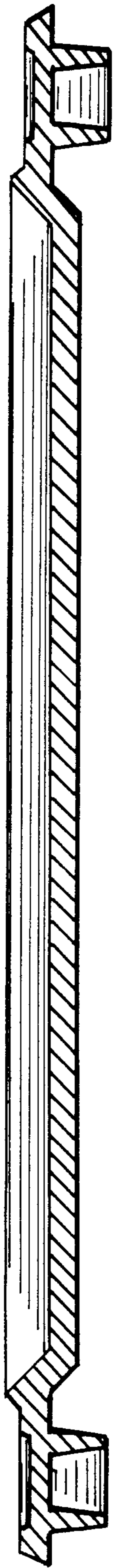

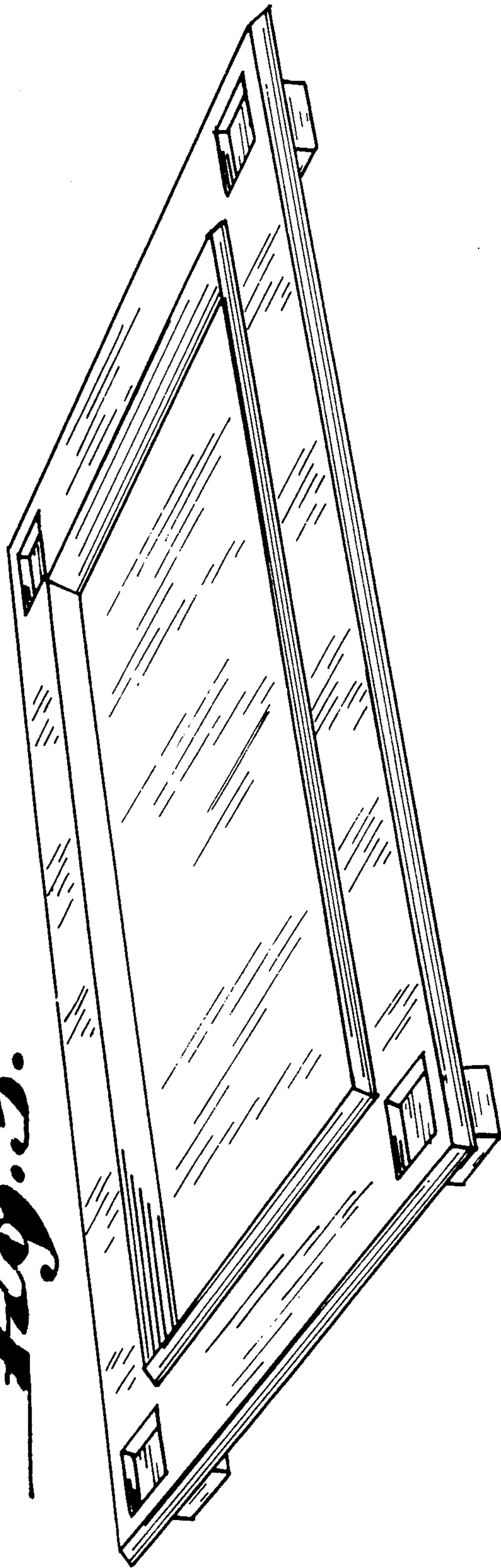
