[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a walk-up banking building, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a walk-up banking building taken generally from the left front; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 6 is a sectional view from the walkway facing the building; FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken from the walkway facing the pillar; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view illustrating the exterior ceiling of the walkway, the remaining portions of the building in the bottom view are non-ornamental. The roof of the building is non-ornamental.

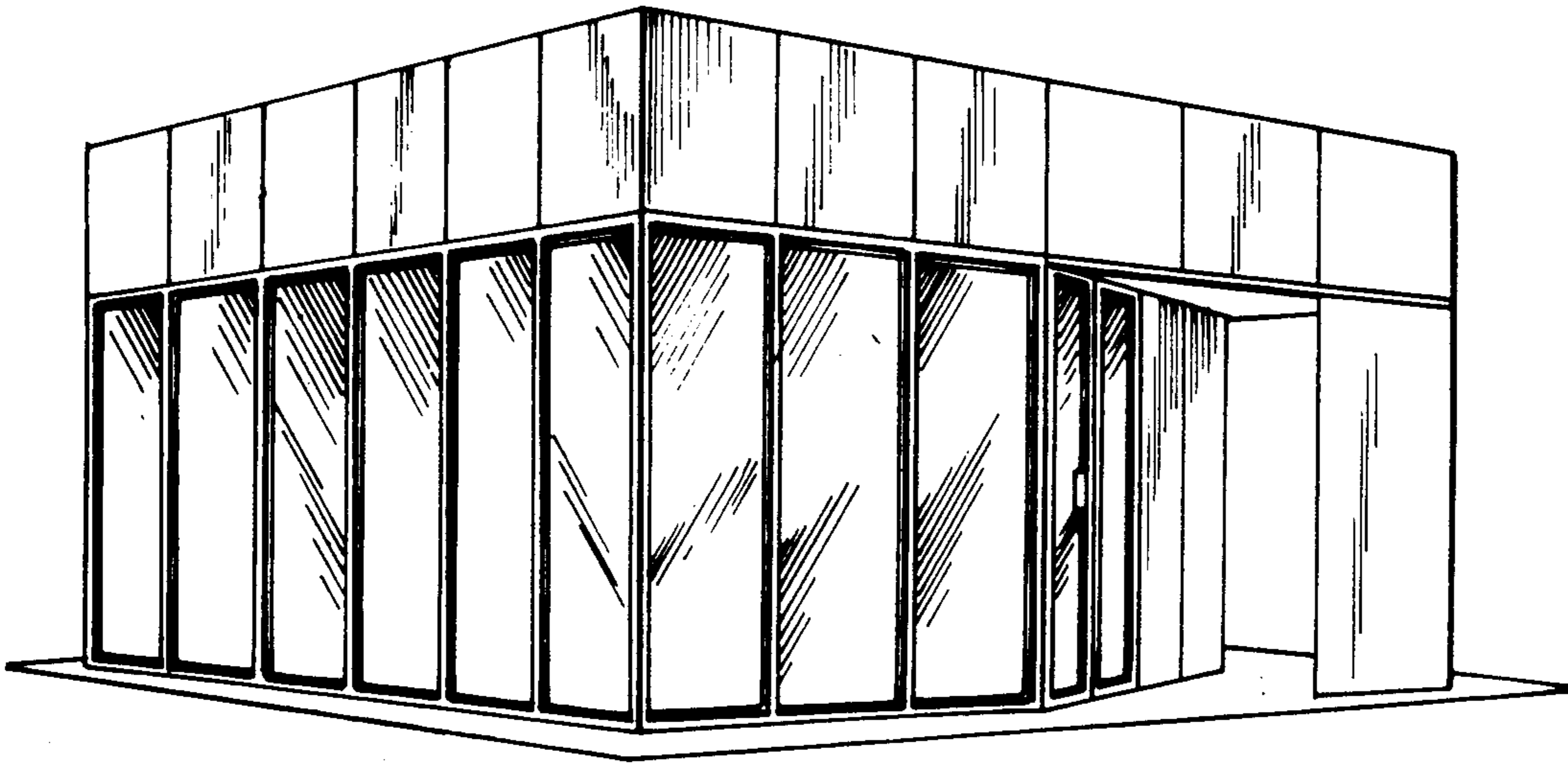

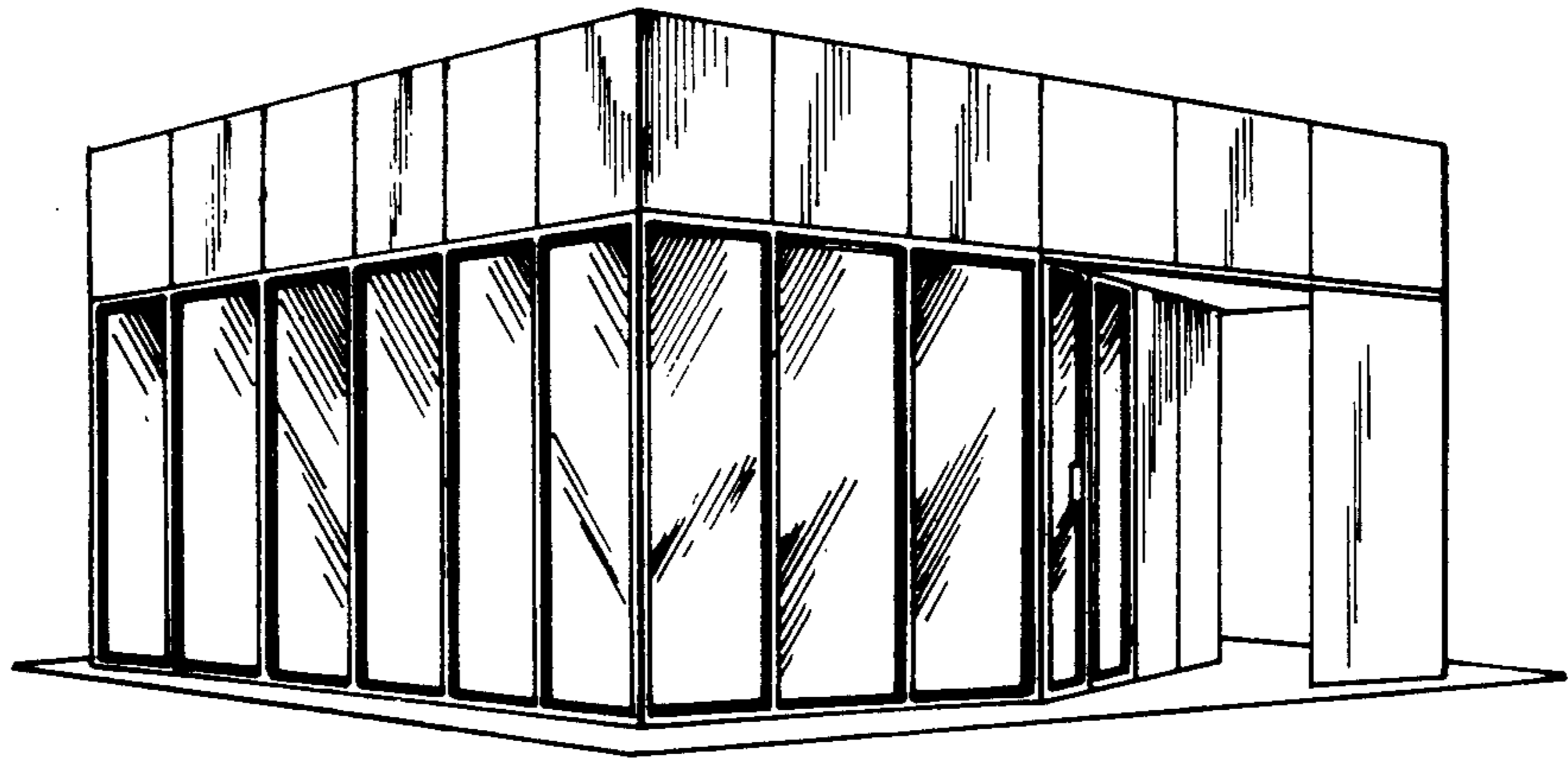

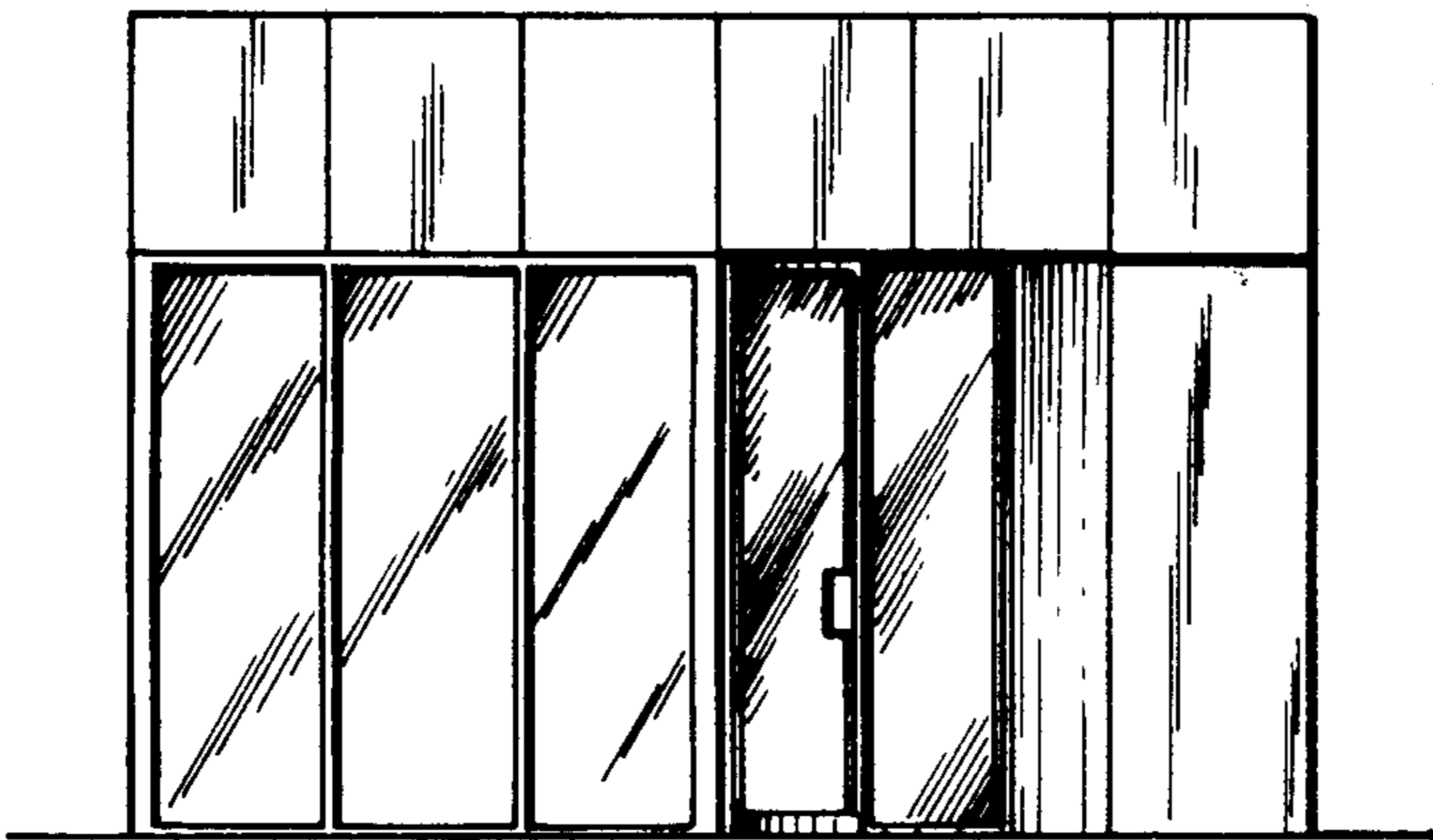

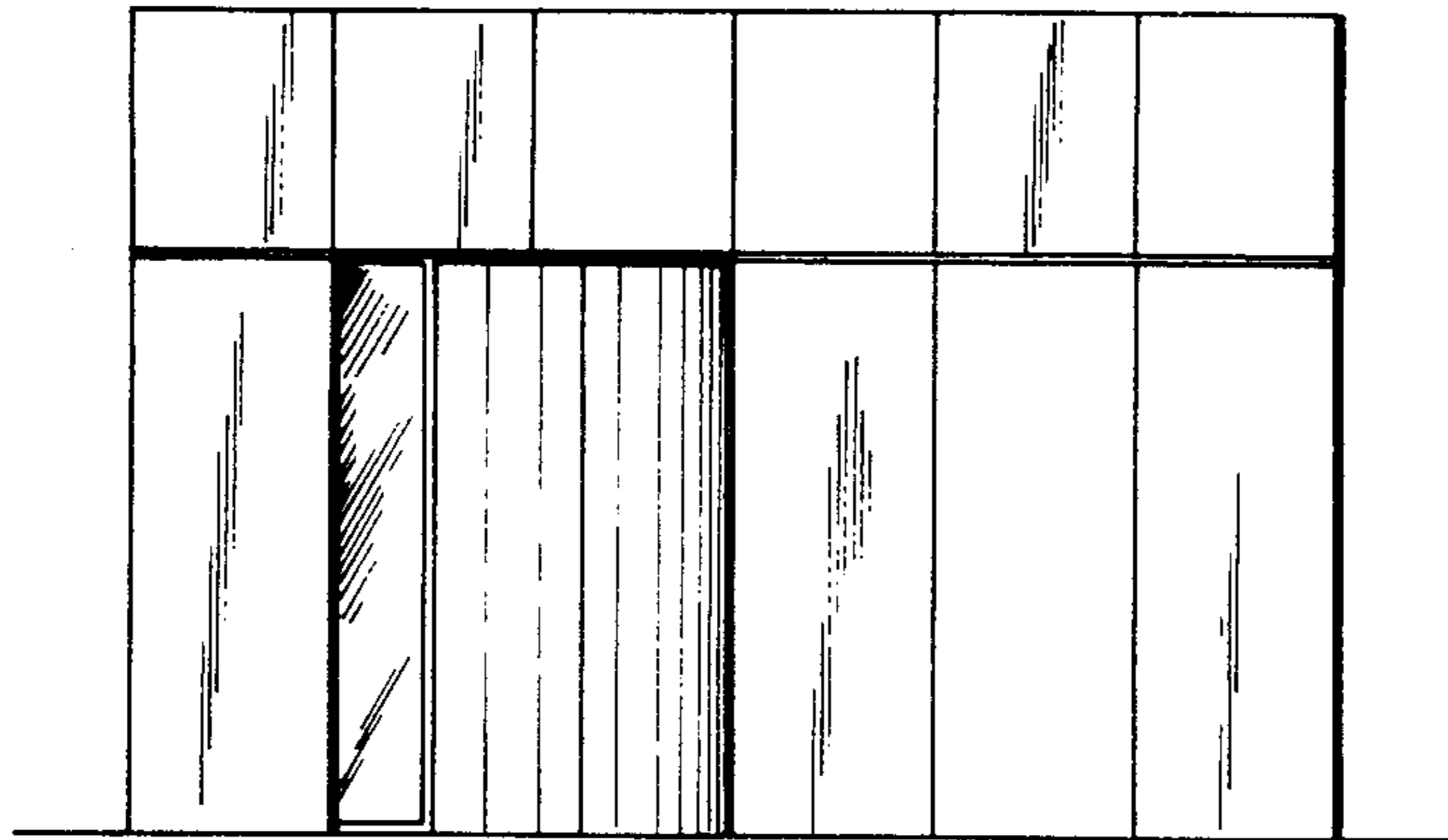

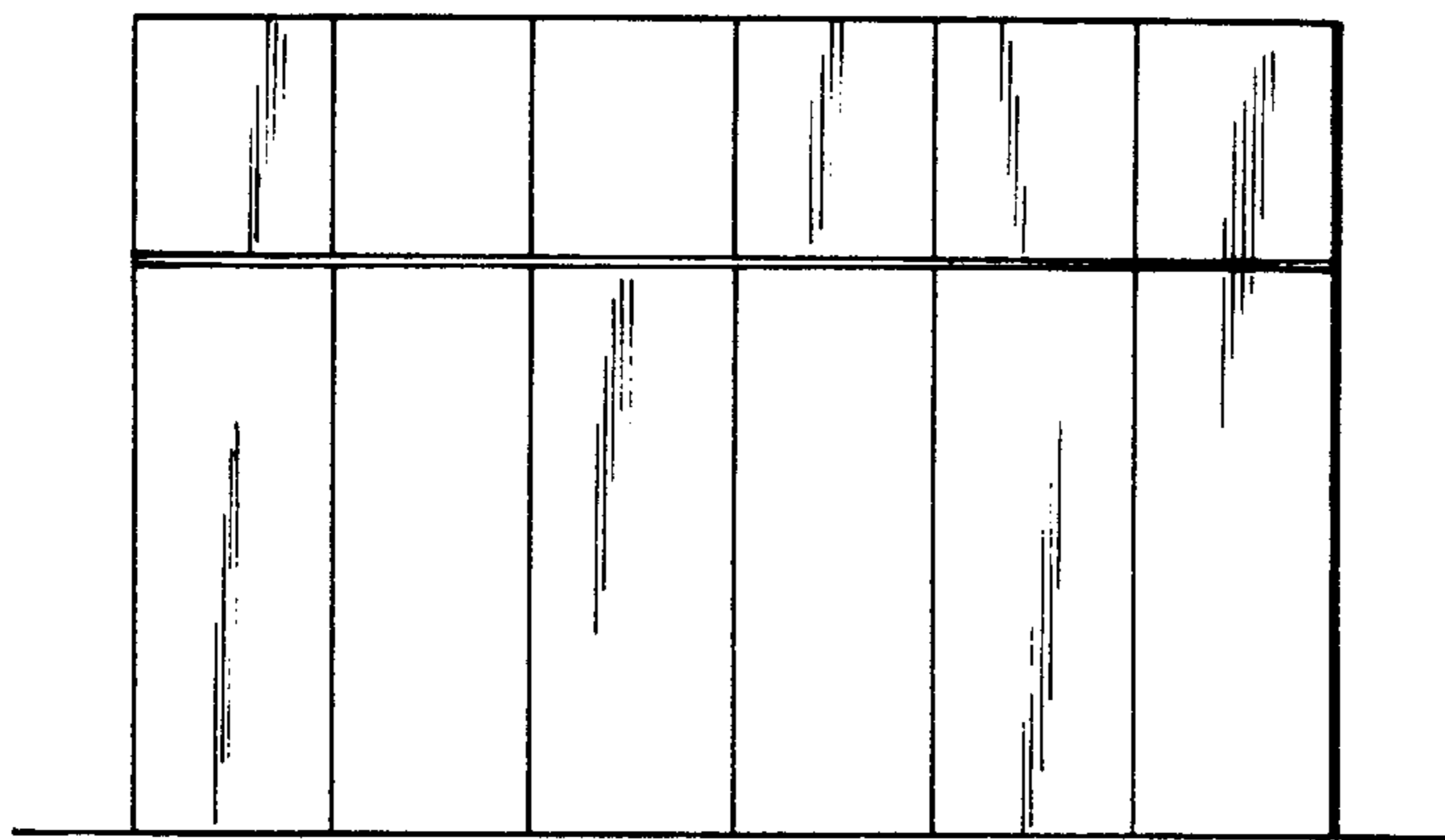

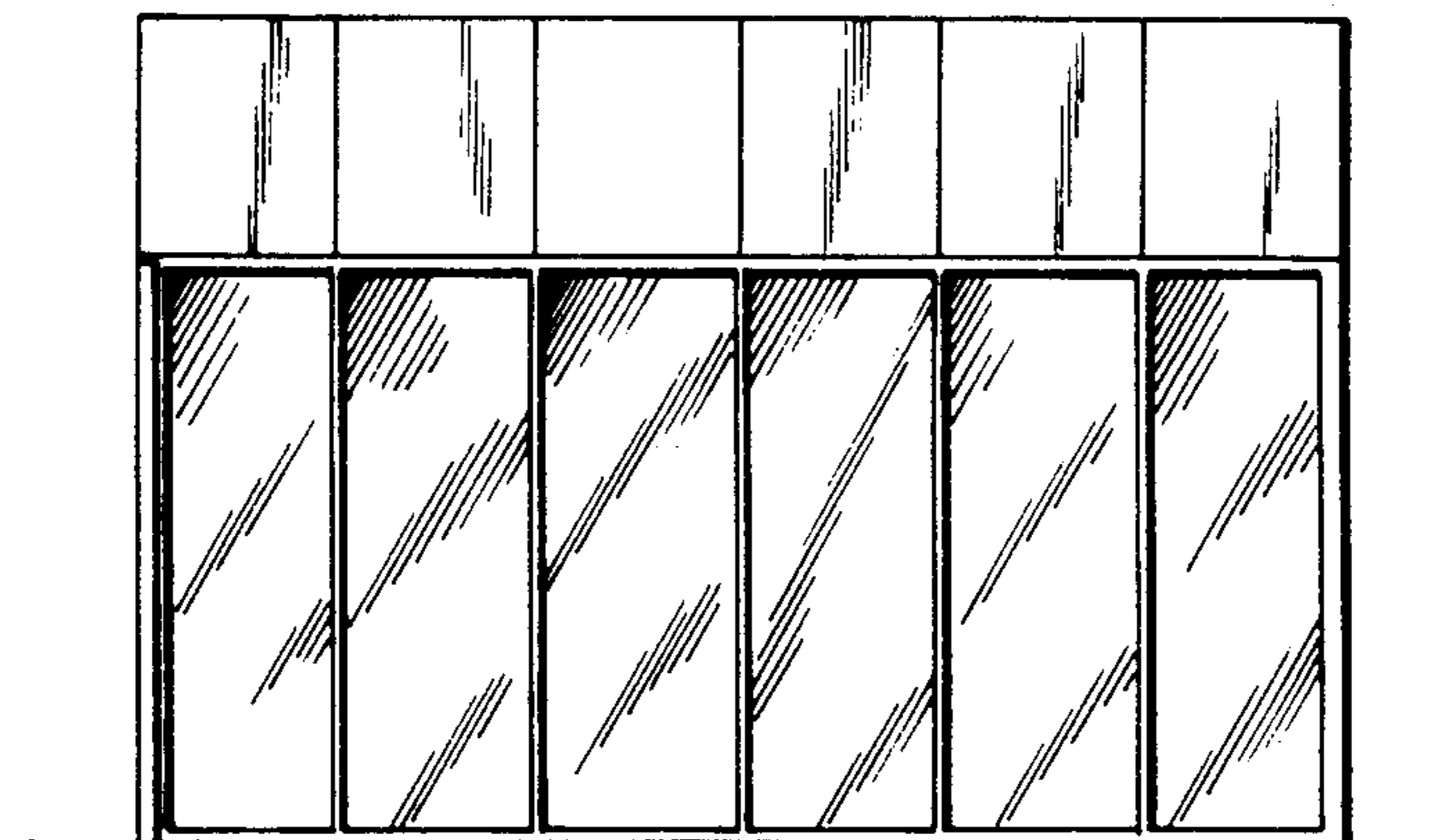

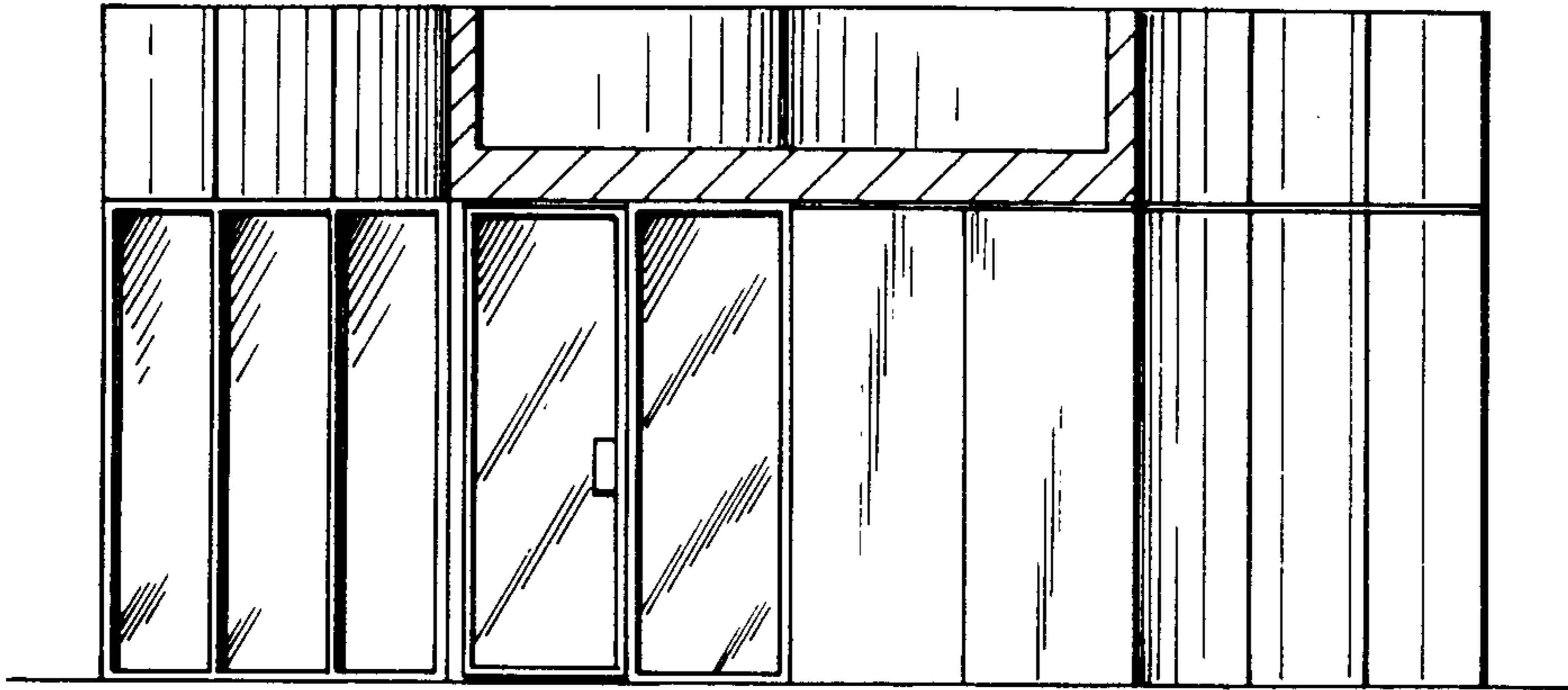

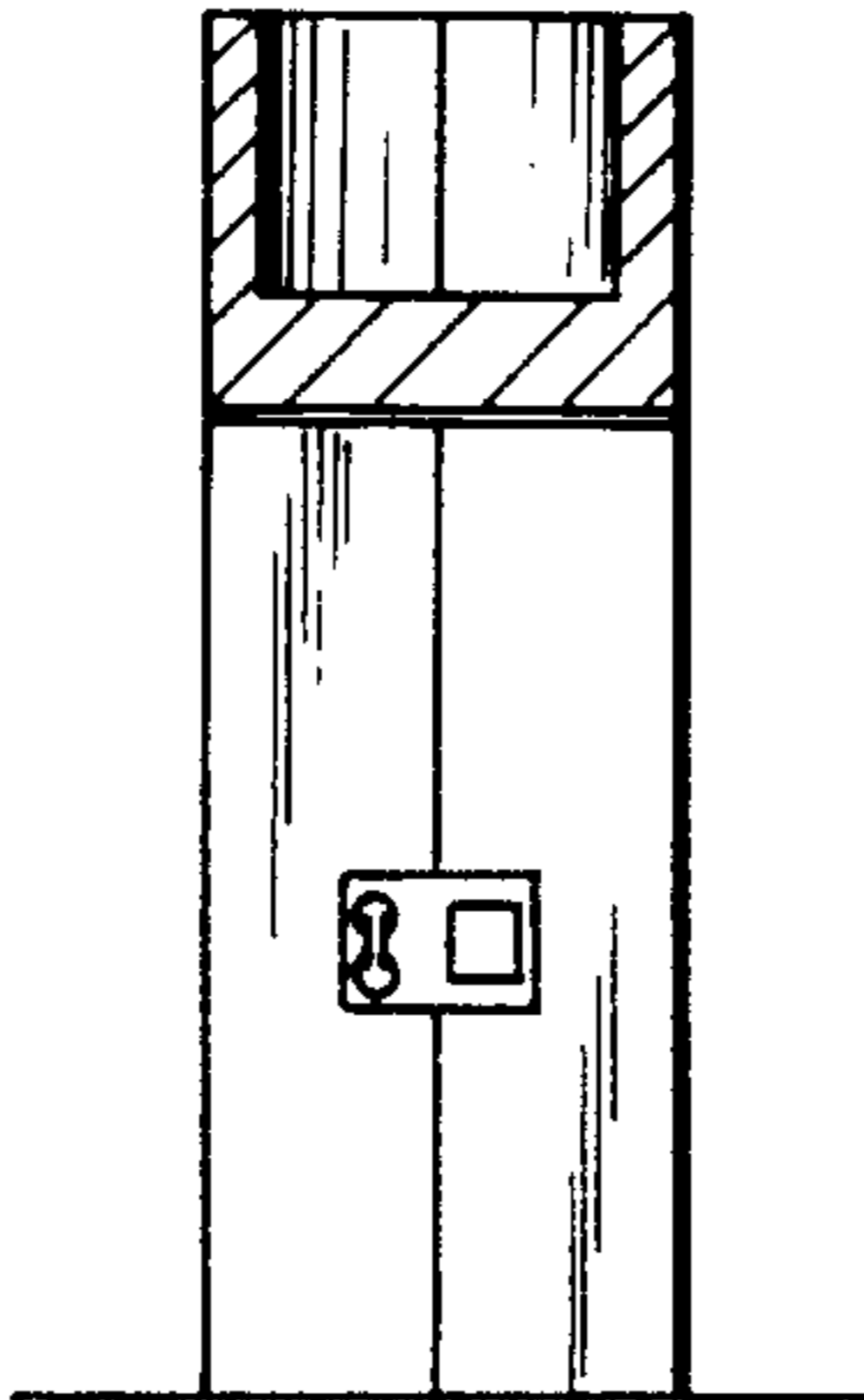

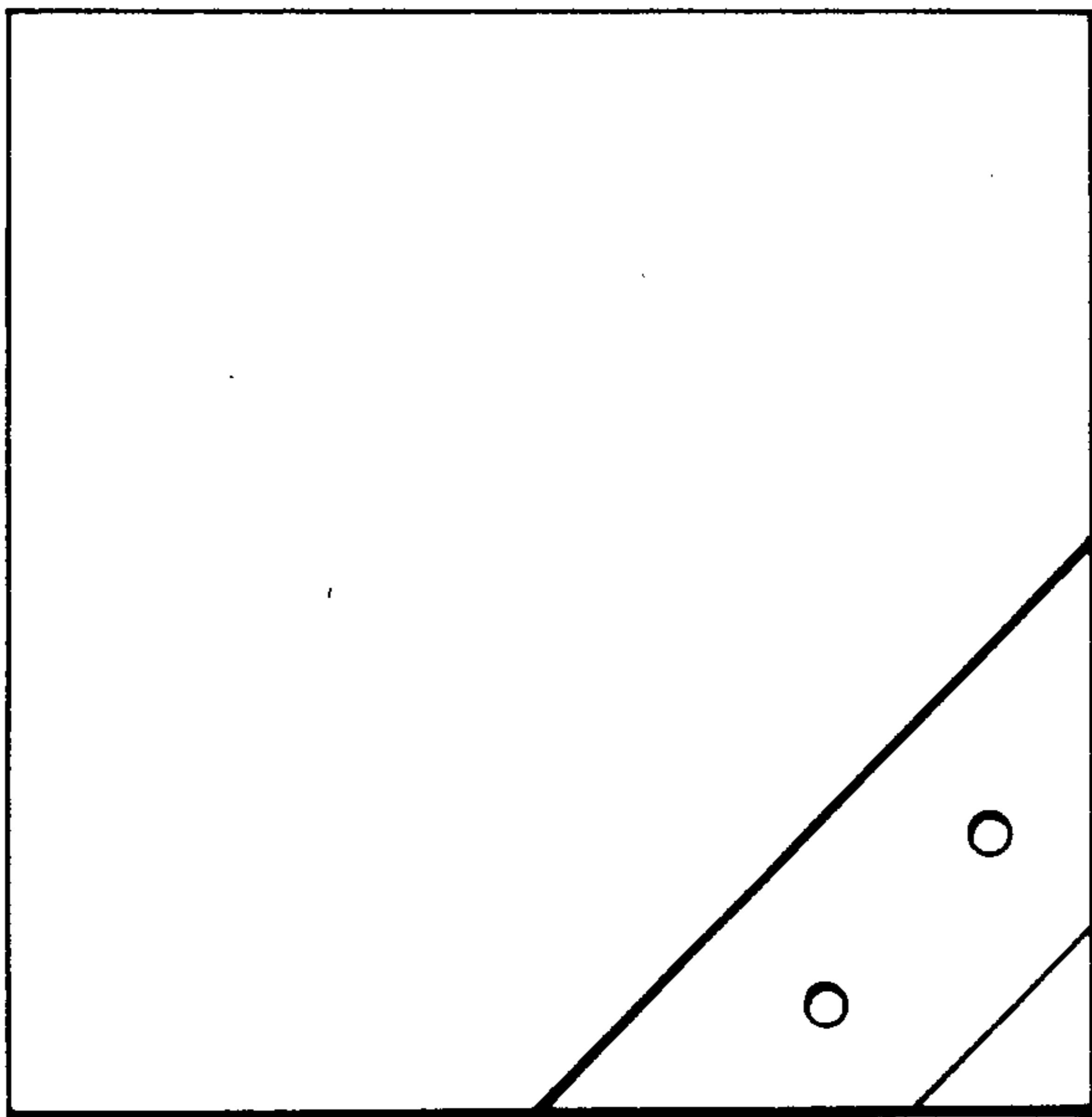
